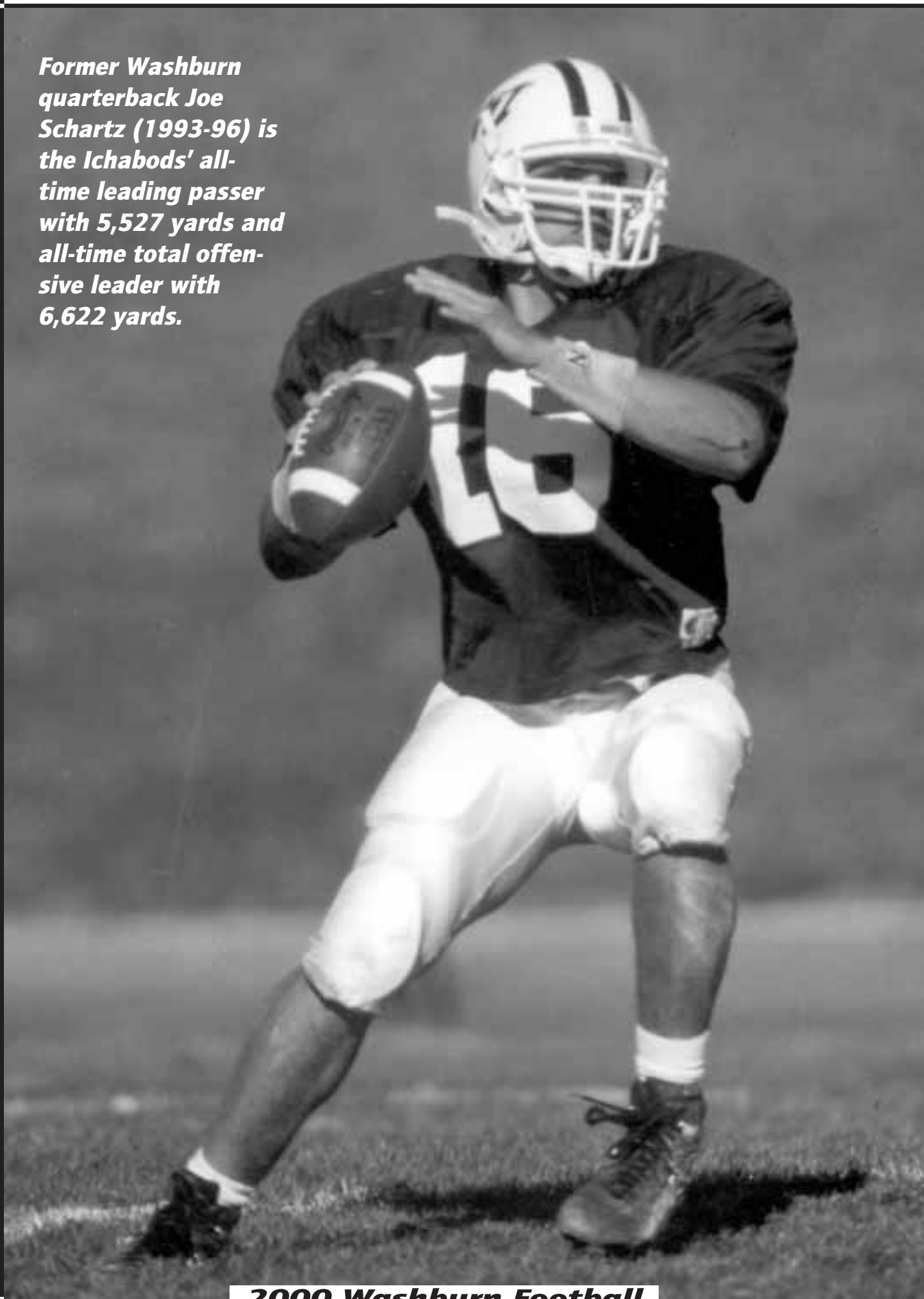

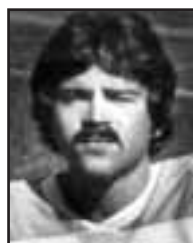

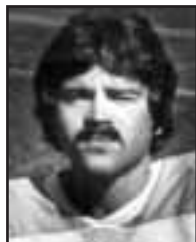

Former Washburn receiver Michael Dritlein (1992-95) is the Ichabods' career leader in pass receptions and receiving yards. His 3,103 career receiving yards ranks first in MIAA history. He is the only Ichabod to lead the team in receiving all four years of a career. Dritlein was the 'Bods last all-America selection making the second team in 1995.
