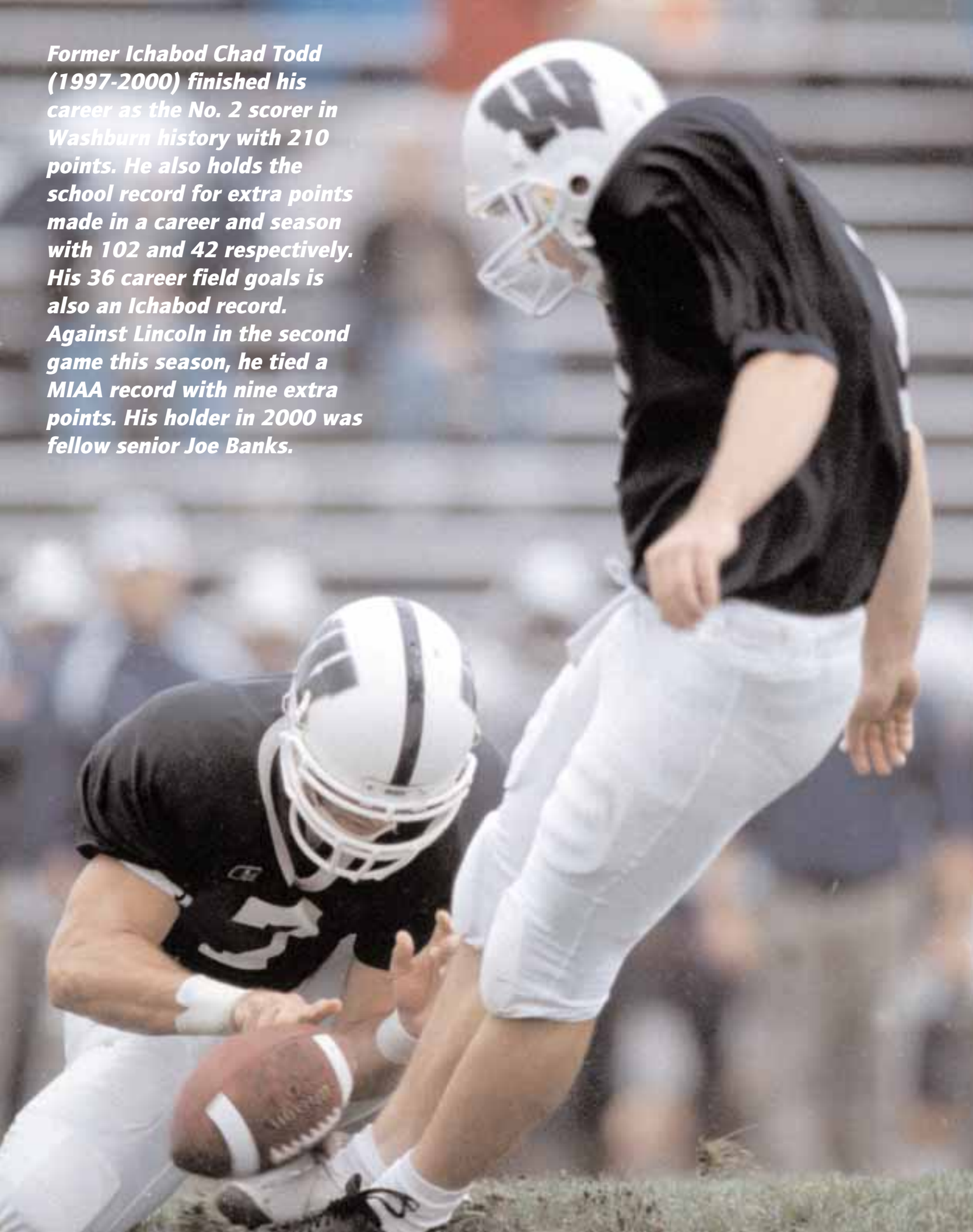


Former Ichabod Chad Todd (1997-2000) finished his career as the No. 2 scorer in Washburn history with 210 points. He also holds the school record for extra points made in a career and season with 102 and 42 respectively. His 36 career field goals is also an Ichabod record. Against Lincoln in the second game this season, he tied a MIAA record with nine extra points. His holder in 2000 was fellow senior Joe Banks.

The Washburn Ichabods provided a dominating performance in their 2000 opener against Wisconsin-Lacrosse. The Ichabods downed the Eagles 26-6 in the 108 degree heat for their third-straight season opening victory.

Freshman quarterback Tyler Schuerman wasn't showing his age in his first start for Washburn. Schuerman rushed for 102 yards and passed for 97 more, becoming the first Washburn player since Willie Sapp in 1997 to rush for over 100 yards.

Chad Todd kicked his first of a Washburn record-tying four field goals with a 39-yarder to open the scoring at 7:42 in the first quarter. Brandon Rainer became the first Ichabod to score a touchdown this season with 1-yard score with 2:42 left in the first.

Todd added three more field goals, including a 47-yard kick to give Washburn a 19-0 lead after three quarters. The 47-yard kick tied a personal best.

Corey Crain added an 18-yard touchdown with 8:19 left in the ballgame, while Mike Smith put the Eagles on the board with a 2-yard score with 2:22 to play.

Rainer ran 11 times for 59 yards, while Colon McNeal caught three passes for 53 yards.

The Ichabod defense forced four turnovers, while Clarence Williams and Chris Simmons came up with six tackles apiece.

The Ichabods' 63 points was the highest total since they rolled up a 61-0 win over McPherson College in 1995.

Junior fullback Brandon Rainer led the Ichabod attack with 105 yards rushing on 16 attempts, averaging 6.6 yards per carry. Rainer also lit the score-board with three touchdowns. Freshman quarterback Tyler Schuerman ran for 83 yards on 12 carries. Schuerman also ran for four touchdowns and completed four passes on nine attempts for 50 yards.

After leading at halftime 28-14, the Ichabods scored touchdowns on five-of-its six possessions in the second half. Senior placekicker Chad Todd tied an MIAA record with nine extra points in a game.

The Ichabods totaled 417 total offensive yards and recorded five sacks for 29 yards. The Ichabods also had 15 different people record a tackle for loss. Junior safety Jeremy Potts recorded a team high six tackles and three pass breakups.

The Ichabods opened the MIAA season with a 24-22 win over Missouri Southern in Joplin, Mo.The Ichabods fans had hardly got to their seats as Missouri Southern took the opening kickoff and on the Lions second play, watched the Lions' Antonio Whitney run 87 yards for the first score of the ball game.

After trading three-and-outs, the Lions then marched 77 yards in six plays for another score to take a 13-0 lead. Washburn's first score would come at the 5:51 mark of the second quarter with a 66-yard drive on five plays capped by a Brandon Rainer 1-yd touchdown run.

Missouri Southern would then take the lead going into the half driving 64 yards in nine plays in 2:16 seconds to lead 14-12 at the break. The Schuerman-Banks combo connected again with 6:23 left in the third quarter for a 29-yd touchdown pass completing a 93-yd, 10-play drive.

For the game, the Ichabods were led on the ground by Brandon Rainer who had 90 yards on 13 carries and one touchdown. Schuerman ran for 71 on 19 carries. Schuerman was 8 of 27 passing for 147 yards and his first two Washburn touch-down passes. Joe Banks had four receptions for 69 yards and two touchdowns.

On defense, Ryan Huske and Chad Gordon each had seven tackles. Dan Wilson had two sacks for 17 yards.

The Washburn Ichabod football team tasted defeat for the first time this season in their MIAA home opener 23-13 against Missouri Western in Moore Bowl. Washburn trailed 3-0 late in the first half, before Brandon Rainer put the Ichabods on the scoreboard with a 10-yard touchdown with 2:47 left.

The Ichabods looked to go up 13-3 on a 33-yard run by quarterback Tyler Schuerman. The play was called back on a holding penalty and momentum shifted to the Griffons. Missouri Western scored the next 20 points in the ballgame, taking a 23-7 lead with 4:43 left on a 13-yard pass to Jerris Evans from Kasey Waterman.

Washburn tried to rally back with a pass to Colon McNeal. McNeal caught the ball at the Missouri Western 45, ran it to the 25 before pitching it to Chris Whittle. Whittle took it into the end zone, but the attempt at a two-point conversion failed.

Brandon Rainer rushed for 105 yards on 19 carries, Tyler Schuerman passed for 220 yards on 11 of 17 passing, while Colon McNeal had a career-high 149 receiv- ing yards on 7 catches. Brandon Perry led Missouri Western with 195 yards on 30 carries.

Six Washburn Ichabod turnovers leading to 21 points for the Central Missouri State Mules was the story of the game.

The Ichabods piled up 22 first downs, compared to 15 for the Mules, 295 yards rushing compared to 136 for CMSU, and 409 yards in total offense compared to 237 for CMSU however, the Ichabods turned the ball over on three of their first six drives in the first half and had another fumble that was recovered by themselves.

The Mules got on the board first with a 6-yd run. The Ichabods came back putting together a nine-play, 70-yd drive capped by a Tyler Schuerman 33-yd touchdown run.

The Ichabods took the lead midway through the third quarter on a Chad Todd 40-yd field goal, his 35th of his WU career, topping Nick Kresic's mark of 34.

The Mules would then score 21-unanswered points to go up 28-10. The Bods would score again on another 70-yd drive finished off by Darryl Humphrey's 3-yd touchdown run.

Schuerman led the Bods with 97 yards rushing and we was 12-21 for 128 yards and three interceptions. Brandon Rainer carried the ball 16 times for 76 yards before leaving in the third quarter with an injury. Colon McNeal had four catches for 42 yards. Corey Phipps led the defense with 10 tackles.

Game #6 Washburn34 Missouri-Rolla14

Oct. 7, 2000 • Allgood-Bailey Stadium • Rolla, Mo.

The Washburn Ichabods improved to 4-2 and 2-2 in the MIAA with a 34-14 win over the University of Missouri-Rolla Miners.

The Miners jumped out to a 14-0 lead over the Ichabods on a pair of long touchdown runs. UMR's Ken Okwuonu took the Miners' first play from scrimmage for 58 yards for a score. Midway through the second quarter, Darron Boyer and the Miners' took a play out of the 'Bods playbook on an end-around for 67 yards.

The Ichabods took the ensuing kickoff and put together a five-play 50-yd drive capped by a Reggie Jones 14-yd touchdown run.

After the Washburn defense forced a three-and-out for the Miners, the Ichabods took the next possession for a touchdown - a 41-yd touch-down strike from Tyler Schuerman to Colon McNeal tying the score at 14 at the half.

Coming out after the break, the Washburn defense forced another Miner punt. Washburn would take the ball 48 yards on six plays capped by a Schuerman 9-yd touchdown run to put the 'Bods up for good. Schuerman would score two more touch-downs on a pair of 2-yd runs to put the Ichabods up 34-14.

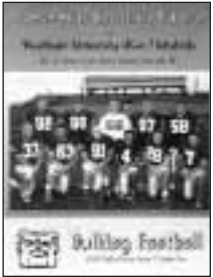

Schuerman broke the Washburn total offense record with 2,644 yards. He also bettered his school-record rushing touchdown mark to 16. Brandon Rainer rushed 15 times for a team-high 70 yards.
