2002 Season Flashback



Bods win 3 of last 6 games under new coach, program and attitude

The 2002 edition of the Washburn Ichabod football team was a list of firsts and lasts over the 11-game schedule in which the Ichabods finished 3-8 under first-year head coach Craig Schurig.

After starting the last season in Moore Bowl with a tough loss to Wisconsin-La Crosse, in which the Ichabods lost three starters to various injuries, Washburn continually improved throughout the rest of the season to win three of its last six games.

The first win of the season for the Ichabods and Schurig came on Oct. 12 against Truman State in Kirksville. The Ichabods gained some revenge for 2001 when the Bulldogs beat Washburn on homecoming 27-26, on a last second 47-yard field goal.

The Ichabods defeated the Bulldogs 26-21 and it was the first win for Washburn in Kirksville in school history.

"It was great to get that first win,"
Schurig said. "It was important to this
program, these players and our staff to get it because
everyone had worked so hard."

The biggest of the three wins came in 10 Ichabod senior's final game in Moore Bowl Nov. 2 against arch-rival and No. 16 ranked Emporia State 34-21. The win was the first over the Hornets snapped an 11-game slide to Emporia State.

"We knew this was going into the Emporia State game, that it was going to be a great day for Washburn athletics and the whole university," said head coach Craig Schurig.

Coming off the big win over Emporia State, the Ichabod defense posted a shutout in a 49-0 white-washing over Missouri-Rolla on the road. The shutout was the first for the Ichabods in 36 games, last coming in a 36-0 win over Southwest Baptist on Oct. 14, 1999.

"The shutout was really great," Schurig said. "When you look back at our defense improved from week one against La Crosse to the Missouri-Rolla game and even to the Southwest Baptist game, by the end our defense made tremendous strides and we expect that same improvement to carry into the 2003 season."

Even though the Ichabods opened the season with five straight losses, the team stayed together and bought into the program the coaching staff was implementing.

During the 2002 season, the Ichabods did have some outstanding single-game and season outings breaking several school records.

• Senior punter Eric Roth broke the single-season school record for average with a 42.5 clip eclipsing the previous mark of 42.0 by Brent Cripps recorded in

the all-time career chart with an average of 38.2 and total yardage list with 7,800 yards.

1977. Roth finished his career fourth on both

 2002 MIAA Freshman of the Year Sam Sissom broke several school records including most receiv-

ing touchdowns by a freshman in a season with 12.
The freshman record for a season was three, and
Sissom had three in a single game on two separate occa-

sions against Missouri Western and Missouri Southern. His 719 receiving yards also set a new freshman record. He also became the first freshman since Michael Dritlein in 1992 to lead the team in receiving.

- Sophomore quarterback Dustin Hickel snapped the sophomore record for passing yards in a season with 2,160 while falling two touchdown passes short of tying the school record of 23. Hickel also accounted for 28 total offensive touchdowns setting a new record and his 2,571 total offensive yards was the second highest in school history.
- Senior punt returner Patrick Hayes finished his career with 51 kick returns tying the school record and his 23.3 yards per kick return places him third on the all-time chart. Hayes recorded these stats playing in parts of three seasons and missing 10 games as a senior after suffering a knee injury.
- Senior returner Corey Crain is the only Ichabod in the last 17 seasons to return a kickoff for a touchdown joining Ed Vacek, finishing second on the career kickoff return chart with a 24.6 average.

Topeka - Sept. 7 - The Washburn Ichabods opened the 2002 season with a 31-17 loss in its 1,000th game in school history.

The Ichabods' junior quarterback Tyler Schuerman was injured on the first play of the game. To open the 2001 season, Schuerman injured his knee on the sixth play of the season against Wisconsin-La Crosse.

The Ichabods jumped out to a 3-0 lead on freshman Aaron DeKosky's 36-yard field goal with 11:22 left in the first half. That score was set up by Andrew Mocadlo's fumble on the Eagles' first play of scrimmage after taking a

hard hit from senior cornerback Corey Crain. Junior Morgan Dewey recovered to set up the initial score of the game.

The Eagles would then score the next 17 points on a pair of touchdown passes of 77- and 64-yards and a 46-yard field goal.

Junior wideout DaWight Benning and sophomore Dustin Hickel would then hook up on a 55-yard touchdown pass with 1:53 left in the second quarter. The Eagles would then score another touchdown pass right before the half.



Neither team would score in the third quarter. The Ichabods would start the fourth quarter with a punt block for a touchdown. Freshman Bobby Nelson blocked the punt and junior Brooks Myers recovered it in the endzone to cut the Eagles led to 24-17. The Eagles would add another score to push the margin to 14.

On defense, sophomore Joe Corcoran led the Ichabods with 11 tackles. Nelson had nine tackles and a forced fumble to go with his blocked punt and Dewey also had nine including 2 tackles for loss.

Senior punter Eric Roth had nine punts for 395 yards including a 63-yard attempt on his first punt of the season.

Brooks Myers picked up a blocked Eagles' punt in the endzone in the Ichabods' first game of the 2002 season.

Hays - Sept. 14 - The Washburn Ichabods scored two touchdowns in the final 1:42 of the game with Fort Hays State, but it wasn't enough as the Tigers pulled out a 37-29 win over the Ichabods.

The Ichabods opened the scoring with a 9-yard touchdown pass from sophomore Dustin Hickel to freshman Sam Sissom capping a 72-yard, eight play drive However the Tigers would come back before the first quarter ended to tied the score at seven. Earlier in the drive, junior Brooks Myers picked off a Dustin Demel pass, but a roughing the quarterback penalty against the Ichabods kept the drive alive allowing the tying touchdown.

In the second quarter, the Tigers would take the lead on a 37-yard field goal but with 5:06 remaining in the quarter, junior wide receiver DaWight Benning would score a 30-yard touchdown run on a reverse to put the Ichabods in front 14-10 going into the halftime break.

The lone score in the third quarter would be a Jason Broom touchdown run for the Tigers as they would take the lead for good 30-14. After a pair of touchdowns by FHSU pushing the Tiger lead to 30-14, the Ichabods would mount a furious rally to cut the lead to eight on Sissom's second touchdown reception of the evening from

back-up quarterback Cason Lehman, who replaced Hickel for a few plays.

Lehman would then run the swinging gate play for the two point conversion cutting the lead to 30-22.

The Ichabods would then drive 64 yards in six plays as Benning would score his second touchdown of the night on a 36-yard pass reception from Hickel to cut the score to the final 37-29 margin.

Hickel would finish 16 of 27 for 191 yards and two touchdown passes and lead the team with 31 yards rushing. Benning caught four passes for 79 yards and the lone touchdown. Freshman Grant Gould led the Ichabods with 13 tackles and junior Eric Taylor recorded 12. Sophomore Joe Corcoran recorded 11 and senior Chad Gordon picked up 10.



The Gorillas took the opening kickoff and drove 86 yards in 12 plays to take an early 7-0 lead. Pitt State would then score a pair of touchdowns and lead 21-0 after one quarter.


The Ichabods were shutout in the second half as the Gorillas added a



Kirksville - Oct. 12 - To payback a loss that ruined the Ichabods' 2001 homecoming celebration is nice. To land the first win of the season is nicer. Washburn picked up its first win of the season and Craig Schurig landed his first win as a head coach in the 'Bods 26-21 win over Truman State. The loss avenged the Bulldogs win over the Ichabods in last season's homecoming game in Moore Bowl.

The Ichabods jumped on the scoreboard first taking advantage of a Bulldog turnover as DaWight Benning ran the reverse for a 34-yard touchdown run. However the Bulldogs would score on the ensuing possession and take the lead 7-6.

The Bulldogs would close out the scoring in the first half on the first play of the second quarter and take a 14-6 lead into the lockers at halftime.

The Ichabods scored first in the third quarter on Dustin Hickel's 4-yard touchdown scamper to cut the Bulldog lead to 14-12. In the fourth quarter, Sam Sissom would catch his freshman record sixth and seventh touchdown receptions of the season on catches of 27- and 6-yards. He also pulled down a two-point conversion on his first touchdown reception.

The Bulldogs would score with 8:36 left in the game to cut the Ichabod lead to 26-21. The Bulldogs had two chances to take the lead, but the Ichabod defense held and stopped the Bulldogs on both fourth down situations.

The Ichabod defense held the potent Bulldog offense to 373 yards, 108 under their season average and 24 points under their scoring average of 45 points per game. The 'Bods



defense also kept the Bulldog offense in check for 123 yards in the second half and kept held them to 4 of 14 on third down conversions while the Ichabod offense helped out the defense going 12 for 19 on third down. In the third quarter, the Ichabods ran 25 plays compared to seven for the Bulldogs.

Hickel led the Ichabods on the ground gaining 104 yards on 22 carries and one touchdown while completing 15 of 29 passes for 216 yards and two touchdowns. Sissom finished with 93 yards receiving and seven receptions with two touchdowns. Sissom's 469 yards on this season is a new freshman receiving record.

On defense, Joe Corcoran had 12 tackles and an interception and Darold Smith had six tackles with two interceptions.

DaWight Benning had three rushes for 41 yards and one touchdown along with four receptions for 79 yards in the Ichabods 26-21 win over the Bulldogs.



With 3:24 left in the second quarter, the Hornets would cut the lead to eight at 22-14 on a touchdown run by Tad Hatfield.

After the break, the Ichabods would again score with 7:52 left in the third on a 20-yard touchdown pass from Hickel to Dawight Benning capping a 7-play, 60-yard drive. After the Hornets scored with 2:22 left in the third, the Ichabods would finish the scoring on Hickel's 3-yard scamper for a touchdown to push the score to 34-21.

Hickel would finish the game 12 of 27 passing for 240 yards and three touchdowns while


Rolla - Nov. 9 - The Washburn Ichabod defense stonewalled the Miner attack while the Ichabod offense rolled to its highest output of the season in a 49-0 win over Missouri-Rolla. The shutout was the first for the Ichabods since Oct 14, 1999, when the 'Bods shut out Southwest Baptist 36-0 in Bolivar - a span of 36 games.

The Ichabod defense set the tone on the Miners' first possession as on their fourth play from scrimmage, the Ichabods' Grant Gould forced a UMR fumble on the Miners' 33 yard line. Six plays later, WU quarterback Dustin Hickel scampered nine yards for the 'Bods first touchdown.

On the Miners' next series, the Ichabod defense forced another fumble and the Ichabod offense scored another touchdown on Rawshawn Bland's 1-yard touchdown plunge - a two point conversion out of the swinging gate by Cason Lehman put the Ichabods up 15-0.

DaWight Benning rushed for four yards on the fourth play of the second quarter to push the score to 21-0. In the third quarter, freshman Sam Sissom recorded his 12th touchdown reception of the season on a 29-yard touchdown pass from Hickel. The Ichabods would then score 14 points in 20 seconds to end the third quarter to go up 42-0. The first score was a 37-yard touchdown run by Hickel and the second was a 11-yard reverse run by Marcus Miller. Al DeLeon would finish out the scoring for the Ichabods with 13 seconds left in the game on an 8-yard run.

The Ichabods racked up 612 total yards in offense while holding the Miners to 310. Of the 'Bods 612 yards, 361 of them came on the ground - 21 short of the school record set against McPherson in 1995. The 612 yards was 59 yards short of the school record for total offense in



attack with 89 yards and the two rushing touchdowns while DeLeon had eight carries for 84 yards. Hickel passed for 220 yards and one touchdown pass. Hickel recorded overall 319 yards of total offense in three quarters of work as he was relieved by Cason Lehman who finished 4 of 6 for 31 yards. Lehman also had three carries for 27 yards.

On defense, the Ichabods were led by Brooks Myers who had eight tackles, a forced fumble and a pass breakup. The Ichabods Joe Corcoran, J.R. Phillips and Corey Crain each had interceptions for the Ichabods as the defense forced five Miner turnovers.

Dustin Hickel averaged 11 yards a carry and passed for 220 yards and one touchdown with 319 yards in total offense in a 49-0 win over UMR.



The Bearcats would score the next two touchdowns to go up 26-13. Hickel would throw another touchdown pass to DaWight Benning to cut the lead 26-20 with


