For the first time since joining the MIAA, the 2005 season brought the Ichabods their first conference championship of any kind since 1983 when Washburn won the Central State Intercollegiate Championship. The Ichabods were 9-3, which set a new school record for the most wins in a season and they received a bid to the NCAA Playoffs, hosting a second round game in Yager Stadium.

The Ichabods started out the season with high hopes as the seniors in the Washburn program were the first set of recruits by head coach Craig Schurig and the team did not disappoint as they won their season opener 28-17 over No. 14 Colorado Mines. The Orediggers were a playoff team from the season before, but Washburn jumped out to a 21-0 lead and never looked back.

In their home-opener against Western Washington in the first-ever meeting between the two schools, Washburn knocked off the Vikings 31-21 on a hot and humid day in Yager Stadium. In the game, the Schurig-era first recruit of Grant Gould became the all-time leading tackler in Washburn history as he recorded his 353rd tackle of his career.

The Ichabods opened the MIAA slate the following week with a 42-27 win over Central Missouri. The win snapped an eight-game losing streak to the Mules and Fletcher Terrell returned a 100-yard kickoff return for a score, setting a school record for the longest kickoff return.

Washburn fell for the first time in 2005 as their comeback attempt came up inches short as Central Washington held off the Ichabods 48-42 in Ellensburg, Wash. The Ichabods entered the game as the No. 24 ranked team in the AFCA Coaches Poll. It marked the first time the Ichabods had been ranked in the national Top 25 coaches poll. Washburn was down 48-21 midway through the third quarter, but ripped off three touchdowns, including two Jordan Brill to Jake Lebahn receptions. On the final play of the game, Brill's pass into the end zone fell was batted away at the last moment by a Wildcat defender.

The Ichabods improved to 2-0 in the MIAA after a 56-21 thrashing of Southwest Baptist. Washburn shook off a slow start after going into the locker room tied at 21, the Ichabods scored 35 unanswered points. Lebahn scored 12 of them as he hauled in a 47-yard touchdown pass from Brill and also scooped up a blocked punt on special teams and returned it 15 yards for a score.

In a match-up of undefeated MIAA teams, the Ichabods snapped a 25-game losing streak to Pittsburg State as they topped the No. 4 Gorillas 35-34 in overtime. It was the Ichabods' highest win over a ranked opponent. Washburn jumped out to a 21-0 lead and after the Gorillas cut the lead to 21-7, Terrell returned his second kickoff of the season for a touchdown on an 83-yard scamper to push the Ichabods' lead back to 21 at 28-7. In the second half, the Gorillas came out and scored 21 points to tie the game with the final score coming with 32 seconds remaining in regulation. In overtime, the Gorillas scored first, but the extra point was missed. The Ichabods scored on their seventh play as Trent Hearn scored his third touchdown of the day on a 7-yard run and Conner Sabel's extra point ended the game. Hearn finished with 162 yards on the ground on 30 carries.

For the second straight week, the Ichabods were set to battle a top-five team as they traveled to take on No. 5 ranked Northwest Missouri. Washburn led 14-6 at halftime behind a pair of Hearn touchdown runs. The Bearcats scored 15 points in the third quarter to take a 21-14 lead. However the Ichabods

regained the lead on a touchdown reception by Mike Odupitan and another touchdown run by Hearn to take a 28-21 lead. Northwest tied the score with 1:31 remaining, but the Ichabods marched 74 yards on 10 plays to put Sabel into position for the 23-yard game-winning field goal. The win over the Bearcats was the first since 1994 and snapped the Bearcats' 12-game home winning streak.

After two big wins for the program, the Ichabods jumped from No. 25 to No. 13 in the AFCA National Poll.

Washburn returned home to face the Truman Bulldogs. Washburn fell behind 14-7 midway through the third quarter, but Hearn rushed for a pair of touchdowns as the Ichabods rallied for a 21-14 win. Hearn rushed for a career-high 178 yards.

Another streak was snapped as Washburn picked up a 42-14 win over Emporia State on ESU's homecoming. The Ichabods, now ranked No. 10 in the national poll, won in Emporia for the first time since 1987 – a streak of seven games. The Ichabods never trailed as they jumped out to a 21-0 lead. ESU added a score before halftime. To open the second half, the Ichabods scored touchdowns on three of their first four possessions to put the game away as Odupitan recorded two touchdown grabs and Terrell returned a 66-yard interception for a score. On his last trip to ESU in 2003, Terrell returned a 61-yard interception for a score as a freshman.

The Ichabods were 9-1 and 7-0 and ranked No. 6 in the AFCA polls as they hosted Missouri Southern. The Ichabods jumped out to a 35-0 lead on senior day. The Lions scored the final 21 of the game to cut the margin to 14 at 49-35 as the Ichabods clinched their first nine-win season in school history. Hearn also went over the 1,000 yard mark pushing his season total to 1,035 after rushing for 122 yards and three touchdowns against Missouri Southern.

The Ichabods wrapped up the regular season with a heartbreaking 28-21 overtime loss to Missouri Western. Washburn scored the first 14 points of the game as Hearn rushed for scores of 2- and 5-yards. The Griffons scored 21 unanswered points as they took a 21-14 lead. Washburn tied the score at 21 as Hearn rushed for his third touchdown of the afternoon. Neither team scored in the fourth quarter forcing the game into overtime. The Griffons scored on their third play of overtime and the Ichabods were forced into a turnover of their first possession giving the Griffons a 28-21 win.

After finishing the regular season with a 9-2 record, Washburn fans and players gathered in the Bianchino Pavilion to watch the NCAA selection show and the place erupted with high-fives and smiles as it was shown the Ichabods would be the No. 2 seed in the Southwest Regional and received a first round bye for their first NCAA Playoff appearance.

After they topped Angelo State, Northwest Missouri came to Yager Stadium looking for their second straight road play-off win and jumped out to a 28-0 lead over the Ichabods. Washburn would rally to cut the lead to 35-17 at halftime. The Bearcats scored on their first possession of the second half pushing the lead to 42-17. Odupitan recorded two touchdown receptions of 30- and 15-yards to cut the lead to 42-32, but Washburn would get no closer.

#### Individual All-American awards

Fletcher Terrell became the first Ichabod to receive All-American honors since wide receiver Michael Dritelein accomplished the feat in 1995. Terrell was named first team by Daktronics and senior linebacker Grant Gould received second team All-American honors and senior offensive guard Rudy Sué was a third team All-American pick.

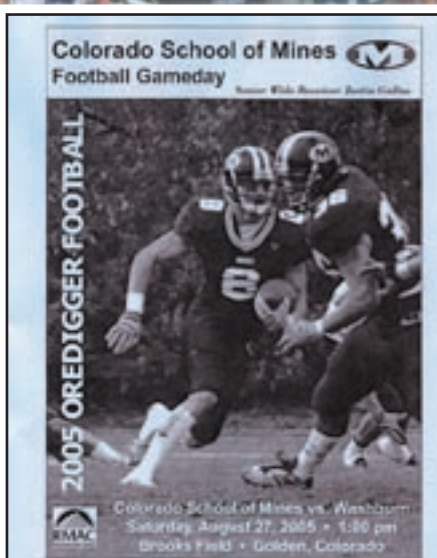


GOLDEN, COLO. - The Washburn Ichabods opened the 2005 season in fine fashion as they topped No. 14 ranked Colorado Mines 28-17. In the process, the Ichabods won their fourth straight overall game since the 1988 season when they won four straight from Oct. 1 to Oct. 22.

The Ichabods jumped on the board early as sophomore quarterback Jordan Brill, making his second career start, hit Sam Sissom on a 62-yard touchdown strike. It was the first of three Sissom touchdown receptions from Brill as he would finish with seven receptions for 231

yards and lifted his career touchdown tally to 36, setting the Washburn all-time record. He also raised his career point total to 226, tying Troy Slusser for the most points in school history. Sissom's 35 regular season touchdown receptions also ties Jamaica Rector's (Northwest Missouri, 2001-04) record for most in MIAA history.

After trading possessions with the Orediggers, Brill and Sissom hooked up again for an 82-yard touchdown to put the Ichabods up 14-0. The Ichabods would increase their lead to 21-0 after Sissom caught his final TD pass capping a 7-play, 97-yard drive after the Ichabod defense held the Orediggers out of the endzone from inside the Washburn 10 yard line.



The Orediggers would rebound with a 50-yard drive right before the half converting a 38-yard field goal to cut the Ichabod lead to 21-3 at the break.

In the second half, the Orediggers jumped on the board on their first drive of the half to cut the lead to 21-10, but the Ichabods came right back with a 78-yard drive finished off by Trent Hearn's 6-yard run, which would wrap the scoring for the Ichabods.

Colorado Mines added a touchdown late, but would not get any closer.

The Ichabods racked up 144 yards on the ground with Hearn going over the 100-yard mark with 21 carries for 106 yards and Ra'Shawn Mosley had 13 carries for 68 yards. Mike Odupitan had four catches for 57 yards and Jeff Scott had a career high 60 yards receiving with three receptions.

On the defense, the Ichabods created five turnovers, including two interceptions by Fletcher Terrell. Calvin Stuckey and Erin Beck each had interceptions and Terrell Cobb had a fumble recovery.

Senior Grant Gould had 12 tackles including two sacks for the Ichabods, giving him 343 for his career, needing seven to break the current school record of 349 held by Tony Scollieri.

## GAME 1 VS COLORADO MINES



TOPEKA -- The Washburn Ichabods improved to 2-0 with a 31-21 win over Western Washington.

The Ichabods found themselves down early as the Vikings' all-America wide receiver Andy Olson scored on an 8-yard reverse putting Western Washington up 7-0. The Ichabods would crack the scoring column on the ensuing drive on a career-long 41-yard field goal by Connor Sabel.

Ra'Shawn Mosley put the Ichabods up for good as he capped a 58-yard drive with a 4-yard touchdown run.

The Ichabods scored again on the very next play from scrimmage as Fletcher Terrell picked off a James Monrean pass and returned it 23 yards for a touchdown to give the Ichabods a 17-7 lead before the end of the first quarter.

The Ichabods added another score as Brandon Walker came in at quarterback and scampered 78 yards for a touchdown to put the 'Bods up 24-7. Trent Hearn rushed 19 yards for a touchdown at the 6:17 mark of the second quarter



to put the Ichabods up 31-7, but that would be all the scoring for the Ichabods as they were shutout by the Vikings in the second half.

The Vikings' offense came alive as Monrean would hit Olson for a 35-yard touchdown strike with 4:09 left in the half and Darrius Tuggle for a 28-yard connection with 11 seconds left in the half to end the scoring for both teams.

Grant Gould became Washburn's all-time leading tackler by col-

lecting his 353rd of his career on the afternoon. He finished the game with 10 tackles, passing Tony Scollieri who had 349 for his career at Washburn. Terell Cobb led the Ichabods with 11 tackles and a forced fumble.

The Ichabods racked up 425 yards in total offense behind Hearn's 94 yards rushing on 16 carries. Jordan Brill was 11 for 18 for 199 yards and Mike Odupitan had six catches for 119 yards.

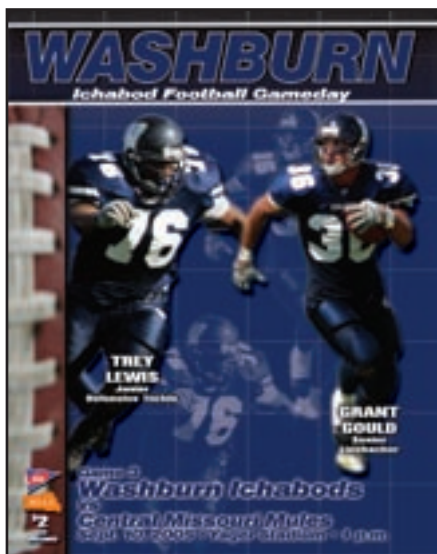


TOPEKA - The Washburn Ichabods improved to 3-0 after topping Central Missouri 42-27 in Yager Stadium. The win was the sixth straight overall win dating back to last season - something that no Ichabod team has done since 1964 - while in the process snapping an eight-game losing streak to the Mules.

The Ichabods jumped on the board first as Jordan Brill hooked up with Mike Odupitan on a 45-yard pass reception capping a six-play, 95-yard drive. The Mules would score their only two points in the first half on a safety late in the first quarter.

The Ichabods rounded out the scoring in the first half with a 7-yard touchdown pass to Jarod Tetuan. It was a busy day for Tetuan as he played both offense and defense for the Ichabods as well as special teams. He had one rush, one carry, one punt return and six tackles in the game.

In the second half, the Mules jumped on the board first as Spencer Webb hit a 32-yard field goal. The teams traded scores as the Cason Lehman caught a 19-yard touchdown pass from Brill - the second of his third TD passes on the day. After a CMSU score to cut the lead to 21-13, Fletcher Terrell set a Washburn record



and became the 13th person in MIAA history to return a kickoff for 100 yards to push the lead back to 15.

The Ichabods would add another score on a Ra'Shawn Mosley 25-yard touchdown run. The Mules would score to cut the lead to 35-19.

Washburn running back Trent Hearn would close out the Ichabod scoring with a 39-yard run to push the lead back to 42-19. The Mules added the final score on a touchdown pass rounding out the scoring at 42-27.

The Ichabod defense held the Mules to 87 yards of total offense in the first half. Grant Gould led the Ichabods with nine tackles including one sack. Aaron Neal had nine tackles. Nick Bull had the Ichabods' only interception of the game and he returned it 12 yards to set up a Washburn touchdown.

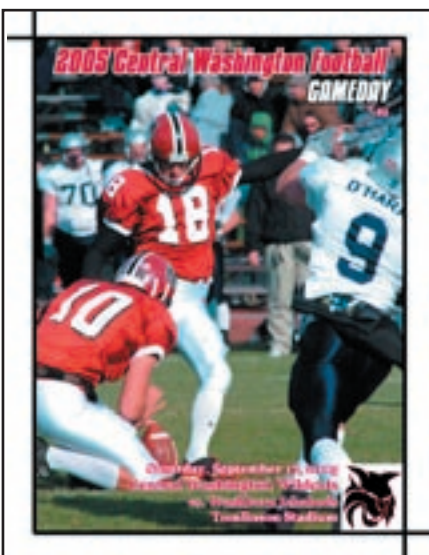
ELLENSBURG, Wash. - The Washburn Ichabods fell for the first time coming up short in the comeback bid dropping a 48-42 decision to Central Washington.

The Ichabods found themselves down 14-0 less than eight minutes into the game as the Wildcats scored the first two touchdowns of the game. The Ichabods jumped on the scoreboard with 4:44 remaining in the first quarter as Ra'Shawn Mosley capped a 6-play, 65 yard drive cutting the score to 14-7.

Central Washington (2-2) would score on the first play of the ensuing drive as they scored on a 52-yard touchdown to increase the lead to 21-7. It would be the first seven of a total of 24-unanswered points the Wildcats would score to build the lead to 38-7 with 9:06 remaining in the first half.

The Ichabods responded as quarterback Jordan Brill connected with Jarod Tetuan on a 24-yard touchdown strike to cut the lead to 38-14. After forcing a three-and-out, the Ichabods scored with 1:27 left in the first half as Jeff Scott caught a 57-yard touchdown reception from Brill cutting the lead to 38-21.

The Wildcats started the second half with the football and after the Ichabods forced the Wildcats into putting formation, Fletcher Terrell blocked the Central Washington punt and recovered it on the Wildcats' 4-yard line, but an offside penalty on the Ichabods on fourth and four gave the Wildcats the first down. On that same drive, the Ichabods' Josh Looney picked off a Mike Riley pass as the Wildcat quarterback was running out of bounds, however the officials ruled they had an inadvertent whistle giving possession back to the Wildcats. The Wildcats would continue to drive and kick a 27-yard field goal to push the lead to 41-21 with 9:05 left in the third quarter. Central Washington would add another touchdown on their next possession.



Washburn would then mount a comeback as Scott caught his second touchdown pass of the afternoon from Brill - this time a 5-yard completion to cut the lead to 48-28 with 1:05 left in the third quarter.

On the Ichabods' next possession, Washburn drove 80-yards in 10 plays as Brill hit Jake Lebahn for a 27-yard touchdown pass. It was Lebahn's first touchdown of his career.

The Ichabods defense forced a missed field goal by the Wildcats and the Ichabods took the ball back over with 4:01 remaining in the game.

Brill then led the Ichabods on another 80-yard drive hitting Lebahn with an 18-yard touchdown hook-up to cut the lead to 48-42 with 3:04 left.

The Ichabods forced the Wildcats into punt formation again,

but the Ichabods were called with a roughing the kicker penalty and the Wildcats regained possession. The Ichabod defense pushed the Wildcats into another punt and the Ichabods took over with 1:11 remaining.

Brill would hit Mosley over the middle for 11-yards. After a CWU offside penalty, Brill again hit Mosley to push the ball up to the Central Washington 47. The Ichabods would get no closer as three passes into the end zone fell incomplete handing the Ichabods the 48-42 loss.

Brill was 21-of-39 for 328 yards and a career-high five touchdown passes - two touchdown passes going to Lebahn and to Scott who finished with 91 and 62 yards receiving respectively. Tetuan had four receptions for 87 yards and the one touchdown reception.

On defense, the Ichabods were led by Grant Gould who had 12 tackles (six solo) including three tackles for loss and two sacks. Sam Tossie had seven tackles.

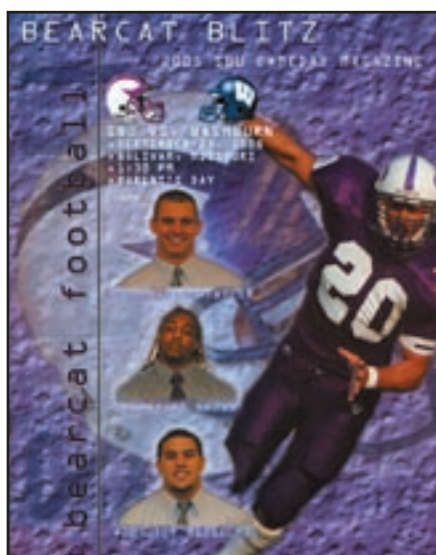


BOLIVAR, Mo. - The Washburn Ichabods scored 42 unanswered points in a 56-21 comeback win over Southwest Baptist at Plaster Stadium Saturday. Washburn trailed 21-14 late in the first half before dominating the second half en route to victory. With the win, Washburn improved to 4-1 and 2-0 in the MIAA.

Washburn suffered an early turnover to lead to an SBU touchdown just over a minute into the game on Rony Santil's touchdown reception. Grant Gould turned the tables on the Bearcats by returning an interception 26 yards for a touchdown minutes later.

The two squads traded scores the rest of the half, including a seven-yard scoring grab by Cason Lehman and a 12-yard grab by Mike Odupitan with 26 seconds left in the half on passes by Jordan Brill. The squads were deadlocked at 21 at the break before Washburn erupted.

The Ichabods owned the second half and went up for good on Jake Lebahn's 47-yard touchdown reception from Brill at 11:13 left in the third quarter. Lebahn added another touchdown on a blocked punt return at 9:01 in the



quarter.

Trent Hearn capped the scoring in the third on a 25-yard touchdown run before Ra'Shawn Mosley added a 15 yard score and Rashawn Bland added a 1-yard run in the fourth quarter to give Washburn a 35-0 margin in the second half.

Mosley led Washburn with 72 yards rushing, while A.J. Patterson and Hearn added 70 and 63 yards respectively. Patterson had a 53-yard run late in the game for WU's longest play of the day. Brill finished with

187 yards and three touchdowns on 10 of 17 passing.

Gould finished with 12 tackles, including three for loss to go along with his interception return for a score. Henry Talley was the other Ichabod in double figures with 10 tackles. Josh Looney and Fletcher Terrell added interceptions in the win.

**TOPEKA** - The Washburn Ichabods snapped a 25-game losing streak while topping the No. 4-ranked Pittsburg State Gorillas in a 35-34 overtime win. With the win, the Ichabods improved to 5-1 and 3-0 in the MIAA and the Gorillas dropped to 4-2, 3-1 in conference play. The win was the first for the Ichabods over the Gorillas since Oct. 4, 1980 in Topeka in a 38-36 win.

The Ichabods won the opening toss and jumped on the board with an eight-play, 80-yard drive as Trent Hearn would score on a 3-yard touchdown run. It would be the first of three touchdowns rushes for Hearn as he would finish the day with 162 yards on 30 carries. He rushed for all 25 yards on the Ichabods' overtime drive.

After the Ichabods took the early lead, Washburn would add another touchdown as Jordan Brill hooked up with Jake Lebahn on a 24-yard strike capping an eight-play, 95-yard drive. The Ichabods would add another as Hearn had a 22-yard scamper after PSU's Andy Majors was picked off by Calvin Stuckey at the Washburn 12 and he returned it 55 yards to the Pitt State 33.

On the next Pitt State drive, they would score on a Germaine Race 26-yard run. On the ensuing kickoff, Fletcher Terrell ran back his second kickoff of the season as he returned the kickoff 83 yards for a score to push the Ichabod lead back to 28-7 heading into the break.

In the second half, the Gorillas took the first drive of the third quarter and marched 65 yards in five plays to cut the Ichabod lead to 28-14. On the ensuing kickoff, the Ichabods would fumble and the Gorillas would take possession back at the Washburn 16. However, four plays into the drive, the



Ichabods' Mike Gonzalez would force a fumble at the Washburn 6 and recover the ball at the Washburn 13 to end the Gorillas' scoring threat.

The Gorillas would score on a 12-play, 93 yard drive cutting the lead to 28-21. After trading possessions and a missed field goal by the Ichabods, the Gorillas would drive 80 yards to tie the score at 28 with 32 seconds remaining.

The Ichabods won the overtime toss and elected to be on defense first. The Gorillas scored in three plays as Race rushed for two yards, however the extra point attempt by Nathan Alleman missed, sailing to the right.

The Ichabods took over at the Pitt State 25. Hearn rushed three straight times for the Ichabods

on carries of 6, 12, and 7 yards for the touchdown. After a Gorilla time out, Connor Sabel's extra point was perfect through the uprights giving the Ichabods its highest win over a nationally ranked opponent since joining the NCAA ranks, improving them to 4-31 since joining Division II.

Hearn averaged 5.4 yards per carry while racking up the 162 yards, his most since rushing for 175 against Missouri-Rolla as a freshman. Ra'Shawn Mosley had 36 yards on the ground as the Ichabods rushed for 217 as a team.

Brill passed for 205 yards with 70 receiving yards going to Cason Lehman and Mike Odupitan.

Mike Gonzalez had a career-high 18 tackles to lead the Ichabod defense. He capped the day with two forced fumbles and two fumble recoveries. Jarod Tetuan had 12 tackles with a forced fumble and Aaron Neal and Grant Gould each had 10 tackles.

MARYVILLE, Mo. - The Washburn Ichabods' Connor Sabel connected on 23-yard field goal with :04 seconds remaining as Washburn knocked off its second top-five team in a week with a 31-28 win over No. 5 Northwest Missouri. The win lifted the Ichabods to 6-1 overall and alone into first place in the MIAA with a perfect 4-0 record.

Northwest Missouri scored first with a 19-yard field goal after a massive defensive stand to start the game by the Ichabods. After a mis-handled snap on a punt, the Bearcats recovered the football at the Ichabod 8 yard line. But the Ichabods defense held and forced the Bearcat field goal. It was the first time the Bearcats scored first in a game this season and did not win.

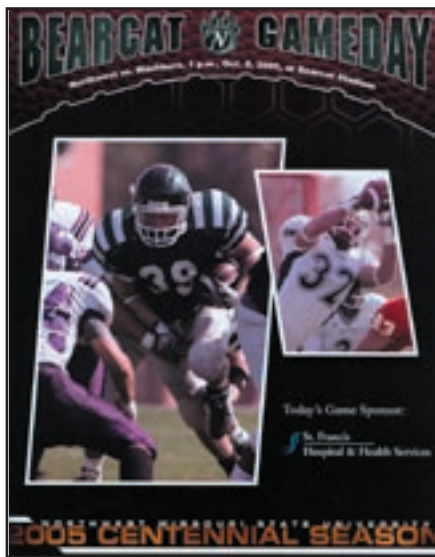
After the teams traded drives, the Ichabods forced a punt by the Bearcats, but Fletcher Terrell would pick up the first of his two blocked punts on the afternoon and the Ichabods recovered the ball at the Northwest 12 yard line. Two plays later, Trent Hearn scored on a 7-yard run. Hearn would go on to score three rushing touchdowns on the afternoon.

On the Bearcats' next drive, Northwest would drive down to the Ichabod two yard line, but Washburn's Cody Huenefeld would pick off a tipped ball for the interception ending the scoring chance for the Bearcats.

The Ichabods converted the turnover into seven points and they would go on a 17-play, 94-yard drive covering 8:58 on the clock to push themselves to a 14-3 lead. The Bearcats added a field goal with under two minutes on the clock and the Ichabods took a 14-6 lead into the break.

After trading drives, the Bearcats opened the scoring in the second half cutting the Washburn lead to 14-13. Northwest added another touchdown with 44 seconds remaining in the half to take a 21-14 lead heading into the fourth quarter.

On the Ichabods opening drive of the fourth quarter, Jordan Brill hooked up with Mike Odupitan for a 17-yard touchdown



pass and tying the score with the extra point knotting the scoreboard at 21.

After Terrell blocked his second punt of the afternoon, the Ichabods covered 37-yards in five plays as Hearn scored from three yards out to push Washburn in front 28-21 with 6:23 to play in the game.

The Ichabods and the Bearcats traded punts and the Bearcats Xavier Omon rushed 11-yards to tie the score. With the extra point, the Bearcats again tied the score at 28 with 1:31 to go in the game setting up the Ichabods winning drive.

After taking possession at their own 20 with 1:31 left, Brill hit Hearn for an 11-yard gain. After an incomplete pass, Brill fired and hit Odupitan for a 26-yard pick up to the Northwest 43. After a false start and a Hearn gain of 3 yards, Brill hit Aaron Gardiner for 3 more yards then hit Gardiner

again after a time out for 24 yards to put the ball on the Northwest 18. After a delay of game penalty, and no time outs, Brill hit a diving Cason Lehman for 18 more yards putting the ball at the Bearcat 6 yard line. After the Ichabods downed the ball to stop the clock, Northwest called a timeout before Sabel's game-winning kick through the uprights with :04 seconds left.

On the Ichabod kickoff, the Bearcats downed the ball and their last second pass was knocked down, ending the game and the 10-game losing streak to the Bearcats for the Ichabods.

Hearn finished the day with 107 yards on 33 carries with three touchdowns. Brill was 21 of 31 for 261 yards and the one touchdown pass to Odupitan, who had six catches for 105 yards.

On defense, the Ichabods were led by Mike Gonzalez, who recorded nine tackles, including seven solo stops and two tackles for loss. Jarod Tetuan, starting at free safety for the second straight week and Grant Gould each had eight tackles.

The Ichabods also had interceptions by Huenefeld and Aaron Neal.

TOPEKA, -- The No. 13-ranked Washburn Ichabods held off the upset-minded Bulldogs of Truman State University in a 21-14 win at Yager Stadium Saturday afternoon in front of a Homecoming crowd of 6,734.

Truman (1-7, 0-6 MIAA) scored first in the game converting a turnover into a touchdown after a scoreless first quarter as senior WR James Walton caught a 23-yard pass from freshman QB Michael Long.

The Ichabods (7-1, 5-0

MIAA) scored until 43 seconds left in the half as senior WR Mike Odupitan hooked up with sophomore QB Jordan Brill on a 21-yard pass reception as the Ichabods drove 76 yards in 12 plays to tie the game at 7-7.

The Bulldogs took the lead on a 1-yard touchdown run by senior RB Jerard Levenson with 5:31 left in the third quarter capping a 12-play 57-yard yard drive. Levenson had 117 yards on 29 carries, his second 100-yard rushing game in as many weeks.

Washburn took the lead for good on a 31-yard run by junior RB Trent Hearn. Hearn rushed for a career-high 178 yards on 27 carries. Hearn



added his second touchdown on the Ichabods' next possession that put the Ichabods up 21-14.

After forcing an Ichabod punt with 3:18 in the game, the Bulldogs drove to their own 45-yard line, but the Ichabods' senior LB Terrell Cobb picked off Long's pass at the Washburn 43 to end the threat and wrap up the game.

Brill passed for 249 yards and one touchdown. On defense, senior LB Grant Gould led the Ichabods with 13 tackles. He also has a tackle

for loss, a pass break up and an interception he returned for 26 yards. Junior DB Fletcher Terrell and senior LB Mike Gonzalez each had nine tackles.

Long was 27-of-51 for 276 yards, three interceptions and one touchdown. Junior WR James Perry had eight catches for 52 yards. Senior DB Jason Douglas led Truman with 10 tackles (five solos), while junior LB Larry Giglio had an interception and a fumble forced and recovered.

The Ichabods outgained the Bulldogs, 418-370, despite running 10 less plays.

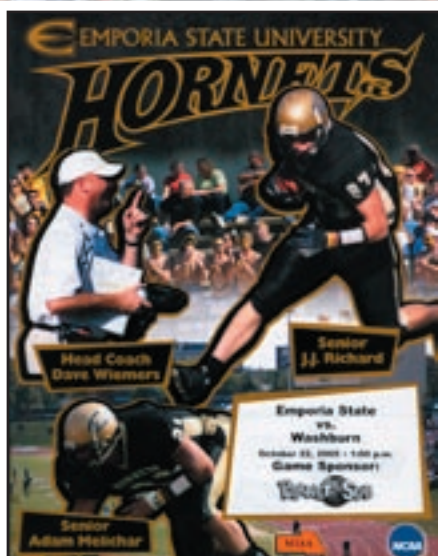
EMPORIA, Kan. - The No. 10 Washburn Ichabods tied a school record for single season wins as they improved to 8-1 with a 42-14 win over arch-rival Emporia State in the 102nd edition of the Turnpike Tussle. The Ichabods also won in Emporia for the first time since 1987, snapping a seven-game losing streak at Welch Stadium. Washburn improved to 8-1 with the win and 6-0 in the MIAA.

The Ichabods set the tone for the game early as they took the opening drive 80 yards in six plays as Jordan Brill hit Jake Lebahn for a 52-yard touchdown pass.

Another piece of history was written as Trent Hearn rushed for a 42-yard touchdown scamper. It was his 32nd of his career, snapping the school record of 31 held by Brandon Rainer. The drive took only :46 seconds and the Ichabods ran three plays covering 70 yards for the score.

Washburn built a 21-0 lead as Brandon Walker came in at quarterback and carried the ball 27 yards converting a two-play drive as Walker covered all 36 yards on the drive in two carries for the score.

The Hornets got on the board after a 16-play, 79-yard drive, helped impart by a Washburn pass interference penalty in the end zone keeping the ESU drive alive while cutting the Ichabod lead to 21-7 at the half.



Emporia State received the kickoff to open the second half, but fumbled the return and the Ichabods Aaron Hicks recovered, setting up the short field for Washburn. The Ichabods would score six plays latter as Brill hit Mike Odupitan for the touchdown strike that covered 20 yards to push the Ichabods to a 28-7 lead.

After trading drives, the Ichabods' Eric Lawrence picked off an ESU pass attempt and Brill again hit Odupitan on a 10-yard reception and a 35-7 Ichabod lead with 5:56 left in the third quarter.

On the ensuing ESU drive, Fletcher Terrell intercepted his 14th pass of his career and returned it 66 yards for an Ichabod score putting the Ichabods up 42-7. His 14th interception passed A.C. Poynter on top of the Washburn record book.

The Hornets would add a late touchdown with 2:09 left in the game placing the final score at 42-14.

Hearn finished the day with 60 yards rushing on 11 carries. Brill was 9 of 15 for 170 and three touchdown passes. Odupitan had three catches for 59 yards and the two scoring strikes.

On defense, the Ichabods were led by Grant Gould who had 14 tackles, including nine solo stops and one tackle for loss.

**GAME 10 VS MISSOURI SOUTHERN**

TOPEKA -- The No. 6 Washburn Ichabods improved to 9-1 and 7-0 in the MIAA with their 49-35 win over Missouri Southern. With the win, the Ichabods clinched at least a share of the MIAA title.

The Ichabods jumped on the Lions as they scored touchdowns on five of its first six possessions. The first two coming on Trent Hearn runs of 3- and 24-yards.

Brandon Walker came in at quarterback and guided the Ichabods on a 10-play, 64-yard drive as he ran 11 yards for a touchdown to put the Ichabods up 21-0 with 14:12 to go in the second quarter.

Hearn rushed for his third touchdown of the afternoon on a 4-yard run. Hearn would not carry the ball the rest of the game as he would finish with 122 yards on eight carries and the three touchdowns playing only one quarter and 3:40 of the second quarter. Hearn also raised his season total to 1,035 yards becoming only the fourth Ichabod to rush for more than 1,000 yards in a single season and the first Ichabod to do it twice in a career.

Rawshaw Bland capped a 9-play, 95-yard drive that put the 'Bods up 35-0 entering halftime.

The Lions jumped on the board as Dartan Johnson scored on a 5-yard run. A.J. Patterson scored on a 16-yard pass from Jordan Brill to push the Ichabods back to a 42-7 lead with 4:41 left in the third quarter.

The Lions scored again as Jamison Hummel pulled



down an Adam Hinspeter pass from seven yards out.

Washburn's Chris Brown, who played both defense and offense for the second straight week, scored on a 6-yard run to wrap up the Ichabod scoring. Brown finished with a game-high 129 yards on the ground on 17 carries.

Southern scored on a 17-yard run by Ronnell Newman and added two more scores within 2:12 of one another as they blocked two punts inside the Ichabod 20 and converted them both for two touchdowns.

The Ichabods as a team rushed for 382 yards with Brown's 129, Hearn's 122 and Walker's 99 yards leading the way. The 382 yards tied a school record for most yards on the ground for a Washburn team. The last time the Ichabods had two 100 yard rushers was on Oct. 22, 1994 in a 60-28 loss to Missouri Western. Joe Schartz had 17 carries for 104 yards and Nick Cummings had 21 carries for 122 yards.

Brill was 10 for 18 with 1 touchdown and 201 yards passing. Cason Lehman had three receptions for 72 yards to lead all receivers.

Mike Gonzalez led the Ichabods with 12 tackles. Fletcher Terrell had two interceptions and one solo tackle.

Overall, the Ichabods outgained the Lions 583 to 441 overall and 382 to 148 on the ground.

The Ichabods committed five turnovers, including an interception in the overtime

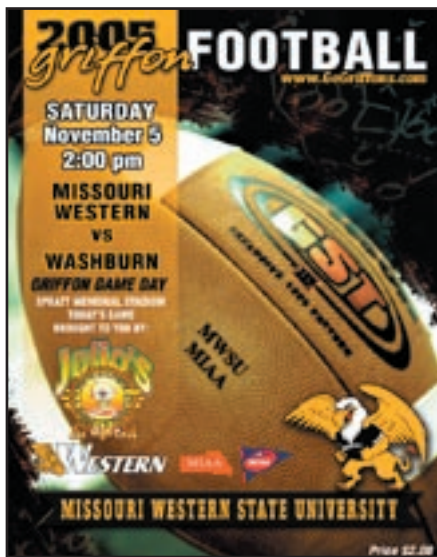
period and two other turnovers inside the Griffon 30 yard line.

Hearn rushed for 107 yards on 23 carries raising his season total to 1,142 yards, trailing Dino DeLisa on the single-season record book, who had 1,185 in 1983.

Jordan Brill became Washburn's single season record holder in passing yards lifting his total to 2,479 yards, passing Barry Griffith's mark of

2,338 in 1988.

On defense, the Ichabods were led by Mike Gonzalez and Adam Ewy who each had 14 tackles. Grant Gould had 11 including, eight solo tackles. Fletcher Terrell had eight tackles including an interception and three pass break ups giving him 58 for his career, setting a new NCAA Division II record for the most in a career. He passed Rob Keefe of Mercyhurst who had 56 for his career.

GAME 12 VS NORTHWEST MISSOURI - NCAA SECOND ROUND

TOPEKA, — The Washburn Ichabods season came to an end in the second round of the NCAA Playoffs with a 42-32 loss to Northwest Missouri.

The Ichabods were down early as the Bearcats scored two touchdowns on their first four drives as the Ichabod were shutout until the 9:54 mark of the second quarter as Jordan Brill hooked up with Aaron Gardiner for a 45-yard touchdown pass capping a 5-play, 68-yard drive cutting the Bearcat lead to 28-7. The Bearcats would score on the following possession as Xavier Oman ran 70 yards to put Northwest up 35-7.

Washburn then came back with a 75 yard drive with Trent Hearn finishing the drive with a 1-yard touchdown run with 4:51 left in the second quarter. The Ichabods added three more points on a 35-yard Connor Sabel field goal with :16 left in the first half cutting the Bearcat lead to 35-17.

Northwest took the opening possession of



the second half and drove 83 yards in 11 plays for their final touchdown of the game with 11:03 remaining in the third quarter.

Brill and Mike Odupitan connected with each other for the final two touchdowns of the game. The first was a 30-yard strike and the second was a 15-yard reception that pulled the Ichabods within 10 at 42-32.

For the game, the Bearcats outgained

the Ichabods 494 to 372 as the Bearcats racked up 311 yards passing, the Ichabods passed for 296. On the ground, Northwest outgained the Ichabods 183 to 76.

Brill was 16 of 29 for 296 yards and 3 TD's, hitting Odupitan for five receptions and 118 with the two TD's to the senior. Hearn finished the game with 61 yards rushing and his season with 1,203 yards snapping a 22-year old school record held by Dino DeLisa who rushed for 1,185 during his sophomore season in 1983.
