Rob Robinson Wide Receivers / Recruiting Coordinator

Rob Robinson is in his fifth season on the Ichabod coaching staff. He will direct Washburn's wide receivers and kickoff return team and lead the 'Bods recruiting efforts as the coordinator.

While at Washburn, Robinson has coached three of the top seven receivers in school history as well as two all-MIAA selections and an all-region receiver.

In 2004, he coached only the third Washburn receiver to reach at least 1,000 yards as the Ichabods broke the school record for most passing yards in a season.

Robinson spent one season at Pittsburg State as a graduate assistant, coaching the defensive backs with Ichabod head coach Craig Schurig.

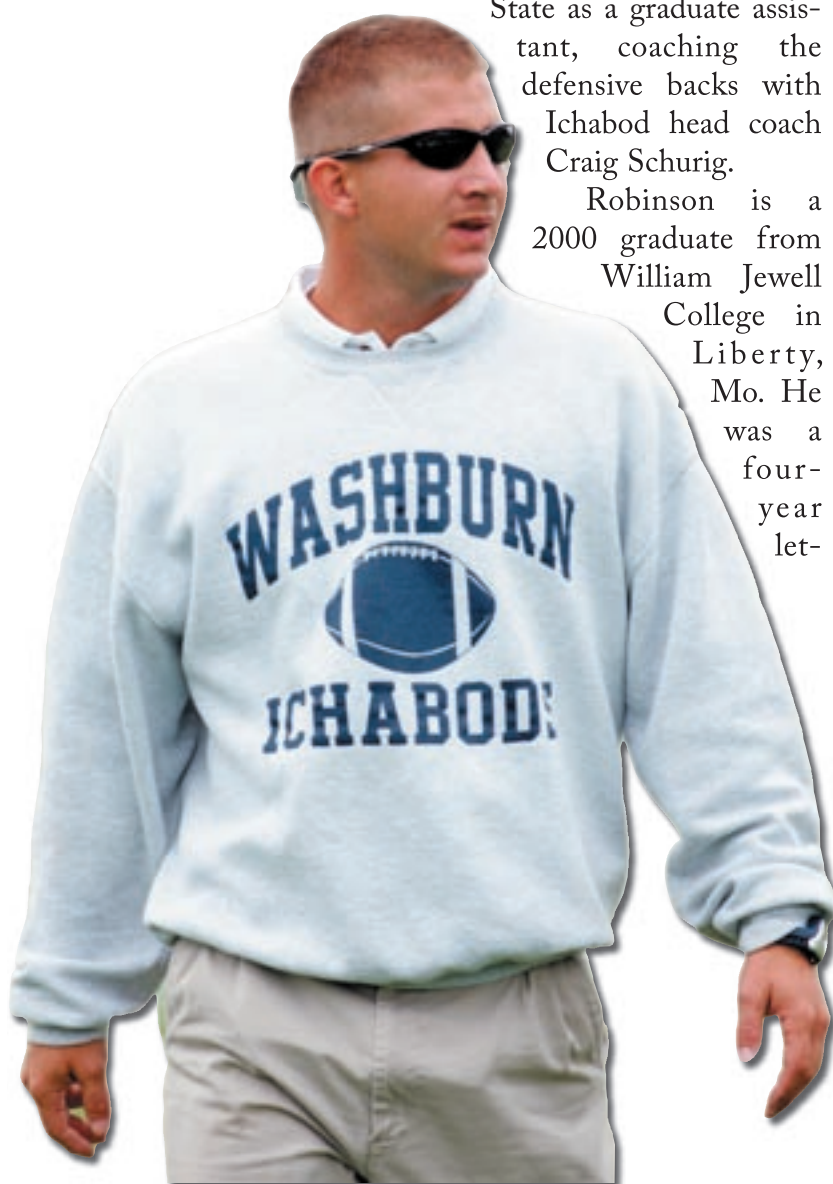
Robinson is a 2000 graduate from William Jewell College in Liberty, Mo. He was a four-year letterman for the Cardinals at fullback, playing on special teams as well.
