The Ichabods are 2-1 in MIAA. The Gorillas are 5-0 and 3-0 in the MIAA. The Ichabods are coming off their first MIAA loss, a 49-21 loss to Northwest Missouri and the Gorillas blasted Missouri-Rolla 91-27 last time out.

Series Notes

Today's meeting is the 77th meeting in the series. A series that has seen the Gorillas win 24 straight games. Overall, Pittsburg State leads the all-time series 57-18-1. The last win in the series was Oct. 4, 1980 when the Ichabods won 38-36 in Topeka. The last win for the Ichabods in Pittsburg was Oct. 18, 1969 when the Ichabods won 19-17. During the 24-game losing streak, the Ichabods have been outscored 984 to 297 — an average of 41 to 12.



The Coaches: Craig Schurig A new era in Washburn football began when Craig Schurig was named head coach of the Ichabod football program Dec. 28, 2001.

Schurig is 11-16 in his third season as the Ichabod head coach and he is 8-13 against the MIAA.

After two seasons as the Ichabods' head coach, Schurig has already made his mark at Washburn defeating arch-rival Emporia State in two of three meetings since taking over the Ichabods. The Ichabods improved two wins from the first season to the second season under Schurig finishing the 2003 season 5-6.

After coaching for nearly a decade in a winning program, Schurig has brought the knowledge of success, a winning attitude and a new intensity to the Ichabod football program.

In each of his two seasons at Washburn, the Ichabods have had two MIAA Freshman of the Year and 16 players receive all-MIAA honors. He has been equally on task with play-

ers in the classroom with 29 Ichabods named to the MIAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll. Following the 2003 season, 16 were named to the honor roll, the most in one single season since joining the MIAA.

While under Schurig, the Ichabod football program has also seen sweeping changes in facilities with the improvements to Yager Stadium and equipment upgrades in the weight room.

Prior to working with the defensive backs, he worked three seasons with the Gorillas' tight ends.

While on the Gorillas coaching staff, Schurig was a part of an NCAA national finalist squad in 1995, four MIAA Championship teams and eight NCAA Division II playoff teams. He helped guide one of the top defenses in Division II including the top-ranked defensive squad in 1999.

Before arriving at Pittsburg State, Schurig spent the 1992 season as a volunteer assistant coach at his alma mater, Colorado School of Mines joining the Gorillas in 1993.

Schurig, a Willingboro, N.J., native, was a four-year letterman as a defensive back at Colorado Mines and was selected team captain as a senior. He earned second-team All-Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference honors as a senior. He graduated in 1987 with a bachelor's degree in petroleum engineering.

Schurig earned a master's degree in physical education at Pittsburg State in 1996. Craig and his wife, Louisa, have a daughter, Samantha, and two sons, Mitchell and Michael.

Pittsburg State's Chuck Broyles is in his 15th season at the helm of his alma mater (PSU, '70). The only collegiate coach since the 1890s to win 100 games in less than 10 full seasons, Broyles has guided the Gorillas to a 145-29-2 (.829) record since taking charge in 1990.

He is the winningest active NCAA-II head coach, by percentage, and the second winningest active coach among NCAA I-A, I-AA, and II schools. Broyles also is the winningest head coach in Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association and Pittsburg State history. PSU has qualified for the NCAA-II national playoffs in 12 of his 14 seasons (1990-97, 1999-2001, '03) and the Gorillas have reached the NCAA-II National Championship game three times (1991-92, '95) under his leadership, including the 1991 NCAA Division II national title.

The Ichabods last time out: TOPEKA, Sept. 25 - The Washburn Ichabods fell for the first time this season in MIAA play as they were knocked off by No. 5 Northwest Missouri 49-21.

The Ichabods fell behind 14-0 as the Bearcats scored on their first two drives. Defensive lineman Mitch Birt scored the first points for the Ichabods as he sacked Northwest quarterback Josh Lamberson and then recovered the fumble in the endzone for the touchdown.

Northwest responded by scoring 28 unanswered points to take a 42-7 lead. The Ichabods scored as time expired in the first half on a 50-yard touchdown pass from Jordan Brill to Mike Odupitan.

Both teams scored seven points in the second half as the Bearcats scored on their first drive to open the half. The Ichabods scored on a 30-yard touchdown pass from Brill to Jarod Tetuan with 10:15 left in the game to make the score Northwest 49, Washburn 21.

Brill finished the game 16 of 31 for 205 yards and two touchdown passes. Ra'Shawn Moseley had 44 yards on 13 carries. Odupitan had six receptions along with Sam Sissom. Odupitan had 96 yards receiving and one touchdown, Sissom had 72 yards

Rolla - Pittsburg State University rolled to a record-breaking 91-27 victory over the University of Missouri-Rolla Saturday night (Sept. 25) at Allgood-Bailey Stadium. The third-ranked Gorillas set school and Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association modern-day scoring and total offense records, with 91 points and 809 total yards in the game.

After leading just 7-0 after one quarter of play, Pitt State (5-0, 3-0 MIAA) scored 35 points in the second quarter, 21 points in the third period and 28 points in the fourth -- thanks, in part, to a pair of UMR fumbles deep in its own territory. The Miners (1-4, 0-3 MIAA) extended their MIAA record losing streak, dropping their 57th consecutive conference game.

Harlon Hill Trophy hopeful Neal Philpot returned to start at quarterback for the Gorillas after missing two games with a foot injury. Philpot completed 8 of 14 passes for 193 yards and three touchdowns and rushed 10 times for 79 yards and two more scores. PSU also established a new PSU team passing record with 407 yards through the air. Philpot and back-up Andy Majors combined to go 20 of 32 for 407 yards and five TDs. Majors was 12 of 18 for 214 yards and two TDs in the game. He also rushed nine times for 79 yards and two scores.

Running back Germaine Race rushed 11 times for 145 yards and one touchdown. Wide receiver Tim Austin had five catches for a career-high 132 yards, including a 51-yard TD grab. Jermaine Carpenter also had three catches for 93 yards and a TD. Eric Clawson (3-69), Mike Ward (3-66), and Brandon Twito (1-12) also had touchdown catches. Place kicker Nathan Alleman set new PSU and MIAA records by converting all 13 PAT tries in the game.

UMR's Brandon Landry completed 24 of 51 passes for 200 yards and three touchdowns with two interceptions. Mark Becker also completed 2 of 2 passes for 31 yards and a score for the Miners.

come right back on Connor Sable's 23-yard field goal to knot the score at three. The Gorillas scored a touchdown with 35 seconds left in the first half to take a 10-3 lead into the locker room.

Neither team would score again until the Gorillas pushed the lead to 17-3 at the 2:20 mark of the third quarter. On the next Ichabod drive, Trent Hearn would dive in the endzone to cut the lead to 17-10.

However the Gorillas would score 20-unanswered points scoring three touchdowns over a five-minute span and win the game 37-10.

The Ichabods were limited to six first downs and 149 total yards. Hearn rushed for 56 yards. DaWight Benning had four receptions for 63 yards and Dustin Hickel was 8 of 17 with one interception for 79 yards.

Mike Odupitan had six kickoff returns for 177 yards averaging 29.5 yards a return. On defense, Grant Gould led the Ichabods with 11 tackles and one fumble recovery. Evin Beck and Joe Corcoran each had eight stops and Corcoran also had an interception.

•There are six current coaches on the Ichabod coaching staff with ties to Pitt State. Other than head coach Craig Schurig's nine years on the Gorilla staff, five other coaches also have ties to the Gorillas' program.

Defensive coordinator Chris Brown was a three-time all-American who recorded 470 tackles in 43 starts and was named the CNN Division II National Player of the Year. He is one of only four Gorillas to be named all-American three times.

Linebacker's coach Cooper Harris played for the Gorillas from 1992 to 1994 where he recorded 295 tackles in 31 games, seventh on the all-time chart. He won the Joe Murphy Award twice as the team's most valuable defensive player.

Wide receivers coach Rob Robinson spent one season as a graduate assistant with the Gorillas after wrapping up his playing days at William Jewell.

Defensive line coach David Trupp was the defensive line and offseason strength and condition coordinator for the Gorillas from 1996 to 1998.

Graduate Assistant Dion Menely was a six-year member of the Gorillas from 1994-99. He recorded 203 tackles and was a two-time all-MIAA pick and team captain as a senior.

•The Gorillas do not have anyone on their roster from Topeka while junior offensive lineman Jim Holland is from Pittsburg.

Schuerman moves closer to top of all-time record

books:

- Against Northwest Missouri, senior quarterback Tyler Schuerman moved within 27 yards of Washburn's all-time total offensive record. The has 6,596 for his career, trailing Joe Schartz who has 6,622 yards.
- He raised his career passing yards to 5,088, to move with in 440 yards of breaking the passing mark of 5,527 also held by Schartz.



TOPEKA - The Washburn Ichabods fell in their season opener 34-27 to the Colorado School of Mines. The Orediggers scored the winning touchdown with 4:55 to play in the fourth quarter to hand Washburn the loss. The Ichabods will take on Langston University next weekend on Sept. 4 at 6 p.m. in Yager Stadium.

The Ichabods opened the game with a 68-yard, 9-play touchdown dirve that was capped by a 38-yard touchdown pass from Tyler Schuerman to Sam Sissom. It was the first of two touchdown passes from the duo of Schuerman to Sissom. However, the extra point attempt missed and the Ichabods led 6-0. The Orediggers would take the ensuing kickoff and score a touchdown of their own, but like the Ichabods could not convert on the extra point.

Both teams would trade touchdown drives to wrap up the first quarter with the score locked at 13. The Ichabods scored a a 4-yard touchdown run by Trent Hearn. Mines would score the next 14 points of the game to take a 27-13 lead. The Ichabods would cut into the lead before halftime on a Ra'Shawn Moseley 13-yard scamper to decrease the margin to seven.

In the second half, the Ichabods and Orediggers would go scoreless in the third quarter. The Ichabods struck next on Sissom's second touchdown of the afternoon - a 64-yard strike from Schuerman that tied the score at 27 with 7:52 remaining. The Orediggers took the kickoff and then marched 77 yards in 11 plays as Chad Friehauf connected with Jonny Chan on a 10-yard touchdown pass.

Moseley finished the game with 108 yards rushing and Hearn finished with 71 yards. Schuerman was 14 of 23 with two tipped interceptions and 178 yards.

Sissom would finished with 113 yards receiving and three receptions for a 37.7 yard per catch average. The Ichabod defense was led by Grant Gould who had 15 tackles and an interception return of 31 yards. Adam Ewy had 12 tackles.



TOPEKA - The Washburn Ichabods picked up their first win of the season with a 30-7 victory over Langston. The Ichabods evened their record to 1-1.

After forcing the Lions into a three-and-out the first drive of the game, the Ichabods drove 68 yards in six plays to take an early lead they would not let go of. Ra'Shawn Moseley capped the drive with a 24-yard touchdown run.



The Hornets struck first on the score board with a 30-yard field goal by Justin Gray. In what set the tone for the afternoon with the Ichabod defense, the Hornets managed just five yards on four plays after the Hornets took their first possession at the Washburn 18-yard line.

The Ichabods did not waste any time as the Ichabods drove 80 yards in five plays as Tyler Schuerman and Sam Sissom hooked up on a 36-yard touchdown strike that gave the Ichabods a lead they would not let go of.





2004 Washburn Football Recap vs Northwest Missouri State 9/25



The Washburn Ichabods fell for the first time this season in MIAA play as they were knocked off by No. 5 Northwest Missouri 49-21.

The Ichabods fell behind 14-0 as the Bearcats scored on their first two drives. Defensive lineman Mitch Birt scored the first points for the Ichabods as he sacked Northwest quarterback Josh Lamberson and then recovered the fumble in the endzone for the touchdown.

Northwest responded by scoring 28 unanswered points to take a 42-7 lead. The Ichabods scored as time expired in the first half on a 50-yard touchdown pass from Jordan Brill to Mike Odupitan.

Both teams scored seven points in the second half as the Bearcats scored on their first drive to open the half. The Ichabods scored on a 30-yard touchdown pass from Brill to Jarod Tetuan with 10:15 left in the game to make the score Northwest 49, Washburn 21.

Brill finished the game16 of 31 for 205 yards and two touchdown passes. Ra'Shawn Moseley had 44 yards on 13 carries. Odupitan had six receptions along with Sam Sissom. Odupitan had 96 yards receiving and one touchdown, Sissom had 72 yards receiving. Linebacker Mike Gonzalez had nine tackles to pace the Ichabod defense. Evin Beck had two sacks.

The 'Cats (5-0, 3-0 MIAA) totaled 491 yards of offense, 267 through the air, as they piled up six offensive touchdowns in the first half to take a 42-14 lead at intermission. Junior QB Josh Lamberson finished his day 16-of-23 for 249 yards and four passing touchdowns (three in the first half). He also added one TD on the ground in the second quarter, and moved into seventh place on Northwest's all-time passing charts with 2,970 yards. Freshman RB Xavier Omon led the rushing attack for Northwest with 13 carries for 95 yards and two first-half touchdowns. Jamaica Rector went for 83 yards on seven catches with two first-half scores. The Ichabods (3-2, 2-1 MIAA) were dealt a hard shot when they lost senior QB Tyler Schuerman in the first quarter with a shoulder injury. Freshman QB Jordan Brill was 16-of-31 passing in his place, for 205 yards, two TDs and no interceptions. He was sacked three times for losses totaling 24 yards.
