Ichabods vs Bearcats

The Game . . .

The Washburn Ichabods (3-1, 1-0 MIAA) will look to rebound from their first loss of the season as they travel to Bolivar, Mo., to take on the Southwest Baptist Bearcats (1-3, 0-1 MIAA). The Ichabods fell 48-42 to Central Washington as their comeback from a 31-point deficit midway through the second quarter came up short. The Bearcats dropped a 45-28 decision to Emporia State last time out.

The Coaches . . .

Washburn head football coach Craig Schurig was named head coach of the Ichabod football program Dec. 28, 2001.

Schurig is 19-19 (.500) in his fourth season as the Ichabod head coach and he is 12-15 against the MIAA.

In only three seasons as the Ichabods' head coach, Schurig has led the Washburn football program to a new level with a school-best finish in the MIAA, their first winning season since 1999 and their first postseason win since 1986 with a 36-33 win over Northern State in the 2004 Mineral Water Bowl.

The Ichabods finished the 2004 season with an 8-4 record as Washburn has improved five victories in the win column since Schurig's first season at the helm.

Southwest Baptist head coach Jack Peavey is in his first year as the head coach of the Bearcats. He received his first SBU win on Saturday, September 3, with a 34-29 come from behind win over Bethel College. Peavey has an overall head coaching record of 6-28.

He comes to SBU after one year at NCAA Division III Millsaps College in Mississippi. Prior to Millsaps, he coached Bishop Feehan H.S. to three straight Massachusetts State High School football championships.

This is his second time around as a head coach. He was the head coach at William Patterson University for three years in 1997, 1998, and 1999.

Peavey won a national championship at Troy State as a player and then went on to play three years in the NFL for the New England Patriots and Denver Broncos. He graduated from Jacksonville State in 1988.

Ichabods last time out . . .

The Ichabods last time out - Central Washington 48, No. 24 Washburn 42 • Sept. 17, 2005: ELLENSBURG, Wash. - The Washburn Ichabods fell for the first time this season coming up short in the comeback bid dropping a 48-42 decision to Central Washington.

The Ichabods found themselves down 14-0 less than eight minutes into the game as the Wildcats scored the first two touchdowns of the game. The Ichabods jumped on the scoreboard

with 4:44 remaining in the first quarter as Ra'Shawn Mosley capped a 6-play, 65 yard drive cutting the score to 14-7.

Central Washington (2-2) would score of the first play of the ensuing drive as they scored on a 52-yard touchdown to increase the lead to 21-7. It would be the first seven of a total of 24-unanswered points the Wildcats would score to build the lead to 38-7 with 9:06 remaining in the first half.

The Ichabods responded as quarterback Jordan Brill connected with Jarod Tetuan on a 24-yard touchdown strike to cut the lead to 38-14. After forcing a three-and-out, the Ichabods scored with 1:27 left in the first half as Jeff Scott caught a 57-yard touchdown reception from Bill cutting the lead to 38-21.

The Wildcats received the second half with the football and after the Ichabods forced the Wildcats into putting formation, Fletcher Terrell blocked the Central Washington punt and recovered it on the Wildcats' 4-yard line, but an offsides penalty on the Ichabods on the 4th and four gave the Wildcats the first down. On that same drive, the Ichabods' Josh Looney picked off a Mike Riley pass as the Wildcat quarterback he was running out of bounds, however the officials ruled they had an inadvertent whistle giving possession back to the Wildcats. The Wildcats would continue to drive and kick a 27-yard field goal to push the lead to 41-21 with 9:05 left in the third quarter. Central Washington would add another touchdown on their next possession.

Washburn would then mount their comeback as Scott caught his second touchdown pass of the afternoon from Brill - this time a 5-yard completion to cut the lead to 48-28 with 1:05 left in the third quarter.

On the Ichabods' next possession, Washburn drove 80-yards in 10 plays as Brill hit Jake Lebahn for a 27-yard touchdown pass. It was Lebahn's first touchdown of his career.

The Ichabods defense forced a missed field goal by the Wildcats and the Ichabods took the ball back over with 4:01 remaining in the game.

Brill then led the Ichabods on another 80-yard drive hitting Lebahn with an 18-yard touchdown hook-up to cut the lead to 48-42 with 3:04 left.

The Ichabods forced the Wildcats into punt formation again, but the Ichabods were called with a roughing the kicker penalty and the Wildcats regained possession. The Ichabod defense

Ichabod head coach Craig Schurig

A new era in Washburn football began when Craig Schurig was named head coach of the Ichabod football program Dec. 28, 2001.

In only three seasons as the Ichabods' head coach, Schurig has led the Washburn football program to a new level with a school-best finish in the MIAA, their first winning season since 1999 and their first postseason win since 1986 with a 36-33 win over Northern State in the 2004 Mineral Water Bowl.

The Ichabods finished the 2004 season with an 8-4 record as Washburn has improved five victories in the win column since Schurig's first season at the helm.

After coaching for nearly a decade in a winning program, Schurig has brought the knowledge of success, a winning attitude and a new intensity to the Ichabod football program.

In his three seasons at Washburn, the Ichabods have had two MIAA Freshman of the Year and 27 players receive All-MIAA honors. He has been equally on task with players in the classroom with 40 Ichabods named to the MIAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll, including two Academic All-Americans.

While under Schurig, the Ichabod football pro-

gram has also seen sweeping changes in facilities with the improvements to Yager Stadium and equipment upgrades in the weight room.

While on the Pittsburg State coaching staff, Schurig was a part of an NCAA national finalist squad in 1995, four MIAA Championship teams and eight NCAA Division II playoff teams. He helped guide one of the top defenses in Division II including the top-ranked defensive squad in 1999.

Prior to working with the defensive backs, he worked three seasons with the Gorillas' tight ends.

Before arriving at Pittsburg State, Schurig spent the 1992 season as a volunteer assistant coach at his alma mater, Colorado School of Mines joining the Gorillas in 1993.

Schurig, a Willingboro, N.J., native, was a fouryear letterman as a defensive back at Colorado Mines and was selected team captain as a senior. He earned second-team All-Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference honors as a senior. He graduated in 1987 with a bachelor's degree in petroleum engineering.

Schurig earned a master's degree in physical education at Pittsburg State in 1996. Craig and his wife, Louisa, have a daughter, Samantha, and two sons, Mitchell and Michael.

pushed the Wildcats into another punt and the Ichabods took over with 1:11 remaining.

Brill would hit Mosley over the middle for 11-yards. After a CWU offsides penalty, Brill again hit Mosley to push the ball up to the Central Washington 47. The Ichabods would get no closer as three passes into the end zone fell incomplete handing the Ichabods the 48-42 loss.

Brill passed was 21-of-39 for 328 yards and a career-high five touchdown passes - two touchdown passes going to Lebahn and to Scott who finished with 91 and 62 yards receiving respectively. Tetuan had four receptions for 87 yards and the one touchdown reception.

On defense, the Ichabods were led by Grant Gould who had 12 tackles (six solo) including three tackles for loss and two sacks. Sam Tossie had seven tackles.

About the Opponent . . . last time out

EMPORIA, Kan. - Southwest Baptist University's second half comeback fell short as Emporia State took a 45-28 win in MIAA play. Down 24-7 at the half, SBU did not give up as they scored 21 second half points.

Only putting together only 115 yards of total offense in the first half, SBU exploded for 268 yards of offense in the second half. Emporia scored on their first two possessions of the second half looking as if they would run away with the game 38-7. On SBU's next possession, they went 78 yards on 12 plays as Moine Nicholson rushed for his third touchdown of the year to make it 38-14.

The Bearcats forced the Hornets to punt on their next possession as SBU took over on their own 40-yard line. Eight plays later Robert Clardy rushed for his second touchdown of the day from one-yard out to cut the lead to 17, 38-21. Two possessions later, SBU drove to the ESU 25-yard line only to turn the ball over on downs trying to cut he lead to 10.

Four plays later, ESU's Justin Whitworth connected with J.J. Richards on a 59-yard touchdown pass to extend their lead to 45-21 with 5:13 left in the game.

Not giving up, SBU drove once again to the ESU 25-yard line only to see the drive end on a fumble. The Bearcat defense did stop ESU in three plays as Joey Maiwelmal picked off a Whitworth pass at the ESU 41-yard line returning it 12-yards to the 29. With just 2:42 left in the game, SBU ran the clock out as Nick Smart scored the final touchdown on a six-yard pass from Clardy to make the final score, 45-28.

Robert Clardy threw for 249 yards as he completed 30-of-42 passes with one interception. Nick Smart was the leading receiver with 10 receptions and 76 yards receiving. Moine Nicholson rushed 16 times for 56 yards. Once again the SBU offensive line did not give up a sack. It is the third time in four games that they have recorded this feat.

Joey Maiwelmal led SBU with 11 tackles, one forced fumble, and one interception while the SBU defense had one sack.

ESU took a quick 14-0 lead in the first quarter as they scored on their opening possession and then stopped a botched SBU punt attempt at the Bearcat 15-yard line. Five plays later the Hornets rushed in to claim a 14-point lead.

SBU did answer right back with a 59-yard drive that took only 1:51 off the clock. Clardy scored his first touchdown of the day on an option from 17-yards out to cut the ESU lead to seven, 14-7. ESU scored two more times before the half to make it 24-7 entering the half.

On the season, the Bearcats are led by quarterback Robert Clardy who is averaging 144 yards passing per game completing 67 percent of his passes. Moine Nicholson is averaging 81.2 yards per game on the ground. Clardy is also averaging 61 yards per game rushing. Clardy's favorite receiving target has been Rony Santill who has 19 catches for 42 yards per game and three touchdowns.

Series Notes . . .

Today's meeting is the 17th meeting in the series. The Ichabods lead the all-time series 11-5 and they have won eight of the last 11 meetings. The Ichabods are 5-3 in games played in Bolivar.

Last Meeting with SBU. . .

The Washburn football team held off Southwest Baptist 38-35 at Yager Stadium. Mike Odupitan's 6-yard touchdown catch from Tyler Schuerman gave the Ichabods a three-point lead with 31 seconds left.

After Southwest Baptist took a 35-30 lead with 1:46 left on JoJo Rawls' 9-yard touchdown run, the Ichabods made their winning drive - a 13-play, 73 yard trip that saw the Ichabods convert two fourth-down conversions. The Ichabods added the two-point conversion on a Schuerman to Sam Sissom pass in the corner of the endzone.

The Ichabods took an early 7-0 lead on Ra'Shawn Mosley's 7-yard scamper that completed a 14-yard drive who took advantage of a SBU failed fake punt attempt. The Bearcats scored two touchdowns in the second quarter both on long drives - the first a 77-yard, 13 play drive and the second, a 74-yard, nine play drive and took a 14-7 lead into halftime.

In the third quarter, the Ichabods marched 74 yards on Sissom's first of two touchdown receptions to tie the score at 14. Southwest Baptist came back on the ensuing drive to take a 21-14 lead on Robert Clardy's 7-yard run.

The Ichabods would tie the score on Sissom's second touchdown reception and then take the lead as the Ichabods' Chris Brown blocked a Southwest Baptist punt as Tramaine Young scooped it up for a 24-yard return for a score with 52 seconds left in the third quarter.

Washburn's Connor Sabel added a 32-yard field goal to push the Ichabods lead to 30-21, the kick was the first field goal for the Ichabods this season. After two Southwest Baptist TD scores to put them up 35-30, the Ichabods made the go ahead drive with Odupitan's reception with 31 seconds left. However, Southwest Baptist had one last chance. After returning the kickoff to their

own 35 yard line, the Bearcats ripped off runs of 23 yards and 20 yards to put the ball on the Ichabods' 20 yard line. After SBU ran another play to spot the ball in between the hash marks, Ryan Smith pushed his 37-yard field goal to the right and the Ichabods would take a knee to end the game.

Against the Bearcats, Schuerman became Washburn's all-time leader in total offensive yards passing Joe Schartz's record of 6,622. Schuerman now has 6,840 yards for his career (5,352 passing and 1,488 rushing).

Mosley had his best day rushing for the Ichabods with a career-high 143 yards on 23 carries. In the receiving corps, Sissom had 10 receptions for 98 yards and two touchdowns and Odupitan had seven receptions for 102 yards. Defensively, the Ichabods were led by linebacker Evin Beck who had 13 tackles.

Division II opponents. The win over the Colorado Mines in the 2005 opener was the first win over a ranked team on the road for the Ichabods. The other two wins over a ranked opponents are Emporia State 34-21, when the Hornets were ranked No. 16 in the nation on Nov. 2, 2002. The other win over a ranked opponent was on Oct. 17, 1992 when the Ichabods beat 20th-ranked Central Missouri 13-10 in Topeka.

The Ichabods in the national rankings . . .

The Ichabods fell out of the national ranking in both the D2football.com poll and the AFCA national poll after their loss to Central Washington. The Ichabods were ranked No. 21 in the D2Football.com national poll and No. 24 in the AFCA national poll. It was the first time in school history the Ichabods have received votes in the national coaches poll as an NCAA Division II school. The last time the Ichabods were ranked in any national top 25 poll was when they were listed as No. 14 in the final NAIA Division I rankings of 1988.

Record watch . . .

Grant Gould and the tackle charts

Senior linebacker Grant Gould, has started 33 games and became Washburn's all-time leading tackler with his 10 tackles against Western Washington. He has 376 career tackles which topped the 349 tackles recorded by Tony Scollieri (1994-97). Gould has already set the school record for assisted tackles (209) for a career and single-season (73) while at Washburn. He has recorded 167 solo tackles in his career, which is second on the solo tackle chart. The record is 196 set by Tony Scollieri.

Fletcher Terrell and the interception charts

Junior cornerback has been a ball hawk to start the season with three interceptions in four games this season. He has raised his career interception total to 12. He has recorded 326 interception yards in those returns and has returned two of those for touchdowns - his second coming on a 23-yard return against Western Washington. His other interception returned for a touchdown was on Sept. 20, 2003 vs Emporia State - a 60 yard return. The all-time interception leader is A.C. Poynter (1982–83) who had 13 in his career for the Ichabods. Terrell is already the Washburn career passes defended record holder with 44.

Connor Sabel closing in on the extra points

Junior placekicker is closing in on the Washburn extra point chart as he kicked six against Central Washington. He was a perfect 6-for-6 and has converted 87 of 94 his career

Mike Odupitan and the receiving charts

Senior wide receiver Mike Odupitan has recorded 1,994 yards in receptions and 121 catches. Only four Ichabod receivers have gone over the 2,000 yard mark in a career. (Michael Dritlein, 1992-95; Troy Slusser, 1985-88; Sam Sissom, 2002-pr; and Marc Nardella 1996-99.)

Josh Looney and the tackle chart

Senior linebacker Josh Looney has moved into tenth on the all-time tackles chart with 189 for his career (2002-05). He passed Morgan Dewey (2002-03) who recorded 185. Looney has 76 solo stops and 113 assisted tackles in his career.

Sam Sissom and the record books

Sissom missed his second game in a row after suffering an injury against Western Washington returning a punt. His status for this week's game is uncertain.

- Senior wide receiver Sam Sissom became only the fourth Ichabod to go over the 2,000-yard mark in receiving yards for a career recording 2,614 yards in all game for his career. He needs 490 yards in receiving yards to break the school record of 3,103 held by Michael Dritlein (1992-95).
- Against the Orediggers he caught his 33rd, 34th and 35th career regular season touch down passes of his career. The MIAA record for regular season games (not counting playoff games) is 35 by former Northwest Missouri State wide receiver Jamaica Rector (2001-04).
- For his career, Sissom has 36 touchdown receptions a new Washburn record -- and he needs three to break MIAA's career record of 38, also held by Rector.
- His 152 catches rank No. 2 second on the all-time chart. He needs 19 to break Dritlein's record of 170 for a career.
- Sissom's 226 points for his career ties the school record held by Troy Slusser (1985-88).
- Sissom's 37 total touchdowns for a career is also tied with Slusser for the school record.

Intercepting Ichabods. . .

The Ichabods had their eight-game interception streak snapped against Central Washington last time out. The Ichabods had recorded 15 interceptions during the streak. The last game without an interception for the Ichabods was an Oct. 9, 2004 game against Southwest Baptist. In the eight-game streak, Fletcher Terrell had six interceptions and Calvin Stuckey has five. Rounding out the list are Grant Gould, Nick Bull and Erin Beck all with 1. Former Ichabod Evin Beck also had one.

Up next . . .

The Ichabods' will return to Yager Stadium after their two-week hiatus and will take on No. 7 ranked Pittsburg State at 1 p.m. on Oct. 8. The Ichabods will then hit the road again as they take on No. 10 ranked Northwest Missouri in Maryville.



Golden, Colo.. - The Washburn Ichabods opened the 2005 season in fine fashion as they topped No. 14 ranked Colorado Mines 28-17. In the process, the Ichabods won their fourth straight overall game since the 1988 season when they won four straight from Oct. 1 to Oct. 22.

The Ichabods jumped on the board early as sophomore quarterback Jordan Brill, making his second career start, hit Sam Sissom on a 62-yard touchdown strike. It was the first of three Sissom touchdown receptions from Brill as he would finish with

seven receptions for 231 yards and lifted his career touchdown tally to 36, setting the Washburn all-time record. He also raised his career point total to 226, tying Troy Slusser for the most points in school history. Sissom's 35 regular season touchdown receptions also ties Jamaica Rector's (Northwest Missouri, 2001-04) record for most in MIAA history.

After trading possessions with the Orediggers, Brill and Sissom hooked up again for an 82-yard touchdown to put the Ichabods up 14-0. The Ichabods would increase their lead to 21-0 after Sissom caught his final TD pass capping a 7-play, 97-yard drive after the Ichabod defense held the Orediggers out of the endzone from inside the Washburn 10



yard line.

The Orediggers would rebound with a 50-yard drive right before the half converting a 38-yard field goal to cut the Ichabod lead to 21-3 at the break.

In the second half, the Orediggers jumped on the board on their first drive of the half to cut the lead to 21-10, but the Ichabods came right back with a 78-yard drive finished off by Trent Hearn's 6-yard run, which would wrap the scoring for the Ichabods.

Colorado Mines added a touchdown late, but would not get any closer.

The Ichabods racked up 144 yards on the ground with Hearn going over the 100-yard mark with 21 carries for 106 yards and Ra'Shawn Mosley had 13 carries for 68 yards. Mike Odupitan had four catches for 57 yards and Jeff Scott had a career high 60 yards receiving with three receptions.

On the defense, the Ichabods created five turnovers, including two interceptions by Fletcher Terrell. Calvin Stuckey and Erin Beck each had interceptions and Terell Cobb had a fumble recovery.

Senior Grant Gould had 12 tackles including two sacks for the Ichabods, giving him 343 for his career, needing seven to break the current school record of 349 held by Tony Scollieri.


TOPEKA -- The Washburn Ichabods improved to 2-0 with a 31-21 win over Western Washington on Saturday in Yager Stadium.



TOPEKA - The Washburn Ichabods improved to 3-0 after topping Central Missouri 42-27 in Yager Stadium. The win was the sixth straight overall win dating back to last season - something that no Ichabod team has done since 1964 - while in the process snapping an eight-game losing streak to the Mules.

The Ichabods jumped on the board first as Jordan Brill hooked up with Mike Odupitan on a 45-yard pass reception capping a six-play, 95-yard drive. The Mules would score their only two points in the first half on a safety late in the first quarter.

The Ichabods rounded out the scoring in the first half with a 7-yard touchdown pass to Jarod Tetuan. It was a busy day for Tetuan as he played both offense and defense for the Ichabods as well as special teams. He had one rush, one carry, one punt return and six tackles in the game.

In the second half, the Mules jumped on the board first as Spencer Webb hit a 32-yard field goal. The teams traded scores as the Ćason Lehman caught a 19-yard touchdown pass from Brill - the second of his third TD passes on the day. After a CMSU score to cut the lead



to 21-13, Fletcher Terrell set a Washburn record and became the 13th person in MIAA history to return a kickoff for 100 yards to push the lead back to 15.

The Ichabods would add another score on a Ra'Shawn Mosley 25vard touchdown run. The Mules would score to cut the lead to 35-19.

Washburn running back Trent Hearn would close out the Ichabod scoring with a 39-yard run to push the lead back to 42-19. The Mules added the final score on a touchdown pass rounding out the scoring at

The Ichabod defense held the Mules to 87 yards of total offense in the first half. Grant Gould led the Ichabods with nine tackles including one sack. Aaron Neal had nine tackles. Nick Bull had the Ichabods only interception of the game and he returned in 12 yards to set up a Washburn touchdown.

Trent Hearn led the Washburn rushing attack with 90 yards and one touchdown. Ra'Shawn Mosley had 78 yards and the team overall had 178 yards.

Mike Odupitan had five catches for 111 yards and one touchdown.

ELLENSBURG, Wash. - The Washburn Ichabods fell for the first time this season coming up short in the comeback bid dropping a 48-42 decision to Central Washington.


The Ichabods found themselves down 14-0 less than eight minutes into the game as the Wildcats scored the first two touchdowns of the game. The Ichabods jumped on the scoreboard with 4:44 remaining in the first quarter as Ra'Shawn Mosley capped a 6-play, 65 yard drive cutting the score to 14-7.

Central Washington (2-2) would score of the first play of the ensuing drive as they scored on a 52-yard touchdown to increase the lead to 21-7. It would be the first seven of a total of 24-unanswered points the Wildcats would score to build the lead to 38-7 with 9:06 remaining in the first half.

The Ichabods responded as quarterback Jordan Brill connected with

Jarod Tetuan on a 24-yard touchdown strike to cut the lead to 38-14. After forcing a three-and-out, the Ichabods scored with 1:27 left in the first half as Jeff Scott caught a 57-yard touchdown reception from Bill cutting the lead to 38-21.

The Wildcats received the second half with the football and after the Ichabods forced the Wildcats into putting formation, Fletcher Terrell blocked the Central Washington punt and recovered it on the Wildcats' 4-yard line, but an offsides penalty on the Ichabods on the 4th and four gave the Wildcats the first down. On that same drive, the Ichabods' Josh Looney picked off a Mike Riley pass as the Wildcat quarterback he was running out of bounds, however the officials ruled they had an inadvertent whistle giving possession back to the Wildcats. The Wildcats would continue to drive and kick a 27-yard field goal to push the lead to 41-21 with 9:05 left in the third quarter. Central Washington would add another touchdown on their next possession.



Washburn would then mount their comeback as Scott caught his second touchdown pass of the afternoon from Brill - this time a 5-yard completion to cut the lead to 48-28 with 1:05 left in the third quarter.

On the Ichabods' next possession, Washburn drove 80-yards in 10 plays as Brill hit Jake Lebahn for a 27-yard touchdown pass. It was Lebahn's first touchdown of his career.

The Ichabods defense forced a missed field goal by the Wildcats and the Ichabods took the ball back over with 4:01 remaining in the game.

Brill then led the Ichabods on another 80-yard drive hitting Lebahn with an 18-yard touchdown hook-up to cut the lead to 48-42 with 3:04 left.

The Ichabods forced the Wildcats into punt formation again,

but the Ichabods were called with a roughing the kicker penalty and the Wildcats regained possession. The Ichabod defense pushed the Wildcats into another punt and the Ichabods took over with 1:11 remaining.

Brill would hit Mosley over the middle for 11-vards. After a CWU offsides penalty, Brill again hit Mosley to push the ball up to the Central Washington 47. The Ichabods would get no closer as three passes into the end zone fell incomplete handing the Ichabods

Brill passed was 21-of-39 for 328 yards and a career-high five touchdown passes - two touchdown passes going to Lebahn and to Scott who finished with 91 and 62 yards receiving respectively. Tetuan had four receptions for 87 yards and the one touchdown reception.

On defense, the Ichabods were led by Grant Gould who had 12 tackles (six solo) including three tackles for loss and two sacks. Sam Tossie had seven tackles.
