Ichabods vs Gorillas

The Game . . .

The Washburn Ichabods (4-1, 2-0 MIAA) will take on the No. 4 ranked Pittsburg State Gorillas as they return to Yager Stadium for their first home game since a 42-27 win over Central Missouri on Sept. 10. The Ichabods scored 42-unanswered points in a 56-21 win over Southwest Baptist last time out in Bolivar, Mo. The Gorillas (4-1, 2-0 MIAA) have won four straight games after falling in the season opener to then-ranked No. 17 Delta State. Pitt State topped Emporia State 52-17 last Saturday in Pittsburg.

The Coaches . . .

Washburn head football coach Craig Schurig was named head coach of the Ichabod football program Dec. 28, 2001.

Schurig is 20-19 (.512) in his fourth season as the Ichabod head coach and he is 12-15 against the MIAA.

In only three seasons as the Ichabods' head coach, Schurig has led the Washburn football program to a new level with a school-best finish in the MIAA, their first winning season since 1999 and their first postseason win since 1986 with a 36-33 win over Northern State in the 2004 Mineral Water Bowl.

The Ichabods finished the 2004 season with an 8-4 record as Washburn has improved five victories in the win column since Schurig's first season at the helm.

Pittsburg State head coach Chuck Broyles is in his 16th season at the helm of his alma mater (PSU, '70). The only collegiate coach since the 1890s to win 100 games in less than 10 full seasons, Broyles has guided the Gorillas to a 158-31-2 (.832) record since taking charge in 1990.

He is the second-winningest active NCAA-II head coach, by percentage, and the second-winningest active coach among all NCAA I-A, I-AA, and II schools. Broyles also is the winningest head coach in Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association and Pitt State history. Broyles, who currently serves as the chair of the NCAA Football Rules Committee, became the first coach in MIAA history to capture his ninth conference championship in 2004. He passed former Truman coach Maurice "Red" Wade, who won eight MIAA titles between 1951 and 1965.

Broyles was named the 2004 MIAA Coach of the Year - marking the fifth time in his tenure he has won the award outright or shared the accolades (1990, '92, '94, '99, '04).

over Southwest Baptist at Plaster Stadium Saturday. Washburn trailed 21-14 late in the first half before dominating the second half en route to victory.

Washburn, which improved to 4-1 and 2-0 in the MIAA heading into a 1 p.m. game with No. 7 Pittsburg State, suffered an early turnover to lead to an SBU touchdown just over a minute into the game on Rony Santil's touchdown reception. Grant Gould turned the tables on the Bearcats by running in a interception return 26 yards for a touchdown minutes later.

The two squads traded scores the rest of the half, including a 7-yard scoring grab by Cason Lehman and a 12-yard grab by Mike Odupitan with 26 seconds left in the half on passes by Jordan Brill. The squads were deadlocked at 21 at the break before Washburn erupted.

The Ichabods owned the second half and went up for good on Jake Lebahn's 47-yard touchdown reception from Brill at 11:13 left in the third quarter. Lebahn added another touchdown on a blocked punt return at 9:01 in the quarter.

Trent Hearn capped the scoring in the third on a 25-yard touchdown run before Ra'Shawn Mosley added a 15 yard score and Rashawn Bland added a 1-yard run in the fourth quarter to give Washburn a 35-0 margin in the second half.

Mosley led Washburn with 72 yards rushing, while A.J. Patterson and Hearn added 70 and 63 yards respectively. Patterson had a 53 yard run late in the game for WU's longest play of the day. Brill finished with 187 yards and three touchdowns on 10 of 17 passing.

Gould finished with 12 tackles, including 2.5 for loss to go along with his interception return for a score. Henry Talley was the other Ichabod in double figures with 10 tackles. Josh Looney and Fletcher Terrell added interceptions in the win.

About the Opponent . . . last time out

PITTSBURG -- Seventh-ranked Pittsburg State University scored 35 unanswered points for a second straight year against Emporia State University and the Gorillas once again easily handled the Hornets -- this time 52-17 Saturday (Sept. 24) before a sellout crowd of 9,534 fans in "The Pitt", Brandenburg Field/Carnie Smith Stadium.

Germaine Race rushed 25 times for 171 yards and four touchdowns to help Pitt State (4-1, 3-0 MIAA) compile 447 yards of total offense against Emporia State (2-2, 1-1 MIAA).

Ichabod head coach Craig Schurig

A new era in Washburn football began when Craig Schurig was named head coach of the Ichabod football program Dec. 28, 2001.

In only three seasons as the Ichabods' head coach, Schurig has led the Washburn football program to a new level with a school-best finish in the MIAA, their first winning season since 1999 and their first postseason win since 1986 with a 36-33 win over Northern State in the 2004 Mineral Water Bowl.

The Ichabods finished the 2004 season with an 8-4 record as Washburn has improved five victories in the win column since Schurig's first season at the helm.

After coaching for nearly a decade in a winning program, Schurig has brought the knowledge of success, a winning attitude and a new intensity to the Ichabod football program.

In his three seasons at Washburn, the Ichabods have had two MIAA Freshman of the Year and 27 players receive All-MIAA honors. He has been equally on task with players in the classroom with 40 Ichabods named to the MIAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll, including two Academic All-Americans.

While under Schurig, the Ichabod football pro-

gram has also seen sweeping changes in facilities with the improvements to Yager Stadium and equipment upgrades in the weight room.

While on the Pittsburg State coaching staff, Schurig was a part of an NCAA national finalist squad in 1995, four MIAA Championship teams and eight NCAA Division II playoff teams. He helped guide one of the top defenses in Division II including the top-ranked defensive squad in 1999.

Prior to working with the defensive backs, he worked three seasons with the Gorillas' tight ends.

Before arriving at Pittsburg State, Schurig spent the 1992 season as a volunteer assistant coach at his alma mater, Colorado School of Mines joining the Gorillas in 1993.

Schurig, a Willingboro, N.J., native, was a four-year letterman as a defensive back at Colorado Mines and was selected team captain as a senior. He earned second-team All-Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference honors as a senior. He graduated in 1987 with a bachelor's degree in petroleum engineering.

Schurig earned a master's degree in physical education at Pittsburg State in 1996. Craig and his wife, Louisa, have a daughter, Samantha, and two sons, Mitchell and Michael.

on their opening drive of the game. ESU benefitted from a 38-yard kickoff return from Ryan Hulings and a 15-yard facemasking penalty against Pitt State to start the drive at the PSU 47. The Hornets drove to the PSU 4, before the Gorilla defense stiffened and forced ESU to settle for Jeff Edwards' 27-yard field goal.

Pitt State wasted little time in turning the tide of momentum back in its favor. Race broke loose for a 73-yard scoring run on the Gorillas' second offensive play, and Pitt State never trailed following that play.

An opportunistic Pitt State defense forced six turnovers in the game, including four interceptions.

Cornerback Matt Sauber had a pair of interceptions in the game. His first came on ESU's second drive and the secone one he returned for a 30-yard score that put Pitt State in front 49-10 with 17 seconds to play in the third quarter. The Gorillas turned ESU's six miscues into 21 points in the game.

Fullback Joe Taylor broke loose for a 37-yard touchdown run on PSU's third offensive series, one play after defensive end Ryan Meredith jarred the ball loose from ESU quarterback Justin Whitworth and recovered the ball at the ESU 37.

Tight end Brandon Twito caught a 17-yard TD pass from Andy Majors, who completed 8 of 12 passes for 139 yards in the game. Race added touchdown runs of 1 and 7 yards in the second quarter. He also capped a 10-play, 65-yard drive with a 9-yard run on PSU's first offensive series of the second half, stretching the Gorillas' margin to 42-10.

ESU managed just 248 yards of offense in the game. PSU, which registered four quarterback sacks in the game, limited the Hornets to 101 yards rushing on 38 carries. Whitworth, who entered the game ranked No. 2 in Division II in passing efficiency, completed 9 of 17 passes for 89 yards and a TD with two INTs.

Wide receiver J.J. Richard, who caught seven passes for 226 yards and three TDs a week ago, was held in check, catching just one pass for four yards in the game.

Meredith led the Pitt State defense with six solo tackles, including three quarterback sacks. Linebacker Chris Jaax had a game-high nine tackles with two TFLs and 1.0 quarterback sack, while linebacker Josh Lattimer added eight stops, a TFL and an interception.

The Gorillas boast the MIAA's leading rusher in junior Germaine Race. Race is averaging 158 yards per game and 7.8 yards per carry to go with 13 touchdowns. Senior quarterback Andy Majors leads the MIAA in total offense with 273.8 yards per game. Majors is fourth in the MIAA in passing per game with a 211.4 per game clip. On defense, the Gorillas are led by senior linebacker Josh Lattimer, who is picking up 9.8 tackles per game. Junior defensive lineman Ryan Meredith leads the league in sacks with 1.1 per game and 5.5 on the season. Meredith is also second in the MIAA in tackles for loss and third in forced fumbles.

Series Notes . . .

Today's meeting is the 78th meeting in the series. A series that has seen the Gorillas win 25-straight games. Overall, Pittsburg State leads the all-time series 58-18-1. The last win in the series was Oct. 4, 1980 when the Ichabods won 38-36 in Topeka. The last win for the Ichabods in Pittsburg was Oct. 18, 1969 when the Ichabods won 19-17. During the 25-game losing streak, the Ichabods have been outscored 1,054 to 311 — an average of 42.2 to 12.4.

Last Meeting with PSU . . .

The Washburn Ichabods fell 70-14 to No. 3 ranked Pittsburg State. The Gorillas scored 22 points in the first quarter, 21 in the second and 20 in the third as they reached at least 70 points for the second straight game.

The Ichabods got on the board in the second quarter as Jordan Brill hooked up with Jeff Scott for a 8-yard touchdown pass. Scott had a career-high seven receptions for 64 yards.

The Gorillas responded by rolling off 35 straight points to push the score to 63-7.

Cason Lehman added the Ichabods final touchdown as he scored on a 34-yard pass reception from Dustin Hickel capping a 6-play, 93-yard drive.

The Gorillas would add one more score to make the final tally 70-14.

Pitt State also piled up more than 700 yards of offense for a second straight game after accumulating an MIAA record 809 total yards in a 91-27 win over Missouri-Rolla last Saturday.

The Ichabods compiled 420 yards of total offense in the game compared to 713 for the Gorillas.

Brill, making his first collegiate start, was 18 of 32 for 167 yards and one touchdown. Ra'Shawn Mosley had 21 carries for 90 yards. Lehman, Sam Sissom and Mike Odupitan each had four catches.

The Gorillas had three rushers go over 100 yards in the game. Starting tailback Germaine Race had 12 carries for 186 yards and three touchdowns, starting quarterback Neal Philpot had 14 carries for 166 yards and reserve quarterback Andy Majors had nine carries for 128 yards and two touchdown scores.

Washburn Football History . . .

Washburn is 463-531-44 in its 115th year of college football. The Ichabods have had seven 8-win seasons, including last year's 8-4 mark. The other

With his 74 receiving yards against Southwest Baptist, senior wide receiver Mike Odupitan has raised his career totals to 2,068 receiving yards and 124 receptions. Odupitan became only the fifth Ichabod to go over the 2,000-yard mark in a career. (Michael Dritlein, 1992-95; Troy Slusser, 1985-88; Sam Sissom, 2002-pr; and Marc Nardella 1996-99.)

Josh Looney and the tackle chart

Senior linebacker Josh Looney has moved into eight on the all-time tackles chart with 195 for his career (2002-05). With his six total tackles against Southwest Baptist, he passed Morgan Dewey (2002-03) who recorded 185 and Wde Dennis (1986-88) who recorded 191 for his career. Looney has 78 solo stops and 117 assisted tackles in his career.

Sam Sissom and the record books

Sissom missed his third game in a row after suffering an injury against Western Washington returning a punt. His status for this week's game is uncertain.

- Senior wide receiver Sam Sissom became only the fourth Ichabod to go over the 2,000-yard mark in receiving yards for a career recording 2,614 yards in all game for his career. He needs 490 yards in receiving yards to break the school record of 3,103 held by Michael Dritlein (1992-95).
- Against the Orediggers he caught his 33rd, 34th and 35th career regular season touch down passes of his career. The MIAA record for regular season games (not counting play-off games) is 35 by former Northwest Missouri State wide receiver Jamaica Rector (2001-04).
- For his career, Sissom has 36 touchdown receptions - a new Washburn record -- and he needs three to break MIAA's career record of 38, also held by Rector.
- His 152 catches rank No. 2 second on the all-time chart. He needs 19 to break Dritlein's record of 170 for a career.
- Sissom's 226 points for his career ties the school record held by Troy Slusser (1985-88).
- Sissom's 37 total touchdowns for a career is also tied with Slusser for the school record.

Ichabod and Gorilla connections . . .

There are six current coaches on the Ichabod coaching staff with ties to Pitt State. Other than head coach Craig Schurig's nine years on the Gorilla staff, five other coaches also have ties to the Gorillas' program.

Defensive coordinator Chris Brown was a three-time all-American who recorded 470 tackles in 43 starts and was named the CNN Division II National Player of the Year. He is one of only four Gorillas to be named all-American three times.

Linebacker's coach Cooper Harris played for the Gorillas from 1992 to 1994 where he recorded 295 tackles in 31 games, seventh on the all-time chart. He won the Joe Murphy Award twice as the team's most valuable defensive player.

Wide receivers coach Rob Robinson spent one season as a graduate assistant with the Gorillas after wrapping up his playing days at William Jewell.

Defensive line coach David Trupp was the defensive line and offseason strength and condition coordinator for the Gorillas from 1996 to 1998.


Graduate Assistant Dion Menely was a six-year member of the Gorillas from 1994-99. He recorded 203 tackles and was a two-time all-MIAA pick and team captain as a senior.



Golden, Colo.. - The Washburn Ichabods opened the 2005 season in fine fashion as they topped No. 14 ranked Colorado Mines 28-17. In the process, the Ichabods won their fourth straight overall game since the 1988 season when they won four straight from Oct. 1 to Oct. 22.

The Ichabods jumped on the board early as sophomore quarterback Jordan Brill, making his second career start, hit Sam Sissom on a 62-yard touchdown strike. It was the first of three Sissom touchdown receptions from Brill as he would finish with seven receptions for 231 yards and lifted his career touchdown tally to 36, setting the Washburn all-time record. He also raised his career point total to 226, tying Troy Slusser for the most points in school history. Sissom's 35 regular season touchdown receptions also ties Jamaica Rector's (Northwest Missouri, 2001-04) record for most in MIAA history.

After trading possessions with the Orediggers, Brill and Sissom hooked up again for an 82-yard touchdown to put the Ichabods up 14-0. The Ichabods would increase their lead to 21-0 after Sissom caught his final TD pass capping a 7-play, 97-yard drive after the Ichabod defense held the Orediggers out of the endzone from inside the Washburn 10



yard line.

The Orediggers would rebound with a 50-yard drive right before the half converting a 38-yard field goal to cut the Ichabod lead to 21-3 at the break.

In the second half, the Orediggers jumped on the board on their first drive of the half to cut the lead to 21-10, but the Ichabods came right back with a 78-yard drive finished off by Trent Hearn's 6-yard run, which would wrap the scoring for the Ichabods.

Colorado Mines added a touchdown late, but would not get any closer.

The Ichabods racked up 144 yards on the ground with Hearn going over the 100-yard mark with 21 carries for 106 yards and Ra'Shawn Mosley had 13 carries for 68 yards. Mike Odupitan had four catches for 57 yards and Jeff Scott had a career high 60 yards receiving with three receptions.

On the defense, the Ichabods created five turnovers, including two interceptions by Fletcher Terrell. Calvin Stuckey and Erin Beck each had interceptions and Terrell Cobb had a fumble recovery.

Senior Grant Gould had 12 tackles including two sacks for the Ichabods, giving him 343 for his career, needing seven to break the current school record of 349 held by Tony Scollieri.


TOPEKA -- The Washburn Ichabods improved to 2-0 with a 31-21 win over Western Washington on Saturday in Yager Stadium.



TOPEKA - The Washburn Ichabods improved to 3-0 after topping Central Missouri 42-27 in Yager Stadium. The win was the sixth straight overall win dating back to last season - something that no Ichabod team has done since 1964 - while in the process snapping an eight-game losing streak to the Mules.

The Ichabods jumped on the board first as Jordan Brill hooked up with Mike Odupitan on a 45-yard pass reception capping a six-play, 95-yard drive. The Mules would score their only two points in the first half on a safety late in the first quarter.

The Ichabods rounded out the scoring in the first half with a 7-yard touchdown pass to Jarod Tetuan. It was a busy day for Tetuan as he played both offense and defense for the Ichabods as well as special teams. He had one rush, one carry, one punt return and six tackles in the game.

In the second half, the Mules jumped on the board first as Spencer Webb hit a 32-yard field goal. The teams traded scores as the Cason Lehman caught a 19-yard touchdown pass from Brill - the second of his third TD passes on the day. After a CMSU score to cut the lead



to 21-13, Fletcher Terrell set a Washburn record and became the 13th person in MIAA history to return a kickoff for 100 yards to push the lead back to 15.

The Ichabods would add another score on a Ra'Shawn Mosley 25-yard touchdown run. The Mules would score to cut the lead to 35-19.

Washburn running back Trent Hearn would close out the Ichabod scoring with a 39-yard run to push the lead back to 42-19. The Mules added the final score on a touchdown pass rounding out the scoring at

42-27.

The Ichabod defense held the Mules to 87 yards of total offense in the first half. Grant Gould led the Ichabods with nine tackles including one sack. Aaron Neal had nine tackles. Nick Bull had the Ichabods only interception of the game and he returned in 12 yards to set up a Washburn touchdown.

Trent Hearn led the Washburn rushing attack with 90 yards and one touchdown. Ra'Shawn Mosley had 78 yards and the team overall had 178 yards.

Mike Odupitan had five catches for 111 yards and one touchdown.


ELLENSBURG, Wash. - The Washburn Ichabods fell for the first time this season coming up short in the comeback bid dropping a 48-42 decision to Central Washington.

The Ichabods found themselves down 14-0 less than eight minutes into the game as the Wildcats scored the first two touchdowns of the game. The Ichabods jumped on the scoreboard with 4:44 remaining in the first quarter as Ra'Shawn Mosley capped a 6-play, 65 yard drive cutting the score to 14-7.

Central Washington (2-2) would score of the first play of the ensuing drive as they scored on a 52-yard touchdown to increase the lead to 21-7. It would be the first seven of a total of 24-unanswered points the Wildcats would score to build the lead to 38-7 with 9:06 remaining in the first half.

The Ichabods responded as quarterback Jordan Brill connected with Jarod Tetuan on a 24-yard touchdown strike to cut the lead to 38-14. After forcing a three-and-out, the Ichabods scored with 1:27 left in the first half as Jeff Scott caught a 57-yard touchdown reception from Bill cutting the lead to 38-21.

The Wildcats received the second half with the football and after the Ichabods forced the Wildcats into putting formation, Fletcher Terrell blocked the Central Washington punt and recovered it on the Wildcats' 4-yard line, but an offsides penalty on the Ichabods on the 4th and four gave the Wildcats the first down. On that same drive, the Ichabods' Josh Looney picked off a Mike Riley pass as the Wildcat quarterback he was running out of bounds, however the officials ruled they had an inadvertent whistle giving possession back to the Wildcats. The Wildcats would continue to drive and kick a 27-yard field goal to push the lead to 41-21 with 9:05 left in the third quarter. Central Washington would add another touchdown on their next possession.



Washburn would then mount their comeback as Scott caught his second touchdown pass of the afternoon from Brill - this time a 5-yard completion to cut the lead to 48-28 with 1:05 left in the third quarter.

On the Ichabods' next possession, Washburn drove 80-yards in 10 plays as Brill hit Jake Lebahn for a 27-yard touchdown pass. It was Lebahn's first touchdown of his career.

The Ichabods defense forced a missed field goal by the Wildcats and the Ichabods took the ball back over with 4:01 remaining in the game.

Brill then led the Ichabods on another 80-yard drive hitting Lebahn with an 18-yard touchdown hook-up to cut the lead to 48-42 with 3:04 left.

The Ichabods forced the Wildcats into punt formation again,

but the Ichabods were called with a roughing the kicker penalty and the Wildcats regained possession. The Ichabod defense pushed the Wildcats into another punt and the Ichabods took over with 1:11 remaining.

Brill would hit Mosley over the middle for 11-yards. After a CWU offsides penalty, Brill again hit Mosley to push the ball up to the Central Washington 47. The Ichabods would get no closer as three passes into the end zone fell incomplete handing the Ichabods the 48-42 loss.

Brill passed was 21-of-39 for 328 yards and a career-high five touchdown passes - two touchdown passes going to Lebahn and to Scott who finished with 91 and 62 yards receiving respectively. Tetuan had four receptions for 87 yards and the one touchdown reception.

On defense, the Ichabods were led by Grant Gould who had 12 tackles (six solo) including three tackles for loss and two sacks. Sam Tossie had seven tackles.


