Ichabods vs Hornets

<u>The Game . . .</u>

The No. 10 Ichabods (7-1, 5-0 MIAA) will look to spoil its arch-rival's homecoming as Washburn travels to Emporia to take on the Emporia State Hornets (3-4, 2-3 MIAA). The Ichabods are coming off a 21-14 win over Truman State. The Hornets fell 21-14 last time out falling to Missouri Western. The Ichabods enter the game ranked No. 10 in the AFCA Coaches Poll and No. 12 in the D2football.com Poll. The ranking is the highest the Ichabods have achieved since joining the NCAA Division II ranks in football. The Ichabods were also ranked as the No. 1 team in the Southwest Regional Poll that was released on Monday.

The Coaches . . .

Washburn head football coach Craig Schurig was named head coach of the Ichabod football program Dec. 28, 2001. Schurig is 23-19 (.548) in his fourth season as the Ichabod head coach and he is 17-15 against the MIAA.

In only three seasons as the Ichabods' head coach, Schurig has led the Washburn football program to a new level with a school-best finish in the MIAA, their first winning season since 1999 and their first postseason win since 1986 with a 36-33 win over Northern State in the 2004 Mineral Water Bowl.

The Ichabods finished the 2004 season with an 8-4 record as Washburn has improved five victories in the win column since Schurig's first season at the helm.

Emporia State head coach Dave Wiemers 31-22 (.548) in his fifth year of guiding the Hornets. He was named Wilson/MIAA Coach of the Year in 2003 after guiding ESU a spot in the NCAA playoffs. He is the third winningest coach by percentage in ESU history. He is 2-2 against Washburn.

Truman (1-7, 0-6 MIAA) scored first in the game converting a turnover into a touchdown after a scoreless first quarter as senior WR James Walton caught a 23-yard pass from freshman QB Michael Long.

The Ichabods (7-1, 5-0 MIAA) would not score until 43 seconds left in the half as senior WR Mike Odupitan hooked up with sophomore QB Jordan Brill on a 21-yard pass reception as the Ichabods drove 76 yards in 12 plays to tie the game at 7-7.

Saturday, November 26 NCAA Division II Playoffs The Bulldogs took the lead on a 1-yard touchdown run by senior RB Jerard Leverson with 5:31 left in the third quarter capping a 12-play 57-yard yard drive. Leverson had 117 yards on 29 carries, his second 100-yard rushing game in as many weeks.

Washburn took the lead for good on a 31-yard run by junior RB Trent Hearn. Hearn rushed for a career-high 178 yards on 27 carries. Hearn added his second touchdown on the Ichabods' next possession that put the Ichabods up 21-14.

After forcing an Ichabod punt with 3:18 in the game, the Bulldogs drove to their own 45-yard line, but the Ichabods' senior LB Terell Cobb picked off Long's pass at the Washburn 43 to end the threat and wrap up the game.

Brill passed for 249 yards and one touchdown. On defense, senior LB Grant Gould led the Ichabods with 13 tackles. He also has a tackle for loss, a pass break up and an interception he returned for 26 yards. Junior DB Fletcher Terrell and senior LB Mike Gonzalez each had nine tackles.

Long was 27-of-51 for 276 yards, three interceptions and one touchdown. Junior WR James Perry had eight catches for 52 yards. Senior DB Jason Douglas led Truman with 10 tackles (five solos), while junior LB Larry Giglio had an interception and a fumble forced and recovered.

The Ichabods outgained the Bulldogs, 418-370, despite running 10 less plays.

About the Opponent . . . last time out

EMPORIA, Kan. -- The Missouri Western Griffons snapped a three-game losing streak to the Emporia State Hornets, getting a 21-14 victory at Welch Stadium Saturday afternoon.

Western (6-2, 3-2 MIAA) found itself down 7-0 by halftime, even though it out-gained the Hornets (3-4, 2-3 MIAA), 148-129, in total yardage, had one more first down and held the ball five minutes longer.

Junior QB Justin Whitworth found junior TE Trent Olivier with a 5-yard scoring pass with 1:27 to go in the second quarter to cap a 10-play, 67-yard drive for Emporia State.

The Griffons scored on their opening possession of the second half, going eight plays for 58 yards capped by a junior QB Michael Burton 1-yard TD run to tie the game at 7-7.

<u>Ichabod head coach Craig Schurig</u>

A new era in Washburn football began when Craig Schurig was named head coach of the Ichabod football program Dec. 28, 2001.

In only three seasons as the Ichabods' head coach, Schurig has led the Washburn football program to a new level with a school-best finish in the MIAA, their first winning season since 1999 and their first postseason win since 1986 with a 36-33 win over Northern State in the 2004 Mineral Water Bowl.

The Ichabods finished the 2004 season with an 8-4 record as Washburn has improved five victories in the win column since Schurig's first season at the helm.

After coaching for nearly a decade in a winning program, Schurig has brought the knowledge of success, a winning attitude and a new intensity to the Ichabod football program.

In his three seasons at Washburn, the Ichabods have had two MIAA Freshman of the Year and 27 players receive All-MIAA honors. He has been equally on task with players in the classroom with 40 Ichabods named to the MIAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll, including two Academic All-Americans.

While under Schurig, the Ichabod football pro-

gram has also seen sweeping changes in facilities with the improvements to Yager Stadium and equipment upgrades in the weight room.

While on the Pittsburg State coaching staff, Schurig was a part of an NCAA national finalist squad in 1995, four MIAA Championship teams and eight NCAA Division II playoff teams. He helped guide one of the top defenses in Division II including the top-ranked defensive squad in 1999.

Prior to working with the defensive backs, he worked three seasons with the Gorillas' tight ends.

Before arriving at Pittsburg State, Schurig spent the 1992 season as a volunteer assistant coach at his alma mater, Colorado School of Mines joining the Gorillas in 1993.

Schurig, a Willingboro, N.J., native, was a fouryear letterman as a defensive back at Colorado Mines and was selected team captain as a senior. He earned second-team All-Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference honors as a senior. He graduated in 1987 with a bachelor's degree in petroleum engineering.

Schurig earned a master's degree in physical education at Pittsburg State in 1996. Craig and his wife, Louisa, have a daughter, Samantha, and two sons, Mitchell and Michael.

The tie was short-lived as freshman K Robbie Walling's kickoff was returned 92 yards by junior WR/KR Ryan Hulings to put the Hornets back on top at 14-7 with 8:07 remaining. It was ESU's first kickoff return for a touchdown since Ryan Johnson returned one 100 yards against CMSU in 1999.

Western then scored the final 14 points of the game in the final quarter. Western capitalized on a nine-play, 70-yard touchdown drive capped by a Burton TD pass to sophomore WR Jarrett Brooks for 35 yards to knot the game at 14-14.

Western went ahead for good after two ESU possessions that were stopped when Griffons' junior RB Jeremiah White scored on a 10-yard run at the 4:34 mark. Western stopped ESU on its final three drives of the fourth quarter to seal the win.

Western out-gained the Hornets 366-232, had an advantage in first downs (24-15) and held the ball for five more minutes.

White rushed for 179 yards on 34 carries and one touchdown for the Griffons. Western rushed for 221 yards on 50 attempts for Western. Burton completed 12-of-25 passes for 145 yards and one TD.

Defensively, the Griffons were led by junior LB John Matthew Fisher with nine tackles, six solo. The Griffons recorded 10 tackles behind the line of scrimmage and three sacks.

Whitworth was 18-of-31 passing for 180 yards, one TD and one interception. Senior WR J.J. Richard caught seven passes for 70 yards, and freshman RB Seville Ko had 38 rushing yards on 17 carries for the Hornets.

Junior S Troy Johnson had 15 tackles (nine solos) for ESU, while sophomore S Jack Richter added 10 stops (six solos).

Series Notes . . .

Today's meeting is the 102nd in the series between the Ichabods and the Hornets. Emporia State and Washburn have met every year since 1899 with the exception of 1943 through 1945 because of World War II and 1989 and 1990 after Washburn moved to NCAA Division II and the Hornets remained in NAIA until 1991. The teams also played twice during the 1966 season. Emporia State leads the all-time series 51-44-6. The Ichabods have won two of the last three meetings. The Ichabods have not won in Emporia

since a Nov. 14, 1987 win over the Hornets with a 28-21 score. Overall, the Ichabods have lost the last seven meetings in Emporia including a 35-28 overtime loss last time in Emporia on Sept. 20, 2003.

Last Meeting with ESU . . .

(Sept. 11, 2005) - TOPEKA - The Washburn Ichabods won their first MIAA-opening game since 2000 and defeated Emporia State in the process in the 101st meeting in the series with a 28-10 win in Yager Stadium. With the win the Ichabods improved to 2-1 on the season and 1-0 in the MIAA.

The Hornets struck first on the score board with a 30-yard field goal by Justin Gray. In what set the tone for the afternoon with the Ichabod defense, the Hornets managed just five yards on four plays after the Hornets took their first possession at the Washburn 18-yard line.

The Ichabods did not waste any time as they drove 80 yards in five plays as Tyler Schuerman and Sam Sissom hooked up on a 36-yard touchdown strike that gave the Ichabods a lead they would not let go of.

The Ichabods would score on their next possession after Fletcher Terrell intercepted ESU quarterback Tad Hatfield and returned in 69 yards to the ESU 11 yard line and three plays later Trent Hearn finished the drive with a 3yard touchdown plunge.

Emporia State scored on the fourth play of the second quarter to make the score 14-10 Washburn, but that would be the last scoring on the day for the Hornets.

Neither team would score in the third quarter and with 5:32 left in the game, Schuerman and Sissom hooked up again on an 86-yard touchdown pass on a third and 10 from their own 14 yard line to put the Ichabods up 21-10. After forcing the Hornets to turn the ball over on downs, the Ichabods would score one more time as Rawshawn Bland rushed for seven yards to put the Ichabods up 28-10 with 2:24 remaining. The key play of the drive was Sissom again catching a third down pass from Schuerman on a third and eight from the ESU 26.

Overall in the second half, the Ichabods forced Emporia State to turn the ball over on downs on four possessions and on three in a row to end the game. The Ichabod defense was on the field for 89 plays.

Grant Gould led the Ichabods with 18 tackles and Evin Beck had 10, including two for loss.

Washburn is 466-531-44 in its 115th year of college football. The Ichabods have had seven 8-win seasons, including last year's 8-4 mark. The other eight-win seasons were 1906. 1907, 1964, 1974, 1983, 1986, and 2004.

The Washburn Ichabods climbed to new heights in the latest NFCA Coaches Poll as they were slotted No. 10. It is the highest the Ichabods have been picked in the NFCA Poll. The Ichabods are No. 12 in the D2football.com national poll.

Record watch ...

Grant Gould and the tackle charts - both Washburn and NCAA Division II

Senior linebacker Grant Gould, has started 37 games and became Washburn's all-time leading tackler with his 10 tackles against Western Washington. He has 419 career tackles which topped the 349 tackles recorded by Tony Scollieri (1994-97). Gould has already set the school record for assisted tackles (237) for a career and single-season (73) while at Washburn. He has recorded 182 solo tackles in his career, which is second on the solo tackle chart. The record is 196 set by Tony Scollieri. Gould who entered his senior season 10th on the NCAA Division II's all-time tackle list (331) is Division II's active leader and his 419 total tackles has vaulted him into fifth on the all-time NCAA Division II chart. With two more tackles, Gould would become only the fifth person in since the NCAA recognized defensive tackles starting in 2000, to reach 400 tackles. Gould's 182 solo tackles ranks him 10th on the NCAA D-II chart. To move into third on the NCAA all-time career chart, Gould needs to reach 446 total tackles.

Fletcher Terrell and the interception charts and NCAA passes defended chart

With his pick against SBU, Fletcher Terrell tied A.C. Poynter (1982-83) atop the Washburn record book, who had 13 in his career for the Ichabods. Terrell is already the Washburn career passes defended record holder with 51. His 51 career passes defended is tied for second on the NCAA chart trailing only Rob Keefe of Mercyhurst who had 56 for his career.

Connor Sabel closing in on the extra points

Junior placekicker Connor Sabel has become Washburn's all-time leader in extra points after hitting Nos. 101-104 at Northwest Missouri. He has converted 106 of 113 his career attempts. Sabel has also hit 37 straight extra points after missing his final attempt of the 2004 season.

Mike Odupitan and the receiving, all-purpose and scoring charts

With his 79 receiving yards and five receptions against Truman, senior wide receiver Mike Odupitan has raised his career totals to 2,322 receiving yards and 139 receptions. Odupitan became only the fifth Ichabod to go over the 2,000-yard mark in a career. His receiving yards rank him fourth on the Washburn career chart and his 139 career receptions place him in third. His 156 points scored also put him in fifth place on the all-time Ichabod scoring charts.

With 121 more yards in all purpose yards, Odupitan would become only the second Ichabod to reach 4,000 yards in all purpose yards as an Ichabod. Troy Slusser had 5,043 in his career. Odupitan is currently in second on the all-time chart with 3,879 yards trailing Troy Slusser in all purpose yards.

Golden, Colo.. - The Washburn Ichabods opened the 2005 season in fine fashion as they topped No. 14 ranked Colorado Mines 28-17. In the process, the Ichabods won their fourth straight overall game since the 1988 season when they won four straight from Oct. 1 to Oct. 22.

The Ichabods jumped on the board early as sophomore quarterback Jordan Brill, making his second career start, hit Sam Sissom on a 62-yard touchdown strike. It was the first of three Sissom touchdown receptions from Brill as he would finish with

TOPEKA -- The Washburn Ichabods improved to 2-0 with a 31-21 win over Western Washington on Saturday in Yager Stadium.





ELLENSBURG, Wash. - The Washburn Ichabods fell for the first time this season coming up short in the comeback bid dropping a 48-42 decision to Central Washington.


The Ichabods found themselves down 14-0 less than eight minutes into the game as the Wildcats scored the first two touchdowns of the game. The Ichabods jumped on the scoreboard with 4:44 remaining in the first quarter as Ra'Shawn Mosley capped a 6-play, 65 yard drive cutting the score to 14-7.

Central Washington (2-2) would score of the first play of the ensuing drive as they scored on a 52-yard touchdown to increase the lead to 21-7. It would be the first seven of a total of 24-unanswered points the Wildcats would score to build the lead to 38-7 with 9:06 remaining in the first half.

The Ichabods responded as quarterback Jordan Brill connected with

Jarod Tetuan on a 24-yard touchdown strike to cut the lead to 38-14. After forcing a three-and-out, the Ichabods scored with 1:27 left in the first half as Jeff Scott caught a 57-yard touchdown reception from Bill cutting the lead to 38-21.

The Wildcats received the second half with the football and after the Ichabods forced the Wildcats into putting formation, Fletcher Terrell blocked the Central Washington punt and recovered it on the Wildcats' 4-yard line, but an offsides penalty on the Ichabods on the 4th and four gave the Wildcats the first down. On that same drive, the Ichabods' Josh Looney picked off a Mike Riley pass as the Wildcat quarterback he was running out of bounds, however the officials ruled they had an inadvertent whistle giving possession back to the Wildcats. The Wildcats would continue to drive and kick a 27-yard field goal to push the lead to 41-21 with 9:05 left in the third quarter. Central Washington would add another touchdown on their next possession.



Washburn would then mount their comeback as Scott caught his second touchdown pass of the afternoon from Brill - this time a 5-yard completion to cut the lead to 48-28 with 1:05 left in the third quarter.

On the Ichabods' next possession, Washburn drove 80-yards in 10 plays as Brill hit Jake Lebahn for a 27-yard touchdown pass. It was Lebahn's first touchdown of his career.

The Ichabods defense forced a missed field goal by the Wildcats and the Ichabods took the ball back over with 4:01 remaining in the game.

Brill then led the Ichabods on another 80-yard drive hitting Lebahn with an 18-yard touchdown hook-up to cut the lead to 48-42 with 3:04 left. The Ichabods forced the

Wildcats into punt formation again,

but the Ichabods were called with a roughing the kicker penalty and the Wildcats regained possession. The Ichabod defense pushed the Wildcats into another punt and the Ichabods took over with 1:11 remaining.

Brill would hit Mosley over the middle for 11-yards. After a CWU offsides penalty, Brill again hit Mosley to push the ball up to the Central Washington 47. The Ichabods would get no closer as three passes into the end zone fell incomplete handing the Ichabods the 48-42 loss.

Brill passed was 21-of-39 for 328 yards and a career-high five touchdown passes - two touchdown passes going to Lebahn and to Scott who finished with 91 and 62 yards receiving respectively. Tetuan had four receptions for 87 yards and the one touchdown reception.

On defense, the Ichabods were led by Grant Gould who had 12 tackles (six solo) including three tackles for loss and two sacks. Sam Tossie had seven tackles.

Washburn suffered an early turnover to lead to an SBU touchdown just over a minute into the game on Rony Santil's touchdown reception.


Grant Gould turned the tables on the Bearcats by running in a interception return 26 yards for a touchdown minutes later.

2005 Washburn Ichabod Football -- Recaps Game 6

TOPEKA - The Washburn Ichabods snapped a 25-game losing streak while topping the No. 4 ranked Pittsburg State Gorillas in a 35-34 overtime win. With the win, the Ichabods improved to 5-1 and 3-0 in the MIAA and the Gorillas dropped to 4-2, 3-1 in conference play. The win was the first for the Ichabods over the Gorillas since Oct. 4, 1980 in Topeka in a 38-36 win.


The Ichabods won the opening toss and jumped on the board with an eight-play, 80-yard drive as Trent Hearn would score on a 3-yard touchdown run. It would be the first of three touchdown rushes for Hearn as he would finish the day with 162 yards on 30 carries. He rushed for all 25 yards on the Ichabods' overtime drive.

After the Ichabods took the early lead, Washburn would

add another touchdown as Jordan Brill hooked up with Jake Lebahn on a 24-yard strike capping an eight-play, 95-yard drive. The Ichabods would add another as Hearn had a 22-yard scamper after PSU's Andy Majors was picked off by Calvin Stuckey at the Washburn 12 and he returned it 55 yards to the Pitt State 33.

On the next Pitt State drive, they would score on a Germaine Race 26-yard run. On the ensuing kickoff, Fletcher Terrell ran back his second kickoff of the season as he returned the kickoff 83 yards for a score to push the Ichabod lead back to 28-7 heading into the break.

In the second half, the Gorillas took the first drive of the third quarter and marched 65 yards in five plays to cut the Ichabod lead to 28-14. On the ensuing kickoff, the Ichabods would fumble and the Gorillas would take possession back at the Washburn 16. However, four plays into the drive, the



Ichabods' Mike Gonzalez would force a fumble at the Washburn 6 and recover the ball at the Washburn 13 to end the Gorillas' scoring threat.

The Gorillas would score on a 12-play, 93 yard drive cutting the lead to 28-21. After trading possessions and a missed field goal by the Ichabods, the Gorillas would drive 80 yards to tie the score at 28 with 32 seconds remaining.

The Ichabods won the overtime toss and elected to be on defense first. The Gorillas scored in three plays as Race rushed for two yards, however the extra point attempt by Nathan Alleman missed, sailing to the right.

The Ichabods took over at the Pitt State 25. Hearn rushed three straight times for the

Ichabods on carries of 6, 12, and 7 yards for the touchdown. After a Gorilla time out, Connor Sabel's extra point was perfect through the uprights giving the Ichabods its highest win over a nationally ranked opponent since joining the NCAA ranks, improving them to 4-31 since joining Division II.

Hearn averaged 5.4 yards per carry while racking up the 162 yards, his most since rushing for 175 against Missouri-Rolla as a freshman. Ra'Shawn Mosley had 36 yards on the ground as the Ichabods rushed for 217 as a team.

Brill passed for 205 yards with 70 receiving yards going to Cason Lehman and Mike Odupitan.

Mike Gonzalez had a career-high 18 tackles to lead the Ichabod defense. He capped the day with two forced fumbles and two fumble recoveries. Jarod Tetuan had 12 tackles with a forced fumble and Aaron Neal and Grant Gould each had 10 tackles

Washburn Ichabod Football -- Recaps Game

MARYVILLE, Mo. - The Washburn Ichabods' Connor Sabel connected on 23-yard field goal with :04 seconds remaining as Washburn knocked off its second top-five team in a week with a 31-28 win over No. 5 Northwest Missouri. The win lifted the Ichabods to 6-1 overall and alone into first place in the MIAA with a perfect 4-0 record.

Northwest Missouri scored first with a 19-yard field goal after a massive defensive stand to start the game by the Ichabods. After a mishandled snap on a punt, the Bearcats recovered the football at the Ichabod 8 yard line. But the Ichabods defense held and forced the Bearcat field goal. It was the first time the Bearcats scored first in a game this season and did not win.

After the teams traded drives, the Ichabods forced a punt by the Bearcats, but Fletcher Terrell would pick up the first of his two blocked punts on the afternoon and the


Ichabods recovered the ball at the Northwest 12 yard line. Two plays later, Trent Hearn scored on a 7-yard run. Hearn would go on to score three rushing touchdowns on the afternoon.

On the Bearcats' next drive, Northwest would drive down to the Ichabod two yard line, but Washburn's Cody Huenefeld would pick off a tipped ball for the interception ending the scoring chance for the Bearcats.

The Ichabods converted the turnover into seven points and they would go on a 17-play, 94-yard drive covering \$:58 on the clock to push themselves to a 14-3 lead. The Bearcats added a field goal with under two minutes on the clock and the Ichabods took a 14-6 lead into the break.

After trading drives, the Bearcats opened the scoring in the second half cutting the Washburn lead to 14-13. Northwest added another touchdown with 44 seconds remaining in the half to lead 21-14 heading into the fourth quarter.

On the Ichabods opening drive of the fourth quarter, Jordan Brill hooked up with Mike Ödupitan for a 17-yard touchdown



pass and tie the score with the extra point knotting the scoreboard at 21. After Terrell blocked his

second punt of the afternoon, the Ichabods covered 37-yards in five plays as Hearn scored from 3 yards out to push Washburn in front 28-21 with 6:23 to play in the game.

The Ichabods and the Bearcats traded punts and the Bearcats Xavier Omon rushed 11-yard to tie the score with the extra point, the Bearcats again tied the score at 28 with 1:31 to go in the game setting up the Ichabods winning drive

After taking possession at their own 20 with 1:31 left, Brill hit Hearn for an 11-yard gain. After an incomplete pass, Brill fired and hit Odupitan for a 26-yard pick up to the Northwest 43. After a false start and a Hearn gain of 3 yards, Brill hit Aaron Gardiner for 3 more yards then hit

Gardiner again after a time out for 24 yards to put the ball on the Northwest 18. After a delay of game penalty, and no time outs, Brill hit a diving Cason Lehman for 18 more yards putting the ball at the Bearcat 6 yard line. After the Ichabods down the ball to stop the clock, Northwest called a timeout before Sabel's gamewinning kick through the uprights with :04 seconds left.

On the Ichabod kickoff, the Bearcats downed the ball and their last second pass was knocked down, ending the game and the 10-game losing streak to the Bearcats for the Ichabods.

Hearn finished the day with 107 yards on 33 carries with three touchdowns. Brill was 21 of 31 for 261 yards and the one touchdown pass to Odupitan, who had six catches for 105 yards.

On defense, the Ichabods were led by Mike Gonzalez, who recorded nine tackles, including seven solo stops and two tackles for loss. Jarod Tetuan, starting at free safety for the second straight week and Grant Gould each had eight tackles.

The Ichabods also had interceptions by Huenefeld and Aaron Neal.



The Bulldogs took the lead on a 1-vard touchdown run by senior RB Jerard Leverson with 5:31 left in the third quarter capping a 12play 57-yard yard drive. Leverson had 117 yards on 29 carries, his second 100-yard rushing game in as many weeks.

Washburn took the lead for good on a 31yard run by junior RB Trent Hearn. Hearn rushed for a career-high 178 yards on 27 car-

Long was 27-of-51 for 276 vards, three interceptions and one touchdown. Junior WR James Perry had eight catches for 52 yards. Senior DB Jason Douglas led Truman with 10 tackles (five solos), while junior LB Larry Giglio had an interception and a fumble forced and recovered.

The Ichabods outgained the Bulldogs, 418-370, despite running 10 less plays.
