2005-06 Washburn Basketball -- 3-time defending MIAA Champions

Head Coach Bob Chipman

Bob Chipman, one of college basketball's winningest coaches, begins his 27th season at the helm of the Ichabod basketball program.

Chipman, the all-time winningest coach in Washburn University's basketball history, enters the season with a career record of 610-205 (.748).

With the Ichabods' 82-62 win over Southwest Baptist on Jan. 19, 2005 Chipman became the tenth coach in Division II to reach 600 wins. Chipman enters this season ranked fifth in victories and sixth by winning percentage among active NCAA Division II coaches. He is eighth in all-time winning percentage and coaching wins, in winning percentage, and 12th in all-time Division II victories.

Chipman has guided his teams to 22 20-win seasons, including seven in a row from 1983-84 to 1989-90, and four in a row from 1991-92 to 1994-95 and seven in a row from 1998-99 to 2004-05. Chipman's teams have made 13 national tournament appearances, nine in the NCAA and four in the NAIA. His teams have averaged 24 wins a year. Coach Chipman has never seen a losing season.

Chipman joined the Washburn staff in 1976 as an assistant to longtime head coach Glenn Cafer. He served as assistant coach for three seasons, in addition to being an associate professor of physical education, softball and men's tennis coach, and facilities coordinator. Chipman was promoted to head coach in April 1979 when Cafer was appointed director of athletics. Chipman enjoyed a banner season in 1986-87, capping a 35-4 campaign with an NAIA national championship crown. A 90-59 win over Marymount that season gave him career victory No. 173, making him the winningest coach in Washburn history. Chipman was well-recognized for his accomplishments, garnering conference, district, area and national coach of the year honors.

In addition to the coaching awards obtained after the 1986-87 season, Chipman was named MIAA coach of the year following the 1992, 1993 and 2004 seasons. He was named Kodak district coach of the year by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) in 1993 and the men's four-year coach of the year by the Kansas Basketball Coaches Association (KBCA) in 1994 and 2001.

His success at the collegiate level has brought Chipman the opportunity to coach on an international level as well. He served a second stint as an assistant coach for the U.S. entry in the Pan American Games during the summer of 1991, earning a bronze medal. In 1983, he was an assistant to the team that won the gold medal. He helped coach the U.S. entry in the World University Games to a gold medal in 1989. In 1985, he was an assistant coach for the Amateur Basketball Association/USA Jones Cup Team that won a silver medal. Chipman holds both bachelor's and master's degrees from Kansas State University.

Chipman has always looked to Kansas basketball players first as evident from the six Kansas players on this year's roster. In his 24 years as the Ichabod's head coach, he has spent more than \$1 million in scholarship money for basketball players from the Sunflower State.

The 1973 graduate earned two letters as a guard while playing for Wildcat coaching legend Jack Hartman. He played his first two seasons of college ball at Flint Community Junior College, in his hometown of Flint, Mich.

Chipman and his wife, Carol, live in Topeka with their children, Kelsey and Bobby.

<u>THE COACHES. . .</u>

Ichabod head coach Bob Chipman, one of college basketball's winningest coaches, begins his 27th season at the helm of the Ichabod basketball program.

Chipman, the all-time winningest coach in Washburn University's basketball history, enters the season with a career record of 610-205 (.748). (more bio information on page 2 of game notes).

The Runnin' Rebels are coached by Lon Kruger. Lon Kruger is in his second year at the helm of the Runnin' Rebels.

A veteran of two-plus decades as a head coach on the collegiate and professional levels, Kruger came to Las Vegas after a four-year stint in the NBA. Following 18 years as one of the nation's most successful college coaches, Kruger spent three seasons (2000-03) as the head coach of the Atlanta Hawks and then part of the 2003-04 season as an assistant with the New York Knicks.

Hired at UNLV on March 15, 2004, as the 10th full-time head coach in UNLV men's basketball history, Kruger's first Runnin' Rebel team recorded a 17-14 overall record and was invited to the National Invitation Tournament. The postseason trip was made possible by a late surge that saw Kruger's team win seven of its last nine games. It capped off a Year One filled with positive signs of progress by a program steadily regrouping behind its new leader for a climb back up the national ladder.

At the collegiate level, Kruger has compiled an impressive 335-247 (.576) overall mark in 19 seasons as a head coach at Pan American (1982-86), Kansas State (1986-90), Florida (1990-96), Illinois (1996-2000) and now UNLV (2004-05).

He led each of the first four schools he coached to 20-win seasons and is one of only a handful of active Division I head coaches to have taken three different programs to the NCAA Tournament.

ICHABODS LAST TIME OUT . . .

Nov. 4, 2005 • Washburn 79, Washburn Alumni 77 • Exhibition Game TOPEKA - The Washburn Ichabods held off a late rally by the Alumni team pulling out a 79-77 win in Lee Arena. Rashad Adams led Washburn with 19 points and 12 rebounds. Dylan Channel also had a double-double with 11 points and 10 rebounds. J.B. Murray added 18 points off the bench.

The Ichabods led by 13 with 4:37 to play, but the Alumni team would cut the lead to two at 73-71 with 1:37 remaining. The Ichabods built the lead back to five at 79-74 with three seconds left as the Alumni's Todd Alexander hit a three from just inside the halfcourt line. Jeremy Cunningham led the Alumni with 18 points. Troy Douglas had 16 and Alexander and Ryan Murphy each had 12.

KNOW THE FOE . . .

The UNLV men's basketball team was picked to finish third behind San Diego State and Utah as the Mountain West Conference released its men's basketball preseason media poll and all-conference team at the league's media day being held at the University Park Marriott.

Eight players return for UNLV in 2005-06, all with the benefit of having been in Kruger's program last season. Seniors Louis Amundson and Ricky Morgan, along with junior Michael Umeh all played a significant role on last year's team and spent a good portion of the season as starters. Also



returning are seniors Joel Anthony, Robert Berkey and Dustin Villepigue, sophomore Curtis Terry and redshirt freshman René Rougeau. Amundson, a 6-9 forward, started all 30 games he played in last season and led the team in field goal percentage at 56.1. He earned honorable mention for the All-Mountain West Conference team after averaging 7.8 points, 7.5 rebounds and 1.4 blocks per game.

Six new faces adorn the 2005-06 roster for UNLV in the form of freshmen Jo'Van Adams and Joe Darger, junior Gaston Essengue, freshman Jerome Johnson and juniors Jason Petrimoulx and Wendell White. Freshman Scott Hoffman and junior Efrem Lawrence also have been added to this season's roster. Adams, a 6-0 guard, averaged 28.0 ppg, 12.0 apg and 8.0 steals per game last year at Gulf Shores Academy in Houston, Texas. His team won the Texas state championship three years in a row and was ranked as high as sixth in the nation last year.

LAST TIME THE TEAMS MET . . .

Tonight's meeting is the first between the two schools.

A WIN OVER UNLV WOULD . . .

be the first win for the Ichabods over a NCAA Division I program since a Nov. 29, 1984 win over Oklahoma State when Washburn won 67-66 in Stillwater, when current Kansas coach was a guard on the Cowboy team.

SIX DEGREES OF SEPARATION . . .

• Tonight's game is not the first time Ichabod head coach Bob Chipman and UNLV's Lon Kruger have coached against each other. The two faced off on Dec. 17, 1983 when Chipman was in his fifth year as the Ichabods head coach and Kruger was coaching Texas Pan-American. Kruger's squad won the game 77-70.

• Kruger and Chipman were teammates at Kansas State during the 1972 and 1973 seasons as they won two Big 8 Championships.

• Kruger's nephew Shannon was a four-year starter for the Ichabods from 1998 to 2002. Shannon finished his career No. 16 on Washburn's all-time scoring chart with 1,014 points and also wore the same number as Lon did at Kansas State, No. 12.

• UNLV assistant coach Steve Henson's younger brother Brian played for Washburn and Chipman from 1993-95 and hit 84 3point attempts for his career. His .389 3-point FG percentage is No. 9 on the school's all-time chart.

ICHABODS AT HOME IN LEE ARENA . . .

In its 22nd season in Lee Arena, the Ichabods are 296-43 (.873). The Ichabods finished the 2004-05 slate at Lee Arena 14-3. The Ichabods are 110-12 in Lee Arena since the 1997-98 season.

ICHABODS IN DIVISION I EXHIBITION GAMES . . .

The Ichabods are 0-5 in NCAA Division I Exhibition games. All five games have been against either Kansas or Purdue. Last season, the Ichabods lost to both Purdue and No. 1 ranked Kansas by nine points.
