#### Head Coach Bob Chipman

Bob Chipman, one of college basketball's winningest coaches, begins his 27th season at the helm of the Ichabod basketball program.

Chipman, the all-time winningest coach in Washburn University's basketball history, enters the season with a career record of 615-207 (.748).

With the Ichabods' 82-62 win over Southwest Baptist on Jan. 19, 2005 Chipman became the tenth coach in Division II to reach 600 wins. Chipman enters this season ranked fifth in victories and sixth by winning percentage among active NCAA Division II coaches. He is eighth in all-time winning percentage and coaching wins, in winning percentage, and 12th in all-time Division II victories.

Chipman has guided his teams to 22 20-win seasons, including seven in a row from 1983-84 to 1989-90, and four in a row from 1991-92 to 1994-95 and seven in a row from 1998-99 to 2004-05. Chipman's teams have made 13 national tournament appearances, nine in the NCAA and four in the NAIA. His teams have averaged 24 wins a year. Coach Chipman has never seen a losing season.

Chipman joined the Washburn staff in 1976 as an assistant to longtime head coach Glenn Cafer. He served as assistant coach for three seasons, in addition to being an associate professor of physical education, softball and men's tennis coach, and facilities coordinator. Chipman was promoted to head coach in April 1979 when Cafer was appointed director of athletics. Chipman enjoyed a banner season in 1986-87, capping a 35-4 campaign with an NAIA national championship crown. A 90-59 win over Marymount that season gave him career victory No. 173, making him the winningest coach in Washburn history. Chipman was well-recognized for his accomplishments, garnering conference, district, area and national coach of the year honors.

In addition to the coaching awards obtained after the 1986-87 season, Chipman was named MIAA coach of the year following the 1992, 1993 and 2004 seasons. He was named Kodak district coach of the year by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) in 1993 and the men's four-year coach of the year by the Kansas Basketball Coaches Association (KBCA) in 1994 and 2001.

His success at the collegiate level has brought Chipman the opportunity to coach on an international level as well. He served a second stint as an assistant coach for the U.S. entry in the Pan American Games during the summer of 1991, earning a bronze medal. In 1983, he was an assistant to the team that won the gold medal. He helped coach the U.S. entry in the World University Games to a gold medal in 1989. In 1985, he was an assistant coach for the Amateur Basketball Association/USA Jones Cup Team that won a silver medal. Chipman holds both bachelor's and master's degrees from Kansas State University.

Chipman has always looked to Kansas basketball players first as evident from the six Kansas players on this year's roster. In his 24 years as the Ichabod's head coach, he has spent more than \$1 million in scholarship money for basketball players from the Sunflower State.

The 1973 graduate earned two letters as a guard while playing for Wildcat coaching legend Jack Hartman. He played his first two seasons of college ball at Flint Community Junior College, in his hometown of Flint, Mich.

Chipman and his wife, Carol, live in Topeka with their children, Kelsey and Bobby.

TOPEKA - The Washburn Ichabods won its 300th game all-time in Lee Arena in an 88-68 win over Newman. The Ichabods were led by Rashad Adams who led five Ichabods in double figures with 16 points. Kris Milburn and Brady Sisk each scored 15. Kyle Fisher scored 14 and J.B. Murray scored 13. The Ichabods are 300-44 all-time in Lee Arena in its 22nd season. The Ichabods shot 47 percent from the field.

#### KNOW THE FOE . . .

Central Missouri is 7-1 this season, dropping a 79-77 decision last time out on Dec. 5 at St. Edwards in Austin, Texas. The Mules are ranked No. 9 in the NABC/D2Bulletin National Poll. The Mules were tabbed as the team to beat in the MIAA Coaches Poll this season after receiving 7 of 9 first place votes.

Preseason all-American Michael Hicks has lived up the early accolades as he leads the team with a 17.4 ppg average. He has also made the most of his trips to the free throw line hitting 37 of 44 attempts for a 84 percent clip.

#### SERIES NOTES . . .

Today's meeting is the 76th meeting between the Ichabods and the Mules. The Ichabods lead the series 39-36. The Mules have won the last three meetings between the two teams. Overall, the Ichabods have won 12 of the last 15 meetings. Last season, the Mules snapped a 13-game losing streak in Lee Arena with a 91-85 win over the Ichabods in the regular season finale on Feb. 26, 2005, earning a share of the 2005 MIAA Championship. During the 13-game losing streak for the Mules, the Ichabods have won by an average of 14.9 points per game including a 40-point win on Jan. 17, 2001 - the largest victory margin by Washburn in the 76-game series history.

#### LAST MEETING WITH THE MULES . . .

### Feb. 26, 2005 · CMSU 91, WU 85

TOPEKA, Kan. - The Washburn Ichabods ended the regular season with a 91-85 loss to Central Missouri on Saturday night in Lee Arena.

The Ichabods (23-6, 14-4 MIAA) led at the break 41-39, but couldn't overcome 64 percent shooting by the Mules (21-6, 14-4 MIAA) in the second half as they hit 17 of 26 field goal attempts and 15 of 19 trips to the free throw line. The Ichabods connected on 5 of 9 attempts from the free throw line in the second half.

There were eight lead changes and five ties in the second half as the Mules took the lead for good on the second of two free throws by Michael Hicks. After the Mules built their lead to six at 84-78 with 1:01 remaining, the Ichabods cut it to four on a tip-in by Steve Bonner. Bonner finished with a career-high 26 points and career-high 13 rebounds.

After CMSU made 1 of 2 free throws, the Ichabods cut it to two at 85-83 on a Jerad Head 3-pointer, he was also fouled but the free throw was off the mark and the Ichabods would get no closer.

The Mules make 6 of 8 free throws the rest of the game to ice the victory and claim a share of their first MIAA title in 20 years. The loss dropped the Ichabods to a share of the MIAA title, their ninth in the last 14 years.

CMSU's Michael Hicks took game-high honors with 29 points. He was 5 of 14 from the field, but 15 of 17 from the free throw line. All five Mule starters reached double figures.

Following up Bonner's 26 points, were Travis Robbins, who had 17 points and Karlton Mims had 15 points.

### **ICHABODS IN MIAA OPENERS...**

The Ichabods are 9-6 in MIAA openers. The Ichabods snapped a three-game conference opener streak to Missouri Southern to start the 2002-03 season in Joplin. The Ichabods topped Missouri Western 67-64 to open the 2003-04 MIAA slate. Last season, the Ichabods dropped a 73-70 decision to Missouri Western after the Griffons' Roosevelt Bolden banked a half-court 3-pointer as time expired for win.

#### **BODS AND ENDS...**

• Paul Byers' five blocks against Ottawa was the tied for the highest total since Travis Robbins had five against MidAmerica Nazarene last season. Both total are the highest in any single game since at least the 1998 season.

#### ICHABODS AT HOME IN LEE ARENA . . .

In its 22nd season in Lee Arena, the Ichabods are 300-44 (.873). The Ichabods finished the 2004-05 slate at Lee Arena 14-3. The Ichabods are 113-13 in Lee Arena since the 1997-98 season.
