TONIGHT'S GAME . . .

The Ichabods will take on arch-rival Emporia State Wednesday evening at 7:30 in at White Auditorium in the 183rd meeting between the two schools, dating back 100 years. A win would break a four-game losing streak and give Washburn its first MIAA win of the year. The Ichabods (6-7, 0-3 MIAA) were off last weekend while ESU hosted and defeated Pittsburg State 80-68 Saturday to improve to 11-5 and 2-2 in the league.

2005-06 ICHABOD BASKETBALL

Head Coach Bob Chipman

Bob Chipman, one of college basketball's winningest coaches, begins his 27th season at the helm of the Ichabod basketball program.

Chipman, the all-time winningest coach in Washburn University's basketball history, enters the season with a career record of 616-212 (.744) in 828 games.

With the Ichabods' 82-62 win over Southwest Baptist on Jan. 19, 2005 Chipman became the tenth coach in Division II to reach 600 wins. Chipman enters this season ranked fifth in victories and sixth by winning percentage among active NCAA Division II coaches. He is eighth in all-time winning percentage and coaching wins, in winning percentage, and 12th in all-time Division II victories.

Chipman has guided his teams to 22 20-win seasons, including seven in a row from 1983-84 to 1989-90, and four in a row from 1991-92 to 1994-95 and seven in a row from 1998-99 to 2004-05. Chipman's teams have made 13 national tournament appearances, nine in the NCAA and four in the NAIA. His teams have averaged 24 wins a year. Coach Chipman has never seen a losing season.

Chipman joined the Washburn staff in 1976 as an assistant to longtime head coach Glenn Cafer. He served as assistant coach for three seasons, in addition to being an associate professor of physical education, softball and men's tennis coach, and facilities coordinator. Chipman was promoted to head coach in April 1979 when Cafer was appointed director of athletics. Chipman enjoyed a banner season in 1986-87, capping a 35-4 campaign with an NAIA national championship crown. A 90-59 win over Marymount that season gave him career victory No. 173, making him the winningest coach in Washburn history. Chipman was well-recognized for his accomplishments, garnering conference, district, area and national coach of the year honors.

In addition to the coaching awards obtained after the 1986-87 season, Chipman was named MIAA coach of the year following the 1992, 1993 and 2004 seasons. He was named Kodak district coach of the year by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) in 1993 and the men's four-year coach of the year by the Kansas Basketball Coaches Association (KBCA) in 1994 and 2001.

His success at the collegiate level has brought Chipman the opportunity to coach on an international level as well. He served a second stint as an assistant coach for the U.S. entry in the Pan American Games during the summer of 1991, earning a bronze medal. In 1983, he was an assistant to the team that won the gold medal. He helped coach the U.S. entry in the World University Games to a gold medal in 1989. In 1985, he was an assistant coach for the Amateur Basketball Association/USA Jones Cup Team that won a silver medal. Chipman holds both bachelor's and master's degrees from Kansas State University.

Chipman has always looked to Kansas basketball players first as evident from the six Kansas players on this year's roster. In his 24 years as the Ichabod's head coach, he has spent more than \$1 million in scholarship money for basketball players from the Sunflower State.

The 1973 graduate earned two letters as a guard while playing for Wildcat coaching legend Jack Hartman. He played his first two seasons of college ball at Flint Community Junior College, in his hometown of Flint, Mich.

Chipman and his wife, Carol, live in Topeka with their children, Kelsey and Bobby.

THE COACHES...

Emporia State head coach David Moe is in his 5th season with the Hornets and has a 72-55 record (.567).

Moe has 14 years of experience at the NBA and NCAA Division I level. He was an assistant at the University of Colorado from 1993-2001. Prior to his stay in Boulder, Moe was an assistant coach for the Philadelphia 76ers. Other NBA experience includes work for the Denver Nuggets and Charlotte Hornets. Moe began his professional coaching career at Texas Tech from 1988-91. He was a graduate assistant at the University of Kansas when the Jayhawks won the NCAA national championship in 1988 under then coach Larry Brown.

ICHABODS LAST TIME OUT...

Ichabods drop MIAA game to Northwest Missouri State Jan. 4, 2006 • Northwest Missouri 77, Washburn 60

TOPEKA - Washburn took a four-point lead into halftime, but cold shooting in the second half gave Northwest Missouri a 77-60 win Wednesday night at Lee Arena in an MIAA contest. The Ichabods (6-7, 0-3 MIAA) will take on Emporia State January 11 on the road as they look to end a four-game losing streak. Washburn lost for the fourth straight time for the first time since the 1990-91 season and went to 0-3 in the conference for the first time since the 1995-96 season. Dylan Channel scored 10 points in the first half and the Ichabods made 8 of 16 3-pointers. Washburn was down by as much as eight in the first period but ended the half on a 15-3 run to take the lead. Kyle Fisher made two 3-pointers in the final 2:22 of the half to spark the comeback. The Ichabods held the lead for the first 3:35 of the second half, but the team ended up shooting just 36 percent in the half and was 0 for 12 from behind the 3-point line. Northwest took advantage of 26 free throw attempts while limiting the Ichabods to seven. Bearcat guard Mose Howard led all scorers with 21 points. Channel led WU with 12 points while Brady Sisk put in 11 and grabbed nine rebounds.

KNOW THE FOE...

Emporia State and Washburn are last in the MIAA in scoring defense with ESU allowing 72.8 points per game and WU letting in 74.8 points. The Hornets (11-5, 2-2 MIAA) are third in total scoring offense with 81.6 points per game. They have scored 80 or more points in seven of the last eight games and passed the 100-point mark twice in that span. The Hornets have twice scored 94 points or more and lost, including a 110-118 loss at Montana State-Billings. Tyrell Sledge is fifth in the MIAA with 15.4 points per game and Shawn Herrman is sixth with 15.1. Leroy Dawson, who has played just six games after sitting out the first semester, is averaging 19.8 points per game. He had a career-high 35 points last week against Pittsburg State.

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE HORNETS...

The Hornets put five players in double figures to offset 31 points from PSU's Eddie Jackson in an 80-68 victory over the Gorillas last Saturday night. ESU opened the game on a 13-0 run and never trailed as it won its second straight MIAA game. Tyrell Sledge had 18 points after not playing at MWSU with an ankle injury. Ryan Blevins ended with 15 points, six rebounds and three assists for ESU, while LeRoy Dawson tossed in 13 points, Shawn Herrman had 11 points and Wes Book chipped in 10 off the bench. Joe Bridges was the only other Gorilla in double figures with 11 points.

ALL-TIME SERIES WITH THE OPPONENT...

These two in-state rivals have played each other 183 times over the last 100 years with the Ichabods holding a 93-89 lead in the series. The two teams first met on the court during the 1905-06 season with WU winning twice during that year. In recent history, Washburn has dominated the series, winning 18 of the last 20 going back to the 1995-96 season. WU beat Emporia State three times last year with the last coming as the Ichabods knocked ESU out of the MIAA tournament in the first round. Washburn beat the Hornets last year at White Auditorium after dropping two straight there the previous two years.

LAST MEETING WITH THE HORNETS...

(March 4, 2005) KANSAS CITY, Mo. - The Washburn Ichabods improved to 24-6 with a 78-71 win over arch-rival Emporia State in the quarterfinals of the MIAA Tournament. The Ichabods led at the break 32 to 29 behind 11 points from Steve Bonner. The Ichabods built leads of five points on three different occasions, but could not push ahead any more as the Hornets kept close behind 48 percent shooting from the field. In the second half, the Ichabods and Hornets both were 16 of 31 from the field (51 percent), but the Ichabods attempted 11 more free throws and connected on seven more than the Hornets. The Ichabods pushed their lead to as many as nine in the second half at 41-32, but a 11-2 run by the Hornets knotted the score at 43 with 14:32 remaining. The Hornets would lead by two on two different occasions, but the Ichabods took the lead for good at 49-47 on Travis Robbins' lay-up with 11:21 to play. Emporia State did get within one at 57-56 with 7:31 to play, but the Ichabods would go on a quick 5-0 run to up the game out of reach. Steve Bonner led the Ichabods with a career-high 28 points connecting on 9 of 12 attempts from the field, including 8 of 11 at the free throw line. Travis Robbins scored 18 points and had nine rebounds and Jerad Head scored 17 points.

LONE SENIOR MILBURN FINISHING SOLID

Guard Kris Milburn is the only senior on the team and the only player to have started all 13 games for Washburn. He is averaging 13.0 points per game to lead the team and rank 12th in the MIAA. His 22 steals also leads the team and he is second with 16 made free throws. Milburn is scoring much more this year than he was last year. He started 30 of 32 games last year and averaged 5.4 points per game.

SISK REMAINING STRONG ON BOTH ENDS OF COURT

Sophomore forward Brady Sisk has consistently been one of Washburn's leading scorers and rebounders this year. He has scored in double figures in 9 of 11 games played this year and is averaging 12.6, second best on the team and 15th in the MIAA. He leads the team with 6.3 rebounds per game and that total is ninth best in the league. Sisk has started the last six games

ICHABODS AT HOME IN LEE ARENA ...

In their 22nd season in Lee Arena, the Ichabods are 300-46 (.867). The Ichabods finished the 2004-05 slate at Lee Arena 14-3. The Ichabods are 114-15 in Lee Arena since the 1997-98 season.

A WINNING HISTORY ...

The Ichabods are 1,324-897-4 (.596 in 2,225 games) all-time in their 99th season of basketball.

UP NEXT FOR THE ICHABODS ...

The Ichabods will host seventh-ranked Southwest Baptist on January 14 at 7:30 p.m. in Lee Arena. Following that, Washburn will host Pittsburg State January 18.

BODS AND ENDS ...

- The Ichabods have lost four games in a row for the first time since the 1990-91 season and went to 0-3 in the conference for the first time since the 1995-96 season. They have not lost five in a row since they lost the last 12 games of the 1976-77 season.

- The loss against NWMSU marked the first time this year Washburn lost a game after leading at the half. The Ichabods were up 37-33 at halftime and fell 77-60. WU is 3-1 when leading at the half.

- Dylan Channel started against NWMSU for the first time in seven games and led the team with 12 points. He is averaging 10.0 points per game in the last five games and has scored in double figures in four of those games.

- Former Ichabod wide receiver Mike Odupitan joined the Ichabods for practice on Dec. 26. He has used up his football eligibility, but will be a junior on the basketball team as this semester is his eighth semester of action after playing football as a true freshman.

- The 51 points against Central Arkansas in Las Vegas was the lowest Ichabod output since a 78-53 loss at Lynn (Fla.) on Nov. 30, 2002.
