The Ichabods will welcome the No. 7 team in the nation to Lee Arena as they host Southwest Baptist Saturday evening at 7:30 p.m. Washburn (6-8, 0-4 MIAA) will be looking to snap a five-game losing streak and earn its first conference win while the Bearcats (15-1, 4-1 MIAA), with the second most wins in the nation, will be looking to stay atop the conference standings. The Ichabods dropped a close game at Emporia State Wednesday while SBU took care of Central Missouri State Tuesday. History will be on the Ichabods' side as they have won the last 15 meetings against the Bearcats dating back to 1996.

2005-06 ICHABOD BASKETBALL

Head Coach Bob Chipman

Bob Chipman, one of college basketball's winningest coaches, begins his 27th season at the helm of the Ichabod basketball program.

Chipman, the all-time winningest coach in Washburn University's basketball history, enters the season with a career record of 616-213 (.743) in 829 games.

With the Ichabods' 82-62 win over Southwest Baptist on Jan. 19, 2005 Chipman became the tenth coach in Division II to reach 600 wins. Chipman enters this season ranked fifth in victories and sixth by winning percentage among active NCAA Division II coaches. He is eighth in all-time winning percentage and coaching wins, in winning percentage, and 12th in all-time Division II victories.

Chipman has guided his teams to 22 20-win seasons, including seven in a row from 1983-84 to 1989-90, and four in a row from 1991-92 to 1994-95 and seven in a row from 1998-99 to 2004-05. Chipman's teams have made 13 national tournament appearances, nine in the NCAA and four in the NAIA. His teams have averaged 24 wins a year. Coach Chipman has never seen a losing season.

Chipman joined the Washburn staff in 1976 as an assistant to longtime head coach Glenn Cafer. He served as assistant coach for three seasons, in addition to being an associate professor of physical education, softball and men's tennis coach, and facilities coordinator. Chipman was promoted to head coach in April 1979 when Cafer was appointed director of athletics. Chipman enjoyed a banner season in 1986-87, capping a 35-4 campaign with an NAIA national championship crown. A 90-59 win over Marymount that season gave him career victory No. 173, making him the winningest coach in Washburn history. Chipman was well-recognized for his accomplishments, garnering conference, district, area and national coach of the year honors.

In addition to the coaching awards obtained after the 1986-87 season, Chipman was named MIAA coach of the year following the 1992, 1993 and 2004 seasons. He was named Kodak district coach of the year by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) in 1993 and the men's four-year coach of the year by the Kansas Basketball Coaches Association (KBCA) in 1994 and 2001.

His success at the collegiate level has brought Chipman the opportunity to coach on an international level as well. He served a second stint as an assistant coach for the U.S. entry in the Pan American Games during the summer of 1991, earning a bronze medal. In 1983, he was an assistant to the team that won the gold medal. He helped coach the U.S. entry in the World University Games to a gold medal in 1989. In 1985, he was an assistant coach for the Amateur Basketball Association/USA Jones Cup Team that won a silver medal. Chipman holds both bachelor's and master's degrees from Kansas State University.

Chipman has always looked to Kansas basketball players first as evident from the six Kansas players on this year's roster. In his 24 years as the Ichabod's head coach, he has spent more than \$1 million in scholarship money for basketball players from the Sunflower State.

The 1973 graduate earned two letters as a guard while playing for Wildcat coaching legend Jack Hartman. He played his first two seasons of college ball at Flint Community Junior College, in his hometown of Flint, Mich.

Chipman and his wife, Carol, live in Topeka with their children, Kelsey and Bobby.

THE COACHES . . .

Ichabod head coach Bob Chipman, one of college basketball's winningest coaches, is in his 27th season at the helm of the Ichabod basketball program.

Southwest Baptist coach Jeff Guiot is in his 2nd season with the Bearcats and has a 31-14 record (.567). Guiot has guided SBU to its first national ranking since the 1994-95 season and just the second top-10 appearance in school history. Guiot spent three years as the coach at Bemidji State before coming to SBU.

ICHABODS LAST TIME OUT . . .

Washburn comeback falls short at Emporia State Emporia State 80, Washburn 76

(Jan. 11) EMPORIA – WU took a four-point lead into halftime, but cold shooting in the second half gave NWMSU a 77-60 win. WU lost for the fourth straight time for the first time since the 1990-91 season and went to 0-3 in the conference for the first time since the 1995-96 season. Dylan Channel scored 10 points in the first half and the Ichabods made 8 of 16 3-pointers. Washburn was down by as much as eight in the first period but ended the half on a 15-3 run to take the lead. Kyle Fisher made two 3-pointers in the final 2:22 of the half to spark the comeback.

KNOW THE FOE . . .

No. 7 Southwest Baptist is off to one of its best starts in school history with a 15-1 record. The Bearcats won 14 straight games to open the season, setting a school record, and earned their first national ranking since the 1994-95 season. Their top-10 spot is just the second in school history and their 15 wins is currently the second most in the nation. They sit atop the MIAA with a 4-1 record. Sheldon Pace leads the team and is eighth in the MIAA with 14.1 points per game. His 9.06 assists per game average leads the MIAA. Frans Steyn, a 7-2 senior center, and Jason Jemison both have 12.8 points per game and Steyn leads the squad with 8.4 rebounds per game. The Bearcats' only loss came two contests ago at Northwest Missouri State in an 80-68 defeat.

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE BEARCATS . . .

(Jan. 10) BOLIVAR, MO. – A 25-12 run early in the second half pushed No. 7 SBU to a 95-78 win over No. 17 Central Missouri State. The win put SBU in first place in the MIAA with a 4-1 record. Senior Sheldon Pace had 17 assists, a new single game record for SBU. He is also the first player in the MIAA since Jordan Canfield (Washburn) in 1995 to have 17 assists in one game. He finished the game with 20 points. SBU had four other players in double figures as freshman Colt Blair had a career-high 17 points followed by Frans Steyn's 14 points and Owen Newman and Deon Davis with 10. Steyn had nine rebounds to lead SBU.

ALL-TIME SERIES WITH THE OPPONENT . . .

Washburn will take a 15-game winning streak in the all-time series against SBU into Saturday's game. The Ichabods last loss to SBU came in February of 1996. WU leads the series 25-8 and has won the last 10 games by an average of 18.7 points.

LAST MEETING WITH THE BEARCATS. . .

(Feb. 10, 2005) BOLIVAR, Mo. - The Ichabods held off a charging Southwest Baptist squad down the stretch for a 90-80 win to clinch a spot in the MIAA Postseason Tournament. Travis Robbins scored a game-high 34 points with 17 coming in each half. He also added his 11th double double of the season and the 14th of his career. Robbins scored 12 of the Ichabods final 14 points of the game after SBU had cut the lead to five. Jerad Head scored a season-high 20 points hitting 5 of 6 3-point attempts and Karlton Mims scored 14.

SISK REMAINING STRONG ON BOTH ENDS OF COURT

Sophomore forward Brady Sisk has consistently been one of Washburn's leading scorers and rebounders this year. His career-high 22 points at ESU boosted him into first on the team and 10th in the MIAA with 13.4 points per game. Sisk has scored in double figures in 10 of 12 games played this year. After pulling in nine rebounds at ESU he leads the team with 6.5 per game and that total is seventh best in the league. He leads the team with 16.5 points per game and 10.0 rebounds in MIAA contests. Sisk has started the last seven games.

LONE SENIOR MILBURN FINISHING SOLID

Guard Kris Milburn is the only senior on the team and the only player to have started all 14 games for Washburn. He is averaging 12.6 points per game to rank 15th in the MIAA. His 23 steals also leads the team and he is second with 16 made 3-pointers. Milburn is scoring much more this year than he was last year. He started 30 of 32 games last year and averaged 5.4 points per game.

MEILE LEADS THE MIAA IN 3-POINT PERCENTAGE

Sophomore guard Andrew Meile is leading the MIAA with a .488 3-point percentage, making 21 of 43 attempts. He made three at Emporia State and had a career-high and team season-high five against Southeastern Oklahoma. He is averaging 7.4 points per game and has reached double figures five times. Meile is also leading the team with 2.7 assists per game and he tied a career high with six against Ottawa.

CHANNEL LEADING TEAM IN FIELD GOAL PCT.

Dylan Channel had a career-high 18 points at Emporia State in his second consecutive start and he is averaging 9.4 points per game. He has scored 10 or more points in five of the last six. Channel is 49 of 74 from the field to lead the team with a .662 shooting percentage. He started last week against NWMSU for the first time in seven games and led the team with 12 points.

ICHABODS AT HOME IN LEE ARENA . . .

In their 22nd season in Lee Arena, the Ichabods are 300-46 (.867). The Ichabods finished the 2004-05 slate at Lee Arena 14-3. The Ichabods are 114-15 in Lee Arena since the 1997-98 season.

UP NEXT FOR THE ICHABODS . . .

The Ichabods will host Pittsburg State January 18 at 7:30 p.m. and then will travel to Missouri Southern January 21.

BODS AND ENDS . . .

- The Ichabods have lost five games in a row for the first time since they lost the last 12 games of the 1976-77 season and they went to 0-4 in the conference for the first time since joining the MIAA.

- The Ichabods are 4-1 this year when out shooting their opponents with the lone loss coming at Emporia State.

- The loss against NWMSU marked the first time this year Washburn lost a game after leading at the half. The Ichabods were up 37-33 at halftime and fell 77-60. WU is 3-1 when leading at the half.

- Former Ichabod wide receiver Mike Odupitan joined the Ichabods on Dec. 26. He made his debut, playing one minute in the first half, at ESU. He has used up his football eligibility, but will be a junior on the basketball team as this semester is his eighth semester of action after playing football as a true freshman.

- The 51 points against Central Arkansas in Las Vegas was the lowest Ichabod output since a 78-53 loss at Lynn (Fla.) on Nov. 30, 2002.
