Action resumes for Ichabods with MIAA matchup at No. 3 Central Missouri Saturday

Washburn will return to the court Saturday at 3:30 p.m. at third-ranked Central Missouri after a nine-day holiday break. The game will be the second MIAA contest of the season after both schools opened conference play with wins earlier in the month. It will also be Washburn's sixth away game (eight counting neutral games) of the season and fourth straight game away from home.

The Ichabods kept their record even at 5-5 after splitting a pair of games last week at the Lynn Holiday Classic. They lost to host LU, 68-61, and then defeated Barry, 63-47. Central Missouri is 10-0 (1-0 MIAA) for the first time since 1995-96 after a 103-67 win over Sterling last week. The Mules, picked first in the MIAA preseason poll, are No. 3 in the nation in the National Association of Basketball Coaches national poll released December 19.

Bob Chipman Head Coach 1979-80 - Present (28th Season) Kansas State '73

At Washburn: 625-226 (.734) **Overall:** 625-226 (.734)



Bob Chipman, one of college basketball's winningest coaches, is in his 28th season at the helm of the Ichabod basketball program. His first win in 2006-07 will made him the second winningest coach as a member of the MIAA with his 380th win since joining the league.

With the Ichabods' 82-62 win over Southwest Baptist on Jan. 19, 2005 Chipman became the tenth coach in Division II to reach 600 wins. Chipman enters this season ranked fourth in victories and fourth by winning percentage among active NCAA Division II coaches. He is 13th in all-time winning percentage and 9th in all-time Division II victories.

Chipman has guided his teams to 22 20-win seasons, including seven in a row from 1983-84 to 1989-90, and four in a row from 1991-92 to 1994-95 and seven in a row from 1998-99 to 2004-05. Chipman's teams have made 14 national tournament appearances, 10 in the NCAA and four in the NAIA. His teams have averaged 23 wins a year and his 10-16 record last year marked his only losing season in 27 years.

Chipman joined the Washburn staff in 1976 as an assistant to longtime head coach Glenn Cafer. He was promoted to head coach in April 1979 when Cafer was appointed director of athletics. Chipman enjoyed a banner season in 1986-87, capping a 35-4 campaign with an NAIA national championship crown. In addition to the coaching awards obtained after the 1986-87 season, Chipman was named MIAA coach of the year following the 1992, 1993 and 2004 seasons. He was named Kodak district coach of the year by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) in 1993 and the men's four-year coach of the year by the Kansas Basketball Coaches Association (KBCA) in 1994 and 2001. Chipman served a second stint as an assistant coach for the U.S. entry in the Pan American Games during the summer of 1991, earning a bronze medal. In 1983, he was an assistant to the team that won the gold medal. He helped coach the U.S. entry in the World University Games to a gold medal in 1989. In 1985, he was an assistant coach for the Amateur Basketball Association/USA Jones Cup Team that won a silver medal. Chipman holds both bachelor's and master's degrees from Kansas State University.

The 1973 graduate earned two letters as a guard while playing for Wildcat coaching legend Jack Hartman. He played his first two seasons of college ball at Flint Community Junior College, in his hometown of Flint, Mich.

Chipman and his wife, Carol, live in Topeka with their son Bobby. Their daughter Kelsey is a freshman on the Kansas State volleyball

Well-balanced effort leads to win over Barry at Lynn Holiday Classic December 21, 2006

BOCA RATON, Fla. - Seven players had six or more points as the Ichabods defeated Barry 63-47 at the Lynn Holiday Classic. Senior forward Frank Phifer led Washburn with 14 points, all of them in the second half, and junior guard Grant Hargett chipped in a seaon-high 10.

Washburn shot 46 percent in the first half off 13-of-25 shooting and a 6-of-9 effort from 3-point range. The Buccaneers started the game 1-of-8 and finished the half 4-of-23 to shoot 17 percent. They were without a field goal the final 4:19 of the first half. The Ichabods kept on building their lead in the second half. They went up by 20, 40-20 at 16:25 when Phifer scored five of the first seven points in the half. Barry remained without a field goal until 14:23 of the half for a 9:44 drought without one.

A day after turning the ball over 26 times in a loss to host Lynn, the Ichabods turned it over 14 times against BU and had a 42-25 advantage on rebounds. Sophomore forward Paul Byers led Washburn with 11 rebounds.

Washburn shot 45 percent on the night and was 7-of-13 from 3-point range. After a 17 percent effort in the first half, the Buccaneers shot 37 percent in the second half to end the night shooting 28 percent. Phifer was 5-for-10 from the field while junior guard Reed Hein and Hargett were each 2-for-2 from 3-point range.

No. 3 Mules move to 10-0 with 100-point win December 20, 2006

The third-ranked Central Missouri Mules moved to 10-0 for the first time since 1995-96 with a 103-67 win over Sterling College. By the 12:56 mark of the first half, the Mules were up by double figures for good, and cruised to a 52-32 halftime advantage. Central Missouri ran the advantage to as much as 39 in the second stanza and cleared the bench with more than nine minutes remaining. The two squads shot lights out in the period with Sterling knocking down 56 percent and the Mules hitting 58. Six players scored in double-figures for Central Missouri while head coach Kim Anderson moved into a tie for 5th all time with his 89th career victory as a Mule (Don Doucette). Wright and Sommerset had 22 and 21, respectively, while reining MIAA player of the week Wadale Williams chipped in with 13 and five assists.

Ichabods end 2005-06 season with loss at UCM February 26, 2006

WARRENSBURG, Mo. – The Ichabods dropped their season finale 75-69 at Central Missouri. Having needed a win and some help elsewhere to get into the MIAA Postseason Tournament, Washburn ended its season at 10-16 and last in the conference at 4-12. Sophomore Andrew Meile and freshman Paul Byers both set career highs and the Ichabods led at halftime, but Central Missouri, fighting for a top seed in the conference tournament, was able to pull away. Meile had a career-high 20 points while scoring 16 of the Ichabods' 32 first half points off 6-of-8 shooting. He was 4 of 6 from 3-point range. Byers, who led the team with a career-high 21 points, scored 15 of them in the second half.

About the Central Missouri Mules

Central Missouri is 10-0 for the first time since 1995-96 and is ranked No. 3 in the latest NABC national poll. Zach Wright leads the Mules in scoring with 18.3 after putting in 22 in UCM's last game, a 103-67 win over Sterling last week. He is second on the team in rebounding with 6.1 per game. Daryyl Sommerset leads the team with 7.2 per game. The Mules are scoring 85.1 points a game while allowing just 59.2.

UCM head coach Kim Anderson is 89-40 (.690) in five years, all of them with the Mules. He is 5-4 against Washburn and has won the last five. Anderson is a graduate of Missouri where he played from 1973-77. He was an assistant coach at Big 12 schools MU and Baylor and prior to coming to UCM he served as an assistant commissioner of the Big 12.

Series notes

- Central Missouri has won the last five meetings. Before that Washburn had won 12 straight.
- Washburn and UCM met for the first time in 1912-13 with the Ichabods winning 52-36.
- They resumed the series in 1937-38 and played regularly from then on with Washburn holding a slight lead, 39-38, in the series.
- Washburn is 18-10 against the Mules in MIAA games and 7-8 at UCM since joining the league.
- The Mules have swept the Ichabods the last two seasons, holding WU to 74.8 points a game in the four games while scoring 81.3.
- Washburn is 0-2 against UCM in overtime games, the last coming in a 78-76 defeat at Central Missouri on 02/28/04.

Chipman second in the MIAA in wins as a league coach

Chipman's win over Kansas Wesleyan to start the season gave him his 380th win, making him the second winningest coach while coaching in the MIAA. He now has 385. He entered the year tied with Boyd King, the coach at Truman from 1946-71 who compiled 379 wins while there. Tom Smith, the Missouri Western coach, has over 400 wins under his belt as an MIAA coach to lead all league coaches.

A winning history

- The Ichabods are 1,334-911 (.594 in 2,245 games) and are in their 103rd season of basketball.
- Starting their 23rd season in Lee Arena, the Ichabods are 306-49 (.862). The Ichabods are 3-0 this year at home and they finished the 2005-06 slate 7-6. The Ichabods are 120-18 in Lee Arena since the 1997-98 season.
- In 17 seasons as an NCAA II school, the Ichabods have 10 NCAA tournament appearances and nine MIAA titles. Last year snapped a streak of three straight conference championships.
- Washburn won the 1986-87 NAIA national championship with a 35-4 record under head coach Bob Chipman in his eighth year as coach.
- Washburn was fourth in the nation last year among NCAA II schools in attendance, averaging 2,750 fans a game. WU was the highest ranked MIAA team. As a conference, the MIAA had the second highest attendance with an average of 1,851 fans per game.

Washburn looking for second road win

The Ichabods are 1-4 on the road this year with the win coming at Eastern New Mexico. Last year's lone road win came at Missouri Southern in a 60-56 win on 01/21/06. The Ichabods ended the year 1-8 in road contests last year.

Ichabods need offensive boost

Washburn is last in the MIAA with a 66.6 points per game average and a .409 shooting percentage. Despite shooting a season-high 48 percent at Lynn last week, Washburn only scored 61 points. In a winning effort the next day they scored just 53 against Barry.

Washburn's highest output was 77, reached twice this year. In the season-opener the Ichabods reached it in double overtime against Kansas Wesleyan and then they matched it in the MIAA win over Missouri Western. The Ichabods' lowest scoring game came in a 83-55 loss at UNLV.

Ichabods add junior forward Mamadou Sy from Cloud County CC

Forward Mamadou Sy joined the Ichabods earlier this month and has played in the last two game. In 25 minutes he has seven points and eight rebounds as a forward. Sy, a 6-6 native of Paris, France, played guard at Cloud County Community College the previous two years. His freshman year (2004-05) he played all 31 games and averaged 6.4 points and 4.7 rebounds per game as his team went 15-16. His sophomore year (2005-06) he played all 33 games with 6.3 points, 5.6 rebounds and 1.5 assists. The T-Birds went 24-9 that year. Sy averaged 6.3 points, 5.1 rebounds and 1.2 assists in his two years in junior college. He played with current Ichabod junior guard Reed Hein both years.

Phifer gives Ichabods inside presence, leads team in scoring

Senior forward Frank Phifer leads the team and is fifth in the MIAA with 17.4 points a game and has reached double figures in all 10 games. Earlier this year he had three straight double-doubles and 20-point efforts. He had his first double-double at Washburn after scoring a team season-high 25 points at Central Oklahoma with 10 rebounds. He followed that with 26 points and 11 rebounds against Missouri Western for another double-double and then at Cameron he had 20 points and a season-high 18 rebounds.

Phifer is shooting 52 percent from the field and is 80 percent from the free throw line, sixth best in the league. He leads the 'Bods with 52 made free throws and 65 attempts. He also leads the team with 8.4 rebounds per game and 16 blocks. He is averaging 8.4 rebounds a game to lead the team, and coming into last week he was seventh in the MIAA with 7.3 a game.

He was named to the Eastern New Mexico all-tournament team after scoring 17 points in each game.

Byers second on the team in scoring

Paul Byers had his first career double-double at Cameron with 13 points and 10 rebounds. At the Lynn Holiday Classic he scored 12 points and he is averaging 9.0, second best on the team. He has double-digit efforts in five of 10 games this year. Byers is shooting 47 percent on the year after going 5-of-8 in the two games at Lynn. He has started all but one game this year. In his only game off the bench he scored 10 points and had six rebounds against Cameron.

Meile strong from the line, sets career-high in steals

Junior guard Andrew Meile is 21-of-26 from the free throw line for an .808 average, second best in the MIAA coming into last week. He leads the team with 20 steals and 2.0 steals per game after a career-high five at Lynn. Before last week he was fourth in the league with 1.9 steals a game. Meile had his fifth double-figure game of the year with 10 points at Lynn. He had 18 points against Fort Hays State off 6-of-11 shooting in the first game of the ENMU shootout. Against UNLV he was 4-of-6 for 10 points. He is third on the team with 8.6 points a game and leads WU with 13 made 3-pointers.

Williams giving WU senior leadership as starting guard

Senior Michael Williams has started all 10 games as Washburn's point guard. He is averaging 8.0 points a game and 2.0 assists.

Williams was the hero in Washburn's win over Missouri Western. He hit a 3-pointer in the final minute to put WU up by a point. With just one second left he hit a pull-up jumper just inside the free throw line to give Washburn the win. Williams led Washburn with 14 points against Cameron and also threw in double digits with 16 in the season opener against Kansas Wesleyan.

The Ichabods are 3-0 when Williams scores 10 points or more.

Sisk leading Ichabods off the bench

Junior forward Brady Sisk had his second career double-double with 12 points and 12 rebounds against Missouri Western. He leads the Washburn non-starters with 77 points off the bench. He is fifth on the team with 7.7 points a game, fourth with 30 field goals and fourth with 70 attempts. Sisk is averaging 17.3 minutes a game. He led the Ichabods in the season opener with 19 points and scored 10 against Cameron.

Sisk has reached double figures in scoring three times this year and the Ichabods are undefeated in those games.

Snyder returns after shoulder injury keeps him out

Junior forward Kyle Snyder re-injured his shoulder at Central Oklahoma December 5 and then missed two straight games. He played in both games at Lynn with a start against Barry. Snyder is second on the team with 8.1 rebounds a game. He had a double-double at Eastern New Mexico with a careerhigh 17 rebounds. He also had 12 points that game and a career-high four assists. Against both Cameron and Fort Hays State he pulled down nine rebounds. Snyder is scoring 4.7 points a game and shooting 10-of-28 from the field and 7-of-10 from the free throw line.

Last year he played in six games before having surgery on the shoulder. He received a medical redshirt.

Ichabods looking for a solid starting five

Last year the Ichabods started 11 different players and used nine different starting lineups. Their best combination managed just three wins. Guard Andrew Meile started 24 of the 26 games, the most for any returner, and the team picked up nine of its 10 wins when he started. Washburn returns seven letterwinners, including four with a lot of starting experience. Forward Paul Byers returns after starting 19 games and going 8-11 when starting.

This year Washburn's Michael Williams, Meile and Frank Phifer have started all 10 games. Paul Byers started nine games and Kyle Snyder has seven starts. Snyder started the first six games before injury. Grant Hargett has three starts and Reed Hein has also started a game.

Ichabods strong from the free throw line

The Ichabods were second in the MIAA with a .723 free throw percentage coming into last week. Right now they are shooting .719. They set team season-highs against Missouri Western with 25 made free throws and 37 attempts. They shot a season-high .875 against Cameron with a 14-for-16 effort and were .850 against ENMU with a 17-for-20 mark.

They are shooting .768 (53-of-69) from the line in the final five minutes of the game and are .789 (15-for-19) in overtime periods (3 games, 4 periods).

Final notes on the Lynn game

- Mamadou Sy, a transfer from Cloud County who joined the team earlier in the month, scored four points off 2-of-3 shooting. He also had three rebounds in seven minutes.
- Kyle Snyder played in his first game since missing two to injury. He played 19 minutes and scored five points with four rebounds, a block and a steal.
- Washburn had its first streak of any kind with the loss with a two-game losing streak. Prior to the game, Washburn had alternated wins and losses all season.

Final notes on the Barry game

- Washburn's 16-point win is its biggest of the year.
- The 15-point halftime lead was the biggest and the 20-point lead during the game was also the largest of the year for Washburn.
- BU's 28 percent shooting was the lowest allowed this year.
- The 47 points allowed was the sixth lowest total for Washburn since joining NCAA II in 1989-90.

Bods and Ends

- Washburn is 3-0 when Brady Sisk scores 10 points or more and 3-0 when Michael Williams scores 10 points or more.
- Frank Phifer's 18 rebounds at Cameron was the most since Clarence Tyson had 18 at Missouri Western in 1993-94. The school record is 23 by Joe Luebcke in 1974.
- Frank Phifer and Paul Byers each had double-doubles at Cameron. Phifer had 20 points and a season-high 18 rebounds while Byers had 13 points and 10 rebounds. This is the second time this year WU has had two players with double-doubles.
- Washburn's 48 rebounds against ENMU was the most since 2004-05 for the Ichabods. They doubled up the Greyhounds 48-24 on rebounds and held a 17-1 advantage on offensive rebounds.
- With WU's win over ENMU ending in regulation, the Ichabods avoided going into overtime for the third straight time, something WU has never done. The Ichabods opened the year with a pair of OTs, marking the sixth time they have played consecutive overtimes and first to start a season.
- UNLV was the first team to shoot 50 percent against WU this year and the first in the previous 15 games. Southwest Baptist was the last team to shoot at least 50 percent, hitting 52 percent of its shots on 01/14/06.
- The Ichabods are 29-23 all-time in overtimes with two wins and one loss this year. Washburn is 6-6 all-time in 12 games that went into at least double-overtime.


