### Conference rivalry renews itself when Ichabods host Fort Hays State Wednesday

They may have played each other once already this year, but when the Ichabods host Fort Hays State at Lee Arena Wednesday at 7:30 p.m. on KTWU it will mark the first time they've played as conference foes since 1989. Washburn (5-8, 1-3 MIAA) will be looking to break a three-game losing streak while the Tigers (7-6, 0-4 MIAA) will be looking for their first conference win since joining the MIAA this year.

### Wednesday's game is second of three on KTWU

Bob Chipman, one of college basketball's winningest coaches, is in his 28th season at the helm of the Ichabod basketball program. His first win in 2006-07 will make him the second winningest coach as a member of the MIAA with his 380th win since joining the league.

With the Ichabods' 82-62 win over Southwest Baptist on Jan. 19, 2005 Chipman became the tenth coach in Division II to reach 600 wins. Chipman enters this season ranked fourth in victories and fourth by winning percentage among active NCAA Division II coaches. He is 13th in all-time winning percentage and 9th in all-time Division II victories.

Chipman has guided his teams to 22 20-win seasons, including seven in a row from 1983-84 to 1989-90, and four in a row from 1991-92 to 1994-95 and seven in a row from 1998-99 to 2004-05. Chipman's teams have made 14 national tournament appearances, 10 in the NCAA and four in the NAIA. His teams have averaged 23 wins a year and his 10-16 record last year marked his only losing season in 27 years.

Chipman joined the Washburn staff in 1976 as an assistant to longtime head coach Glenn Cafer. He was promoted to head coach in April 1979 when Cafer was appointed director of athletics. Chipman enjoyed a banner season in 1986-87, capping a 35-4 campaign with an NAIA national championship crown. In addition to the coaching awards obtained after the 1986-87 season, Chipman was named MIAA coach of the year following the 1992, 1993 and 2004 seasons. He was named Kodak district coach of the year by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) in 1993 and the men's four-year coach of the year by the Kansas Basketball Coaches Association (KBCA) in 1994 and 2001. Chipman served a second stint as an assistant coach for the U.S. entry in the Pan American Games during the summer of 1991, earning a bronze medal. In 1983, he was an assistant to the team that won the gold medal. He helped coach the U.S. entry in the World University Games to a gold medal in 1989. In 1985, he was an assistant coach for the Amateur Basketball Association/USA Jones Cup Team that won a silver medal. Chipman holds both bachelor's and master's degrees from Kansas State University.

The 1973 graduate earned two letters as a guard while playing for Wildcat coaching legend Jack Hartman. He played his first two seasons of college ball at Flint Community Junior College, in his hometown of Flint, Mich.

Chipman and his wife, Carol, live in Topeka with their son Bobby. Their daughter Kelsey is a freshman on the Kansas State volleyball team.

#### Slow start to second half costly in loss to No. 15 Bearcats January 6, 2007

TOPEKA - Despite a better shooting percentage and a six-point halftime lead, the Ichabods once again could not hold on against a ranked MIAA team as they fell 69-58 to No. 15 Northwest Missouri State. Kyle Snyder led WU with 15 points and just missed his second straight double-double with nine rebounds. Andrew Meile had 10 points and six rebounds. The 'Bods led 31-25 at halftime, marking the third straight time they led a ranked team unbeaten in MIAA play at the half. They shot 50 percent in the first half and held the Bearcats (11-2, 4-0 MIAA) to 26 percent shooting. Washburn made just one field goal in the first 6:26 of the second half. After a jumper from Brady Sisk for their second basket of the half, they still led by three at 13:34. They pushed it to five on another shot from Sisk, who ended the night with nine points, but then NWMSU went on a 10-2 run to build a 42-39 lead. With under a minute remaining the Bearcats led by 11 to put the game out of reach. WU shot 36 percent in the second half and ended the game with a 42 percent effort. NWMSU shot just 39 percent but made 21-of-26 free throws and took advantage of 19 WU turnovers. The Ichabods out-rebounded NWMSU 40-31 and blocked five shots.

#### FHSU Denied First Conference Win With Loss To Southwest Baptist January 6, 2007

HAYS - FHSU lost 69-59 to Southwest Baptist to remain without a win in four tries in the MIAA. Anthony Grant led the Tigers with 13 points and Jeff Pruitt and Kevin Wagstaff each put in 12. Tim Peintner led FHSU with 10 rebounds. The Tigers were down 33-29 at halftime but shot just 35 percent in the second half. They ended the game shooting 36 percent while the Bearcats shot 39 percent. Jason Jemison led SBU with 19 points.

#### Ichabods drop overtime game to Fort Hays State November 17, 2006

PORTALES, N.M. - Fort Hays State hit a field goal with four seconds left in overtime to send the Ichabods to a 70-69 loss in the first game of the Eastern New Mexico Shootout. Andrew Meile led Washburn with 18 points, Frank Phifer made 17 and Paul Byers had 16. Kyle Snyder had nine rebounds to lead the Ichabods. FHSU's Loranja Owens hit a free throw to cut it to two with 13 seconds left in regulation. Byers was fouled on the inbounds pass and he made one of two free throws with 11 seconds left to make it a three-point game. The Tigers got the rebound and pushed the ball up the court. Pruitt, who made 7-of-11 shots from inside and finished the night with 21 points, took his only 3 of the night and drained it to tie the game and send it to overtime. Playing in their second straight overtime game of the young season, the Ichabods failed to make a field goal. They shot 0-for-5 and their only points came off five free throws. FHSU hit a pair of field goals and a pair of free throws. Matt Stramel's layup with four seconds left proved to be the difference as Sergio Negrin's shot at the buzzer missed. Washburn, which was shooting 53 percent from the field late in the second half, finished the game shooting 44 percent. The Tigers shot just 39 percent. They out-rebounded the Ichabods 42-40 and had a 9-4 advantage on second chance points.

### About the Fort Hays State Tigers

Fort Hays State enters the game still searching for its first conference win since joining the MIAA this year. The Tigers are 7-6 this year after a 7-2 non-conference schedule, but are winless in the MIAA at 0-4. Leading FHSU in scoring this year is Jeff Pruitt with 13.8 points a game and 7.3 rebounds. Kevin Wagstaff is second on the team in scoring with 10.3 a game. Both players led all scorers with 21 points in the game against Washburn earlier this year.

FHSU head coach Mark Johnson is in his sixth year with the Tigers and has a 113-46 (.711) record. Last year he led the Tigers to a Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference title and to the NCAA tournament. With a 27-4 record he earned RMAC coach of the year honors. Johnson is a 1993 graduate of Pittsburg State where he played for two years.

### Series notes

- This is the 139th meeting between these schools in a series that goes back to 1918-19. It is the third most played series for WU behind Emporia State and Pittsburg State. Washburn leads the series 81-58.
- Washburn is 12-2 against FHSU in Lee Arena. This will be the first meeting in Lee since 12/01/99 when WU won 73-53.
- Since parting ways as conference opponents, they have met 18 times in non-conference games with WU holding a 13-5 lead in the series since then.
- These two schools shared five CSIC titles and three NAIA national championships during the 1980's. They also played each other 27 times during that time with WU winning 14 games. Six of those meetings came in the NCAA playoffs with FHSU winning four of them.
- Washburn's 1983-84 team was 24-8 heading into the district final against the Tigers. The Ichabods were sent on the road to play them for a chance to advance to the national tournament. WU's president arranged to have the team flown there for the game on a twin-propeller airplane. Despite their first class travel arrangements, the Ichabods ended up losing the game and Fort Hays State went on to win the national title. The Ichabods got their revenge in the 1986-87 season when they beat the Tigers three times on their way to a national title.
- These two teams have met in overtime six times with FHSU holding a 4-2 lead. The last OT meeting came earlier this year when the Tigers won 70-69 in the Eastern New Mexico Shootout.

### A winning history

- The Ichabods are 1,333-914 (.593 in 2,247 games) and are in their 102nd season of basketball.
- Starting their 23rd season in Lee Arena, the Ichabods are 306-51 (.857). The Ichabods are 3-2 this year at home and they finished the 2005-06 slate 7-6. The Ichabods are 120-20 in Lee Arena since the 1997-98 season.
- In 17 seasons as an NCAA II school, the Ichabods have 10 NCAA tournament appearances and nine MIAA titles. Last year snapped a streak of three straight conference championships.
- Washburn won the 1986-87 NAIA national championship with a 35-4 record under head coach Bob Chipman in his eighth year as coach.
- Washburn was fourth in the nation last year among NCAA II schools

in attendance, averaging 2,750 fans a game. WU was the highest ranked MIAA team. As a conference, the MIAA had the second highest attendance with an average of 1,851 fans per game.

• The Ichabods suffered their first losing season last year since 1976-77 and first of head coach Bob Chipman's career. They also failed to advance to the MIAA tournament for the first time since joining the league in 1989-90.

### Up next for the Ichabods

The Ichabods will play on the road after a three-game home stand when they travel to Truman Saturday for a 3:30 p.m. game.

### Ichabods need offensive boost, near bottom on MIAA scoring stats

Washburn is last in the MIAA with 65.5 points per game and ninth with a .406 field goal percentage. The Ichabods had their lowest scoring output ever as an NCAA II school when they scored just 50 at Central Missouri. Washburn's highest output this year was 77, reached three times. They scored 77 in a three-point loss to Emporia State Wednesday. In the season-opener the Ichabods reached it in double overtime against Kansas Wesleyan and then they matched it in the MIAA win over Missouri Western.

Their -3.9 scoring margin is the lowest in the MIAA, as is their .289 3-point shooting percentage.

The Ichabods are third in free throw percentage at .732 and fourth in rebounding with 38.2 per game.

### Phifer gives Ichabods inside presence, leads team in scoring

Senior forward Frank Phifer leads the team and is eighth in the MIAA with 15.1 points a game and he has reached double figures in 11 of the 13 games. The last two games he has been held below 10 points. Phifer is shooting 48 percent from the field and is 81 percent from the free throw line, sixth best in the league. He leads the 'Bods with 62 made free throws and 77 attempts. He is fifth in the MIAA with 7.5 rebounds a game and tied for third with 1.6 blocks a game. He has blocked a shot in every game this year but one and has seven games with multiple blocks.

Earlier this year he had three straight double-doubles and 20-point efforts. He had his first double-double at Washburn after scoring a team season-high 25 points at Central Oklahoma with 10 rebounds. He followed that with 26 points and 11 rebounds against Missouri Western for another double-double and then at Cameron he had 20 points and a season-high 18 rebounds. That rebound total is the highest this year for any MIAA individual.

### Byers second on the team in scoring

Paul Byers is second on the team with 9.0 points a game and third with 5.4 rebounds. His rebound total is 15th best in the MIAA. Against ESU he had a season-high 17 points. Byers is shooting 48 percent from the field, 35 percent from 3-point range and 82 percent from the free throw line. He was a perfect 6-for-6 from the line against ESU. He has started all but one game this year. In his only game off the bench he scored 10 points and had six rebounds against Cameron. Byers had his first career double-double at Cameron with 13 points and 10 rebounds.

### Meile leads team in steals

Junior guard Andrew Meile leads the team with 24 steals and 1.9 steals per game after a career-high five at Lynn. That total is tied for fourth best in the MIAA. He is third on the team with 8.3 points a game and leads WU with 17 made 3-pointers. Against Northwest Missouri State he had 10 points for his seventh double-figure game, however, the Ichabods are 0-7 when Meile scores in double digits. Meile leads the team averaging 30.6 minutes a game.

### Williams giving WU senior leadership as starting guard

Senior Michael Williams has started all 13 games as Washburn's point guard. After a season-high 19 points against ESU he is averaging 7.9 points a game, fourth best on the team. In MIAA games he leads the team with 2.0 assists per game.

Williams was the hero in Washburn's win over Missouri Western. He hit a 3-pointer in the final minute to put WU up by a point. With just one second left he hit a pull-up jumper just inside the free throw line to give Washburn the win.

### Snyder returns after shoulder injury keeps him out

Junior forward Kyle Snyder re-injured his shoulder at Central Oklahoma December 5 and then missed two straight games. Since then he has played in the last five with four starts. He had his second double-double of the season with 10 points and 11 rebounds against ESU and he just missed a double-double Wednesday against Northwest Missouri with 15 points and nine rebounds. Snyder leads the team and is fourth in the MIAA with 7.8 rebounds a game. He holds the MIAA's second highest single-game rebounding total this year with a career-high 17 at Eastern New Mexico.

Last year he played in six games before having surgery on the shoulder. He received a medical redshirt.

### Sisk leading Ichabods off the bench

Junior forward Brady Sisk had his second career double-double with 12 points and 12 rebounds against Missouri Western. He leads the Washburn non-starters with 88 points off the bench. Averaging 15.5 minutes a game, he is averaging 6.8 points, fifth best on the team. Sisk has reached double figures in scoring three times this year and the Ichabods are undefeated in those games.

### Ichabods add junior forward from Cloud County CC

Forward Mamadou Sy joined the Ichabods earlier this month. He is averaging 4.2 points and 4.0 rebounds a game. He had nine points and six rebounds at UCM. Sy, a 6-6 native of Paris, France, played guard at Cloud County

Community College the previous two years. Sy averaged 6.3 points, 5.1 rebounds and 1.2 assists playing with current Ichabod junior guard Reed Hein both years.

### Hein gives 'Bods 3-point boost off the bench

Junior guard Reed Hein is scoring 4.2 points a game while averaging 13.9 minutes. Of the 31 field goals he has attempted, 28 have been 3-pointers. He is shooting 50 percent (14-of-28) from 3-point range and 52 percent (16-of-31) overall. All 15 field goals attempted in MIAA games have been 3-pointers and he has made eight of them.

### Ichabods looking for a solid starting five

Last year the Ichabods started 11 different players and used nine different starting lineups. Their best combination managed just three wins. Guard Andrew Meile started 24 of the 26 games, the most for any returner, and the team picked up nine of its 10 wins when he started.

This year Washburn's Michael Williams, Meile and Frank Phifer have started all 13 games. Paul Byers has started 12 games and Kyle Snyder has 10 starts. Snyder started the first six games before injury. Grant Hargett has three starts and Reed Hein has also started a game.

### Ichabods strong from the free throw line

The Ichabods are third in the MIAA with a .732 free throw percentage. They set team season-highs against Missouri Western with 25 made free throws and 37 attempts. They shot .875 against Cameron with a 14-for-16 effort and were .850 against ENMU with a 17-for-20 mark.

They are shooting .792 (61-of-77) from the line in the final five minutes of the game and are .789 (15-for-19) in overtime periods (3 games, 4 periods).

### Washburn looking for second road win

The Ichabods are 1-5 on the road this year with the win coming at Eastern New Mexico. Last year's lone road win came at Missouri Southern in a 60-56 win on 01/21/06. The Ichabods ended the year 1-8 in road contests last year.

### Final notes on the Northwest Missouri State game

- For the third straight game the Ichabods led a ranked team undefeated in the MIAA at halftime and for the third straight time they lost.
- Kyle Snyder led Washburn with 15 points and just missed a double-double with nine rebounds.

### Bods and Ends

• The Ichabods hold the top two individual rebounding performances this year in the MIAA. Frank Phifer's 18 rebounds at Cameron was the most since Clarence Tyson had 18 at Missouri Western in 1993-94. Kyle Snyder had 17 in a win at Eastern New Mexico.

• Washburn is 3-0 when Brady Sisk scores 10 points or more.

• The Ichabods held Barry to 47 points in the Lynn Holiday Classic, the sixth lowest total for Washburn since joining NCAA II in 1989-90. BU's 28 percent shooting was the lowest allowed this year by Washburn.

• The 50 points scored by Washburn against Emporia State was its lowest total since joining the NCAA Division II in 1989-90. The last time the Ichabods scored less than 50 points was a 75-47 loss at UCM in 1982-83. The previous low as a DII school was the 51 scored in a loss last year to Central Arkansas.

• Washburn's 48 rebounds against ENMU was the most since 2004-05 for the Ichabods. They doubled up the Greyhounds 48-24 on rebounds and held a 17-1 advantage on offensive rebounds.

• With WU's win over ENMU ending in regulation, the Ichabods avoided going into overtime for the third straight time, something WU has never done. The Ichabods opened the year with a pair of OTs, marking the sixth time they have played consecutive overtimes and first to start a season.

• The Ichabods are 29-23 all-time in overtimes with two wins and one loss this year. Washburn is 6-6 all-time in 12 games that went into at least double-overtime.
