Bob Chipman, one of college basketball's winningest coaches, is in his 28th season at the helm of the Ichabod basketball program. His first win in 2006-07 will make him the second winningest coach as a member of the MIAA with his 380th win since joining the league.

With the Ichabods' 82-62 win over Southwest Baptist on Jan. 19, 2005 Chipman became the tenth coach in Division II to reach 600 wins. Chipman enters this season ranked fourth in victories and fourth by winning percentage among active NCAA Division II coaches. He is 13th in all-time winning percentage and 9th in all-time Division II victories.

Chipman has guided his teams to 22 20-win seasons, including seven in a row from 1983-84 to 1989-90, and four in a row from 1991-92 to 1994-95 and seven in a row from 1998-99 to 2004-05. Chipman's teams have made 14 national tournament appearances, 10 in the NCAA and four in the NAIA. His teams have averaged 23 wins a year and his 10-16 record last year marked his only losing season in 27 years.

Chipman joined the Washburn staff in 1976 as an assistant to longtime head coach Glenn Cafer. He was promoted to head coach in April 1979 when Cafer was appointed director of athletics. Chipman enjoyed a banner season in 1986-87, capping a 35-4 campaign with an NAIA national championship crown. In addition to the coaching awards obtained after the 1986-87 season, Chipman was named MIAA coach of the year following the 1992, 1993 and 2004 seasons. He was named Kodak district coach of the year by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) in 1993 and the men's four-year coach of the year by the Kansas Basketball Coaches Association (KBCA) in 1994 and 2001. Chipman served a second stint as an assistant coach for the U.S. entry in the Pan American Games during the summer of 1991, earning a bronze medal. In 1983, he was an assistant to the team that won the gold medal. He helped coach the U.S. entry in the World University Games to a gold medal in 1989. In 1985, he was an assistant coach for the Amateur Basketball Association/USA Jones Cup Team that won a silver medal. Chipman holds both bachelor's and master's degrees from Kansas State University.

The 1973 graduate earned two letters as a guard while playing for Wildcat coaching legend Jack Hartman. He played his first two seasons of college ball at Flint Community Junior College, in his hometown of Flint, Mich.

Chipman and his wife, Carol, live in Topeka with their son Bobby. Their daughter Kelsey is a freshman on the Kansas State volleyball team.

### Hargett scores career-high 18 but Ichabods fall to SBU January 17, 2007

TOPEKA - Junior guard Grant Hargett had a career-high 18 points but it wasn't enough as the Ichabods let a halftime lead slip away in a 76-69 loss to Southwest Baptist Wednesday night at Lee Arena. WU led 44-36 at halftime and opened the half with a 3-pointer from Hargett and then a three-point play by senior forward Frank Phifer to take a 14-point lead. The Bearcats then chipped away and took the lead, 59-58 at 8:04 on a 21-8 run. During that run they held the Ichabods without a field goal for 7:18. Washburn broke that drought on a jumper from Hargett at 6:40 to lead by one. SBU regained the lead for good at 3:25 and went on to a seven-point win. Hargett scored his 18 points off 7-of-14 shooting and three 3-pointers. Senior guard Michael Williams had 12 points. Junior guard Reed Hein was 3-for-4 from 3-point range for nine points and Phifer also chipped in nine. Junior forward Kyle Snyder had 14 rebounds to lead all players as he reached double digits for the fourth time this year. Washburn shot 35 percent in the game after shooting 23 percent in the second half. The Bearcats were 42 percent from the field.

### Reed's tip-in lifts MWSU to win as time expires in overtime January 17, 2007

PITTSBURG -- J.R. Reed's tip-in as time expired capped a mad flurry in the final seconds of overtime and lifted Missouri Western State University to an 71-69 victory over Pittsburg State University Wednesday (Jan. 17) at John Lance Arena. Pittsburg State (9-7, 2-5 MIAA), which dropped its fourth straight game, had a chance to win the game in regulation but Daniel Blair's inside shot rimmed out with 2.9 seconds remaining. Cory Abercrombie scored a game-high 23 points for Pitt State before fouling out with 37.1 seconds left in regulation. Ed Morris added a double-double for the Gorillas with 18 points and a game-high 14 rebounds. Michael Hutchingson also scored in double figures with 10 points for Pitt State. Western shot 47.1 percent from the field while holding Pitt State to 41.4 percent shooting. The Gorillas struggled from the foul line, making just 18 of 30 charity shots. Quarels scored a team-leading 21 points for Western. Manthe and Reed added 13 and 10 for the Griffons.

### PSU wins to split season series February 4, 2006

PITTSBURG - A late rally by the Ichabods fell short as they lost 67-60 to Pittsburg State in John Lance Arena. Washburn trailed by 16 at 62-46 with 8:30 remaining in the second half, but the Ichabods rallied to cut the lead to five at 65-60 at the 1:54 mark. The Ichabods led 31-29 at the half after trailing by as many as eight points, but a tip in by Moriba DeCoteau at the buzzer gave Washburn a two-point lead. Washburn shot 40 percent in the first half but cooled in the second half to 32 percent while going 0-6 from 3-point land and 1-of-13 for the game from behind the arc. Washburn was led by Sisk who scored 25 points hitting 7-of-19 shots from the field.

### About the Pittsburg State Gorillas

Pittsburg State is 9-7 overall and 2-5 in the MIAA. The Gorillas have lost their last four. Leading PSU in scoring is Cory Abercrombie with 15.1 points a game, the eighth highest total in the league. In MIAA games he is scoring 19.9 a game. PSU's leading rebounder is Ed Morris with 9.1 a game.

Gorilla head coach Gene Iba is 216-121 (.641) in his 12th year and 441-324 (.576) in his 27th year overall.

### Series notes

- This is the 156th meeting between the two schools, making it Washburn's second most played rivalry behind Emporia State. The Ichabods lead the series 86-69.
- Washburn has won all 22 meetings against PSU played in Lee Arena since it opened in 1984-85. Pittsburg State's last win in Topeka was 63-61 on 01/26/82 when Washburn played in Whiting Auditorium.
- The two teams have split the season series the last three years with the home team winning. Head coach Bob Chipman is 40-13 against PSU and 25-1 against the Gorillas in Topeka, including a 22-0 record against them in Lee Arena.
- The two teams have met twice in overtime with Washburn winning both of them. The last came in a 67-54 win on 03/05/92 in the MIAA tournament. The first came when Washburn played in consecutive triple overtime games in 1985-86.

### A winning history

- The Ichabods are 1,334-916 (.593 in 2,250 games) and are in their 102nd season of basketball.
- Starting their 23rd season in Lee Arena, the Ichabods are 307-52 (.855). The Ichabods are 4-3 this year at home and they finished the 2005-06 slate 7-6. The Ichabods are 121-21 in Lee Arena since the 1997-98 season.
- In 17 seasons as an NCAA II school, the Ichabods have 10 NCAA tournament appearances and nine MIAA titles. Last year snapped a streak of three straight conference championships.
- Washburn won the 1986-87 NAIA national championship with a 35-4 record under head coach Bob Chipman in his eighth year as coach.
- Washburn was fourth in the nation last year among NCAA II schools in attendance, averaging 2,750 fans a game. WU was the highest ranked MIAA team. As a conference, the MIAA had the second highest attendance with an average of 1,851 fans per game.
- The Ichabods suffered their first losing season last year since 1976-77 and first of head coach Bob Chipman's career. They also failed to advance to the MIAA tournament for the first time since joining the league in 1989-90.

### Up next for the Ichabods

The Ichabods will play at Missouri Southern Wednesday at 7:30 p.m., starting the final stretch of the season in which seven of the last 10 games are on the road. The following Saturday WU will travel to Missouri Western.

### Ichabods near bottom of MIAA offensive stats

Washburn is last in the MIAA in scoring (64.6 points per game) and field goal percentage (.400). While the Ichabods have been struggling to score, they have been able to keep their opponents' point totals low. Opponents are scoring 68.4 points a game against WU and shooting .416 from the field.

The Ichabods had their lowest and second lowest scoring outputs ever as an NCAA II school this year when they scored 45 at Truman and 50 at Central Missouri. Washburn's highest output this year was 77, reached three times. They scored 77 in a three-point loss to Emporia State. In the season-opener the Ichabods reached it in double overtime against Kansas Wesleyan and then they matched it in the MIAA win over Missouri Western.

### Washburn able to get to the boards

The Ichabods have been able to out-rebound their opponents this year. They are averaging 38.7 a game, fourth best in the league and have a +4.3 rebound margin, the fifth best. They have gotten to the boards more than their opponents in 10 of 16 games and are 5-5 when doing so. When they get out-rebounded they have a 1-5 record. Kyle Snyder is fourth in the conference in rebounding with 8.4 a game and Frank Phifer is sixth with 7.4. Snyder's 6.2 defensive rebounds a game is the second best average in the league.

### Ichabods strong from the free throw line

Washburn has been near the top of the MIAA in free throw percentage and is currently fifth at .710. The Ichabods shot 80 percent from the line against Southwest Baptist and have hit 80 percent or better five times this year, topping out at 94 percent (17-of-18) against Emporia State. Frank Phifer is eighth in the MIAA in free throw percentage with a .793 effort.

The Ichabods are shooting .783 (65-of-83) from the line in the final five minutes of the game and are .789 (15-for-19) in overtime periods (3 games, 4 periods).

### Phifer returns to starting lineup, leads team in scoring

Senior forward Frank Phifer returned to the starting lineup Wednesday against SBU after missing two starts. He leads the team and is 10th in the MIAA with 14.4 points a game and he has reached double figures in 13 of 16 games. When he fails to reach 10 or more points WU is 0-3. In his two games off the bench last week he scored 26 points and 13 rebounds.

Phifer scored nine points against SBU Wednesday and tied a season-high with three blocks. He is third in the MIAA with 1.5 blocks per game and he has blocked a shot in every game but three and has eight games with multiple blocks. His 24 blocks this year is currently tied with assistant coach Ewan Auguste for 13th in a single season at WU.

Phifer is shooting 79 percent from the free throw line, eighth best in the conference and he leads Washburn with 73 free throws made and 92 attempts. He has made nearly three times as many free throws as anyone else on the team and almost one out of every three Washburn free throws is taken by Phifer.

Earlier this year he had three straight double-doubles and 20-point efforts. He had his first double-double at Washburn after scoring a team season-high 25 points at Central Oklahoma with 10 rebounds. He followed that with 26 points and 11 rebounds against Missouri Western for another double-double and then at Cameron he had 20 points and a season-high 18 rebounds. That rebound total is the highest this year for any MIAA individual.

### Byers second on the team in scoring

Sophomore forward Paul Byers is second on the team in scoring with 8.5 points a game and third with 5.3 rebounds a game. He also leads the team with a 49 percent field goal percentage. Byers has reached double figures in scoring six times. He had his first career double-double at Cameron with 13 points and 10 rebounds. Against ESU he had a season-high 17 points. He has started all but one game this year. In his only game off the bench he scored 10 points and had six rebounds against Cameron.

### Meile leads team in free throw percentage, steals

Junior guard Andrew Meile leads the Ichabods with 24 steals, 1.5 per game, but hasn't had a steal in the last three games. In the game Wednesday against Southwest Baptist he scored eighth points with three assists before fouling out for the first time this year and third in his career.

Meile also leads the team with a .806 free throw percentage, making 25-of-31 shots from the line. He is tied with Byers for second on the team with 8.5 points a game and leads WU with 25 made 3-pointers. He scored 14 points against FHSU and for the first time this year Washburn won a game when he scored in double figures. Prior to that the team was 0-7 in such games. Meile leads the team averaging 30.1 minutes a game.

### Snyder returns after shoulder injury keeps him out

Junior forward Kyle Snyder re-injured his shoulder at Central Oklahoma December 5 and then missed two straight games. Since then he has played in every game. On Wednesday against SBU he had 14 rebounds, reaching double figures for the second straight game and for the fourth time this year. He leads Washburn and is fourth in the MIAA with 8.4 rebounds a game. His 6.2 offensive rebounds a game is the second highest total in the MIAA. Snyder holds the MIAA's second highest single-game rebounding total this year with a career-high 17 at Eastern New Mexico.

Last year he played in six games before having surgery on the shoulder. He received a medical redshirt.

### Sisk leads Washburn bench in scoring

Junior forward Brady Sisk came off the bench Wednesday against SBU after starting a pair of games. In his two starts he totaled 15 points and six assists. Off the bench he leads Washburn with 88 points and overall he is averaging 6.4 points a game. Sisk had his second career double-double with 12 points and 12 rebounds against Missouri Western. Sisk has reached double figures in scoring three times this year and the Ichabods are undefeated in those games.

### Hargett leads team in assists

Junior guard Grant Hargett had a career-high 18 points against Southwest Baptist Wednesday off career highs of three 3-pointers and seven total field goals. It was his first game leading the team in scoring. He has started the last three games at guard and has six total starts this year. As a starter he is averaging 8.2 points a game and from the bench he is totaling just 4.4.

He is leading Washburn in assists with 36 and 2.6 a game. Hargett is averaging 6.0 points and 2.8 rebounds a game and is a 76 percent free throw shooter.

### Williams giving WU senior leadership at guard

Senior Michael Williams started the first 13 games at guard this year for Washburn. He is averaging 7.5 points a game, fourth best on the team, and is second on the team scoring 11.3 points in home games. All five of his games reaching double figures have come in home games. Wednesday against SBU he was one of two Ichabods to reach double figures with 12 points.

Williams was the hero in Washburn's win over Missouri Western. He hit a 3-pointer in the final minute to put WU up by a point. With just one second left he hit a pull-up jumper just inside the free throw line to give Washburn the win.

### Ichabods add junior forward from Cloud County CC

Forward Mamadou Sy joined the Ichabods earlier this month. He is averaging 3.3 points and 3.8 rebounds a game. He had nine points and six rebounds at UCM. Sy, a 6-6 native of Paris, France, played guard at Cloud County Community College the previous two years. Sy averaged 6.3 points, 5.1 rebounds and 1.2 assists playing with current Ichabod junior guard Reed Hein both years.

### Hein gives 'Bods 3-point boost off the bench

Junior guard Reed Hein was 3-for-4 from 3-point range Wednesday against SBU for nine points. It was his third game of the year hitting a season-high three 3-pointers. He is scoring 4.3 points a game while averaging 13.6 minutes. Of the 41 field goals he has attempted, 38 have been 3-pointers. He is shooting 49 percent (20-of-41). All 25 field goals attempted in MIAA games have been 3-pointers and he has made 12 of them. His last 21 field goal attempts have been from 3-point range.

### Ichabods looking for a solid starting five

Washburn used its fifth different starting lineup combination Wednesday against SBU. Andrew Meile has started every game as a guard for the Ichabods. Paul Byers has started all but one and Frank Phifer has started all but two. Kyle Snyder started the first six games then missed three starts due to injury. He has started every game since then for a total of 13.

### Washburn looking for second road win

The Ichabods are 1-6 on the road this year with the win coming at Eastern New Mexico. Last year's lone road win came at Missouri Southern in a 60-56 win on 01/21/06. The Ichabods ended the year 1-8 in road contests last year and are 2-14 in the last two seasons.

### Final notes on the Southwest Baptist game

- The Ichabods made a season-high 11 3-pointers and took a season-high 71 field goals. Their six blocks tied a season-high. The Ichabods' 46 rebounds was their second highest total this year. Their highest effort came against Eastern New Mexico on 11/18/06 when they had 48.
- Grant Hargett scored a career-high 18 points with a career-high three 3-pointers and seven total field goals.
- Frank Phifer tied his season-high with three blocks.
- Junior guard Andrew Meile fouled out for the first time this year and third time in his career. He had eight points and three assists.
- Washburn gave up its biggest lead in a loss this year. The Ichabods led by 15 in the first period. The previous largest lead overcome by an opponent was 10 by Fort Hays State on 11/17/06.
- The Ichabods dropped to 5-5 when leading at the half and 2-9 when being whistled for more fouls.

### Bods and Ends

- The Ichabods hold the top two individual rebounding performances this year in the MIAA. Frank Phifer had 18 rebounds at Cameron and Kyle Snyder had 17 in a win at Eastern New Mexico.
- Against FHSU Washburn shot 50 percent or better for the first time since the season finale last year at Central Missouri. The 52 percent shooting was the best in 20 games for the Ichabods.
- The eight turnovers by WU at Truman was a season low and the four turnovers that TSU had was an opponent season low. The 105 points the two combined for was the lowest total in a Washburn game since joining NCAA II in 1989-90.
- Washburn has suffered its two lowest point totals as an NCAA II school this year. The Ichabods scored just 45 at Truman Saturday and the 50 points scored by Washburn at Central Missouri was its previous lowest total since joining DII in 1989-90.
- Washburn's 48 rebounds against ENMU was the most since 2004-05 for the Ichabods. They doubled up the Greyhounds 48-24 on rebounds and held a 17-1 advantage on offensive rebounds.
- The Ichabods are 29-23 all-time in overtimes with two wins and one loss this year. Washburn is 6-6 all-time in 12 games that went into at least double-overtime.
