Bob Chipman Head Coach 1979-80 - Present (28th Season) Kansas State '73

Bob Chipman, one of college basketball's winningest coaches, is in his 28th season at the helm of the Ichabod basketball program. His first win in 2006-07 will made him the second winningest coach as a member of the MIAA with his 380th win since joining the league.

With the Ichabods' 82-62 win over Southwest Baptist on Jan. 19, 2005 Chipman became the tenth coach in Division II to reach 600 wins. Chipman enters this season ranked fourth in victories and fourth by winning percentage among active NCAA Division II coaches. He is 13th in all-time winning percentage and 9th in all-time Division II victories.

Chipman has guided his teams to 22 20-win seasons, including seven in a row from 1983-84 to 1989-90, and four in a row from 1991-92 to 1994-95 and seven in a row from 1998-99 to 2004-05. Chipman's teams have made 14 national tournament appearances, 10 in the NCAA and four in the NAIA. His teams have averaged 23 wins a year and his 10-16 record last year marked his only losing season in 27 years.

Chipman joined the Washburn staff in 1976 as an assistant to longtime head coach Glenn Cafer. He was promoted to head coach in April 1979 when Cafer was appointed director of athletics. Chipman enjoyed a banner season in 1986-87, capping a 35-4 campaign with an NAIA national championship crown. In addition to the coaching awards obtained after the 1986-87 season, Chipman was named MIAA coach of the year following the 1992, 1993 and 2004 seasons. He was named Kodak district coach of the year by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) in 1993 and the men's four-year coach of the year by the Kansas Basketball Coaches Association (KBCA) in 1994 and 2001. Chipman served a second stint as an assistant coach for the U.S. entry in the Pan American Games during the summer of 1991, earning a bronze medal. In 1983, he was an assistant to the team that won the gold medal. He helped coach the U.S. entry in the World University Games to a gold medal in 1989. In 1985, he was an assistant coach for the Amateur Basketball Association/USA Jones Cup Team that won a silver medal. Chipman holds both bachelor's and master's degrees from Kansas State University.

The 1973 graduate earned two letters as a guard while playing for Wildcat coaching legend Jack Hartman. He played his first two seasons of college ball at Flint Community Junior College, in his hometown of Flint, Mich.

Chipman and his wife, Carol, live in Topeka with their son Bobby. Their daughter Kelsey is a freshman on the Kansas State volleyball team

After two ties and three lead changes in the first overtime, the Ichabods led the entire way in the second extra frame. Rashad Adams, who led all scorers with 22 points, opened the period with a pair of free throws. Getting into overtime was not easy for the Ichabods. The Lions led for most of the second half and led by two with under a minute to play. Milburn had a chance to win it but missed a 3-pointer with 11 seconds left. Adams came out with the rebound and was fouled. The Lions are led in scoring by junior forward Deonte Cox with 12.5 points a game. Junior guard TJ Britton leads the team in rebounding with 6.9 a game. The Lions are seventh in the MIAA averaging 70.4 points a game and their 73.8 points allowed per game is the ninth highest in league.

MSSU coach Robert Corn 271-227 (.544) in his 18th season overall, all spent with the Lions. Corn is a 1978 graduate of MSSU and was an assistant coach at Alabama-Birmingham for 10 years before returning to his alma mater.

- This is the 60th meeting between the two schools. Washburn holds a 43-16 lead in the series record.

A winning history

- Starting their 23rd season in Lee Arena, the Ichabods are 307-53 (.853). The Ichabods are 4-4 this year at home and they finished the 2005-06 slate 7-6. The Ichabods are 121-22 in Lee Arena since the 1997-98 season.

Washburn looking for second road win

The Ichabods are 1-6 on the road this year with the win coming at Eastern New Mexico. Last year's lone road win came at Missouri Southern in a 60-56 win on 01/21/06. The Ichabods ended the year 1-8 in road contests last year and are 2-14 in the last two seasons.

Ichabods near bottom of MIAA offensive stats

Washburn is last in the MIAA in scoring (65.5 points per game) and field goal percentage (.405). While the Ichabods have been struggling to score, they have been able to keep their opponents' point totals low. Opponents are scoring 69.4 points a game against WU, sixth lowest in the league and are shooting .421 from the field, sixth lowest.

The Ichabods scored a season-high 79 points in a loss to Pittsburg State Saturday. They had a season-high 30 field goals. The Ichabods had their lowest and second lowest scoring outputs ever as an NCAA II school this year when they scored 45 at Truman and 50 at Central Missouri.

Washburn able to get to the boards

The Ichabods have been able to out-rebound their opponents this year. They are averaging 38.4 a game, fourth best in the league while allowing 33.9. They have a +4.5 rebound margin, the fifth best in the conference. They have gotten to the boards more than their opponents in 11 of 17 games and are 5-6 when doing so. When they get out-rebounded they have a 1-5 record. Kyle Snyder is fourth in the conference in rebounding with 8.3 a game and Frank Phifer is seventh with 7.2. Snyder's 6.0 defensive rebounds a game is the second best average in the league.

Ichabods strong from the free throw line

Washburn has been near the top of the MIAA in free throw percentage and is currently fifth at .711. The Ichabods have hit 80 percent or better five times this year, topping out at 94 percent (17-of-18) against Emporia State. Frank Phifer is seventh in the MIAA in free throw percentage with a .786 effort.

The Ichabods are shooting .783 (66-of-84) from the line in the final five minutes of the game and are .789 (15-for-19) in overtime periods (3 games, 4 periods).

Snyder has started the last 8 after should injury has kept him out

Junior forward Kyle Snyder re-injured his shoulder at Central Oklahoma December 5 and then missed two straight games. Since then he has played in every game. Against SBU he had 14 rebounds, reaching double figures for the second straight game and for the fourth time this year. He leads Washburn and is fourth in the MIAA with 8.3 rebounds a game. His 6.0 offensive rebounds a game is the second highest total in the MIAA. Snyder holds the MIAA's second highest single-game rebounding total this year with a career-high 17 at Eastern New Mexico.

Last year he played in six games before having surgery on the shoulder. He received a medical redshirt.

Phifer leads team in scoring

Senior forward Frank Phifer came off the bench Saturday against Pittsburg State to score 22 points, the highest point total off the bench this year for Washburn. It was his fourth game scoring 20 or more points this year. He leads the team and is ninth in the MIAA with 14.9 points a game and he has reached double figures

in 14 of 17 games. When he fails to reach 10 or more points WU is 0-3. In three games off the bench he is averaging 16.0 points and 5.7 rebounds.

Phifer is fourth in the MIAA with 1.4 blocks per game and he has blocked a shot in every game but four and has eight games with multiple blocks. His 24 blocks this year is currently tied with assistant coach Ewan Auguste for 13th in a single season at WU.

Phifer is shooting .786 percent from the free throw line, seventh best in the conference and he leads Washburn with 77 free throws made and 98 attempts. He has made nearly three times as many free throws as anyone else on the team and almost one out of every three Washburn free throws is taken by Phifer.

Earlier this year he had three straight double-doubles and 20-point efforts. He had his first double-double at Washburn after scoring a team season-high 25 points at Central Oklahoma with 10 rebounds. He followed that with 26 points and 11 rebounds against Missouri Western for another double-double and then at Cameron he had 20 points and a season-high 18 rebounds. That rebound total is the highest this year for any MIAA individual.

Byers third on the team in scoring

Sophomore forward Paul Byers is third on the team in scoring with 8.4 points a game and third with 5.5 rebounds a game, 14th best in the MIAA. He leads the team with a .486 field goal percentage and a 50 percent effort in MIAA games. He also leads Washburn with a .800 free throw percentage and he's shooting 86 percent in MIAA games.

Byers has reached double figures in scoring six times. He had his first career double-double at Cameron with 13 points and 10 rebounds. Against ESU he had a season-high 17 points. He has started all but one game this year. In his only game off the bench he scored 10 points and had six rebounds against Cameron.

Meile scored 16 points Saturday, leads team in steals

Junior guard Andrew Meile had his second highest point total of the year with 16 against Pittsburg State Saturday. He also tied a career-high with five made 3-pointers. He leads the Ichabods with 24 steals and his 1.53 per game is eighth best in the conference.

Meile is second on the team with a .788 free throw percentage, making 26-of-33 shots from the line. He is second on the team with 8.9 points a game and leads WU with 30 made 3-pointers. He scored 14 points against FHSU and for the first time this year Washburn won a game when he scored in double figures. The team is 1-8 in such games. Meile leads the team averaging 30.2 minutes a game.

Sisk leads Washburn bench in scoring

Junior forward Brady Sisk has started three of the last four games and has averaged 6.3 points as a starter. Off the bench he is also averaging 6.3 a game and he leads Washburn with 88 bench points and overall he is averaging 6.3 points a game. Sisk had his second career double-double with 12 points and 12 rebounds against Missouri Western. Sisk has reached double figures in scoring three times this year and the Ichabods are undefeated in those games.

Hargett leads team in assists

Junior guard Grant Hargett had a career-high 18 points against Southwest Baptist off career highs of three 3-pointers and seven total field goals. It was his first game leading the team in scoring. He has started the last four games at guard and has seven total starts this year. As a starter he is averaging 8.0 points a game and from the bench he is totaling just 4.4.

He is leading Washburn in assists with 39 and 2.6 a game. Hargett is averaging 6.1 points and 2.7 rebounds a game and is a 76 percent free throw shooter.

Williams giving WU senior leadership at guard

Senior Michael Williams started the first 13 games at guard this year for Washburn. He is averaging 7.3 points a game, fourth best on the team, and is second on the team scoring 10.4 points in home games. All five of his games reaching double figures have come in home games. Against SBU he was one of two Ichabods to reach double figures with 12 points.

Williams was the hero in Washburn's win over Missouri Western. He hit a 3-pointer in the final minute to put WU up by a point. With just one second left he hit a pull-up jumper just inside the free throw line to give Washburn the win.

Ichabods add junior forward from Cloud County CC

Forward Mamadou Sy joined the Ichabods earlier this month. He is averaging 2.9 points and 3.6 rebounds a game. He had nine points and six rebounds at UCM. Sy, a 6-6 native of Paris, France, played guard at Cloud County Community College the previous two years. Sy averaged 6.3 points, 5.1 rebounds and 1.2 assists playing with current Ichabod junior guard Reed Hein both years.

Hein gives 'Bods 3-point boost off the bench

Junior guard Reed Hein was 3-for-4 from 3-point range-against SBU for nine points. It was his third game of the year hitting a season-high three 3-pointers. He made two more against PSU Saturday. He is scoring 4.5 points a game while averaging 13.7 minutes. Of the 45 field goals he has attempted, 42 have been 3-pointers. He is shooting 49 percent (22-45). All 29 field goals attempted in MIAA games have been 3-pointers and he has made 14 of them. His last 25 field goal attempts have been from 3-point range.

Washburn has started eight different players and has used five different starting lineup combinations. Andrew Meile has started every game as a guard for the Ichabods. Paul Byers has started all but one and Frank Phifer has started all but three. Kyle Snyder started the first six games then missed three starts due to injury. He has started every game since then for a total of 14. Brady Sisk has taken Phifer's place in three of the last four games.

Final notes on the Pittsburg State game

- Washburn scored a season-high 79 points and had a season-high 30 made field goals and 17 assists.
- Andrew Meile tied a career-high with five made 3-pointers. He was 5-for-8 from 3-point range.
- Washburn made 10 3-pointers, marking the second consecutive game making 10 or more and just the second game this season doing so.
- Pittsburg State shot 52 percent from the field and became the third team to reach 50 percent against WU.
- The Gorillas won in Lee Arena for just the second time in 24 attempts. WU is 22-2 against PSU in Lee. The last win came 01/30/99.


Bods and Ends

- The Ichabods hold the top two individual rebounding performances this year in the MIAA. Frank Phifer had 18 rebounds at Cameron and Kyle Snyder had 17 in a win at Eastern New Mexico.
- Against Southwest Baptist last week the Ichabods made a season-high 11 3-pointers and took a season-high 71 field goals. Their six blocks tied a season-high.
- Washburn gave up its biggest lead in a loss this year against Southwest Baptist. The Ichabods led by 15 in the first period. The previous largest lead overcome by an opponent was 10 by Fort Hays State on 11/17/06.
- Against FHSU Washburn shot 50 percent or better for the first time since the season finale last year at Central Missouri. The 52 percent shooting was the best in 20 games for the Ichabods.
- The eight turnovers by WU at Truman was a season low and the four turnovers that TSU had was an opponent season low. The 105 points the two combined for was the lowest total in a Washburn game since joining NCAA II in 1989-90.
- Washburn has suffered its two lowest point totals as an NCAA II school this year. The Ichabods scored just 45 at Truman Saturday and the 50 points scored by Washburn at Central Missouri was its previous lowest total since joining DII in 1989-90.
- The Ichabods are 29-23 all-time in overtimes with two wins and one loss this year. Washburn is 6-6 all-time in 12 games that went into at least double-overtime.


