# 2006-07 Washburn Chabods P. 2 Wen's Basketball Game Notes

Bob Chipman Head Coach 1979-80 - Present (28th Season) Kanasas State '73

**At Washburn:** 627-236 (.727) **Overall:** 627-236 (.727)



Bob Chipman, one of college basketball's winningest coaches, is in his 28th season at the helm of the Ichabod basketball program. His first win in 2006-07 will made him the second winningest coach as a member of the MIAA with his 380th win since joining the league.

With the Ichabods' 82-62 win over Southwest Baptist on Jan. 19, 2005 Chipman became the tenth coach in Division II to reach 600 wins. Chipman enters this season ranked fourth in victories and fourth by winning percentage among active NCAA Division II coaches. He is 13th in all-time winning percentage and 9th in all-time Division II victories.

Chipman has guided his teams to 22 20-win seasons, including seven in a row from 1983-84 to 1989-90, and four in a row from 1991-92 to 1994-95 and seven in a row from 1998-99 to 2004-05. Chipman's teams have made 14 national tournament appearances, 10 in the NCAA and four in the NAIA. His teams have averaged 23 wins a year and his 10-16 record last year marked his only losing season in 27 years.

Chipman joined the Washburn staff in 1976 as an assistant to longtime head coach Glenn Cafer. He was promoted to head coach in April 1979 when Cafer was appointed director of athletics. Chipman enjoyed a banner season in 1986-87, capping a 35-4 campaign with an NAIA national championship crown. In addition to the coaching awards obtained after the 1986-87 season, Chipman was named MIAA coach of the year following the 1992, 1993 and 2004 seasons. He was named Kodak district coach of the year by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) in 1993 and the men's four-year coach of the year by the Kansas Basketball Coaches Association (KBCA) in 1994 and 2001. Chipman served a second stint as an assistant coach for the U.S. entry in the Pan American Games during the summer of 1991, earning a bronze medal. In 1983, he was an assistant to the team that won the gold medal. He helped coach the U.S. entry in the World University Games to a gold medal in 1989. In 1985, he was an assistant coach for the Amateur Basketball Association/USA Jones Cup Team that won a silver medal. Chipman holds both bachelor's and master's degrees from Kansas State University.

The 1973 graduate earned two letters as a guard while playing for Wildcat coaching legend Jack Hartman. He played his first two seasons of college ball at Flint Community Junior College, in his hometown of Flint, Mich.

Chipman and his wife, Carol, live in Topeka with their son Bobby. Their daughter Kelsey is a freshman on the Kansas State volleyball

BOLIVAR, Mo. - The Ichabods cut the Southwest Baptist lead to four or less on five different occasions with under five minutes left in the game, but could not get any closer in a 79-72 loss to the Bearcats on the road. The Ichabods cut the Bearcat lead down to two at 70-68 with 2:17 remaining as Brady Sisk scored on a jumper in the paint The Ichabods fell behind quickly in the first half as SBU opened on a 9-2 run and then led 16-7 at 13:39. Washburn then went on an 11-2 run capped by a dunk from Phifer to pull within one, 21-20 at 8:12. SBU quickly regrouped and led 35-24 until Michael Williams hit a 3-pointer to bring WU within eight. In the final seconds it looked like WU would be going into the locker room down by just six when Andrew Meile made a 3 but SBU's Luke Folkerts made a 3 from just beyond half court at the buzzer to give his team a 41-32 halftime lead. # Ichabods go cold in second half in loss at Truman January 13, 2007

KIRKSVILLE, Mo. - The Ichabods scored just 17 second-half points as they lost 60-45 at Truman. Senior forward Frank Phifer led Washburn with 15 points while junior forward Kyle Snyder had a game-high 13 rebounds. No other Ichabod reached double figures as Washburn was held to its lowest point total as an NCAA Division II member. The Ichabods scored the opening points and led four times in the first half. The Bulldogs went ahead with 3:47 remaining in the half on a shot from Andy Calmes and they led 31-28 at halftime. They held the lead the entire second half as Washburn shot just 19 percent. For the game the Ichabods shot a season-low 28 percent (15-of-54) and shot just 56 percent from the free throw line after bringing in a 72 percent season effort from the line. # **About the Truman Bulldogs**

Truman is 13-9 overall and 7-6 in the conference. On the road the Bulldogs are 3-4. They are coming off a 64-50 loss to Northwest Missouri State on Wednesday. Sophomore guard Banks Estridge led his team that night with 18 points and he is third on the team overall with 11.2 points a game. Junior forward Nick Certa is the leading scorer for TSU with 13.5 points a game while Andy Calmes leads the team and MIAA with 9.5 rebounds a game. Overall, the Bulldogs are ninth in the MIAA in scoring, one spot ahead of WU, with 67.9 points a game.

# **Series notes**

- This is the 47th meeting between the two schools with Washburn holding a 30-16 lead in the series.
- Washburn is 16-2 when hosting Truman in Lee Arena and 21-9 in MIAA games vs the Bulldogs.
- Prior to getting swept by the Bulldogs last year, the Ichabods had won 12 straight games against them. Last year was TSU's first sweep over WU since 1998-99.
- Washburn's lowest scoring game as an NCAA II school came against TSU when the Ichabods scored just 45 points against the Bulldogs.
- The two teams have never met in overtime.

# A winning history

- The Ichabods are 1,335-921 (.592 in 2,256 games) and are in their 102nd season of basketball.
- Starting their 23rd season in Lee Arena, the Ichabods are 307-54 (.850). The Ichabods are 4-5 this year at home and they finished the 2005-06 slate 7-6. The Ichabods are 121-23 in Lee Arena since the 1997-98 season.
- In 17 seasons as an NCAA II school, the Ichabods have 10 NCAA tournament appearances and nine MIAA titles. Last year snapped a streak of three straight conference championships.
- Washburn won the 1986-87 NAIA national championship with a 35-4 record under head coach Bob Chipman in his eighth year as coach.
- Washburn was fourth in the nation last year among NCAA II schools in attendance, averaging 2,750 fans a game. WU was the highest ranked MIAA team. As a conference, the MIAA had the second highest attendance with an average of 1,851 fans per game.
- The Ichabods suffered their first losing season last year since 1976-77 and first of head coach Bob Chipman's career. They also failed to advance to the MIAA tournament for the first time since joining the league in 1989-90.

# **Around the world in 80 days**

It may have taken a little longer than 80 days, but when the Ichabods returned home from Southwest Baptist Tuesday night they reached approximately 24,924 miles of travel this year dating back to the summer trip to China. That's about 23 miles longer than the equatorial circumference of the Earth. The Ichabods have spent about 19,644 of those miles on an airplane with flights to Shanghai, Las Vegas and Fort Lauderdale, Fla., and they have spent about 5,280 miles on a bus.

# More free throws equals more wins

All but two of Washburn's games this year have been decided by who makes the most free throws. The Ichabods are 6-1 when making more and 1-14 when making less or equal amounts. Their loss Tuesday at SBU was the first defeat when making more free throws than their opponent. They are 0-9 in conference games when making less. Those numbers are nearly comparable to their record with regards to fouls. When being called for more fouls WU is 2-13 and when getting the whistle to go their way they are 5-2. Washburn's lone win when making less free throws was a 63-47 victory against Barry. WU was also called for more fouls that game.

# **Washburn able to get to the boards**

The Ichabods have been able to out-rebound their opponents this year. The Ichabods are fourth in the MIAA averaging 37.5 a game and they have a +2.6 rebound margin, the fifth best in the conference. They have gotten to the boards more than or as many times as their opponents in 13 of 22 games and are 6-7 when doing so. When they get out-rebounded they have a 1-8 record. Frank Phifer leads Washburn and is eighth in the MIAA with 6.9 rebounds a game.

# **Ichabods near bottom of MIAA offensive stats**

The Ichabods may be last in the conference in scoring at 65.9 points a game, but in the last seven games they have averaged 69.3 points a game. While the Ichabods have been struggling to score, they have been able to keep their opponents' point totals low. The Ichabods are sixth in the conference allowing 70.0 points a game and they have kept their opponents under 70 total points 13 times. Washburn's .420 field goal percentage defense is the fourth lowest in the league.

The Ichabods scored a season-high 79 points in a loss to Pittsburg State at home. They had a season-high 30 field goals. The Ichabods had their lowest and second lowest scoring outputs ever as an NCAA II school this year when they scored 45 at Truman and 50 at Central Missouri.

# **Ichabods strong from the free throw line**

Washburn shot a season-best 14-for-14 from the free throw line at MSSU to put them in fourth in the conference in free throw percentage. In the last four games the Ichabods are 62-of-95 (.653), dropping them to fifth in the conference with a .708 percentage.

The Ichabods have hit 80 percent or better six times this year and were 94 percent (17-of-18) against Emporia State. Frank Phifer is eighth in the MIAA in free throw percentage with a .763 effort.

The Ichabods are shooting .748 from the line in the final five minutes of the game and are .789 (15-for-19) in overtime periods (3 games, 4 periods).

# **Phifer leads team in scoring**

Senior forward Frank Phifer has reached double figures in his last six games and the 20-point mark the last two. In that stretch he is averaging 18.3 points a game and shooting 58 percent.

Phifer has returned to the starting lineup the last two games after coming off the bench in six of the last seven. As a reserve he shoots 57 percent while as a starter he is a 48 percent shooter. Overall he leads the team and is seventh in the MIAA with 15.5 points a game his .502 field goal percentage is eighth best in the league.

Phifer blocked a school-record seven shots against MSSU and moved into third in the MIAA with 1.7 a game. He has blocked a shot in every game but five and has 11 games with multiple blocks. With 37 this year he passed assistant coach Ewan Auguste and moved into sixth on the WU single-season chart. His next block will put him into fifth, tying Rich Hamilton's 1987-88 total of 38.

Phifer has reached double figures in 19 of 22 games and has 20 or more in six games. When he fails to reach 10 or more points WU is 0-3.

Phifer is shooting .763 percent from the free throw line, eighth best in the conference and he leads Washburn with 103 free throws made and 135 attempts. He has made more than one third of Washburn's total free throws.

# Meile turning it up in last five games

Junior guard Andrew Meile reached double figures for the fifth time in six games when he scored 14 at SBU. In that stretch he is averaging 13.0 points a game and shooting 49 percent from the field and 49 percent from 3-point range. Overall he is a 39 percent shooter with a 36 percent mark from 3-point range.

Meile leads the Ichabods with 32 steals and his 1.5 per game is eighth best in the conference. Meile is second on the team with 9.7 points a game overall and leads WU with 41 made 3-pointers. He scored 14 points against FHSU and for the first time this year Washburn won a game when he scored in double figures. The team is 1-12 in such games.

# **Byers third on the team in scoring**

Sophomore forward Paul Byers is third on the team in scoring with 7.2 points a game and second with 5.3 rebounds a game. He leads the team with a .824 free throw percentage and he's shooting 89 percent in MIAA games. Byers has started all but three games this year.

# Sisk seeing time as starter and bench player

Junior forward Brady Sisk has started five of the last nine games. As a starter he is averaging 7.2 points a game and off the bench he is the leading scorer with 108 total points. He came off the bench Tuesday at SBU to score nine points, just missing double-figures for the third time in five games. Overall he is scoring 6.5 a game. Sisk had his second career double-double with 12 points and 12 rebounds against MWSU earlier in the season.

# **Hargett leads team in assists**

Junior guard Grant Hargett had a career-high 18 points against SBU off career highs of three 3-pointers and seven field goals. It was his first game leading the team in scor-

# Williams giving WU senior leadership at guard

Williams was the hero in Washburn's home win over Missouri Western. He hit a 3-pointer in the final minute to put WU up by a point. With just one second left he hit a pull-up jumper inside the free throw line to give WU the win.

# **Ichabods add junior forward from Cloud County CC**

Forward Mamadou Sy joined the Ichabods earlier this month. He is averaging 2.5 points and 3.2 rebounds a game. Sy has started the last two games and Tuesday at SBU he tied his season-high with nine points. He also had nine points with six rebounds at UCM. Sy, a 6-6 native of Paris, France, played guard at Cloud County Community College the previous two years. Sy averaged 6.3 points, 5.1 rebounds and 1.2 assists playing with current Ichabod junior guard Reed Hein both years.

# Hein gives 'Bods 3-point boost off the bench

Junior guard Reed Hein moved into fourth in the conference shooting 43 percent from 3-point range. Hein scored a season-high 12 points last week against MSSU off season-highs of four 3-pointers and 12 field goal attempts, all from 3-point range. He has reached double figures in two of his last four games and in his last seven games he is averaging 7.7 points a game. Overall he is scoring 5.3 points a game while averaging 14.7 minutes. Of the 77 field goals he has attempted, 72 have been 3-pointers. 59 of his 61 field goals attempted in MIAA games have been 3-pointers and he has made 25 of them. Of his last 56 field goal attempts, 54 have been from 3-point range.

# **Snyder out for season after shoulder surgery**

Junior forward Kyle Snyder re-injured his shoulder at Missouri Southern and he will now miss the rest of the season. He finished the season first on the team and fourth in the conference in rebounding with 7.8 a game. Last year he played in six games before having surgery on the shoulder. He received a medical redshirt.

# **Final notes on the Southwest Baptist game**


- Washburn shot 50 percent for the second time this year hitting 25-of-50 shots. The Ichabods set a season-high with a .538 3-point percentage after making 7-of-13 attempts.
- The Ichabods lost for the first time when making more free throws than their opponents. They had been 6-0 coming into the game when making more free throws.
- When the Ichabods returned home from Southwest Baptist Tuesday night they reached approximately 24,924 miles of travel this year dating back to the summer trip to China. That's about 23 miles longer than the equatorial circumference of the Earth.

# **Bods and Ends**

- The Ichabods hold the top two individual rebounding performances this year in the MIAA. Frank Phifer had 18 rebounds at Cameron and Kyle Snyder had 17 in a win at Eastern New Mexico.
- The Ichabods won on the road at MWSU for the second time this year after winning just once away last year. WU is 3-16 on the road in the last two years.
- At MSSU Washburn was 14-for-14 from the free throw line for a 1.000 percentage. The Ichabods' highest free throw total when shooting 1.000 is against Fort Hay State on 02/22/85 when they made 16-of-16.
- Washburn gave up its biggest lead in a loss this year against Southwest Baptist. The Ichabods led by 15 in the first period. The previous largest lead overcome by an opponent was 10 by Fort Hays State on 11/17/06.
- Washburn has suffered its two lowest point totals as an NCAA II school this year. The Ichabods scored just 45 at Truman Saturday and the 50 points scored by Washburn at Central Missouri was its previous lowest total since joining DII in 1989-90.
- The Ichabods are 29-23 all-time in overtimes with two wins and one loss this year. Washburn is 6-6 all-time in 12 games that went into at least double-overtime.


