Afternoon showdown at ESU Saturday a crucial match as Ichabods look to extent season

For the second straight game Washburn will take on one of the top teams in the conference as it tries to dig out of the bottom of the standings and gain a spot in the MIAA Postseason Tournament. The Ichabods head to Emporia State Saturday afternoon for a 1:30 game against the No. 19 Hornets. Washburn (8-16, 4-11 MIAA) fell in double overtime at 18th-ranked Northwest Missouri State Wednesday while ESU (19-4, 10-4 MIAA) dropped its second straight game at home to Pittsburg State.

When the week began Washburn was in a four-way tie for last in the conference. Two of those teams, Fort Hays State and Missouri Western State won this week while WU and Missouri Southern State lost. Washburn has three games remaining, two on the road, to try and gain a spot in the standings. Following the ESU game the Ichabods head to Fort Hays State Wednesday and then host Central Missouri February 24 in the finale.

Fast Facts: This is the 186th meeting between these two schools, making it the most played rivalry for Washburn. Emporia State sits in third in the league and has clinched its spot in the tournament.

Bob Chipman, one of college basketball's winningest coaches, is in his 28th season at the helm of the Ichabod basketball program. His first win in 2006-07 will make him the second winningest coach as a member of the MIAA with his 380th win since joining the league.

With the Ichabods' 82-62 win over Southwest Baptist on Jan. 19, 2005 Chipman became the tenth coach in Division II to reach 600 wins. Chipman enters this season ranked fourth in victories and fourth by winning percentage among active NCAA Division II coaches. He is 13th in all-time winning percentage and 9th in all-time Division II victories.

Chipman has guided his teams to 22 20-win seasons, including seven in a row from 1983-84 to 1989-90, and four in a row from 1991-92 to 1994-95 and seven in a row from 1998-99 to 2004-05. Chipman's teams have made 14 national tournament appearances, 10 in the NCAA and four in the NAIA. His teams have averaged 23 wins a year and his 10-16 record last year marked his only losing season in 27 years.

Chipman joined the Washburn staff in 1976 as an assistant to longtime head coach Glenn Cafer. He was promoted to head coach in April 1979 when Cafer was appointed director of athletics. Chipman enjoyed a banner season in 1986-87, capping a 35-4 campaign with an NAIA national championship crown. In addition to the coaching awards obtained after the 1986-87 season, Chipman was named MIAA coach of the year following the 1992, 1993 and 2004 seasons. He was named Kodak district coach of the year by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) in 1993 and the men's four-year coach of the year by the Kansas Basketball Coaches Association (KBCA) in 1994 and 2001. Chipman served a second stint as an assistant coach for the U.S. entry in the Pan American Games during the summer of 1991, earning a bronze medal. In 1983, he was an assistant to the team that won the gold medal. He helped coach the U.S. entry in the World University Games to a gold medal in 1989. In 1985, he was an assistant coach for the Amateur Basketball Association/USA Jones Cup Team that won a silver medal. Chipman holds both bachelor's and master's degrees from Kansas State University.

The 1973 graduate earned two letters as a guard while playing for Wildcat coaching legend Jack Hartman. He played his first two seasons of college ball at Flint Community Junior College, in his hometown of Flint, Mich.

Chipman and his wife, Carol, live in Topeka with their son Bobby. Their daughter Kelsey is a freshman on the Kansas State volleyball team.

Ichabods lose double overtime heart breaker at No. 18 NWMSU February 14, 2007

MARYVILLE, Mo. – Reed Hein hit a 3-pointer at the end of the first overtime to send the Ichabods into double overtime against Northwest Missouri State but the No. 18 Bearcats held on for an 87-85 win over Washburn Wednesday night. Frank Phifer was 12-of-13 for a season-high 32 points. He was 8-of-11 from the free throw line and shot all but two of Washburn's foul shots. He also pulled in 11 rebounds for his second straight double-double and fifth of the year. It was also his fourth straight game scoring 20 or more points. Hein finished with a season-high 15 points off 5-of-7 shooting from behind the 3-point line. Andrew Meile and Paul Byers reached double figures with 10 points each. The Ichabods had an 11-point lead, 50-39 with 11:00 to go in the second period. Washburn held the lead the rest of regulation until the Bearcats went on a 9-2 run to close the half and tie the game. Washburn made a season-high 32 field goals but shot 14 less free throws than the Bearcats. Northwest made 24-of-27 foul shots while the 'Bods were 10-of-13 from the line. The Bearcats shot just 39 percent but made up the difference by turning the ball over just five times while the Ichabods gave it away 18 times.

In a dramatic finish the No. 19 Hornets fell in White Auditorium to Pittsburg State 91-88. DeAndre Townsend had 29 points as the Hornets could not come not complete a comeback from being down 16 with 8:13 to go in the ball game. The Hornets tied the score at 88 with only 34 seconds remaining, only to see the Gorillas Ed Morris hit a lay-up with 5.4 seconds remaining for the game winner.

Emporia State 80, Washburn 77

Ichabods denied in upset bid over No. 8 Emporia State January 3, 2007

TOPEKA - The Ichabods twice cut away 10-point deficits but for the second straight game they couldn't hold a halftime lead to an unbeaten, top-10 opponent as they lost 80-77 to Emporia State. The 'Bods kept ESU scoreless the final 5:06 of the first half and went on a 12-0 run to take a 36-34 lead into the locker room. Emporia State opened the second half on a 14-2 run to lead 48-38 at the 16:11 mark. The Hornets built their largest lead at 13 points when DeAndre Townsend hit a 3-pointer at 10:19 to make the score 64-51. The Hornets made eight free throws in the final 3:46 and held off another Ichabods surge in the final seconds for the win. Down four at 79-75 with 10 seconds remaining Michael Williams missed a 3. Kyle Snyder got the rebound and was tied up on a jump ball. Keeping the possession, Andrew Meile scored off the inbound pass from Snyder with three seconds remaining to put WU within two. After a Hornet free throw, Hein's 3-pointer at the buzzer was off the mark and ESU held on for the win. The Ichabods shot a season-high 94 percent from the free throw line off a 17-of-18 effort. Paul Byers was a perfect 6-for-6. Williams led WU with a season-high 19 points off 7-of-14 shooting and three 3's. Byers also had a season-high with 17 points.

About the Emporia State Hornets

No. 19 Emporia State has lost two straight games and is 19-4 overall and third in the MIAA at 10-4. Senior guard Donta Watson leads the MIAA with 19.4 points a game and junior guard DeAndre Townsend is fourth in the conference with 17.2 points a game. The Hornets lead the MIAA in scoring offense with 84.9 points a game, 3-point shooting at 41 percent and rebounding at 38.0 a game. Townsend led ESU with 23 points in the game earlier this year against WU.

Series notes

- This is the 186th meeting between the two schools in a series that goes back to 1905-06, WU's first season of play. It is Washburn most played series and WU leads the series 93-92.

- WU is 11-5 against ESU since joining the league in 1989-90 and 22-6 in conference games.

- This is head coach Bob Chipman's 58th matchup against ESU and he holds a 42-15 record against the Hornets.

- ESU swept the Ichabods last year for the first time in the regular season since 1984-85.

- Washburn's last win against ESU was 78-71 on 03/04/05 in the first

round of the MIAA tournament. The last win in White Auditorium was 77-74 on 01/05/05

- Washburn is 2-1 against the Hornets in overtime. The two teams last met in OT on 01/12/00 with WU winning 93-89.

- Since 2002-03 the series is tied 5-5. Seven of those 10 were decided by 10 or less and two were decided by three or less.

A winning history

- The Ichabods are 1,336-922 (.592 in 2,258 games) and are in their 102nd season of basketball.

- Starting their 23rd season in Lee Arena, the Ichabods are 308-54 (.850). The Ichabods are 5-5 this year at home and they finished the 2005-06 slate 7-6. The Ichabods are 122-23 in Lee Arena since the 1997-98 season.

- In 17 seasons as an NCAA II school, the Ichabods have 10 NCAA tournament appearances and nine MIAA titles. Last year snapped a streak of three straight conference championships.

- Washburn won the 1986-87 NAIA national championship with a 35-4 record under head coach Bob Chipman in his eighth year as coach.

- Washburn was fourth in the nation last year among NCAA II schools in attendance, averaging 2,750 fans a game. WU was the highest ranked MIAA team. As a conference, the MIAA had the second highest attendance with an average of 1,851 fans per game.

- The Ichabods suffered their first losing season last year since 1976-77 and first of head coach Bob Chipman's career. They also failed to

More free throws equals more wins

All but two of Washburn's games this year have been decided by who makes the most free throws. The Ichabods are 7-1 when making more and 1-15 when making less or equal amounts. Their loss at SBU was the first defeat when making more free throws than their opponent. They are 0-10 in conference games when making less. Those numbers are nearly comparable to their record with regards to fouls. When being called for more fouls WU is 2-14 and when getting the whistle to go their way they are 6-2. Washburn's lone win when making less free throws was a 63-47 victory against Barry. WU was also called for more fouls that game.

Washburn able to get to the boards

The Ichabods have been able to out-rebound their opponents this year. They are currently fifth in the MIAA in rebounding averaging 37.7 a game and they have a +3.1 rebound margin, the fifth best in the conference. They have gotten to the boards more than or as many times as their opponents in 15 of 24 games and are 7-8 when doing so. When they get out-rebounded they have a 1-8 record. Frank Phiher leads Washburn and is sixth in the MIAA with 7.2 rebounds a game.

Ichabods near bottom of MIAA offensive stats

The Ichabods may be last in the conference in scoring at 66.8 points a game, but in the last eight games they have averaged 71.1 points a game. While the Ichabods have been struggling to score, they have been able to keep their opponents' point totals low. The Ichabods are sixth in the conference allowing 70.2 points a game and they have kept their opponents under 70 total points 14 times. Washburn's .417 field goal percentage defense is the fourth lowest in the league.

The Ichabods scored a season-high 85 points at Northwest Missouri State in a double overtime loss. They had a season-high 32 field goals. The Ichabods had their lowest and second lowest scoring outputs ever as an NCAA II school this year when they scored 45 at Truman and 50 at Central Missouri.

Ichabods strong from the free throw line

Washburn is fourth in the conference with a .714 free throw percentage. The Ichabods have hit 80 percent or better seven times this year and were 94 percent (17-of-18) against Emporia State. Frank Phiher is eighth in the MIAA in free throw percentage with a .757 effort.

The Ichabods are shooting .762 from the line in the final five minutes of the game and are .833 (25-of-30) in overtime periods (5 games, 7 periods).

Phiher leads team in scoring

Senior forward Frank Phiher has reached double figures in his last eight games and the 20-point mark the last four. He scored a team, season-high 32 points Wednesday at Northwest Missouri State and had his second straight double-double and fifth of the season with 11 rebounds. He had his fourth double-double of the year with 24 points and 14 rebounds against Truman last week. In the last eight games he is averaging 20.8 points per game and shooting 63 percent (62-of-98).

Phiher has returned to the starting lineup the last four games after coming off the bench in six of the previous seven. As a reserve he shoots 57 percent while as

a starter he is a 52 percent shooter. Overall he leads the team and is sixth in the MIAA with 16.5 points a game and his .530 field goal percentage is sixth best in the league.

Phifer blocked a school-record seven shots against MSSU and moved is third in the MIAA with 1.6 a game. He has blocked a shot in every game but six and has 12 games with multiple blocks. With 39 this year he has the fifth highest single-season total at Washburn. He is three away from tying for fourth in school history with Clarence Tyson's 42 set in 1993-94.

Phifer has reached double figures in 21 of 24 games and has 20 or more in eight games. When he fails to reach 10 or more points WU is 0-3.

Phifer is shooting 76 percent from the free throw line, eighth best in the conference and he leads Washburn with 115 free throws made and 152 attempts. He has made more than one third of Washburn's total free throws.

Meile turning it up down the stretch

Junior guard Andrew Meile has reached double figures six times in the last eight games. In that stretch he is averaging 11.9 points a game and shooting 45 percent from the field and 42 percent from 3-point range. Overall he is a 38 percent shooter with a 35 percent mark from 3-point range.

Meile leads the Ichabods with 33 steals and his 1.4 per game is tied for eighth best in the conference. Meile is second on the team with 9.6 points a game overall and leads WU with 44 made 3-pointers. He scored 14 points against FHSU and for the first time this year Washburn won a game when he scored in double figures. The team is 1-13 in such games.

Byers third on the team in scoring

Sophomore forward Paul Byers is third on the team in scoring with 7.2 points a game and second with 5.4 rebounds a game. He leads the team with a .824 free throw percentage and he's shooting 89 percent in MIAA games. He scored 10 points Wednesday at NWMSU to reach double figures for the first time in 12 games.

Sisk seeing time as starter and bench player

Junior forward Brady Sisk has started five games this year but has come off the bench in the last four. As a starter he is averaging 7.2 points a game and off the bench he is the leading scorer with 122 total points. Overall he is scoring 6.6 a game, fourth best on the team. Sisk had his second career double-double with 12 points and 12 rebounds against MWSU earlier in the season.

Hargett leads team in assists

Junior guard Grant Hargett had a career-high 18 points against SBU off career highs of three 3-pointers and seven

Hein gives 'Bods 3-point boost off the bench

- The Ichabods won on the road at MWSU for the second time this year after winning just once away last year. WU is 3-16 on the road in the last two years.
- At MSSU Washburn was 14-for-14 from the free throw line for a 1.000 percentage. The Ichabods' highest free throw total when shooting 1.000 is against Fort Hay State on 02/22/85 when they made 16-of-16.
- Washburn gave up its biggest lead in a loss this year against Southwest Baptist. The Ichabods led by 15 in the first period. The previous largest lead overcome by an opponent was 10 by Fort Hays State on 11/17/06.
- Washburn has suffered its two lowest point totals as an NCAA II school this year. The Ichabods scored just 45 at Truman Saturday and the 50 points scored by Washburn at Central Missouri was its previous lowest total since joining DII in 1989-90.
