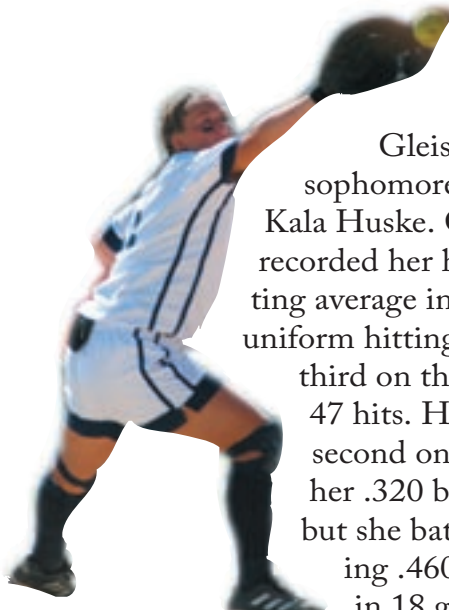

2004 In Review

The Washburn Lady Blues finished the 2004 season with an overall 32-25 mark and a 8-10 record in the MIAA qualifying for the postseason MIAA Tournament for the 14th straight time. The Lady Blues have qualified for the tournament every season they have been in the MIAA.

Postseason honors

The Lady Blues had two picked for the Second Team all-MIAA squad in senior outfielder Molly Gleisberg and



sophomore utility player Kala Huske. Gleisberg recorded her highest batting average in a Washburn uniform hitting .305 finishing third on the team with a 47 hits. Huske finished second on the team with her .320 batting average, but she batted a scorching .460 with 23 hits in 18 games.

The Lady Blues also had four placed on the all-MIAA Honorable Mention team in senior first baseman Dara Clouse and third baseman Katie Schmidt. Freshman outfielder Asheyy Webb and freshman pitcher Joanne Flucker were also tabbed for the team.

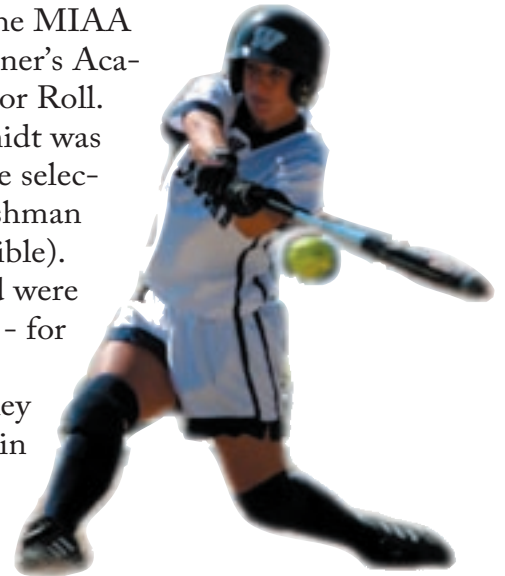
Clouse finished her career as a four-time all-MIAA honoree and Schmidt was picked for conference honors three times.

• Senior first basemen and 2004 Most Valuable Player Dara Clouse finished her career as one of the all-time leaders in Lady Blues history.

She finished her career No. 6 on the all-time hit chart with 201, No. 4 on the doubles chart with 40, No. 5 on the RBI chart with 118, No. 6 on the runs scored chart with 96 and No. 9 in all-time batting average with a .318 clip. She is also the all-time leader in total putouts (1,489) and fielding percentage (.996)

• Senior third basemen Katie Schmidt finished No. 10 on the all-time hit list with 139, tied for fourth on the home run chart with 21, No. 7 in RBI with 105. Her 65 bases on balls is also a school record.

Schmidt also became Washburn's all-time career assist leader with 382.

• Senior outfielder Molly Gleisberg finished her career at No. 11 on the all-time hit list with 137.
