2005 Season Review

The 2005 Washburn Lady Blues season ran to every end of the spectrum as the Lady Blues had both highs and lows finishing the campaign with a 30-26 overall record.

Washburn started the season like a ball of fire winning its first seven games winning the Angelo State Tournament the first weekend of the season while going 4-2 at the St. Cloud State Tournament in Minnesota starting the season 8-2.

From Minnesota, the Lady Blues traveled to St. Joseph, Mo., for the Missouri Western Tournament and struggled going 1-4 with the lone win over Nebraska-Omaha. However, the win over the Mavericks jump started the Lady Blues' motors as the next weekend at the Missouri Southern Invitational, the Lady Blues returned to their winning ways going 4-1 and were named tournament champions.

In their home opener on March 14 against Fort Hays State, the Lady Blues swept the Tigers winning game one 8-0. The fans who were in attendance saw some Washburn history as Erin Pierce tossed only the sixth no-hitter in Lady Blues history. In game two, Pierce did not strike anyone out, but retired 13 of the 21 batters faced with ground outs. It was a pitcher's duel as the Tigers and the Lady Blues picked up only one hit – a fifth inning home run by senior Jackie Sells that gave Washburn the winning run.

The Lady Blues opened MIAA play with Missouri-Rolla and were swept at home before evening out their MIAA record with a sweep of their own over Southwest Baptist in a pair of shutouts tossed by Erin Bryan and Pierce. The Lady Blues continued their home stand with a doubleheader sweep over Bemidji State before wrapping it up with a split with Missouri Southern. In the second game against the Lions, the Lady Blues set a new school record with three home runs in the fifth inning while scoring six runs to rally from five-run deficit.

At the Nebraska-Omaha tournament, the Lady Blues went 4-1 lifting their record to 24-11 on the season and reaching No. 23 in the national poll – the first time since the 2002 season Washburn received any poll votes. However, three days later, despite going 6-2 the Lady Blues fell to No. 25 in the national rankings.

After being swept at Fort Hays State, the Lady Blues would drop two of their next 13 games, including an eight-game slide that would tie a school record for the most consecutive losses.

The Lady Blues missed out on the MIAA playoffs for the first time in 14 years after splitting a heartbreaking doubleheader with Northwest Missouri. The Lady Blues needed to sweep the twinbill and won the first game 6-2. In the second game, the Lady Blues rallied to score three runs in the top of the sixth to take a 3-2 lead. After the Bearcats scored once in the bottom of the inning, the Lady Blues scored two more in the top of the seventh to take a 5-4 lead. The Bearcats tied it in the bottom of the seventh to force extra innings. Brooke DeVader led off the eighth with a home run, but it was not enough as the Bearcats scored two unearned runs in the bottom of the eighth for the win ending, the Lady Blues season with a 30-26 record.

Postseason Honors

The Lady Blues placed two on the all-MIAA first team in catcher Kala Huske and outfielder Ashley Webb. Huske led the Lady Blues with a .343 batting average and her 29 RBI tied for the team lead. Webb batted .316 on the season while batting .400 dur-

ing MIAA play to earn all-conference honors. Huske went on to NFCA first team all-region honors as well.

First baseman Brooke DeVader received second team all-MIAA honors after leading the Lady Blues with seven home runs. DeVader finished second on the team with 54 hits and 22 RBI. DeVader was equally as impressive in the classroom as she earned MIAA all-academic team honors with a GPA better than 3.5 with her second team honors.

Amanda Carey, Jackie Sells and Mandy Tarbuton each earned honorable mention all-MIAA honors.

Sells, the only senior on the team was named the Lady Blues most valuable player as she played three different positions during the season.

Webb Gems

Against Northwest Missouri on May 3, Ashley Webb became the 14th Lady Blue to hit two home runs in a single game. Against Nebraska-Omaha on March 6, her triple in the top of the seventh drove in the winning run in a 2-0 win over the Mavericks.

The Pierce is Right

The no-hitter Erin Pierce tossed against Fort Hays State on March 15 was the sixth in Lady Blues history, but she was only the fourth Washburn pitcher to accomplish the feat. Rhonda Rouck tossed two no-no's in 1990 and Shannon Rhodes pitched two no-hitters in 1993. Ashley Perkins pitched the fifth one against Central Missouri in 2003.

Huske's Long Season at the Plate

On top of leading or sharing the team lead this season for the Lady Blues in batting average, slugging percentage, hits, triples and RBI, catcher Kala Huske caught every game behind the plate for the Lady Blues. She also had a team-high .996 fielding percentage with 207 putouts, 39 assists and only one error.

Lady Blues working overtime

The Lady Blues had six games go extra innings this season with three of them going nine innings and the other three going eight innings. Washburn was 3-3 in extra inning contests in 2005.

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The Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, a 10-member conference of NCAA Division II institutions in Missouri and Kansas, was first organized in 1912 as the Missouri Intercollegiate Athletic Association.

Over the past 15 years, the league has undergone several changes, highlighted by expansion and increased participation in national championships.

The MIAA has gained the reputation of being one of the top NCAA Division II conferences in the nation. MIAA student-athletes have won 11 national championships and more than 100 individual national titles.

The MIAA currently conducts conference championships in eight men's and

eight women's sports. Men's champions are crowned in football, cross country, basketball, indoor and outdoor track and field, baseball, tennis, and golf. Women's champions are determined in volleyball, cross country, soccer, basketball, indoor and outdoor track and field, softball and tennis.

Ralph McFillen was named to succeed Ken B. Jones as commissioner of the MIAA in January 1997, and took over in July of that year. He formerly served as commissioner of the Metro and Gulf South conferences. Matt Newbery, formerly an assistant sports information director at Pittsburg State University, joined the conference in July 1994 as director of sports information.
