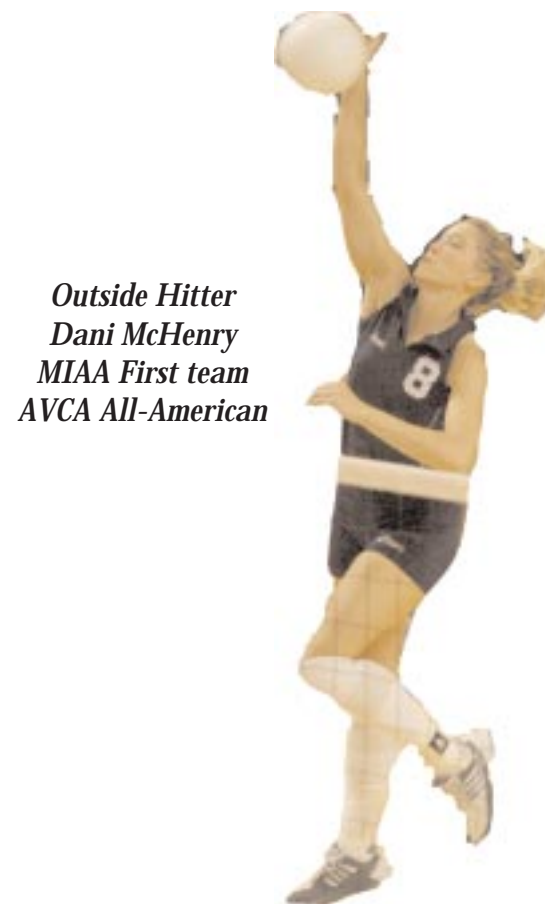

CAMP DETAILS

July 7-9 • 9 a.m.-12 p.m.

Libero/D.S. Camp (Grades 9-12) \$85

This camp is designed for those players who wish to work on defensive skills, serve and serve reception skills. This camp is intense. It is recommended for high level players only. Enrollment is limited to 25 campers.

July 7-9 • 1-4 p.m.

Setter/Hitter Camp (Grades 9-12) \$85

An hour and a half each day will be spent on position specific training. This will be followed by an hour and a half of setters and hitters being brought together to perform combination drills. This camp is recommended for higher level players. The camp is limited to 25 setters and 40 hitters.

July 18-20 9 a.m.-12 p.m.

General Skills Camp (Grades 5-8) \$80

Skill Camp covers all individual volleyball skills to make a complete player. Camp enrollment is limited to 40 campers.

Players and parents are encouraged to enroll early. Last year's camp enrollment exceeded the number we are allowing this year. No additional campers will be accepted beyond the limit set for each camp.

Location: Air-conditioned Lee Arena is located on the east side of the Washburn University campus in the Petro Allied Health Center of 19th and Washburn. Lee Arena, which is host to several summer camps, is among the elite in NCAA Division II

Washburn volleyball reaching new heights under coach Chris Herron



Head coach Chris Herron is heading into his third season at the helm of the Lady Blue volleyball program after compiling a 55-15 record the past two seasons.

Herron has an overall 130-44 record in five seasons of coaching in college. He spent three seasons at Benedictine College from 1999-2001. Herron also coached 15 seasons in high school and compiled a 387-105 record.

Herron led Washburn to its first-ever MIAA title and NCAA Division II postseason appearance in his first year in 2002 with a 29-5 record. For his efforts he was named MIAA Coach of the Year. He was named head coach at Washburn March 25, 2002.

Herron is in his third year conducting camps at Washburn and coaches numerous years at a variety of other top camps.
