# CAMP DETAILS

## Libero/Defensive Specialist Camp

**July 9-11 • 9 a.m.-12 p.m. • Grades 10-12 • \$85**

This camp is designed for those players who wish to work on defensive skills, serve and serve reception skills. This camp is intense. It is recommended for high level players only. Enrollment is limited to 40 campers.

## Middle Hitter Camp

**July 9-11 • 2-5 p.m. • Grades 9-12 • \$85**

An hour and a half each day will be spent on position specific training. This will be followed by an hour and a half of combination drills. This camp is recommended for higher level players. The camp is limited to 30 campers.

## Outside Hitter Camp (LS/RS)

**July 12-14 • 9 a.m.-12 p.m. • Grades 9-12 • \$85**

An hour and a half each day will be spent on position specific training. This will be followed by an hour and a half of combination drills. This camp is recommended for higher level players. The camp is limited to 30 campers.

## Setter Camp

**July 12-14 • 1-3:30 p.m. • Grades 9-12 • \$85**

This camp will have two groups. Only 10 players will be accepted for each group. Experienced setters will be grouped with coach Herron and trained in advanced fashion. Less experienced setters will be grouped with coach Jones and trained with more fundamental techniques.

## General Skills Camp

**July 16-18 • 9-11:30 a.m. • Grades 5-6 • \$85**

Skill Camp covers all individual volleyball skills to make a complete player. Camp enrollment is limited to 30 campers.

**July 16-18 • 1-4 p.m. • Grades 7-9 • \$85**

Skill Camp covers all individual volleyball skills to make a complete player. Camp enrollment is limited to 60 campers.

**Players and parents are encouraged to enroll early. Last year's camp enrollment exceeded the number we are allowing this year. No additional campers will be accepted beyond the limit set for each camp. Please enroll early to ensure a place in the camp.**

# COACHING STAFF

## Chris Herron • Head Coach • Six Seasons



Chris Herron is heading into his sixth season at the helm of the Lady Blues volleyball program after compiling a 146-34 record the past five seasons.

Herron has an overall 225-63 record in eight seasons of coaching in college. He spent three seasons at Benedictine College from 1999-2001. Herron also coached 15 seasons in high school and compiled a 387-105 record.

Herron helped lead the Lady Blues to their fourth NCAA tournament last year as Washburn finished with a 27-9 record and an MIAA West Division championship.

He led Washburn to its second MIAA title 2005 and was named MIAA Coach of the Year. He was named head coach at Washburn March 25, 2002.

Herron is in his fifth year conducting camps at Washburn and has coached numerous years at a variety of other top camps.



## Trent Jones • Assistant Coach • Three Seasons



Trent Jones is heading into his fourth season as an assistant coach for the Lady Blues after spending two seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Kansas.

Jones played collegiately for NAIA national champion Columbia College and at Graceland.
