## Coaching Staff



**Head Coach  
Ron McHenry**

Since his appointment as head coach prior to the 2000-01 season, Ron McHenry has quickly returned the Washburn women's basketball program to national prominence.

McHenry has posted a 188-37 (.838) record overall and 98-26 (.782) record in the MIAA with four MIAA regular season championships and the 2005 NCAA National Championship. He was named the Lady Blues head coach prior to the 2000-01 season. He is third among active women's NCAA Division II coaches in winning percentage and has the 10th most wins in MIAA history. McHenry was named the MIAA's Coach of the Year in 2005 and in 2006 and the Division II Bulletin National Coach of the Year in 2005.

Prior to his new appointment, McHenry spent the previous 11 seasons as a member of the men's basketball coaching staff under current coach Bob Chipman. While on the Washburn bench, he was a part of 243 wins. In addition to his basketball duties, McHenry was the men's golf coach for eight seasons.

He graduated from Washburn with a bachelor's degree in communications and went on to earn a master's degree in sports administration from Wichita State University in 1987.

McHenry and his wife, Mischa, have three children, Danielle, Samantha and Ronnie.

Dustin Odum will be entering his fifth season as an assistant coach for the Lady Blues, after serving one season as the head girls coach Wamego High School in 2001-02.

Odum was elevated to the top assistant post in June of 2003 and is in charge of recruiting, scheduling, conditioning and video operations. He is also handles summer camps and leagues and assists with recruiting and on-court coaching for the Lady Blues.

He is a native of Seneca, Kan., where he graduated from Nemaha Valley High in 1994.
