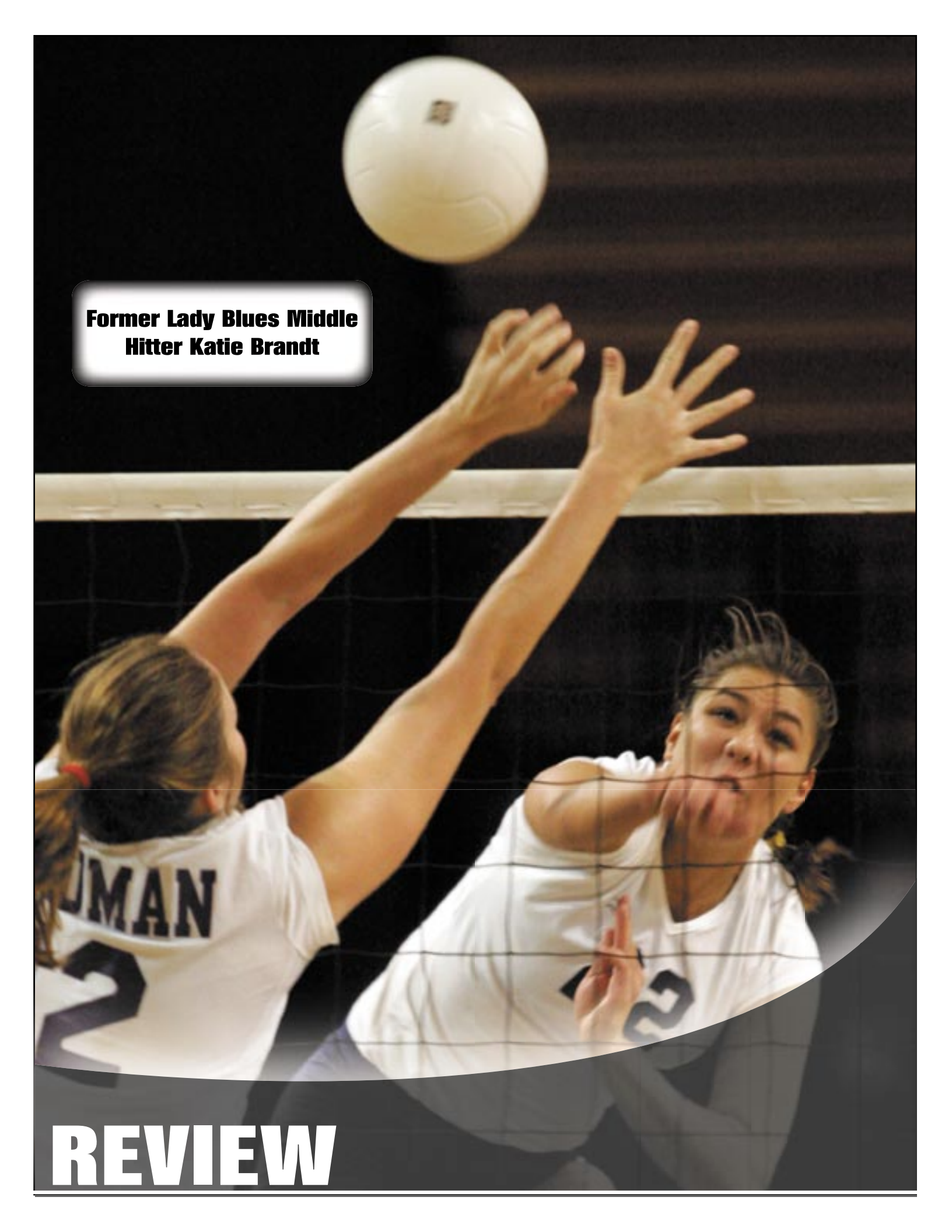




**Former Lady Blues Middle
Hitter Katie Brandt**

REVIEW

The Washburn Lady Blues shattered many team records en route to a 29-7 record and second appearance into the NCAA Division II National Tournament in 2004.

The Lady Blues opened the season by sweeping through competition at three tournaments and the first two matches of the conference season to set a school record with a 14-0 mark.

Washburn beat Cameron and Regis 3-1 in the first day of the Rockhurst Invitational before sweeping Northwest Missouri State and Texas Woman's University 3-0 the second day. Katie Brandt and Emily Foster were named to the all-tournament team.

The Lady Blues followed with another four wins at the Central Arkansas Invitational Sept. 3-4. The Lady Blues swept Southern Arkansas, Alabama-Huntsville and West Alabama before beating host Central Arkansas 3-1. Brandt and Foster were named to the all tournament team again. Julie Sackman was also named to the all-tournament team and was named MIAA Specialist of the Week.

After a win over William Woods in the home opener on Sept. 7, Washburn cruised through the West Florida Invitational.

Washburn swept Ouachita Baptist and Albany State and topped host West Florida 3-1 in the Invitational. Katie Brandt had 50 kills in the three matches with a .413 hitting percentage to be named the Most Valuable Player of the Invitational. She was also named MIAA Hitter of the Week. Wendy Kobbeman and Dani McHenry were named to the all-tournament team, while Julie Sackman was named MIAA Specialist of the Week for the second straight week.

The Lady Blues followed with wins over Missouri Western 3-0 and at Northwest Missouri State 3-2 to improve to 14-0 to begin the season. The Lady Blues suffered their first loss at No. 3 Truman State 3-1 on Sept. 18.

Washburn setter Julie Sackman suffered a stress fracture injury to her foot that sidelined her for about a month during the MIAA season.

Backup Ashley Smith stepped in and led Washburn to three straight wins over Missouri Southern, Southwest Baptist and No. 18 Pittsburg State. Smith was named MIAA Specialist of the Week for her performance.

The Lady Blues fell at No. 9 Central Missouri State 3-0 on Sept. 28 despite a career-high 24 kills by Emily Foster. Foster followed with 14 kills in a 3-0 sweep over Emporia State the following match. She finished the week with 38 kills and hit .432 to earn MIAA Hitter of the Week and AVCA Division II National Player of the Week honors.

The Lady Blues picked up their second win over a nationally-ranked team with 3-2 comeback win over No. 22 Rockhurst in Lee Arena Oct. 7. The Lady Blues fell behind 13-9 in the fifth game before winning 16-14. Dani McHenry led the way with 25 kills.

McHenry later earned MIAA Hitter of the Week honors with a 28-kill performance at Pittsburg State Oct. 23.

The Lady Blues topped No. 7 Central Missouri State 3-2 in Lee Arena Oct. 26 in front of a regular season-record 985 fans.

The Lady Blues finished the regular season with a 27-5 record and a school-record No. 15 AVCA ranking.

Washburn got its first-ever win in NCAA Tournament play with a 3-1 win over Harding Nov. 18 in the South Central Regional quarterfinals in Kirksville, Mo. The Lady Blues followed with a 3-0 loss to CMSU to finish the season 29-7.

Katie Brandt had 30 kills in the two matches to earn All-South Central Regional Tournament honors. The Lady Blues finished the season with a No. 16 ranking in the AVCA National Poll, which was the best finish in school history.

Dani McHenry, who became the first Lady Blue in school history to earn AVCA All-American honors as a junior in 2003, earned third team All-American honors as a junior.

McHenry broke her own record for kills per game with 4.36 kills per game and finished with 534 kills.

McHenry was joined on the AVCA All-South Central Region team by Emily Foster and Katie Brandt.

McHenry and Foster were first team All-MIAA picks, while Brandt was named to the second team. Wendy Kobbeman and Julie Sackman were named to the honorable mention team.

McHenry, Foster and Valerie Peterson were named to the MIAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll.

The Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, a nine-member conference of NCAA Division II institutions in Missouri and Kansas, was first organized in 1912 as the Missouri Intercollegiate Athletic Association.

Over the past 20 years, the league has undergone several changes, highlighted by increased participation in national championships.

The MIAA has gained the reputation of being one of the top NCAA Division II conferences in the nation. MIAA student-athletes have won 13 national team championships and 141 individual national titles.

The MIAA currently conducts conference championships in eight men's and eight women's sports. Men's championships include football, cross country, basket-

ball, indoor and outdoor track and field, baseball, tennis, and golf. Women's champions are determined in volleyball, soccer, cross country, basketball, indoor and outdoor track and field, softball and tennis.

Ralph McFillen, formerly of the Metro and Gulf South conferences, succeeded Ken B. Jones as commissioner of the MIAA in July 1997.

Matt Newbery, previously the assistant sports information director at Pittsburg State University, is the assistant to the commissioner for media relations and in his 12th year with the MIAA.

Natasha Oakes, a former All-MIAA track performer at Emporia State University, was added as the third full-time staffer in July 2005 as the assistant to the commissioner for compliance.
