



Dani McHenry became the first AVCA All-American in Washburn history when she earned honorable mention honors in 2003. The next year she was named a third-team selection. McHenry played three years at Washburn after transferring from Kansas. During her tenure she had 1,491 kills to put her fourth all-time at WU.

While at Washburn she helped lead the Lady Blues to their first NCAA tournament appearance in 2002 and they repeated that in 2004, advancing to the second round. To go with her All-American honors, McHenry also earned first-team all-region recognition twice and three first-team all-MIAA honors.

McHenry's numbers were consistently strong during her three years with the Lady Blues. She had at least 20 double-doubles every year and after having 23 double-figure kill matches her first year she had over 30 each of her last two years. She also had close to 30 double-figure dig matches every year at WU. Her 558

kills her junior year was the second highest season total in Washburn history and her 534 her senior year was the third highest. She also is first all-time in career kills per game with 4.01 and she holds the top two single-season records in that category. McHenry is third all-time at Washburn with a .278 career attack percentage and her .340 mark in 2003 was the second highest total. She is also fourth all-time with 1757.0 points in her three years.

McHenry had a career-high 28 kills at Pittsburg State her senior year. She hit .348 that match and added 14 digs for a double-double. That kill total is the highest at WU since at least 1998 and she holds the top three single-match kill records since rally scoring began in 2001.


In the 2004 first round NCAA tournament match against Harding McHenry had 18 kills and hit .372 as the Lady Blues won their first NCAA tournament match. That kill total is the highest for a Lady Blue in

the NCAA tournament.

"Dani may not rank as the best player I've ever coached in terms of athleticism, but her work ethic made her the easiest one to coach," said head coach Chris Herron. "Almost every phase of her game was good. She could swing hard, block and she had great ball control. She knew when she needed to improve something and she worked hard to get better. She definitely had the best work ethic of anyone I've ever coached."

McHenry also played basketball under her father, head coach Ron McHenry, for four years. When she ended that career after the 2005-06 season, she helped the Lady Blues to a national championship and four MIAA titles.

She will join the WU volleyball coaching staff as a graduate assistant in 2006 as she works towards her master's degree. She earned her bachelor's degree in business at Washburn in the fall of 2005.

## The History of Washburn Volleyball

### 1969

Coach Janet Nuzman fielded the first Lady Blues volleyball team. The team, made up of 10 women from Kansas and one from Iran, finished the year 3-9. Washburn competed in the Association of Kansas Women's Intercollegiate Sports (AKWIS) the first two years along with Kansas State, Kansas, Kansas State Teacher's College (Emporia State), Fort Hays State and Mt. St. Scholastica.

### 1971

The Lady Blues switched to the newly-formed Eastern Kansas State Intercollegiate Volleyball League (EKSIVL) with Benedictine, Kansas, Kansas State Teacher's College and Kansas State.

### 1972

Washburn once again switched affiliations and played in the Kansas Association of Intercollegiate Athletics for Women (KAIAW). Benedictine, Fort Hays State, Marymount, Ottawa, Newman and Pittsburg State also played in the league.

### 1976

Still belonging to the KAIAW, Washburn now joined the Central States Intercollegiate Conference (CSIC) and remained in it until jumping to NCAA II and the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association in 1990. Kearney State (Nebraska-Kearney), Pittsburg State, Missouri Western State, Emporia State, Missouri Southern State, Wayne State (Neb.) and Fort Hays State were also CSIC members. During their first year in the conference, Carol Williams was named to the all-CSIC second team and Tina Martin and Mary Vaughn earned honorable mention.

### 1978

Washburn finished first in the KAIAW Small College Playoffs and went on to a fifth-place finish in the AIAW Region 6 tournament. WU was 23-19 overall and finished fifth in the CSIC at 7-7. Carol Williams earned her second straight all-CSIC first team award.

### 1980

The first volleyball scholarships were awarded and Nuzman had \$1,500 dollars to divide between the 15 players on her squad.

### 1981

Despite finishing the year 12-32 with a 1-13 CSIC record, the Lady Blues once again won the KAIAW Small College State Playoffs and advanced to the AIAW Region 6 tournament.

### 1984

Now under the direction of coach Linda Moley, who started in 1982, this Lady Blues team posted the best winning percentage to date at .711 (42-17). Sharon Lord and Sally Tracy were both named first-team all-district while Lord was further honored as second-team all-CSIC.

### 1985

The Lady Blues set a school record for wins in a season with 45. That record still stands today. Tami Dall sweeps first-team honors at the district and conference level. Vicki Jarnagin repeats as both first-team all-district and second-team all-conference.



### 1986

Now playing in the NAIA, the Lady Blues won their first-ever NAIA District 10 championship as Linda Moley was named district coach of the year. Washburn finished 42-25 after losing a bi-district championship match to Southern Nazarene. Marilee Baumchen and Vicki Jarnagin were both named first-team all-district while Baumchen was further honored as first-team all-CSIC. Jarnagin was a second-team all-CSIC pick. The 42 wins tied for second most wins in a season.

### 1988

Along with second-year coach Kelly Stauffer-Osburn, Washburn plays host to the 20-team NAIA national volleyball tournament in Lee Arena.

### 1990


Washburn enters its first MIAA postseason tournament as the fifth-seeded team. Shanna Haslett becomes the first Washburn player named first-team all-MIAA while Susan Waller is a second-team pick.

### 1993

The Lady Blues proved to be one of the best defensive teams in not only the MIAA, but also NCAA Division II. Washburn led the MIAA in digs per game (21.53) while also finishing first in that category in NCAA Division II national stats compiled by the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA).


### 1997

First year head coach Allison Jones led the Lady Blues to a second straight winning season and the highest ever finish in the MIAA (fourth).






