Ron McHenry starts a new chapter in Washburn basketball as he takes over the reigns of the Lady Blues.

McHenry was named the head coach on May 8, 2000, taking over for Patty Dick, who retired in April.

McHenry spent the previous 11 seasons as a member of the men's basketball coaching staff under current coach Bob Chipman. While on the Washburn bench, he was a part of 243 wins. In addition to his basketball duties, McHenry was the men's golf coach for eight seasons.

McHenry has had a diverse coaching career. He began his career as a graduate assistant to Chipman during the 1984-85 season. He then went on to Perry High School in 1986 where he served as assistant boys coach.

McHenry quickly moved up the coaching ranks in 1988 when he assumed an assistant's position with the Topeka Sizzlers of the Continental Basketball Association. McHenry eventually became the Sizzlers' interim head coach before joining the Washburn staff for the 1989-90 campaign. During his first year on the

Washburn staff, McHenry was the department's academic adviser.

McHenry played for Washburn after stints at Coffeyville Community College and the University of



Kansas. He started for the Ichabods during the 1983-84 season.

He graduated from Washburn with a bachelor's degree in communications and went on to earn a master's degree in sports administration from Wichita State University in 1987.

McHenry, who will be 39 Jan. 21, and his wife, Mischa, live in Topeka with their children, Danielle, Samantha and Ronnie.

Former Ichabod Reggie Hulbert has been named as Ron McHenry's assistant coach for the Washburn Lady Blues basketball team. Hulbert was a two-year member of the Ichabods basketball team during the 1990-91 and 1991-92 seasons.

His senior year he started 32 games earning second team all-MIAA honors and the team's most valuable player award.

Hulbert spent the past season guiding Cair Paravel High School in Topeka. He compiled a 22-3 record in one season as their head coach.

McHenry coached Hulbert in each of his two seasons at Washburn after transferring from Western Nebraska Community College.

Hulbert duties include recruiting, scouting and scheduling of games.

Kristen Crosby joins the Lady Blues coaching staff after one season as a Lady Blue. Crosby was second on the squad in scoring with 13.2 points per game and 4.7 rebounds per game. She received honorable mention all-MIAA honors.

Crosby transferred from the University of Missouri-Kansas City following her junior season. She averaged 5.5 points and three rebounds a game at UMKC last season after transferring from Barton County Community College.

She played two seasons at Barton County from 1996-1998, garnering first team all-West Jayhawk Conference honors both her freshman and sophomore years. In 1996-97 she was named conference freshman of the year, averaging 12.6 and six rebounds a game.

Her sophomore year she was named conference player of the year, second team all-region and was a Kodak honorable mention all-American, averaging 19.6 points and grabbing 7.9 rebounds a game.

She graduated from Larned High School in 1996 where she earned all-state honors and par-

ticipated in the KBCA All-Star game. She is engaged to former Ichabod baseball player Brad Madden.
