✓ **LADY BLUES LOOKING FOR FIFTH STRAIGHT WIN:** The No. 10 Washburn Lady Blues take a four-game winning streak into their 5:30 p.m. game with Missouri Western Saturday night. The Lady Blues are 16-2 and 7-2 in MIAA play after a 75-66 win at Pittsburg State Wednesday night. Missouri Western is 13-5 and 5-4 in the MIAA after a 71-56 loss at home to Emporia State Wednesday night.

Washburn is 27-35 all-time against the Griffons but won the last three meetings in the series. Washburn topped Missouri Western 68-53 in St. Joseph, Mo. Dec. 30, 2003 to open the MIAA slate. Washburn has lost the last four meetings against the Griffons in Lee Arena. The Griffons have handed Washburn its only home loss the past two seasons, including a 60-56 win in Lee Arena Jan. 29, 2003.

The Lady Blues are 43-20 in MIAA play under Ron McHenry, including a 36-9 record the past three seasons.

✓ **COACHES:** Since his appointment as the women's head coach prior to the 2000-01 season, **Ron McHenry** has quickly returned the Washburn women's basketball program to national prominence.

In only his third season in 2002-03, McHenry guided the Lady Blues to a regular season MIAA title, a Sonic/MIAA Tournament championship and a berth to the Division II Elite Eight. For his efforts he was named South Central Region Coach of the Year.

The Lady Blues tied for second most wins in team history at 30-4 and went to the Elite Eight for the third time in team history. He has posted a **82-27 (.752)** overall record during his career.

In his second season McHenry engineered one of the best turnarounds in Division II, guiding Washburn to the South Central Regional and finishing with a 23-7 record.

He guided the Lady Blues to back-to-back 20 win seasons after finishing with a 13-14 record in 2000-01, which was also his first season as a head coach at the collegiate level.

McHenry was named the head coach on May 8, 2000.

He became only the fifth coach in the history of the women's basketball program at Washburn and the first new head coach since Patty Dick joined the Lady Blues as the head coach in the 1977-78 season.

Prior to his new appointment, McHenry spent the previous 11 seasons as a member of the men's basketball coaching staff under current coach Bob Chipman. While on the Washburn bench, he was a part of 243 wins. In addition to his basketball duties, McHenry was the men's golf coach for eight seasons.

McHenry has a bachelor's degree from Washburn in communications and a master's degree in sports administration from Wichita State. McHenry and his wife, Mischa, have three children, Danielle, Samantha and Ronnie.

Missouri Western coach **Dave Slifer** is in his ninth season, posting a 197-65 record. He has posted a 376-95 record in 15 seasons overall. He coached six seasons at Mount Mercy (Iowa) College prior to his stint at Missouri Western.

✓ **SCOUTING THE GRIFFONS:** The Griffons are 13-5 and 5-4 in the MIAA after a 71-56 loss at home against Emporia State Wednesday night. Danielle McKinley had 18 points to lead the Griffons, while Carly Lee and Tera Petersen added 12 points apiece. McKinley leads Western with 15.8 points and game, while Eldra Paixao is averaging 14.5 a game. Peterson and Lee are averaging 11.1 and 10.1 a game respectively.

✓ **THE SERIES:** The Lady Blues are 27-35 all-time against the Griffons but have won the last three meetings. Washburn topped the Griffons 68-53 in St. Joseph, Mo. on Dec. 30, 2003. Washburn has lost the last four meetings against the Griffons in Lee Arena. ✓ **WASHBURN LAST TIME OUT AT PITTSBURG STATE JAN. 28, 2003:** PITTSBURG, Kan. - The No. 10 Washburn Lady Blues won their fourth straight with a 75-66 comeback win at Pittsburg State's John Lance Arena Wednesday.

The Gorillas took a 36-26 lead with 4:05 left in the opening half on Janelle Klein's layup. Washburn responded to cut the gap to 40-36 at the break after a 3-pointer by Juwana Rivers and a basket by Cindy Keeley in the final minute.

Carla Sintra, who had 15 of her career-high 22 points at the half, put the Lady Blues up 64-56 on a layup with 5:15 to play. The basket capped a 13-0 run in a 3:32 stretch in the second half. Rivers had her second 3-pointer and two free throws to give Washburn the lead for good during the run.

The Lady Blues shot 53.6 percent on 15 of 28 shooting to finish 30 of 61 from the field. Pittsburg State, which shot 63.2 percent on 12 of 19 field goals in the first half, made only 9 of 27 shots in the second half. The Lady Blues hit a season-low two 3-pointers in 10 attempts.

Lora Westling had 13 points on 5 of 8 shooting, while Brooke Ubelaker and Rivers added 12 and 11 respectively to compliment Sintra's 22 point effort.

✓ WASHBURN VS. PSU LEFTOVERS:

• Washburn won its fifth straight against the Gorillas and third straight at John Lance Arena.

• Washburn hit a season-low two 3-pointers and a season-low 10 3-point attempts.

• Washburn improved won its first game decided by less than 10 points.

• Washburn trailed a the half for the third time this season.

• Washburn shot 49.2 percent, which was the team's best in MIAA play.

• Washburn gave up 40 first half points, which were the most by a Washburn opponent in a first half or any half this season.

• Carla Sintra had a career-high 22 points and tied a career high with three steals.

✓ WASHBURN LAST TIME VS. MISSOURI WESTERN ON DEC. 30, 2003:

ST. JOSEPH, Mo. - The Washburn Lady Blues won their 10th straight game to open the season in a 68-53 win.

The Lady Blues led by 19 at the break shooting 48 percent from the field hitting 4 of 7 3-point attempts. The Lady Blues also outrebounded the Griffons 42 to 32 and hit five more 3-pointers in the game.

Freshman Brooke Ubelaker led the Lady Blues recording her first double-double with 13 points and 11 rebounds. Junior Lora Westling scored 12 and senior Montoya Whitfield scored 10 off the bench.

The Lady Blues missed their first six shots from the field, but the Lady Blues' defense held the Griffons to 7 of 27 from the field in the first half.

✓ LADY BLUES RUNS LEADING TO BIG WINS:

Washburn has outscored opponents 78.4-52.5 in large part because of big runs in games this season. The Lady Blues have had 18 runs of 10 or more straight points in their first 18 games this season.

✓ **LADY BLUES IN THE NATIONAL STATS (THROUGH JAN. 25):** Washburn was ranked fourth in scoring margin (+25.9), fifth in rebounding margin (+10.5), third in 3-point field goal percentage (42.2%), 20th in scoring offense (78.4), ninth in scoring defense (52.5), 7th in 3-pointers per game (8.18), 25th in opponent field goal percentage (35.3%) and 24th in field goal percentage (45.9%) as a team in the latest NCAA stats for games through Jan. 25.

Burlington native Erin Menard was fifth in 3-point percentage (47.8%). Menard was 29th in 3-pointers per game (2.6). Alison Garrett's 54.2 percent 3-point field goal percentage would lead the NCAA but Garrett does not have the 2.0 minimum 3-pointers per game to qualify.

✓ BURLINGTON BOMBERS RAINING TREYS:

Burlington natives Erin Menard and Alison Garrett have been among the MIAA's and nation's best in making 3-pointers this season. Menard has hit 44 of 93 treys, while Garrett has hit 32 of 60 from beyond the arch this season.

Menard is second in the MIAA (6th NCAA) in 3-point field goal percentage at 47.3% and is third in the MIAA in 3-pointers made (2.44 3s per game.). Garrett is first in the MIAA in 3-point field goal percentage at 53.3% and tied for eighth in the MIAA in 3-pointers made (1.78 per game).

Menard's 10 3-pointers against Truman broke Brenda Schaffer-Dahl (Feb. 16, 1988 vs. ESU) and Rhonda Matzke's (Jan. 30, 1993 vs. NEMSU-now TSU) school record of seven. UMSL's Laura Satterfield (vs. Tampa Nov. 11, 1994) and PSU's Jenni Miller (vs. TSU Jan. 28, 1995) own the MIAA record with 11 3-pointers. California's (Pa.) Lara Thornton set the NCAA Division II record with 12 3-pointers against Clarion March 5, 1994.

The 10 3-pointers were also the most in Division II this season. South Dakota's Erin Bourne hit nine 3-pointers against William Penn on Nov. 29, 2003. Joy Gallagher of Division I Wagner is the only other women's player to reach double figures this year with 11 3-pointers against Boston University Dec. 30, 2003.

✓ DISHING IT OUT:

Washburn point guards April Roadhouse and Juwanna Rivers have combined for 118 assists with only 68 turnovers. Roadhouse leads the MIAA with a 2.50 assist/turnover ratio with 65 assists and 26 turnovers. Roadhouse is also ninth in the MIAA with 3.61 assists a game.

✓ FRESHMAN MAKING HER MARK:

Freshman Brooke Ubelaker has been making her mark in her freshman campaign. The Osborne, Kan. native has made 64 of 116 field goal attempts (55.2 percent) and 20 of 22 free throws (90.9 percent). Both percentages lead Washburn but are not included in MIAA and NCAA statistics because of minimum attempts.

Ubelaker is also the first freshman to be a regular starter since Nikki Olberding started 27 of 31 games in 1994-95. Laura Mueller was the last Washburn freshman to start every game by making 33 starts in 1988-89.

Ubelaker's 8.6 points per game average is the highest for a Washburn freshman since Olberding scored 12.2 a game in 1994-95.

✓ **BENCH BRIGADE:** Washburn's bench has scored 688 (48.9%) of the team's 1408 points this season. Montoya Whitfield (9.8 ppg) and Erin Menard (9.1 ppg) are WU's top leading scorers off the bench. Starters Lora Westling and Carla Sintra are the only Washburn players in double figures scoring with 11.3 and 10.2 points a game respectively. Washburn's bench has outscored opponents bench players 688-241 (38.2-13.4 ppg).

✓ **LADY BLUES OWN GLASS IN OPENING GAMES:** Washburn has outrebounded its first 18 opponents 739-553 (41.1 to 30.9) to own a +10.2 rebounding margin.

The Lady Blues lead the MIAA and are fifth in the NCAA stats in rebounding margin. Washburn has been outrebounded three times this season (vs. Texas A&M-Kingsville, at Missouri-Rolla and Missouri Southern).

Lady Blues Basketball

✓ **LADY BLUES IN LEE ARENA:** In their 18th season in Lee Arena, the Lady Blues are 238-53 (.818) overall at home. The longest winning streak was 44 games from Dec. 1, 1990 to March 20, 1993.

The Lady Blues were 16-1 in Lee Arena in 2002-03, outscoring opponents by an average of 71.1 to 56.2 (1209-955 points). The Lady Blues were 15-1 in Lee Arena in 2001-02.

Washburn won 44 straight homes game after capturing the South Central Regional Title 75-62 over Missouri Southern on March 20, 1993.

Washburn won also 19 straight games in Lee Arena before falling to Missouri Western 60-56 Jan 29, 2003. The last lost prior was 69-67 to Missouri Western on Jan. 2, 2002 in the MIAA opener in the 2001-02 season. The Lady Blues had a 13-game home court winning streak snapped against ESU on Jan. 7. Washburn is 47-7 in home games under Ron McHenry.

✓ **LADY BLUES HISTORY:** Washburn is 563-310 (.645) in its 33rd season of intercollegiate action.

✓ WBCA NATIONAL POLL (JAN. 27, 2004):

Despite two wins last week, the Washburn Lady Blues fell to No. 10 in the WBCA National Poll after opening with a No. 13 ranking in the preseason poll.

The team received its first national ranking last season in the WBCA Division II Women's National Poll since the 1997-98 season, when it entered the poll in a tie for No. 24 in Dec. 11, 2002. The next poll will be released on Feb. 3.

✓ SOUTH CENTRAL REGIONAL RANKINGS (JAN. 28, 2004):

The Lady Blues were No. 5 in the South Central Region rankings released by the NCAA Wednesday. Three automatic qualifiers (MIAA, Lone Star and Heartland conference's champions) and five at-large teams will advance to the South Central Region tournament March 12-15 at a site to be determined.

✓ **TURNING UP THE D:** Under coach Ron McHenry the Lady Blues have been among the best in the MIAA and the nation in defensive statistics.

The Lady Blues **led** the MIAA and were **24th** in the nation in 2002-03 by holding opponents to **58.6** points a game, while improving even further this season.

In the final statistics report on in 2003, Washburn **led** the MIAA and was **12th** in the nation by holding opponents to **56.6** points a game.

The Lady Blues currently lead the MIAA and are 9th in the nation by holding opponents to **53.3** points a game.

✓ **LADY BLUES PUTTING UP RECORD NUMBERS OFFENSIVELY:** In 16 games Washburn has scored 1408 points (78.2 ppg) and is on pace to challenge the team season scoring average of 78.2 points a game set in 1988-89. The Lady Blues are third in the MIAA and 20th in the NCAA rankings in scoring average.

The Lady Blues have scored 90 points or more in four games this season, including a 106-point effort against Saint Mary on Nov. 22. It was the first time WU reached 100 points in 360 games.

Washburn has also hit **141 3-pointers** in the first 18 games, which puts the team on pace to break the record of **192** from the 2002-03 season. Washburn hit a school record 14 3-pointers and broke the MIAA record for attempts (40) against Truman on Jan. 17.

✓ WASHBURN TIP-INS:

- The Lady Blues have been the MIAA's best the last three seasons with a combined 36-9 record in league play from 2001-02 to 2003-04. Missouri Western (34-11), Emporia State (31-14) and Northwest Missouri (24-21) are the only other MIAA schools at .500 or better. Southwest Baptist (22-23), Central Missouri (22-23), Pittsburg State (21-24), Missouri Southern (19-26), Truman State (13-32) and Missouri-Rolla (3-44) are below .500.

- The Lady Blues have had excellent balance in scoring this season. Six different players have led the Lady Blues in scoring and five players average between 8.6-11.3 points. Lora Westling's team-high 11.3 points a game would be the lowest average to lead the Washburn in team history. Kristy Chapman's 12.7 points a game led the Lady Blues in 2000-01 and was the lowest average to lead a team in school history.

- The Lady Blues average margin of victory **24.9** is well above the school record for margin of victory (+19.8) set in 1992-93. The Lady Blues won their first 11 straight games by 10 points or more. The streak tied the 1992-93 team, which won 11 straight by double figures. Washburn is 15-0 in games with double digit victory margins and 1-2 in single digit victory margins. Washburn leads the MIAA and is fourth in the nation in scoring margin.

- The Lady Blues were unranked in the **Women's Division II Bulletin Preseason Poll**. Washburn was **13th** in the **Women's WBCA Division II Preseason Poll**.

The Lady Blues were also picked **second** in the **MIAA Preseason Coaches Poll**. Emporia State was ranked first in the poll.
