✓ **LADY BLUES AND LIONS HOOK UP IN BATTLE OF TOP MIAA SCORING DEFENSES:** The No. 9 Washburn Lady Blues take a six-game winning streak into their 5:30 p.m. game at Missouri Southern Saturday night. The Lady Blues are 18-2 and 9-2 in MIAA play after a 67-37 win over Pittsburg State Wednesday night. Missouri Southern is 13-7 and 4-7 in the MIAA after an 80-71 double overtime win at Missouri-Rolla Wednesday night.

Washburn is first in the MIAA and fifth in the nation in scoring defense at 51.8 points a game allowed, while Missouri Southern is second in the conference with 59.3 points allowed a game.

Washburn is 32-21 all-time against Missouri Southern after winning 59-47 Jan. 24 in Lee Arena in the first matchup between the teams this season. The Lady Blues have a six-game winning streak against Southern.

The Lady Blues are 45-20 in MIAA play under Ron McHenry, including a 38-9 record the past three seasons.

✓ **LADY BLUES ON RADIO:** All Lady Blue games will be broadcast on AM 580-WIBW radio with former Washburn quarterback Mark Elliott calling the play-by-play action and Bruce Steinbrock adding color analysis. ✓ **COACHES:** Since his appointment as the women's head coach prior to the 2000-01 season, **Ron McHenry** has quickly returned the Washburn women's basketball program to national prominence.

In only his third season in 2002-03, McHenry guided the Lady Blues to a regular season MIAA title, a Sonic/MIAA Tournament championship and a berth to the Division II Elite Eight. For his efforts he was named South Central Regional Coach of the Year.

The Lady Blues tied for second most wins in team history at 30-4 and went to the Elite Eight for the third time in team history. He has posted a **84-27 (.757)** overall record during his career.

In his second season McHenry engineered one of the best turnarounds in Division II, guiding Washburn to the South Central Regional and finishing with a 23-7 record.

He guided the Lady Blues to back-to-back 20 win seasons after finishing with a 13-14 record in 2000-01,

which was also his first season as a head coach at the collegiate level.

McHenry was named the head coach on May 8, 2000.

He became only the fifth coach in the history of the women's basketball program at Washburn and the first new head coach since Patty Dick joined the Lady Blues as the head coach in the 1977-78 season.

Prior to his new appointment, McHenry spent the previous 11 seasons as a member of the men's basketball coaching staff under current coach Bob Chipman. While on the Washburn bench, he was a part of 243 wins. In addition to his basketball duties, McHenry was the men's golf coach for eight seasons.

McHenry has a bachelor's degree from Washburn in communications and a master's degree in sports administration from Wichita State. McHenry and his wife, Mischa, have three children, Danielle, Samantha and Ronnie.

Maryann Mitts is in her third season at Missouri Southern and holds a 45-33 (.577) mark at the school.

In her eighth year as a collegiate head coach, Mitts has a 128-90 (.587) ledger. A 1992 graduate of Rockhurst University, she has led Southern to back-to-back berths in the MIAApostseason tournament and took this year's edition to the team's best start since 1995-96.

✓ **SCOUTING THE LIONS:** The Lions improved to 13-7 and 4-7 in the MIAA with an 80-71 double overtime win at Missouri-Rolla Wednesday night. Carol Koenig and Wyketha Harrell had career highs with 27 and 21 points respectively. Aubrie Hallman, who earned MIAA Player of the Week honors last week, had 17 points but hit just 5 of 18 shots.

Hallman leads the Lions with 15.8 points a game, while Harrell and Koenig are averaging 12.3 and 10.7 points a game respectively.

✓ **THE SERIES:** Washburn is 32-21 all-time against Missouri Southern after winning 59-47 Jan. 24 in Lee Arena in the first matchup between the teams this season. The Lady Blues have a six-game winning streak against Southern.

✓ **WASHBURN LAST TIME OUT VS. PSU FEB. 4, 2003:** TOPEKA - The No. 9 Washburn Lady Blues extended their winning streak to six games with a 67-37 win over Pittsburg State in Lee Arena Wednesday night.

PSU's 37 points tied the fewest by a Washburn opponent in an MIAA game. Washburn topped Missouri Southern 73-37 Feb. 12, 1990 in its first year in the MIAA.

The Lady Blues took a 5-0 lead on Brooke Ubelaker's 3-pointer 53 seconds into the game and

never trailed. Carla Sintra scored 10 of her game-high 16 points in the first half to help WU to a 25-19 lead at the break.

After Kami Scrivner's free throw pulled PSU within five in the opening seconds of the second half, Washburn expanded the lead to 39-22 with a 14-2 with 15:08 left. WU outscored the Gorillas 42-18 in the second half.

Ubelaker, Alison Garrett and Juwanna Rivers each had 10 points to compliment Sintra's 16. Scrivner led PSU with nine points. PSU hit only 13 of 48 (27.1 percent) of its field goal attempts.

✓ WASHBURN VS. PSU LEFTOVERS:

• Washburn won its sixth straight against the Gorillas and third straight in the series in Lee Arena.

• PSU's 37 points tied the least ever by a Washburn MIAA opponent. WU topped Missouri Southern 73-37 Feb. 12, 1990.

• PSU, which was ranked 10th in the nation in field goal percentage was held to 27.1 percent on 13 of 48 shooting.

• Washburn held its fourth opponent in five games under 50 points.

• Carla Sintra had a career-high four steals to go with a game-high 16 points.

✓ WASHBURN LAST TIME VS. MISSOURI SOUTHERN ON JAN. 24, 2004: TOPEKA

- The No. 9 Washburn Lady Blues topped Missouri Southern 59-47 in Lee Arena. With the win, Washburn improved to 15-2 and 6-2 in the MIAA, while Southern fell to 11-6 and 2-6 in the MIAA.

With the score tied at 8, Washburn used a 7-0 run to take a 15-8 lead with 6:54 left in the opening half. Juwanna Rivers' 3-point play with three seconds left gave the Lady Blues a 31-22 lead at the break. Both teams struggled and made just 9 of 26 (34.6%) from the field.

The Lions got within 39-32 on Wyketha Harrell's basket early in the second half but couldn't get any closer the rest of the way.

Rivers led the way with a career-high 15 points on 5 of 7 field goals (3 of 5 3-pointers) and four assists. Lora Westling had 12 points and eight rebounds.

✓ LADY BLUES GET DEFENSIVE IN SIX-GAME

STREAK: During its current six-game winning streak, Washburn has turned its defense up another notch. Washburn opponents have averaged just 47.7 points a game in the streak.

Washburn has held four of its last five opponents under 50 points and only Pittsburg State had scored more than 55 points in the streak with 66 points in John Lance Arena Jan. 28. The Gorillas followed with a 37-point effort in a 67-37 loss Feb. 4 in Lee Arena. The 37 points tied the fewest by a

✓ **LADY BLUES IN THE NATIONAL STATS (THROUGH FEB. 1):** Washburn was ranked fourth in scoring margin (+24.5), fifth in rebounding margin (+10.5), fifth in 3-point field goal percentage (41.0%), 27th in scoring offense (77.1), fifth in scoring defense (52.6), eighth in 3-pointers per game (7.7), 23th in opponent field goal percentage (35.6%) and 23rd in field goal percentage (45.9%) as a team in the latest NCAA stats for games through Feb. 1.

Burlington native Erin Menard was ninth in 3-point percentage (46.4%). Menard was 46th in 3-pointers per game (2.4). Alison Garrett's 51.6 percent 3-point field goal percentage would be second in the NCAA stats but Garrett does not have the 2.0 minimum 3-pointers per game to qualify.

✓ BURLINGTON BOMBERS RAINING TREYS:

Burlington natives Erin Menard and Alison Garrett have been among the MIAA's and nation's best in making 3-pointers this season. Menard has hit 46 of 100 treys, while Garrett has hit 35 of 67 from beyond the arch this season.

Menard is second in the MIAA (9th NCAA) in 3-point field goal percentage at 46.0% and is third in the MIAA in 3-pointers made (2.30 3s per game.). Garrett is first in the MIAA in 3-point field goal percentage at 52.2% and 10th in the MIAA in 3-pointers made (1.75 per game).

Menard's 10 3-pointers against Truman State Jan. 17 broke Brenda Schaffer-Dahl (Feb. 16, 1988 vs. ESU) and Rhonda Matzke's (Jan. 30, 1993 vs. NEMSU-now TSU) school record of seven. UMSL's Laura Satterfield (vs. Tampa Nov. 11, 1994) and PSU's Jenni Miller (vs. TSU Jan. 28, 1995) own the MIAA record with 11 3-pointers. California's (Pa.) Lara

Thornton set the NCAA Division II record with 12 3-pointers against Clarion March 5, 1994.

The 10 3-pointers were also the most in Division II this season. South Dakota's Erin Bourne hit nine 3-pointers against William Penn on Nov. 29, 2003. Joy Gallagher of Division I Wagner is the only other women's player to reach double figures this year with 11 3-pointers against Boston University Dec. 30, 2003.

✓ DISHING IT OUT:

Washburn point guards April Roadhouse and Juwanna Rivers have combined for 132 assists with only 74 turnovers. Roadhouse is first in the MIAA with a 2.48 assist/turnover ratio with 72 assists and 29 turnovers. Roadhouse is also 9th in the MIAA with 3.60 assists a game. Rivers is eighth in the MIAA with a 1.33 assist/turnover ratio.

✓ FRESHMAN MAKING HER MARK:

Freshman Brooke Ubelaker has been making her mark in her freshman campaign. The Osborne, Kan. native has made 73 of 126 field goal attempts (57.9 percent) and 24 of 27 free throws (88.9 percent). Both percentages lead Washburn but are not included in MIAA and NCAA statistics because of minimum attempts.

Ubelaker is also the first freshman to be a regular starter since Nikki Olberding started 27 of 31 games in 1994-95. Laura Mueller was the last Washburn freshman to start every game by making 33 starts in 1988-89.

Ubelaker's 8.9 points per game average is the highest for a Washburn freshman since Olberding scored 12.2 a game in 1994-95.

✓ **BENCH BRIGADE:** Washburn's bench has scored 740 (48.3%) of the team's 1531 points this season. Montoya Whitfield (9.5 ppg) and Erin Menard (8.6 ppg) are WU's top leading scorers off the bench. Starters Lora Westling and Carla Sintra are the only Washburn players in double fig-

ures scoring 10.8 and 10.2 points a game. Washburn's bench has outscored opponents bench players 740-257 (37.6-12.9 ppg).

✓ **LADY BLUES WINNING BATTLE OF THE BOARDS:** Washburn has out-rebounded its first 20 opponents 817-615 (40.8 to 30.8) to own a +10.0 rebounding margin.

The Lady Blues lead the MIAA and were fifth in the NCAA stats in rebounding margin. Washburn has been outrebounded three times this season (vs. Texas A&M-Kingsville, at Missouri-Rolla and Missouri Southern).

✓ **LADY BLUES IN LEE ARENA:** In their 18th season in Lee Arena, the Lady Blues are 240-53 (.819) overall at home. The longest winning streak was 44 games from Dec. 1, 1990 to March 20, 1993.

The Lady Blues were 16-1 in Lee Arena in 2002-03, outscoring opponents by an average of 71.1 to 56.2 (1209-955 points). The Lady Blues were 15-1 in Lee Arena in 2001-02.

Washburn won 44 straight homes game after capturing the South Central Regional Title 75-62 over Missouri Southern on March 20, 1993.

Washburn won also 19 straight games in Lee Arena before falling to Missouri Western 60-56 Jan 29, 2003. The last lost prior was 69-67 to Missouri Western on Jan. 2, 2002 in the MIAA opener in the 2001-02 season. The Lady Blues had a 13-game home court winning streak snapped against ESU on Jan. 7. Washburn is 49-8 in home games under Ron McHenry.

✓ **LADY BLUES HISTORY:** Washburn is 565-310 (.646) in its 33rd season of intercollegiate action.

✓ WBCA NATIONAL POLL (FEB. 3, 2004):

The Washburn Lady Blues moved up a spot to No. 9 in the WBCA National Poll after opening with a No. 13 ranking in the preseason poll.

The team received its first national ranking last season in the WBCA Division II Women's National Poll since the 1997-98 season, when it entered the poll in a tie for No. 24 in Dec. 11, 2002. The next poll will be released on Feb. 10.

✓ SOUTH CENTRAL REGIONAL RANKINGS (FEB. 4, 2004):

Despite winning two games, the Lady Blues fell a spot to No. 6 in the South Central Region rankings released by the NCAA Wednesday. Three automatic qualifiers (MIAA, Lone Star and Heartland conference's champions) and five at-large teams will advance to the South Central Region tournament March 12-15 at a site to be determined.

✓ **TURNING UP THE D:** Under coach Ron McHenry the Lady Blues have been among the best in the MIAA and the nation in defensive statistics.

The Lady Blues **led** the MIAA and were **24th** in the nation in 2002-03 by holding opponents to **58.6** points a game, while improving even further this season.

In the final statistics report on in 2003, Washburn **led** the MIAA and was **12th** in the nation by holding opponents to **56.6** points a game.

The Lady Blues currently lead the MIAA and are fifth in the nation by holding opponents to **51.8** points a game.

✓ **LADY BLUES NEARING 3-POINT RECORD:** Washburn has also hit **153 3-pointers** in the first 20 games, which puts the team on pace to break the record of **192** from the 2002-03 season. Washburn hit a school record 14 3-pointers and broke the MIAA record for attempts (40) against Truman on Jan. 17. Washburn leads the MIAA by hitting 40.7 percent beyond the arch and making 7.65 3-pointers a game.

✓ WASHBURN TIP-INS:

- The Lady Blues have been the MIAA's best the last three seasons with a combined 38-9 record in league play from 2001-02 to 2003-04. Missouri Western (35-12), Emporia State (32-15) and Northwest Missouri (26-21) are the only other MIAA schools at .500 or better. Southwest Baptist (23-24), Central Missouri (22-25), Pittsburg State (22-25), Missouri Southern (20-27), Truman State (14-33) and Missouri-Rolla (3-46) are below .500.

- The Lady Blues have had excellent balance in scoring this season. Six different players have led the Lady Blues in scoring and five players average between 8.6-10.8 points. Lora Westling's team-high 10.8 points a game would be the lowest average to lead the Washburn in team history. Kristy Chapman's 12.7 points a game led the Lady Blues in 2000-01 and was the lowest average to lead a team in school history.

- The Lady Blues average margin of victory **24.8** is well above the school record for margin of victory (+19.8) set in 1992-93. The Lady Blues won their first 11 straight games by 10 points or more. The streak tied the 1992-93 team, which won 11 straight by double figures. Washburn is 17-0 in games with double digit victory margins and 1-2 in single digit victory margins. Washburn leads the MIAA and is fourth in the nation in scoring margin.

- The Lady Blues were unranked in the **Women's Division II Bulletin Preseason Poll**. Washburn was **13th** in the **Women's WBCA Division II Preseason Poll**.

The Lady Blues were also picked **second** in the **MIAA Preseason Coaches**
