✓ **LADY BLUES BACK HOME TO FACE SOUTHWEST BAPTIST:** The No. 13 Washburn Lady Blues are back home Wednesday for a 5:30 p.m. game against Southwest Baptist. The Lady Blues are 18-3 and 9-3 in MIAA play after a 63-60 overtime loss at Missouri Southern Saturday night. Southwest Baptist is 13-8 and 5-7 in MIAA play after falling 52-49 at Missouri Western Saturday.

Washburn has posted a 15-10 record in the all-time series with Southwest Baptist after winning the last six matchups. Washburn defeated SBU 63-41 in Bolivar, Mo. Jan. 20.

The Lady Blues are 45-21 in MIAA play under Ron McHenry, including a 38-10 record the past three seasons.

✓ **LADY BLUES ON RADIO:** All Lady Blue games will be broadcast on AM 580-WIBW radio with former Washburn quarterback Mark Elliott calling the play-by-play action and Bruce Steinbrock adding color analysis. ✓ **COACHES:** Since his appointment as the women's head coach prior to the 2000-01 season, Ron McHenry has quickly returned the Washburn women's basketball program to national prominence.

In only his third season in 2002-03, McHenry guided the Lady Blues to a regular season MIAA title, a Sonic/MIAA Tournament championship and a berth to the Division II Elite Eight. For his efforts he was named South Central Region Coach of the Year.

The Lady Blues tied for second most wins in team history at 30-4 and went to the Elite Eight for the third time in team history. He has posted an **84-28 (.750)** overall record during his career.

In his second season McHenry engineered one of the best turnarounds in Division II, guiding Washburn to the South Central Regional and finishing with a 23-7 record.

He guided the Lady Blues to back-to-back 20 win seasons after finishing with a 13-14 record in 2000-01, which was also his first season as a head coach at the collegiate level.

McHenry was named the head coach on May 8, 2000.

He became only the fifth coach in the history of the women's basketball program at Washburn and the first new head coach since Patty Dick joined the Lady Blues as the head coach in the 1977-78 season.

Prior to his new appointment, McHenry spent the previous 11 seasons as a member of the men's basketball coaching staff under current coach Bob Chipman. While on the Washburn bench, he was a part of 243 wins. In addition to his basketball duties, McHenry was the men's golf coach for eight seasons.

McHenry has a bachelor's degree from Washburn in communications and a master's degree in sports administration from Wichita State. McHenry and his wife, Mischa, have three children, Danielle, Samantha and Ronnie.

SBU's winningest women's basketball coach **Jim Middleton** is in his tenth year as the head of the Lady Bearcat basketball team. In 2001, he took the team to the NCAA Division II playoffs for the fourth consecutive season. The Lady 'Cats have traveled to post-season play six of the nine years Middleton has been at the helm of the program.

In July of 2001, Middleton added to his duties as the athletics director for SBU. He now dreams of taking the success he has had in his own program and help to make Bearcat athletics one of the best overall programs in the nation.

Middleton, whose record at SBU is 181-95 (.656), holds the most wins of any head women's basketball coach at the school and also has the highest winning percentage.

✓ **SCOUTING THE LADY BEARCATS:** The Lady Bearcats are 13-8 and 5-7 in the MIAA after a 52-49 loss at Missouri Western Saturday night. Amber Wheeler led SBU with 14 points, while Alicia Mercer added 10. The Lady Bearcats were outrebounded 38-27 in the game.

Wheeler leads SBU with 15.0 points a game and has hit 47 3-pointers this year after earned MIAA Freshman of the Year honors in 2002-03. Mercer is averaging 11.5 points a game, while Gwyn Smith is the other Lady Bearcat in double figures with 10.8 points a game.

✓ **THE SERIES:** The Lady Blues are 15-10 against the Lady Bearcats all-time after winning the last six meetings in the series. Washburn won the first meeting between the schools this season 63-41 in Bolivar, Mo. on Jan. 20.

✓ **WASHBURN LAST TIME OUT AT MSSU FEB. 7, 2004:** JOPLIN, Mo. - The No. 9 Washburn Lady Blues fell 63-60 to Missouri Southern in overtime. The loss drops the Lady Blues to 18-3 and 9-3 in the MIAA.

The Lady Blues led 29-22 at the break on 53 percent shooting, but were scoreless from the free throw line as the Lions hit 6 of 8 from the charity stripe.

The Lady Blues led by as many as 12 points in the second half and struggled in the overtime period as they were 1 of 5 from the field and 0 of 3 from the free throw line.

Brooke Ubelaker led the Lady Blues with a career-high 16 points. Carla Sintra had 11.

## ✓ WASHBURN VS. MSSU LEFTOVERS:

• The loss snapped Washburn's six-game winning streak overall and six-game winning streak against the Lions.

• Washburn fell to 0-2 in overtime games this season and 1-3 in games decided by single digit point margins.

• The Lady Blues ended their string of five straight halves of holding the opposition under 25 points by giving up 35 in the second half.

• Brooke Ubelaker had a career-high 16 points on 6 of 7 field goals and 2 of 3 free throws.

✓ **WASHBURN LAST TIME VS. SOUTHWEST BAPTIST ON JAN. 20, 2004:** BOLIVAR, Mo. - The No. 9 Washburn Lady Blues used a stellar defensive performance to beat Southwest Baptist 63-41 at Davison Fieldhouse Tuesday night.

Washburn held Southwest Baptist to 41 points by surrendering only 15 field goals in 41 attempts. The 41 points were the least by the Lady blues against MIAA opponent since Washburn topped Lincoln 89-38 Feb. 14, 1990 in Lee Arena. The points were also the least by the Lady Bearcats in the all-time series against Washburn.

Washburn led 17-16 in the opening half before going on a 13-2 run that was capped by Lora Westling's jumper with 53 seconds left. Amber Wheeler's jumper in the final seconds pulled SBU within 30-20 at the break.

Brooke Ubelaker scored nine of Washburn's first 12 points in the second half to cap a 12-2 run and increase the lead to 42-22 with 15:35 left. SBU didn't get within 16 the rest of the way.

Westling led Washburn with 15 points, including 11 in the first half. Brooke Ubelaker added 11 points and seven rebounds, while Carla Sintra had eight points and nine rebounds.

Washburn won its sixth straight over Southwest Baptist and third straight at Davison Fieldhouse to improve to 14-2 and 5-2 in the MIAA. Southwest Baptist fell to 11-5 and 3-4 in the MIAA.

## ✓ LADY BLUES RUNS LEADING TO BIG WINS:

Washburn has outscored opponents 75.8-52.3 in large part because of big runs in games this season. The Lady Blues have had 20 runs of 10 or more straight points in their first 21 games this season.

### ✓ LADY BLUES IN THE NATIONAL STATS (THROUGH FEB. 8):

Washburn was ranked fourth in scoring margin (+23.4), seventh in rebounding margin (+9.6), sixth in 3-point field goal percentage (41.0%), 36th in scoring offense (75.8), fifth in scoring defense (52.3), 11th in 3-pointers per game (7.5), 20th in opponent field goal percentage (35.5%) and 23rd in field goal percentage (46.0%) as a team in the latest NCAA stats for games through Feb. 8.

Burlington native Erin Menard was ninth in 3-point percentage (46.4%). Alison Garrett's 50.0 percent 3-point field goal percentage would be third in the NCAA stats but Garrett does not have the 2.0 minimum 3-pointers per game to qualify.

### ✓ BURLINGTON BOMBERS RAINING TREYS:

Burlington natives Erin Menard and Alison Garrett have been among the MIAA's and nation's best in making 3-pointers this season. Menard has hit 47 of 102 treys, while Garrett has hit 35 of 70 from beyond the arch this season.

Menard is third in the MIAA (9th NCAA) in 3-point field goal percentage at 46.1% and is tied for third in the MIAA in 3-pointers made (2.24 3s per game.). Garrett is first in the MIAA in 3-point field goal percentage at 50.0% and 10th in the MIAA in 3-pointers made (1.67 per game).

Menard's 10 3-pointers against Truman State Jan. 17 broke Brenda Schaffer-Dahl (Feb. 16, 1988 vs. ESU) and Rhonda Matzke's (Jan. 30, 1993 vs. NEMSU-now TSU) school record of seven. UMSL's Laura Satterfield (vs. Tampa Nov. 11, 1994) and PSU's Jenni Miller (vs. TSU Jan. 28, 1995) own the MIAA record with 11 3-pointers. California's (Pa.) Lara Thornton set the NCAA Division II record with 12 3-pointers against Clarion March 5, 1994.

The 10 3-pointers were also the most in Division II this season. South Dakota's Erin Bourne hit nine 3-pointers against William Penn on Nov. 29, 2003. Joy Gallagher of Division I Wagner is the only other women's play-

er to reach double figures this year with 11 3-pointers against Boston University Dec. 30, 2003.

### ✓ DISHING IT OUT:

Washburn point guards April Roadhouse and Juwanna Rivers have combined for 137 assists with only 83 turnovers. Roadhouse is second in the MIAA with a 2.34 assist/turnover ratio with 75 assists and 32 turnovers. Roadhouse is also 9th in the MIAA with 3.57 assists a game.

### ✓ FRESHMAN MAKING HER MARK:

Freshman Brooke Ubelaker has been making her mark in her freshman campaign. The Osborne, Kan. native has made 79 of 133 field goal attempts (59.4 percent) and 26 of 30 free throws (86.7 percent). Both percentages lead Washburn but are not included in MIAA and NCAA statistics because of minimum attempts.

Ubelaker is also the first freshman to be a regular starter since Nikki Olberding started 27 of 31 games in 1994-95. Laura Mueller was the last Washburn freshman to start every game by making 33 starts in 1988-89.

Ubelaker's 9.2 points per game average is the highest for a Washburn freshman since Olberding scored 12.2 a game in 1994-95.

✓ **BENCH BRIGADE:** Washburn's bench has scored 759 (47.7%) of the team's 1591 points this season. Montoya Whitfield (9.2 ppg) and Erin Menard (8.3 ppg) are WU's top leading scorers off the bench. Starters Lora Westling and Carla Sintra are the only Washburn players in double figures scoring 10.6 and 10.2 points a game. Washburn's bench has outscored opponents bench players 759-266 (37.6-12.7 ppg).

✓ **LADY BLUES WINNING BATTLE OF THE BOARDS:** Washburn has

outrebounded its first 21 opponents 849-646 (40.4 to 30.8) to own a +9.6 rebounding margin.

The Lady Blues lead the MIAA and were seventh in the NCAA stats in rebounding margin. Washburn has been outrebounded three times this season (vs. Texas A&M-Kingsville, at Missouri-Rolla and Missouri Southern).

✓ **LADY BLUES IN LEE ARENA:** In their 18th season in Lee Arena, the Lady Blues are 240-53 (.819) overall at home. The longest winning streak was 44 games from Dec. 1, 1990 to March 20, 1993.

The Lady Blues were 16-1 in Lee Arena in 2002-03, outscoring opponents by an average of 71.1 to 56.2 (1209-955 points). The Lady Blues were 15-1 in Lee Arena in 2001-02.

Washburn won 44 straight home games after capturing the South Central Regional Title 75-62 over Missouri Southern on March 20, 1993.

Washburn won also 19 straight games in Lee Arena before falling to Missouri Western 60-56 Jan. 29, 2003. The last loss prior was 69-67 to Missouri Western on Jan. 2, 2002 in the MIAA opener in the 2001-02 season. The Lady Blues had a 13-game home court winning streak snapped against ESU on Jan. 7. Washburn is 49-8 in home games under Ron McHenry.

✓ **LADY BLUES HISTORY:** Washburn is 565-311 (.645) in its 33rd season of intercollegiate action.

## ✓ WBCA NATIONAL POLL (FEB. 10, 2004):

The Washburn Lady Blues fell four spots to No. 13 in the WBCA National Poll after opening with a No. 13 ranking in the preseason poll.

The team received its first national ranking last season in the WBCA Division II Women's National Poll since the 1997-98 season, when it entered the poll in a tie for No. 24 in Dec. 11, 2002. The next poll will be released on Feb. 10.

## ✓ SOUTH CENTRAL REGIONAL RANKINGS (FEB. 4, 2004):

Despite winning two games, the Lady Blues fell a spot to No. 6 in the South Central Region rankings released by the NCAA Wednesday. Three automatic qualifiers (MIAA, Lone Star and Heartland conference's champions) and five at-large teams will advance to the South Central Region tournament March 12-15 at a site to be determined.

✓ **TURNING UP THE D:** Under coach Ron McHenry the Lady Blues have been among the best in the MIAA and the nation in defensive statistics.

The Lady Blues led the MIAA and were 24th in the nation in 2002-03 by holding opponents to 58.6 points a game, while improving even further this season.

In the final statistics report on in 2003, Washburn led the MIAA and was 12th in the nation by holding opponents to 56.6 points a game.

The Lady Blues currently lead the MIAA and are fifth in the nation by holding opponents to 52.3 points a game.

✓ **LADY BLUES NEARING 3-POINT RECORD:** Washburn has also hit 157 3-pointers in the first 20 games, which puts the team on pace to break the record of 192 from the 2002-03 season. Washburn hit a school record 14 3-pointers and broke the MIAA record for attempts (40) against Truman on Jan. 17. Washburn leads the MIAA by hitting 39.9 percent beyond the arch and making 7.48 3-pointers a game.

## ✓ WASHBURN TIP-INS:

- The Lady Blues have been the MIAA's best the last three seasons with a combined 38-10 record in league play from 2001-02 to 2003-04. Missouri Western (36-12), Emporia State (33-15) and Northwest Missouri (26-22) are the only other MIAA schools at .500 or better. Southwest Baptist (23-25), Central Missouri (23-25), Pittsburg State (23-25), Missouri Southern (21-27), Truman State (14-34) and Missouri-Rolla (3-47) are below .500.

- The Lady Blues have had excellent balance in scoring this season. Six different players have led the Lady Blues in scoring and five players average between 8.3-10.6 points. Lora Westling's team-high 10.6 points a game would be the lowest average to lead the Washburn in team history. Kristy Chapman's 12.7 points a game led the Lady Blues in 2000-01 and was the lowest average to lead a team in school history.

- The Lady Blues average margin of victory 23.4 is well above the school record for margin of victory (+19.8) set in 1992-93. The Lady Blues won their first 11 straight games by 10 points or more. The streak tied the 1992-93 team, which won 11 straight by double figures. Washburn is 17-0 in games with double digit victory margins and 1-3 in single digit victory margins. Washburn leads the MIAA and is fourth in the nation in scoring margin.

- The Lady Blues were unranked in the **Women's Division II Bulletin Preseason Poll**. Washburn was 13th in the **Women's WBCA Division II Preseason Poll**.

The Lady Blues were also picked second in the **MIAA Preseason Coaches Poll**. Emporia State was ranked first in the poll.
