✓ LADY BLUES NEED WIN TO CAPTURE AT LEAST A SHARE OF MIAA TITLE: The No. 13 Washburn Lady Blues travel to Warrensburg, Mo. 1:30 p.m. Saturday to take on Central Missouri State University.

Washburn is 23-3 and tied for first in the MIÁA at 14-3 after a 51-50 win over Emporia State in White Auditorium Wednesday night. Central Missouri State is 15-11 and 8-9 in the MIAA after a 66-62 win at Southwest Baptist Tuesday night.

Washburn owns an 18-10 advantage in the all-time series with the Jennies after a 71-61 win in the MIAA home opener Jan. 3. Washburn has won the last four meetings with CMSU, including a 54-48 win at the CMSU Multipurpose Building Feb. 15, 2003. The win snapped a four-game losing skid for Washburn in Warrensburg.

The Lady Blues are 50-21 in MIAA play under Ron McHenry, including a league-best 43-10 record the past three seasons.

- ✓ LADY BLUES NEED HELP TO CLAIM NO. 1 SEED IN SONIC MIAA TOURNAMENT: The Lady Blues need a win and a Emporia State loss to Southwest Baptist at home Saturday to earn the No. 1 seed in the Sonic MIAA Tournament March 4-7. If Emporia State beats SBU, Washburn would be the No. 2 seed and open at 6 p.m. March 4 against either Pittsburg State or Southwest Baptist. If Washburn were to fall at Central Missouri State and tie for second with Northwest Missouri State the Lady Blues would have the tiebreaker by virtue of their win at Emporia State.

✓ **COACHES:** Since his appointment as the women's head coach prior to the 2000-01 season, **Ron McHenry** has quickly returned the Washburn women's basketball program to national prominence.

In only his third season in 2002-03, McHenry guided the Lady Blues to a regular season MIAA title, a Sonic/MIAA Tournament championship and a berth to the Division II Elite Eight. For his efforts he was named South Central Region Coach of the Year.

The Lady Blues tied for second most wins in team history at 30-4 and went to the Elite Eight for the third time

in team history. He has posted an 89-28 (.761) overall record during his career.

In his second season McHenry engineered one of the best turnarounds in Division II, guiding Washburn to the South Central Regional and finishing with a 23-7 record.

He guided the Lady Blues to back-to-back 20 win seasons after finishing with a 13-14 record in 2000-01, which was also his first season as a head coach at the collegiate level

McHenry was named the head coach on May 8, 2000.

He became only the fifth coach in the history of the women's basketball program at Washburn and the first new head coach since Patty Dick joined the Lady Blues as the head coach in the 1977-78 season.

Prior to his new appointment, McHenry spent the previous 11 seasons as a member of the men's basketball coaching staff under current coach Bob Chipman. While on the Washburn bench, he was a part of 243 wins. In addition to his basketball duties, McHenry was the men's golf coach for eight seasons.

McHenry has a bachelor's degree from Washburn in communications and a master's degree in sports administration from Wichita State. McHenry and his wife, Mischa, have three children, Danielle, Samantha and Ronnie

Scott Ballard, who is in his ninth season, has led the Jennies to an 167-88 record, seven Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association Post-Season Tournament berths, three NCAA tourney appearances and a share of one conference championship.

Ballard came to Central following five seasons as head coach at conference-rival Missouri Southern State College, where he led the Lady Lions to a 102-42 record

Ballard, whose twelve-year college coaching record is 269-130 (.708), went to MSSC following nine seasons as girls basketball coach at Marshfield (Mo.) High

✓ **SCOUTING THE JENNIES:** The Jennies are 15-11 and 8-9 in the MIAA after winning 66-62 win at Southwest Baptist Tuesday night. Jena Shackelford had 20 points, including five 3-pointers in the victory. She broke Lori Nichols school record (235) for 3-pointers and now has 240 in her career.

Shackelford leads Central with 14.4 points a game and has hit 65 3-pointers this season in 148 attempts. Ashley Millham is averaging 11.9 points a game, while Bethany Orendorff is averaging 11.7 points a game.

✓ WASHBURN LAST TIME OUT AT ESU FEB. 25, **2004:** EMPORIA, Kan. -- The No. 13 Washburn Lady Blues knocked the No. 4 Emporia State Lady Hornets and moved into a first-place tie with ESU with one game remaining in a 51-50 win. Carla Sintra scored a game-high 16 points including the tying and go-ahead free throws with 1.6 seconds remaining to seal the vic-

The Lady Blues were down as many as 12 points on two separate ocassions in the second half and trailed for 19:58.4 seconds of the half not tying or taking the lead until Sintra's free throws at the end of the game. The Lady Blues finished the game on a 23-10 run from the 12:01 mark when they were down 40-28 until the end of the game.

Both teams struggled from the field to open the second half as the first field was not connected on until the 15:06 mark of the half by ESU.

Sintra was joined in double figures by Brooke Ubelaker who had 10 points. The teams also combined for 1 of 19 shooting from 3-point land as the Lady Blues were 0 for 11 not hitting a shot from behind the arc in 89 games.

#### **✓ WASHBURN VS. ESU LEFTOVERS:**

✓ LADY BLUES IN THE NATIONAL STATS (THROUGH FEB. 22): Washburn was ranked fifth in scoring margin (+22.5), seventh in rebounding margin (+9.8), ninth in 3-point field goal percentage (39.3%), 30th in scoring offense (76.8), eighth in scoring defense (54.3), 13th in 3-pointers per game (7.3), 15th in opponent field goal percentage (35.5%) and 21st in field goal percentage (45.9%) as a team in the latest NCAA stats for games through

Burlington native Erin Menard is third in the nation in 3-point percentage (48.4%). Alison Garrett's 48.8 percent 3-point field goal percentage would lead the NCAA stats but Garrett does not have the 2.0 minimum 3-pointers per game to gualify.

#### **✓** BURLINGTON BOMBERS RAINING TREYS:

Burlington natives Erin Menard and Alison Garrett have been among the MIAA's and nation's best in making 3-pointers this season. Menard has the school record with 59 3-pointers this season in 124 attempts, while Garrett has hit 39 of 82 from beyond the arch this season.

Menard is first in the MIAA (third in NCAA stats) in 3-point field goal percentage at 47.6% and is third in the MIAA in 3-pointers made (2.27 3s per game.). Garrett is second in the MIAA in 3-point field goal percentage at 47.6%. Garrett does not have the minimum 2.0 3-pointers made per game to qualify for NCAA stats.

Menard's 10 3-pointers against Truman State Jan. 17 broke Brenda

Schaffer-Dahl (Feb. 16, 1988 vs. ESU) and Rhonda Matzke's (Jan. 30, 1993 vs. NEMSU-now TSU) school record of seven. UMSL's Laura Satterfield (vs. Tampa Nov. 11, 1994) and PSU's Jenni Miller (vs. TSU Jan. 28, 1995) own the MIAA record with 11 3-pointers. California's (Pa.) Lara Thornton set the NCAA Division II record with 12 3-pointers against Clarion March 5, 1994.

The 10 3-pointers were also the most in Division II this season. Carlee Howard of West Texas A&M also hit 10 3-pointers against Texas A&M-Commerce Feb. 19, 2004. Joy Gallagher of Division I Wagner is the only other women's player to hit more 3-pointers in a game this year with 11 3-pointers against Boston University Dec. 30, 2003.

Washburn point guards April Roadhouse and Juwanna Rivers have combined for 167 assists with only 101 turnovers. Roadhouse leads the MIAA with a 2.42 assist/turnover ratio with 87 assists and 36 turnovers, while Rivers is eighth with a 1.23 assist/turnover ratio with 80 assists and 65 turnovers. Roadhouse is also 9th in the MIAA with 3.35 assists a game.

Freshman Brooke Ubelaker has been making her mark in her freshman campaign. The Osborne, Kan. native has made 98 of 172 field goal attempts (57.0 percent) and 35 of 41 free throws (85.4 percent). Both percentages lead Washburn but are not included in MIAA and NCAA statistics because of minimum attempts.

Ubelaker is also the first freshman to be a regular starter since Nikki Olberding started 27 of 31 games in 1994-95. Laura Mueller was the last Washburn freshman to start every game by making 33 starts in 1988-89.

Ubelaker's 9.3 points per game average is the highest for a Washburn freshman since Olberding scored 12.2 a game in 1994-95.

**✔ BENCH BRIGADE:** Washburn's bench has scored 935 (47.4%) of the team's 1971 points this season. Montoya Whitfield (9.0 ppg), Erin Menard

(8.2 ppg) and Juwanna Rivers (8.1 ppg) are WU's top leading scorers off the bench. Starters Lora Westling and Carla Sintra are the only Washburn players in double figures scoring 10.4 and 11.2 points a game. Washburn's bench has outscored opponents bench players 935-371 (36.9-14.3 ppg).

✓ LADY BLUES WINNING BATTLE OF THE BOARDS: Washburn has outrebounded its first 25 opponents 1052-806 (40.5 to 31.0) to own a +9.8 rebounding margin. The Lady Blues had a season-high 53 rebounds against Northwest Missouri State Feb. 18.

The Lady Blues lead the MIAA and were seventh in the NCAA stats in rebounding margin. Washburn has been outrebounded four times this season (vs. Texas A&M-Kingsville, at Missouri-Rolla, Missouri Southern and at Truman State).

**✓ LADY BLUES IN LEE ARENA:** In their 18th season in Lee Arena, the Lady Blues are 243-53 (.821) overall at home. The longest winning streak was 44 games from Dec. 1, 1990 to March 20, 1993.

The Lady Blues were 16-1 in Lee Arena in 2002-03, outscoring opponents by an average of 71.1 to 56.2 (1209-955 points). The Lady Blues were 15-1 in Lee Arena in 2001-02.

Washburn won 44 straight homes game after capturing the South Central Regional Title 75-62 over Missouri Southern on March 20, 1993.

Washburn won also 19 straight games in Lee Arena before falling to Missouri Western 60-56 Jan 29, 2003. The last lost prior was 69-67 to Missouri Western on Jan. 2, 2002 in the MIAA opener in the 2001-02 season.

The Lady Blues had a 13-game home court winning streak snapped against ESU on Jan. 7. Washburn is 52-8 in home games under Ron McHenry.

✓ LADY BLUES HISTORY: Washburn is 570-311 (.647) in its 33rd season of intercollegiate action.

#### ✓ WBCA NATIONAL POLL (FEB. 24, 2004):

The Washburn Lady Blues were No. 13 in the WBCA National Poll after opening with a No. 13 ranking in the preseason poll.

The team received its first national ranking last season in the WBCA Division II Women's National Poll since the 1997-98 season, when it entered the poll in a tie for No. 24 in Dec. 11, 2002. The next poll will be released on Feb. 24.

#### ✓ SOUTH CENTRAL REGIONAL RANKINGS (FEB. 25, 2004):

The Lady Blues moved up to No. 4 in the South Central Region rankings released by the NCAA Wednesday. Three automatic qualifiers (MIAA, Lone Star and Heartland conference's champions) and five at-large teams will advance to the South Central Region tournament March 12-15 at a site to be determined.

✓ TURNING UP THE D: Under coach Ron McHenry the Lady Blues have been among the best in the MIAA and the nation in defensive statistics.

The Lady Blues **led** the MIAA and were **24th** in the nation in 2002-03 by holding opponents to **58.6** points a game, while improving even further this season.

In the final statistics report on in 2003, Washburn **led** the MIAA and was **12th** in the nation by holding opponents to **56.6** points a game.

The Lady Blues currently lead the MIAA and are **eighth** in the nation by holding opponents to **54.1** points a game.

✓ LADY BLUES NEARING 3-POINT RECORD: Washburn has also hit 183 3-pointers in the first 25 games, which puts the team on pace to break the record of 192 from the 2002-03 season. Washburn hit a school record 14 3-pointers and broke the MIAA record for attempts (40) against Truman on Jan. 17. Washburn leads the MIAA by hitting 38.4 percent beyond the arch and making 7.04 3-pointers a game.

#### ✓ WASHBURN TIP-INS:

- The Lady Blues have been the MIAA's best the last three seasons with a combined 43-10 record in league play from 2001-02 to 2003-04. Missouri Western (40-13), Emporia State (36-17) and Northwest Missouri (29-24) are the only other MIAA schools at .500 or better. Missouri Southern (26-27), Central Missouri (25-28), Southwest Baptist (24-29), Pittsburg State (24-29), Truman State (15-38) and Missouri-Rolla (3-50) are below .500.
- The Lady Blues have had excellent balance in scoring this season. Six different players have led the Lady Blues in scoring and six players average between 8.1-11.2 points. Carla Sintra's team-high 11.2 points a game would be the lowest average to lead the Washburn in team history. Kristy Chapman's 12.7 points a game led the Lady Blues in 2000-01 and was the lowest average to lead a team in school history.
- The Lady Blues average margin of victory 21.7 is well above the school record for margin of victory (+19.8) set in 1992-93. The Lady Blues won their first 11 straight games by 10 points or more. The streak tied the 1992-93 team, which won 11 straight by double figures. Washburn is 19-0 in games with double digit victory margins and 4-3 in single digit victory margins. Washburn leads the MIAA and is fifth in the nation in scoring margin.
- The Lady Blues were unranked in the Women's Division II Bulletin Preseason Poll. Washburn was 13th in the Women's WBCA Division II Preseason Poll.

The Lady Blues were also picked **second** in the **MIAA Preseason Coaches Poll.** Emporia State was ranked first in the poll.
