✓ **LADY BLUES NO. 2 SEED AT SONIC MIAA TOURNAMENT:** The second seeded Washburn Lady Blues open the Sonic MIAA Tournament 6 p.m. March 4 against No. 7 seed Pittsburg State in Municipal Auditorium. Washburn finished the regular season 24-3 overall and won a share of the MIAA regular season crown with a 15-3 conference record after a 59-57 win at Central Missouri State Saturday.

The Lady Blues are 51-21 in regular season MIAA play under Ron McHenry, including a league-best 44-10 record the past three seasons. The Lady Blues are 5-2 in the MIAA tournament under McHenry the past three seasons and are defending Sonic MIAA Tournament champions after beating Missouri Western 71-60.

✓ **COACHES:** Since his appointment as the women's head coach prior to the 2000-01 season, **Ron McHenry** has quickly returned the Washburn women's basketball program to national prominence.

In only his third season in 2002-03, McHenry guided the Lady Blues to a regular season MIAA title, a Sonic/MIAA Tournament championship and a berth to the Division II Elite Eight. For his efforts he was named South Central Region Coach of the Year.

The Lady Blues tied for second most wins in team history at 30-4 and went to the Elite Eight for the third time in team history. He has posted an **90-28 (.763)** overall record during his career.

In his second season McHenry engineered one of the best turnarounds in Division II, guiding Washburn to the South Central Regional and finishing with a 23-7 record.

Washburn won tournament titles in 1991-92, 1992-93 and 2002-03.

He guided the Lady Blues to back-to-back 20 win seasons after finishing with a 13-14 record in 2000-01, which was also his first season as a head coach at the collegiate level.

McHenry was named the head coach on May 8, 2000.

He became only the fifth coach in the history of the women's basketball program at Washburn and the first new head coach since Patty Dick joined the Lady Blues as the head coach in the 1977-78 season.

Prior to his new appointment, McHenry spent the previous 11 seasons as a member of the men's basketball coaching staff under current coach Bob Chipman. While on the Washburn bench, he was a part of 243 wins. In addition to his basketball duties, McHenry was the men's golf coach for eight seasons.

McHenry has a bachelor's degree from Washburn in communications and a master's degree in sports administration from Wichita State. McHenry and his wife, Mischa, have three children, Danielle, Samantha and Ronnie.

PSU head coach **Steve High** is in his 15th season at the helm of the Gorillas. High (Northern Iowa, '74) has compiled a 256-157 (.620) record as head coach at PSU, including two MIAA regular season titles ('92, '96) and five NCAA-II Tournament appearances ('92-93, '95, '97-98).

✓ **SCOUTING THE GORILLAS:** The Gorillas are 12-14 and 7-11 in the MIAA after beating Truman State 85-70 in the MIAA regular season finale Saturday night in John Lance Arena. Katie Spieker and Stephanie Shanline had 17 points apiece for PSU, while Kami Scrivner and Maggie Apt added 16 points apiece.

✓ **THE SERIES:** The Lady Blues swept the Gorillas in two games to improve to 34-24 in the all-time series with PSU. Washburn won 75-66 in Pittsburg on Jan. 28 and 67-37 in Lee Arena Feb. 4. Washburn has won the last six meetings between the two squads.

✓ **WASHBURN LAST TIME OUT AT CMSU FEB. 28, 2004:** WARRENSBURG, Mo. - The Washburn Lady Blues won a share of the MIAA regular season title with a 59-57 win over Central Missouri State Saturday afternoon at the CMSU Multipurpose Building.

Washburn, which improved to 24-3 and 15-3 in the MIAA, is the No. 2 seed in the Sonic MIAA Tournament March 4-7 and will face No. 7 seed Pittsburg State 6 p.m. Thursday night in Municipal Auditorium.

Central Missouri State had a chance to tie the game in the final seconds but Jena Shackelford's jumper on the left baseline rimmed out.

Montoya Whitfield led the Lady Blues with 15 points on 5 of 8 shooting from the field, including a 3-pointer. Carla Sintra had nine points and eight rebounds. Bethany Orendorff led CMSU with 21 points.

✓ WASHBURN VS. CMSU LEFTOVERS:

• Washburn won for the fifth straight time against Central Missouri State and for the second straight time in Warrensburg, Mo.

• Washburn won a share of the MIAA regular season title. It was Washburn's second straight title and third in school history.

• Washburn improved to 5-3 in games decided by single digit victory margins. WU won its fourth straight game with single digit victory margins.

• Washburn improved to 22-0 when holding opponents to 61 points or less. CMSU was the 12th WU opponent at 50 points or less.

✓ WASHBURN LAST MEETING WITH PSU FEB. 4,

2004: TOPEKA - The No. 9 Washburn Lady Blues extended their winning streak to six games with a 67-37 win over Pittsburg State in Lee Arena.

PSU's 37 points tied the fewest by a Washburn opponent in an MIAA game. Washburn topped Missouri Southern 73-37 Feb. 12, 1990 in its first year in the MIAA.

The Lady Blues took a 5-0 lead on Brooke Ubelaker's 3-pointer 53 seconds into the game and never trailed. Carla Sintra scored 10 of her game-high 16 points in the first half to help WU to a 25-19 lead at the break.

After Kami Scrivner's free throw pulled PSU within five in the opening seconds of the second half, Washburn expanded the lead to 39-22 with a 14-2 with 15:08 left. WU outscored the Gorillas 42-18 in the second half.

Ubelaker, Alison Garrett and Juwanna Rivers each had 10 points to compliment Sintra's 16. Scrivner led PSU with nine points. PSU hit only 13 of 48 (27.1 percent) of its field goal attempts.

✓ LADY BLUES RUNS LEADING TO BIG WINS:

Washburn has outscored opponents 75.2-54.2 in large part because of big runs in games this season. The Lady Blues have had 25 runs of 10 or more straight points in their first 27 games this season.

✓ **LADY BLUES IN THE NATIONAL STATS (THROUGH FEB. 29):** Washburn was ranked fifth in scoring margin (+22.5), seventh in rebounding margin (+9.8), ninth in 3-point field goal percentage (39.3%), 30th in scoring offense (76.8), eighth in scoring defense (54.3), 13th in 3-pointers per game (7.3), 15th in opponent field goal percentage (35.5%) and 21st in field goal percentage (45.9%) as a team in the latest NCAA stats for games through Feb. 22. Burlington native Erin Menard is third in the nation in 3-point percentage (48.4%). Alison Garrett's 48.8 percent 3-point field goal percentage would lead the NCAA stats but Garrett does not have the 2.0 minimum 3-pointers per game to qualify.

✓ BURLINGTON BOMBERS RAINING TREYS:

Burlington natives Erin Menard and Alison Garrett have been among the MIAA's and nation's best in making 3-pointers this season. Menard has the school record with 59 3-pointers this season in 126 attempts, while Garrett has hit 39 of 83 from beyond the arch this season.

Menard is first in the MIAA (third in NCAA stats) in 3-point field goal percentage at 46.8% and is third in the MIAA in 3-pointers made (2.19 3s per game.). Garrett would lead the MIAA in 3-point field goal percentage at 47.0%. Garrett does not have the minimum 1.5 3-pointers made per game to qualify for MIAA stats.

Menard's 10 3-pointers against Truman State Jan. 17 broke Brenda Schaffer-Dahl (Feb. 16, 1988 vs. ESU) and Rhonda Matzke's (Jan. 30, 1993 vs. NEMSU-now TSU) school record of seven. UMSL's Laura Satterfield (vs. Tampa Nov. 11, 1994) and PSU's Jenni Miller (vs. TSU Jan. 28, 1995) own the MIAA record with 11 3-pointers. California's (Pa.) Lara Thornton set the NCAA Division II record with 12 3-pointers against Clarion March 5, 1994.

The 10 3-pointers were also the most in Division II this season. Carlee Howard of West Texas A&M also hit 10 3-pointers against Texas A&M-Commerce Feb. 19, 2004. Joy Gallagher of Division I Wagner is the only other women's player to hit more 3-pointers in a game this year with 11 3-pointers against Boston University Dec. 30, 2003.

✓ DISHING IT OUT:

Washburn point guards April Roadhouse and Juwanna Rivers have combined for 172 assists with only 102 turnovers. Roadhouse leads the MIAA with a 2.50 assist/turnover ratio with 90 assists and 36 turnovers, while Rivers is eighth with a 1.24 assist/turnover ratio with 82 assists and 66 turnovers. Roadhouse is also 9th in the MIAA with 3.33 assists a game.

✓ FRESHMAN MAKING HER MARK:

Freshman Brooke Ubelaker has been making her mark in her freshman campaign. The Osborne, Kan. native has made 100 of 176 field goal attempts (57.0 percent) and 35 of 41 free throws (85.4 percent). Both percentages lead Washburn but are not included in MIAA and NCAA statistics because of minimum attempts.

Ubelaker is also the first freshman to be a regular starter since Nikki Olberding started 27 of 31 games in 1994-95. Laura Mueller was the last Washburn freshman to start every game by making 33 starts in 1988-89.

Ubelaker's 9.3 points per game average is the highest for a Washburn freshman since Olberding scored 12.2 a game in 1994-95.

✓ **BENCH BRIGADE:** Washburn's bench has scored 968 (47.7%) of the team's 2030 points this season. Montoya Whitfield (9.2 ppg), Juwanna Rivers (8.0 ppg) and Erin Menard (7.9 ppg) are WU's top leading scorers off the bench. Starters Carla Sintra and Lora Westling are the only Washburn players in double figures scoring 11.1 and 10.3 points a game. Washburn's bench has outscored opponents bench players 968-371 (35.9-14.3 ppg).

✓ **LADY BLUES WINNING BATTLE OF THE BOARDS:** Washburn has outrebounded its first 25 opponents 1052-806 (40.5 to 31.0) to own a +9.8 rebounding margin. The Lady Blues had a season-high 53 rebounds against Northwest Missouri State Feb. 18.

The Lady Blues lead the MIAA and were seventh in the NCAA stats in rebounding margin. Washburn has been outrebounded four times this season (vs. Texas A&M-Kingsville, at Missouri-Rolla, Missouri Southern and at Truman State).

✓ **LADY BLUES IN LEE ARENA:** In their 18th season in Lee Arena, the Lady Blues are 243-53 (.821) overall at home. The longest winning streak was 44 games from Dec. 1, 1990 to March 20, 1993.

The Lady Blues were 16-1 in Lee Arena in 2002-03, outscoring opponents by an average of 71.1 to 56.2 (1209-955 points). The Lady Blues were 15-1 in Lee Arena in 2001-02.

Washburn won 44 straight homes game after capturing the South Central Regional Title 75-62 over Missouri Southern on March 20, 1993.

Washburn won also 19 straight games in Lee Arena before falling to Missouri

Western 60-56 Jan 29, 2003. The last lost prior was 69-67 to Missouri Western on Jan. 2, 2002 in the MIAA opener in the 2001-02 season. The Lady Blues had a 13-game home court winning streak snapped against ESU on Jan. 7. Washburn is 52-8 in home games under Ron McHenry.

✓ **LADY BLUES HISTORY:** Washburn is 571-311 (.647) in its 33rd season of intercollegiate action.

✓ WBCA NATIONAL POLL (MARCH 2, 2004):

The Washburn Lady Blues were No. 11 in the latest WBCA National Poll after opening with a No. 13 ranking in the preseason poll.

The team received its first national ranking last season in the WBCA Division II Women's National Poll since the 1997-98 season, when it entered the poll in a tie for No. 24 in Dec. 11, 2002. The next poll will be released on March 9.

✓ SOUTH CENTRAL REGIONAL RANKINGS (MARCH 3, 2004):

The Lady Blues moved up to No. 3 in the South Central Region rankings released by the NCAA Wednesday. Three automatic qualifiers (MIAA, Lone Star and Heartland conference's champions) and five at-large teams will advance to the South Central Region tournament March 12-15 at a site to be determined.

✓ **TURNING UP THE D:** Under coach Ron McHenry the Lady Blues have been among the best in the MIAA and the nation in defensive statistics.

The Lady Blues led the MIAA and were 24th in the nation in 2002-03 by holding opponents to 58.6 points a game, while improving even further this season.

In the final statistics report on in 2003, Washburn led the MIAA and was 12th in the nation by holding opponents to 56.6 points a game.

The Lady Blues currently lead the MIAA and are eighth in the nation by holding opponents to 54.2 points a game.

✓ **LADY BLUES NEARING 3-POINT RECORD:** Washburn has also hit 185 3-pointers in the first 25 games, which puts the team on pace to break the record of 192 from the 2002-03 season. Washburn hit a school record 14 3-pointers and broke the MIAA record for attempts (40) against Truman on Jan. 17. Washburn leads the MIAA by hitting 38.1 percent beyond the arch and making 6.85 3-pointers a game.

✓ WASHBURN TIP-INS:

- The Lady Blues have been the MIAA's best the last three seasons with a combined 44-10 record in league play from 2001-02 to 2003-04. Missouri Western (41-13), Emporia State (37-17) and Northwest Missouri (30-24) are the only other MIAA schools at .500 or better. Missouri Southern (26-28), Central Missouri (25-29), Pittsburg State (25-29), Southwest Baptist (24-30), Truman State (15-39) and Missouri-Rolla (3-51) are below .500.

- The Lady Blues have had excellent balance in scoring this season. Six different players have led the Lady Blues in scoring and six players average between 7.9-11.1 points. Carla Sintra's team-high 11.1 points a game would be the lowest average to lead the Washburn in team history. Kristy Chapman's 12.7 points a game led the Lady Blues in 2000-01 and was the lowest average to lead a team in school history.

- The Lady Blues average margin of victory 21.0 is well above the school record for margin of victory (+19.8) set in 1992-93. The Lady Blues won their first 11 straight games by 10 points or more. The streak tied the 1992-93 team, which won 11 straight by double figures. Washburn is 19-0 in games with double digit victory margins and 5-3 in single digit victory margins. Washburn leads the MIAA and is fifth in the nation in scoring margin.

- The Lady Blues were unranked in the Women's Division II Bulletin Preseason Poll. Washburn was 13th in the Women's WBCA Division II Preseason Poll.

The Lady Blues were also picked second in the MIAA Preseason Coaches Poll. Emporia State was ranked first in the poll.
