✓ **THE GAME:** The Lady Blues have won five straight MIAA games heading into a 5:30 p.m. matchup with in-state rival Pittsburg State Saturday evening in Lee Arena. Washburn (21-3, 12-3 MIAA) is tied with Missouri Western (19-4, 12-3 MIAA) and Emporia State (19-5, 12-3 MIAA) for first in the conference standings.

Washburn leads the all-time series 31-24, including a 75-68 win in Pittsburg earlier this season. Washburn has won the last three meetings, including a sweep of the Gorillas last season. Senior Crystal Walker is averaging 21.3 points and 10.3 rebounds a game in Washburn's last three meetings with Pittsburg State. Walker had a stellar 26 point and 12 rebound performance in Washburn's last game with PSU in Lee Arena on Jan. 26, 2002 and broke a tie with a layup at the buzzer to give Washburn a 64-62 win.

✓ **LADY BLUES ON RADIO:** The game will be broadcast on AM 580-WIBW radio with Bruce Steinbrock calling play-by-play action and Mark Elliott adding the color commentary. The Ron McHenry show can be heard Thursday at 6 p.m. and is broadcast live from McB's Sports Bar, 4731 NW Hunters Ridge on AM 580 with Bruce Steinbrock.

✓ **THE COACHES:** Ron McHenry is in his third season on the bench for the Lady Blues, posting a 57-24 (.704) career record since being named the head coach on May 8, 2000.

He became only the fifth coach in the history of the women's basketball program at Washburn and the first new head coach since Dick joined the Lady Blues as the head coach in the 1977-78 season.

In only his second season as a head coach, McHenry engineered one of the best turn-arounds in NCAA Division II, guiding Washburn to a regional berth and a 23-7 record. McHenry guided the Lady Blues to his first 20-win season last year after posting a 13-14 mark in his first season as Lady Blues head coach.

Prior to his appointment, McHenry spent the previous 11 seasons as a member of the men's basketball coaching staff under current coach Bob Chipman. While on the Washburn bench, he was a part of 243 wins. In addition to his basketball duties, McHenry was the men's golf coach for eight seasons.

McHenry has had a diverse coaching career. He began his career as a graduate assistant to Chipman during the 1984-85 season. He then went on to Perry High School in 1986 where he served as assistant boys coach.

McHenry quickly moved up the coaching ranks in 1988 when he assumed an assistant's position with the Topeka Sizzlers of the Continental Basketball Association.

McHenry eventually became the Sizzlers' interim head coach before joining the Washburn staff for the 1989-90 campaign. During his first year on the Washburn staff, McHenry was the department's academic advisor.

McHenry played for Washburn after stints at Coffeyville Community College and the University of Kansas. He started for the Ichabods during the 1983-84 season.

He graduated from Washburn with a bachelor's degree in communications and went on to earn a master's degree in sports administration from Wichita State University in 1987.

McHenry and his wife, Mischa, have three children, Danielle, Samantha and Ronnie. Danielle played one season of volleyball for the University of Kansas and transferred this season to Washburn and was named to the All-MIAA first team as a Lady Blue and is also on the Lady Blue basketball squad.

Steve High is 243-140 in his 14th season at the helm of the Gorillas.

✓ LADY BLUES LAST TIME OUT FEB. 19
AGAINST EMPORIA STATE: TOPEKA — The
Washburn Lady Blues pulled into a threeway tie for first in the MIAA with a 65-57
win over Emporia State in Lee Arena
Wednesday night. The Lady Blues are tied
with ESU and Missouri Western at 12-3 in
the MIAA.

The Lady Blues took an early 15-8 lead on Ineke Ingram's layup with 11 minutes left in the opening half and maintained that margin after Ingram's 3-point play with 9:17 to make it 20-13.

Emporia State responded with a 12-0 run capped by Kristy McClain's 3-pointer with 5:47 left to make it 25-20 Emporia State. Alison Garrett canned her second 3-pointer of the night with 2:23 left to help the Lady Blues finish the half with a 7-1 run to take a halftime lead.

Washburn started the second half with a 20-6 run to take a 47-32 after consecutive

baskets by Carissa Goeglein with 9:12. Emporia State pulled within 56-52 on Nicole Patry's 3-pointer with 1:02 left.

Bethany McGraw iced the game by making six straight free throws in the final 39 seconds. McGraw made all nine free throws in the second half.

Crystal Walker led the Lady Blues with 12 points and eight rebounds, while Ingram finished with 11 points. Washburn outrebounded ESU 38-29.

✓ LADY BLUES LAST TIME VS. PITTS-BURG STATE JAN. 25, 2003: PITTSBURG, KAN - After losing for the first time Jan. 22, the No. 4 Washburn Lady Blues responded with a 75-68 win over in-state rival Pittsburg State Saturday night. The win improved Washburn's record to 16-1 and 7-1 in MIAA play. The Lady Blues are tied for first in the conference with Emporia State (14-3, 7-1 MIAA).

Washburn trailed by as many as seven points in the first half, before going on a 26-6 run to take a 36-23 lead on Crystal Walker's layup with 2:47 to go in the opening half. Kristy Chapman helped start the run by canning four first half 3-pointers to finish with a team-high 12 points in the opening half.

The Gorillas try to make a comeback and tied the game twice but could never gain the lead in the second half. The Lady Blues sealed the victory by hitting six straight free throws in the final 39 seconds.

Carissa Goeglein led Washburn with 20 points (10 in each half), while Walker and Chapman finished with 17 apiece. Walker went 8 of 12 from the field and recorded her 13th career double-double with 13 rebounds.

✓ **THE ALL-TIME SERIES:** Washburn is 31-24 in the all-time series against Pittsburg State after beating the Gorillas 75-68 in Pittsburg Jan. 25. The Lady Blues have won three straight in the series after sweeping

Washburn won the first game 64-62 in Topeka on Jan. 26 on Crystal Walker's layup at the buzzer. Walker scored a career-high 26 points and grabbed 12 rebounds. The Lady Blues followed with a 70-55 win Feb. 23 at Pittsburg.

Walker is averaging 21.3 points and 10.3 points a game in Washburn's last three games against the Gorillas.

✓ **ABOUT THE GORILLAS:** The Pittsburg State Gorillas fell 61-52 to Southwest Baptist in John Lance Arena Wednesday night. Tami Hennigh scored 13 points and Katie Spieker added 12 points. SBU's Amber Wheeler scored a career-high 25 points.

Amanda Davied averages 14.7 points and 5.7 assists a game. Kami Scrivner averages 13.8 points, while Stephanie Shanline and Spieker added 11.9 and 10.7 points a game respectively.

**✓ LADY BLUES IN LEE ARENA:** In their 18th season in Lee Arena, the Lady Blues are 225-52 (.812) overall at home. The longest winning streak was 44 games from Dec. 1, 1990 to March 20, 1993.

The Lady Blues were 15-1 in Lee Arena last season, outscoring opponents by an average of 75.6 to 59.9 (1209-959 points). Washburn's current home court winning streak is the longest since March 13, 1993, when Washburn won its 44th straight home game after capturing the South Central Regional Title 75-62 over Missouri Southern.

Washburn won 19 straight games in Lee Arena before falling to Missouri Western 60-56 Jan 29, 2003. The last lost prior was 69-67 to Missouri Western on Jan. 2, 2002 in the MIAA opener last season.

**✓ LADY BLUES HISTORY:** Washburn is 537-307 (.636) in its 33rd season of intercollegiate action.

## ✓ LATEST WBCA POLL (FEB. 19):

The Washburn Lady Blues stayed at No. 12 in the WBCA National Poll after entering the top 25 for the first time since 1997-98 earlier this season.

The team received its first national ranking in the WBCA Division II Women's National Poll since the 1997-98 season, when it entered the poll in a tie for No. 24 in Dec. 11, 2002 poll released by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association.

The ranking was Washburn's first since Dec. 27, 1997, when the squad opened the season with a 6-0 record to obtain a

No. 19 national ranking. The Lady Blues lost five straight games after the 6-0 start in 1997-98 and had not been in the WBCA National Poll until this season.

✓ TURNING UP THE D: Under coach
Ron McHenry the past two seasons, the
Lady Blue trademark has been defense.

The Lady Blues led the MIAA and were 24th in the nation last season by holding opponents to 58.6 points a game, while improving even further this season.

As of statistics on Feb. 16, 2003, Washburn led the MIAA and was 14th in the nation by holding opponents to 56.0 points a game.

✓ WALKER TURNING UP GAME FOR SECOND MVP RUN?: Senior Crystal Walker is stating her case for MIAA Most Valuable Player for a second straight season by averaging 17.1 points and 7.7 rebounds a game in conference play.

Walker netted a new career-high with 32 points, including 20 of Washburn's 28 points in the second half at Southwest Baptist Feb. 6.

Earlier in the season against Central Missouri State Walker became the 16th Lady Blue to score her 1000th career point and netted 22 of her 24 points in a second half comeback. She also grabbed her 500th rebound against Northwest Missouri State Jan. 15.

In conference games only, Walker is currently second in the MIAA in scoring (17.1) and sixth in rebounding (7.7). She is also second in field goal percentage (50.0), second in free throw percentage (84.5) and eighth in blocks (0.93).

✓ **SUPER SOPHOMORES GIVE SPARK TO WU LINEUP:** The Lady Blues traveled to Southwest Baptist and Missouri-Rolla sporting a new lineup for the first time since the second game of the season.

Washburn's five seniors (Crystal Walker, Carissa Goeglein, Bethany McGraw, Gosia Czarnecka and Kristy Chapman) started 17 straight games before a new lineup started at Southwest Baptist Feb. 6.

Sophomores Alison Garrett and Lora Westling joined Walker, Goeglein and McGraw in the starting lineup.

Garrett and Westling are averaging 9.8 and 7.0 points a game respectively in their five games since earning the starting nod.

✓ BLUE DEFENSE KEY TO FIVE GAME WINNING STEAK: The Lady Blues have also turned up their defense in their current five-game winning streak, holding

opponents to 50.8 points a game. The Lady Blues have held opponents to 34.5 percent from the floor and 25.3 percent from 3-point field goal range in the last five.

**▶ BURLINGTON BOMBER HEATING UP BEYOND THE ARCH:** After hitting the second most 3-pointers (24) ever by a Washburn freshman last season, Alison Garrett struggled in non-conference play earlier this season by hitting only 8 of 37 (21.6 percent) 3-pointers.

The Burlington, Kan. native has reversed her sophomore slump by hitting 13 of her last 16 (81.3 percent) since joining the starting lineup five games ago. She is now 28 of 56 (50 percent in MIAA play). Her pecentage is best among all MIAA players in league play.

# **✓ WASHBURN TIP-INS:**

- With a win over Central Missouri State Saturday, Washburn posted its second straight 20-win season for the first time since going 22-8 in 1993-94 and following with a 24-7 record in 1994-95.
- In their three losses the Lady Blues are shooting 36.4 percent (63 of 173) from the field, including 24.1 percent (14 of 58) from 3-point range.

Washburn is 44.4 percent (531 of 1197) from the field and 36.6 percent (118 of 322) from 3-point range in its 21 victories.

• Crystal Walker is averaging 16.8 points and 7.4 rebounds a game in MIAA regular season play the last two seasons. She has scored 555 points and grabbed 244 rebounds in those 33 conference games.

She also became the 16th Washburn player to score 1000 points and 14th player to score 1000 points and grab 500 rebounds earlier this season.

• Kristy Chapman is 20th in career scoring with 898 points and has 107 career 3-pointers. She is just four 3-pointers away from breaking Brenda Shaffer-Dahl's career record of 110.

• Washburn has outscored opponents 68.5 to 56.0 this season and has outrebounded opponents 37.6 to 31.8. The Lady Blues lead the MIAA in both categories.

The Lady Blues were 23rd in scoring margin in the nation (+12.6) when the NCAA statistics report was released Feb. 16. Washburn was also 16th in free throw percentage (75.6 percent).

- Washburn has outshot opponents in 19 of 24 games this season. The Lady Blues have held the opposition to under 50 percent from the field in every game.
- Washburn's starting frontcourt, Crystal Walker and Carissa Goeglein were both selected as preseason All-America players by the Women's Division II Bulletin, a publication focused solely on women's Division II basketball.
- The Lady Blues were picked 16th in the Women's Division II Bulletin Preseason Poll.

The Lady Blues were also picked second in the MIAA Preseason Coaches Poll. Defending conference champion Missouri Western was ranked No. 1 in the poll.
