Washburn vs. Drury

✓ **THE GAME:** The Washburn Lady Blues host the Drury University Lady Panthers in Lee Arena tonight.

✓ **LADY BLUES ON RADIO:** The game will be broadcast in northeast Kansas on KWIC 99.3 Topeka, Kansas, with Ron Simon and Curtis Kitchen calling the action. Simon is in his 14th season as the play-by-play man for the Ichabods and Lady Blues. The Washburn coaches show is at McB's Sports Bar on Thursday's from 6-7 p.m and can be heard on KMAJ 1440 AM.

✓ **THE COACHES:** Ron McHenry is in his second season on the bench for the Lady Blues, posting a 18-15 (.545) career record.

McHenry was named the head coach on May 8, 2000, taking over for Patty Dick, who retired in April.

He became only the fifth coach in the history of the women's basketball program at Washburn and the first new head coach since Dick joined the Lady Blues as the head coach in the 1977-78 season.

McHenry led Washburn to a 13-14 record in his first season, which was also his first season as a head coach at the collegiate level.

Prior to his new appointment, McHenry spent the previous 11 seasons as a member of the men's basketball coaching staff under current coach Bob Chipman. While on the Washburn bench, he was a part of 243 wins. In addition to his basketball duties, McHenry was the men's golf coach for eight seasons.

McHenry has had a diverse coaching career. He began his career as a graduate assistant to Chipman during the 1984-85 season. He then went

on to Perry High School in 1986 where he served as assistant boys coach.

McHenry quickly moved up the coaching ranks in 1988 when he assumed an assistant's position with the Topeka Sizzlers of the Continental Basketball Association. McHenry eventually became the Sizzlers' interim head coach before joining the Washburn staff for the 1989-90 campaign. During his first year on the Washburn staff, McHenry was the department's academic advisor.

McHenry played for Washburn after stints at Coffeyville Community College and the University of Kansas. He started for the Ichabods during the 1983-84 season.

He graduated from Washburn with a bachelor's degree in communications and went on to earn a master's degree in sports administration from Wichita State University in 1987.

McHenry and his wife, Mischa, have three children, Danielle, Samantha and Ronnie. Danielle is a freshman on the University of Kansas volleyball team.

Nyla Milleson is in her second season at the helm of the Lady Panthers, owning a **26-9** record.

✓ **ABOUT DRURY:** The Lady Panthers are 6-3 after a 76-67 victory over Southwest Baptist in Springfield, Mo. Wednesday night. The Lady Panthers are in their second season of intercollegiate basketball and own a 26-9 overall record.

Jill Curry leads Drury with a 17.8 point and 7.0 rebound per game average. Stacy West and Megan Brunson each average double figures in scoring with 15.6 and 10.0 points a game respectively. West leads the team with a 8.1 rebounds a game average.

Drury is 2-1 against MIAA opponents this season, topping SBU and

Central Missouri State, but falling to Pittsburg State.

✓ LADY BLUES LAST TIME OUT:

The Lady Blues dropped their first game of the year in a 63-60 loss at Missouri-St. Louis Monday night.

After falling behind by as many as eight in the opening half, Washburn rallied to take a 29-26 halftime lead on Crystal Walker's jumper with nine seconds left.

The two squads struggled back and forth for the lead in the second half, before UMSL's Christy Lane made her first 3-pointer in six tries to give the Riverwomen the lead for good at 60-59 with 1:00 left.

The Lady Blues fell behind by three and had several chances to tie, before poor shooting 22 of 70 (31.4%) finally doomed the squad.

✓ **SERIES NOTES:** Tonight's meeting is the first between the two squads.

✓ LADY BLUES IN LEE ARENA:

In 17 seasons in Lee Arena, the Lady Blues are 201-50 (.801). The Lady Blues were 8-5 at home last season. The longest winning streak was 44 games from Dec. 1, 1990 to March 20, 1993.

✓ LADY BLUES HISTORY:

Washburn is 499-297 (.626) in its 33rd season of intercollegiate action.

✓ WASHBURN TIP-INS:

- Kristy Chapman moved into 30th place in career scoring at Washburn with a 12-point performance Monday. Chapman has 536 career points.

- Washburn needs only one more victory to become the 28th team in NCAA Division II women's basketball history to with 500 games.
