Washburn vs. Central Missouri State

✓ THE GAME: The Washburn Lady Blues (11-3, 4-2 MIAA) travel to Warrensburg, Mo. to take on Central Missouri State (12-5, 3-3 MIAA).

Washburn is off to its best start since 1993-94, when the squad opened 11-3 and is looking to win five straight MIAA games for the first time since Jan. 23, 1999.

✓ LADY BLUES ON RADIO: The game will be broadcast in northeast Kansas on KWIC 99.3 Topeka, Kansas, with Ron Simon and Curtis Kitchen calling the action. Simon is in his 14th season as the play-by-play man for the Ichabods and Lady Blues. The Washburn coaches show is at McB's Sports Bar on Thursday's from 6-7 p.m and can be heard on KMAJ 1440 AM.

✓ **THE COACHES:** Ron McHenry is in his second season on the bench for the Lady Blues, posting a 24-17 (.585) career record.

McHenry was named the head coach on May 8, 2000, taking over for Patty Dick, who retired in April.

He became only the fifth coach in the history of the women's basketball program at Washburn and the first new head coach since Dick joined the Lady Blues as the head coach in the 1977-78 season.

McHenry led Washburn to a 13-14 record in his first season, which was also his first season as a head coach at the collegiate level.

Prior to his new appointment, McHenry spent the previous 11 seasons as a member of the men's basketball coaching staff under current coach Bob Chipman. While on the Washburn bench, he was a part of 243 wins. In addition to his basketball duties, McHenry was the men's golf coach for eight seasons.

McHenry has had a diverse coaching career. He began his career as a graduate assistant to Chipman during the 1984-85 season. He then went on to Perry High School in 1986 where he served as assistant boys coach.

McHenry quickly moved up the coaching ranks in 1988 when he assumed an assistant's position with the Topeka Sizzlers of the Continental Basketball Association. McHenry eventually became the Sizzlers' interim head coach before joining the Washburn staff for the 1989-90 campaign. During his first year on the Washburn staff, McHenry was the department's academic advisor.

McHenry played for Washburn after stints at Coffeyville Community College and the University of Kansas. He started for the Ichabods during the 1983-84 season.

He graduated from Washburn with a bachelor's degree in communications and went on to earn a master's degree in sports administration from Wichita State University in 1987.

McHenry and his wife, Mischa, have three children, Danielle, Samantha and Ronnie. Danielle is a freshman on the University of Kansas volleyball team.

Scott Ballard is in his seventh season at the helm of the Jennies, compling a 133-56 record. Ballard is 234-97 in his 12-year career, which began at Missouri Southern.

✓ **ABOUT THE JENNIES:** The Jennies are 12-5 and 3-3 in MIAA play after crusing past Missouri-Rolla 72-46 in Rolla Wednesday night.

Jena Shackelford leads a balanced attack for the Jennies, averaging 13.6 points and 3.2 rebounds a game. Kinsey Lehe and Lori Nichols average 9.9 and 9.1 points a game respectively for Central Missouri State.

✓ LADY BLUES LAST TIME OUT:

The Washburn Lady Blues improved to 11-3 (4-2 MIAA) for the first time since 1993-94 with a 77-65 win over Northwest Missouri State in Lee Arena Wednesday night.

The game was tied at the half 35 apiece, before Washburn staged one of its trademark runs in the second half.

The Lady Blues capped a 12-0 run to make it 59-45 at the 10 minute mark on Maggie Diehl's layup.

The run was the eighth time during the season that Washburn has scored at least 10 straight points during a game. Northwest never go within 10 points the remainder of the game.

Kristy Chapman led the way for Washburn with 14 points, including two 3-pointers, while Diehl added a career-high 13 points off the bench. Jovanae St. Cyr added 10 points and seven rebounds.
