# Washburn at Missouri Western

✓ **THE GAME:** The Washburn Lady Blues (13-4, 6-3 MIAA) travel to St. Joseph, Mo. to take on No. 2 ranked Missouri Western (16-1, 8-1) 5:30 Wednesday night. The Lady Blues have won six of their last seven games.

Washburn is off to its best start since the 1994-95 season, when the Lady Blues opened with a 15-4 record to begin the season. Washburn is looking to snap an eight-game losing skid in the series against Missouri Western and is also looking to end an eight-game losing skid at MWSC Fieldhouse.

✓ **LADY BLUES ON RADIO:** The game will be broadcast in northeast Kansas on KWIC 99.3 Topeka, Kansas, with Ron Simon and Curtis Kitchen calling the action. Simon is in his 14th season as the play-by-play man for the Ichabods and Lady Blues. The Washburn coaches show is at McB's Sports Bar on Thursday's from 6-7 p.m and can be heard on KMAJ 1440 AM.

✓ **THE COACHES:** Ron McHenry is in his second season on the bench for the Lady Blues, posting a 26-18 (.591) career record since being named the head coach on May 8, 2000.

He became only the fifth coach in the history of the women's basketball program at Washburn and the first new head coach since Dick joined the Lady Blues as the head coach in the 1977-78 season.

McHenry led Washburn to a 13-14 record in his first season, which was also his first season as a head coach at the collegiate level.

Prior to his new appointment, McHenry spent the previous 11 seasons as a member of the men's basketball coaching staff under current coach Bob Chipman. While on the Washburn bench, he was a part of 243 wins. In addition to his basketball duties, McHenry was the men's golf coach for eight seasons.

McHenry has had a diverse coaching career. He began his career as a graduate assistant to Chipman during the 1984-85 season. He then went on to Perry High School in 1986 where he served as assistant boys coach.

McHenry quickly moved up the coaching ranks in 1988 when he assumed an assistant's position with the Topeka Sizzlers of the Continental Basketball Association. McHenry eventually became the Sizzlers' interim head coach before joining the Washburn staff for the 1989-90 campaign. During his first year on the Washburn staff, McHenry was the department's academic advisor.

McHenry played for Washburn after stints at Coffeyville Community College and the University of Kansas. He started for the Ichabods during the 1983-84 season.

He graduated from Washburn with a bachelor's degree in communications and went on to earn a master's degree in sports administration from Wichita State University in 1987.

McHenry and his wife, Mischa, have three children, Danielle, Samantha and Ronnie. Danielle is a freshman on the University of Kansas volleyball team.

Dave Slifer is in his seventh season with the Griffons, compiling a 150-50 (.750) record at Western and 330-80 (.805) record overall in 13 seasons. Slifer is 13-3 against Washburn.

✓ **ABOUT THE GRIFFONS:** The Griffons are ranked No. 2 in the WBCA National Poll and are 16-1 (8-1 MIAA) after topping Southwest Baptist 77-69 in Bolivar, Mo. Saturday night. JoAnna Stuelke, subbing for the injured Nicole Lindsey, led Western with 18.

Lindsey, who is currently out with an injury, leads the team and the MIAA with 19.9 points and 8.3 rebounds a game. Krista Small is the only other Griffon in double-figures with 12.4 points a game.

# ✓ LADY BLUES AND LADY GRIFFONS LAST TIME OUT:

The Washburn Lady Blues rallied but fell short 69-67 to No. 5 Missouri Western in Lee Arena Wednesday night.

After trailing 62-51 with eight minutes left, Washburn pulled within 68-67 on Crystal Walker's layup with 42 seconds left.

After a Griffon missed shot, the Lady Blues had a chance to take the lead with just seconds remaining but Kristy Chapman's shot fell off hard.

The Lady Blues had four starters in double figures led by Chapman and Carissa Goeglein who had 14 apiece. Nicole Lindsey led Missouri Western with 22 points and 10 rebounds.

#### ✓ LADY BLUES LAST TIME OUT:

Crystal Walker's layup at the buzzer lifted the Washburn Lady Blues to a 64-62 victory over the Pittsburg State Gorillas Saturday night.

Walker, who scored a career-high 26 points, took a pass near the free throw line and drove for her third straight basket down the stretch for the Lady Blues. Walker tallied 16 points in the second half and shot 10 of 14 from the field.

After trailing 32-30 at the half, Washburn opened the second half with a 8-1 run to make it 38-33. The teams traded baskets during the rest of the game, before Walker took control late.

The win was Washburn's first in seven attempts against the Gorillas in Lee Arena and second win the in the last 12 meetings in the series.

Walker recorded her eighth double-double of the season by adding 12 rebounds, while Carissa Goeglein added 12 points and seven rebounds.

## **✓ WASHBURN TIP-INS:**

- The Lady Blues have held 20 straight opponents under 70 points, dating back to a 76-50 loss at Missouri Western on Feb. 17, 2001.
- Washburn is 11-0 this season when outshooting opponents from the field, while going 2-4 in games when

being outshot by opponents.

- With a win last Saturday, Washburn won six of seven conference games for the first time since Jan. 29, 1997 when the Lady Blues won their sixth straight at Emporia State.
- Washburn was ranked in the top 15 in the nation in several team categories in the NCAA Division II stats released last Monday (Jan. 21). The Lady Blues were 13th in scoring defense (56.5 ppg), 19th in scoring margin (+14.1 ppg) and 29th in rebounding margin (+6.9 rpg).
