Washburn vs. Southwest Baptist

✓ **THE GAME:** The Washburn Lady Blues (15-5, 8-4 MIAA) host Southwest Baptist (13-7, 6-6 MIAA) for MIAA game tonight.

Washburn is ranked No. 5 in the latest South Central Regional poll. Washburn is 10 games over .500 overall for the first time since the 1996-97 season, when the Lady Blues started 15-5 and finished 19-8.

✓ LADY BLUES ON RADIO: The game will be broadcast in northeast Kansas on KWIC 99.3 Topeka, Kansas, with Ron Simon and Curtis Kitchen calling the action. Simon is in his 14th season as the play-by-play man for the Ichabods and Lady Blues. The Washburn coaches show is at McB's Sports Bar on Thursday's from 6-7 p.m and can be heard on KMAJ 1440 AM.

✓ **THE COACHES:** Ron McHenry is in his second season on the bench for the Lady Blues, posting a 27-19 (.587) career record since being named the head coach on May 8, 2000.

He became only the fifth coach in the history of the women's basketball program at Washburn and the first new head coach since Dick joined the Lady Blues as the head coach in the 1977-78 season.

McHenry led Washburn to a 13-14 record in his first season, which was also his first season as a head coach at the collegiate level.

Prior to his new appointment, McHenry spent the previous 11 seasons as a member of the men's basketball coaching staff under current coach Bob Chipman. While on the Washburn bench, he was a part of 243 wins. In addition to his basketball duties, McHenry was the men's golf coach for eight seasons.

McHenry has had a diverse coaching career. He began his career as a graduate assistant to Chipman during the 1984-85 season. He then went on to Perry High School in 1986 where he served as assistant boys coach.

McHenry quickly moved up the coaching ranks in 1988 when he assumed an assistant's position with the Topeka Sizzlers of the Continental Basketball Association. McHenry eventually became the Sizzlers' interim head coach before joining the Washburn staff for the 1989-90 campaign. During his first year on the Washburn staff, McHenry was the department's academic advisor.

McHenry played for Washburn after stints at Coffeyville Community College and the University of Kansas. He started for the Ichabods during the 1983-84 season.

He graduated from Washburn with a bachelor's degree in communications and went on to earn a master's degree in sports administration from Wichita State University in 1987.

McHenry and his wife, Mischa, have three children, Danielle, Samantha and Ronnie. Danielle is a freshman on the University of Kansas volleyball team.

Jim Middleton is in his eighth season at SBU, posting a 150-60 overall record.

✓ **ABOUT THE LADY BEARCATS:** The Bearcats are 13-7 after beating Missouri-Rolla 68-52 in Bolivar Monday night. Erin Easterly scored 25 points, while Carrie Long added 14 points for the Lady Bearcats.

Long leads the team with a 17.6 scoring average this season, while Easterly averages 16.8 points and a team-high 8.9 rebounds a game.

✓ LADY BLUES AND LADY BEARCATS LAST TIME OUT:

The Lady Blues snapped a longstanding road losing skid in Bolivar, Mo. with a convincing 85-53 victory over Southwest Baptist on Jan. 10.

The win was Washburn's first over the Lady Bearcats in Bolivar since Jan. 11, 1992, snapping a 7-game skid over that span on the road in the series.

After leading 38-31 at the half, Washburn traded baskets with the Lady Bearcats before errupting with 18 minutes left.

The Lady Blues went on a 25-0 run on Lora Westling's spinning layup to take a 67-35 lead and never looked back.

Carissa Goeglein finished the game with a career-high 25 points and eight rebounds, while Crystal Walker added 14 points.

Westling added 10 points and five assists off the bench for the Lady Blues, who capped their largest MIAA victory since a 90-52 win at Missouri-Rolla Feb. 13, 1999.

✓ LADY BLUES LAST TIME OUT:

The Lady Blues picked up a big South Central Region win on the road against the Missouri Southern Lady Lions 73-60. The win moved the Lady Blues to 15-5 and 7-4 in conference play.

With the win, the Lady Blues move into a second place tie with the Lady Lions, but they would have the tie breaker after beating them in both meetings.

In the first half the Lady Blues shot 61 percent from the field hitting 16 of 26 shots including 3 of 5 from behind the arc holding

a 13-11 advantage on the boards taking a 40-34 lead into the break.

Missouri Southern, keeping pace with the Lady Blues hit 50 percent of its shots hitting 13 of 26 shots - 5 of 8 from 3-point land.

Neither team led by more than six in the first half with six lead changes in the first half.

In the second half, the Lady Blues cooled off from the field hitting 12 of 30 shots, but were 8 of 11 from the free line while maintaining their two rebound margin. The Lady Lions would take the lead at 53-52 with 11:09 remaining, but the Lady Blues would go on a 8-0 run over the next 5-plus minutes to put Missouri Southern away.

The Lady Blues were led by Carissa Goeglein who scored 22 points on 9 of 14 shooting. She scored 12 of those in the second half. Crystal Walker scored 18.

✓ **SERIES NOTES:** Tonight's game is the 21st meeting between the schools. The all-time series is tied at 10-10, after the Lady Blues snapped a four-game losing streak in the series earlier this season. SBU has won 8 of the last 10 meetings.

∠ LADY BLUES IN LEE ARENA: In 17 seasons in Lee Arena, the Lady Blues are 210-51 (.805). The Lady Blues were 8-5 at home last season, The longest winning streak was 44 games from Dec. 1, 1990 to March 20, 1993.

The Lady Blue are 10-1 in Lee Arena this season, outscoring opponents by an average of 76.5 to 58.0.

✓ WASHBURN TIP-INS:

- The Lady Blues have held opponents from shooting over 50% from the field for 25 straight games, dating back to last season when Pittsburg State was the last team to hit over 50% on a 26 of 50 (52%) performance on Feb. 10. Monday Missouri Southern shot exactly 50% on 23-of-46 shooting.
- After holding 20 straight opponents under 70 points, the Lady Blues surrendered a 72-64 loss at Missouri Western Wednesday night. Missouri Western was also the last team to break 70 points in 76-50 victory over Washburn on Feb. 17, 2001.
- Washburn is 12-0 this season when outshooting opponents from the field, while going 2-5 in games when being outshot by opponents. Washburn is 1-0 when shooting the same percentage as opponents.
- In Monday's win over Missouri Southern, Washburn shot 50% or better 28-of-56 (50%) for the sixth time this season. Washburn has won all six games, when it has shot 50% or better.
- Washburn was ranked in the top 30 in the nation in two team categories in the NCAA Division II stats released last Monday (Jan. 28). The Lady Blues were 20th in scoring defense (57.1 ppg), 26th in scoring margin (+13.1 ppg).
