✓ **THE GAME:** The Washburn Lady Blues (20-5, 13-4 MIAA) travel to Pittsburg State (16-9, 10-7 MIAA) for a 5:30 p.m. contest Saturday night. Washburn is 7-0 in the month of February, riding a seven-game winning streak into the game.

Washburn has secured second place in the MIAA and a No. 2 spot in the MIAA tournament. The Lady Blues are trying to secure a berth in the NCAA Division II tournament for the first time since 1994-95, which was also the last time Washburn had a 20-win season (24-7) prior to the 2001-02 campaign.

The Lady Blues are also trying to earn a sweep over Pittsburg State for the first time since the 1988-89 season, when they beat the Gorillas three times en route to a NAIA National Tournament berth.

✓ **LADY BLUES ON RADIO:** The game will be broadcast in northeast Kansas on KWIC 99.3 Topeka, Kansas, with Ron Simon and Curtis Kitchen calling the action. Simon is in his 14th season as the play-by-play man for the Ichabods and Lady Blues. The Washburn coaches show is at McB's Sports Bar on Thursday's from 6-7 p.m and can be heard on KMAJ 1440 AM.

✓ **THE COACHES:** Ron McHenry is in his second season on the bench for the Lady Blues, posting a 33-19 (.634) career record since being named the head coach on May 8, 2000.

He became only the fifth coach in the history of the women's basketball program at Washburn and the first new head coach since Dick joined the Lady Blues as the head coach in the 1977-78 season.

McHenry led Washburn to a 13-14 record in his first season, which was also his first season as a head coach at the collegiate level.

Prior to his new appointment, McHenry spent the previous 11 seasons as a member of the men's basketball coaching staff under current coach Bob Chipman. While on the Washburn bench, he was a part of 243 wins. In addition to his basketball duties, McHenry was the men's golf coach for eight seasons.

McHenry has had a diverse coaching career. He began his career as a graduate assistant to Chipman during the 1984-85 season. He then went on to Perry High School in 1986 where he served as assistant boys coach.

McHenry quickly moved up the coaching ranks in 1988 when he assumed an assistant's position with the Topeka Sizzlers of the Continental Basketball Association. McHenry eventually became the Sizzlers' interim head coach before joining the Washburn staff for the 1989-90 campaign. During his first year on the Washburn staff, McHenry was the department's academic advisor.

McHenry played for Washburn after stints at Coffeyville Community College and the University of Kansas. He started for the Ichabods during the 1983-84 season.

He graduated from Washburn with a bachelor's degree in communications and went on to earn a master's degree in sports administration from Wichita State University in 1987.

McHenry and his wife, Mischa, have three children, Danielle, Samantha and Ronnie. Danielle is a freshman on the University of Kansas volleyball team.

**Steve High** is in his 13th season at Pittsburg State, owing a 231-126 record. He is 13-9 against the Lady Blues in his career.

✓ **ABOUT THE GORILLAS:** The Gorillas improved to 16-9 and 10-7 in the MIAA with a 67-57 win at Southwest Baptist Tuesday night. Katie Spieker led the way with 15 points, while Bethany Turnbull added 13 rebounds.

Kami Scrivner leads the team in scoring with 12.3 points per game, while Amanda Davied is the only other Gorillas in double figures in scoring with 10.9 a game. Turnbull leads PSU with 7.7 rebounds a game.

### ✓ LADY BLUES AND GORILLAS LAST TIME OUT:

TOPEKA.- Crystal Walker's layup at the buzzer lifted the Washburn Lady Blues to a 64-62 victory over the Pittsburg State Gorillas on Jan. 26.

Walker, who scored a career-high 26 points, took a pass near the free throw line and drove for her third straight basket down the stretch for the Lady Blues. Walker tallied 16 points in the second half and shot 10 of 14 from the field.

After trailing 32-30 at the half, Washburn opened the second half with a 8-1 run to make it 38-33. The teams traded baskets during the rest of the game, before Walker took control late.

The win was Washburn's first in seven attempts against the Gorillas in Lee Arena and second win in the last 12 meetings in the series.

Walker recorded her eighth double-double of the season by adding 12 rebounds, while Carissa Goeglein added 12 points and seven rebounds.

### ✓ LADY BLUES LAST TIME OUT:

The Washburn Lady Blues secured second place and a No. 2 seed in the MIAA Tournament with a 79-70 victory over Emporia State at White Auditorium Wednesday night.

The victory, which gave Washburn its first seven-game MIAA winning streak since 1994, secured Washburn's first 20-win season for the first time since 1994-95.

After scoring the first six points of the game, Washburn surrendered a 16-11 lead with 13:30 to play in the opening half. After the Lady Hornets made it 33-22, Washburn pulled within 33-28 at the half when Lora Westling capped a 6-0 run with a layup to help Washburn pull within 35-30 at the half.

The Lady Hornets led by as many as six in the second half before Washburn took a lead on Bethany McGraw's two free throws, making it 47-46 with 14:16 to play.

Washburn pulled away and led by as many as 10 down the stretch to secure the victory, behind Crystal Walker's 13-point effort in the second half. She finished with 21 in the game, while Kristy Chapman had 11 points and six assists.

✓ **SERIES NOTES:** Tonight's game is the 54th meeting between the two schools, with Washburn owning a 29-24 advantage in the series after a win earlier this season. Pittsburg State has won 10 of the last 12 meetings in the series and six of the last seven in Pittsburg.

✓ **LADY BLUES IN LEE ARENA:** In 17 seasons in Lee Arena, the Lady Blues are 212-51 (.806). The Lady Blues were 8-5 at home last season, The longest winning streak was 44 games from Dec. 1, 1990 to March 20, 1993.

The Lady Blues are 13-1 in Lee Arena this season, outscoring opponents by an average of 76.6 to 59.6.

✓ **LADY BLUES HISTORY:** Washburn is 514-301 (.631) in its 33rd season of intercollegiate action.

✓ **SPURTABILITY:** The Lady Blues have staged runs of at least 10 straight points in 11 games this season.

✓ **A BALANCED ACT:** In its 94-85 victory over Central Missouri Saturday night, Washburn had six players in double figures in scoring for the first team since the team joined the MIAA. Crystal Walker had 21 points, Carissa Goeglein 14, Jovanae St. Cyr 11, Kristy Chapman 11, Latasha Moore 11 and Alison Garrett 10 for the Lady Blues.

It is also believed that the feat was the first in Washburn's 33-year history. In records kept from the 1987-88 season to present, Washburn had not had more than five players in double figures in any game.

### ✓ MIAA MVP RACE – CRYSTAL CLEAR?:

Washburn forward Crystal Walker is posting MVP-like numbers this season, averaging 16.4 points a game (4th in MIAA), 7.8 rebounds a game (4th in MIAA) and hitting 166 of 316 shots from the field for 52.5% (1st in MIAA). She has also been named MIAA Player of the Week twice this season. The last Lady Blue to earn MVP honors was Shelly Foster in 1993-94.

### ✓ WASHBURN TIP-INS:

- The Lady Blues have held opponents from shooting over 50% from the field for 30 straight games, dating back to last season when Pittsburg State was the last team to hit over 50% on a 26 of 50 (52%) performance on Feb. 10. Missouri Southern shot exactly 50% on 23-of-46 shooting against the Lady Blues on Feb. 4.

- Washburn is 17-0 this season when outshooting opponents from the field, while going 2-5 in games when being outshot by opponents. Washburn is 1-0 when shooting the same percentage as opponents.

- Washburn is a perfect 7-0 when it has shot 50% or better.

- Washburn was ranked in the top 30 in the nation in two team categories in the NCAA Division II stats released last Monday (Feb. 18). The Lady Blues were 29th in field goal percentage (44.3%), 20th in scoring margin (+12.8 ppg).

- Washburn is 14-0 when scoring at least 68 points this season.

- The Lady Blues are 7-0 in the month of February, winning games by an average of 76.7 to 62.0.

- Washburn's 94-point total was the most it had scored since a MIAA game since a 120-86 win over UMSL on Feb. 23, 1991. The Lady Blues also surrendered the most points in a game since an 89-85 overtime victory over Truman State
