Washburn vs Southwestern

✓ **THE GAME:** The Washburn Lady Blues open the 2001-02 season at home against the Southwestern College. Southwestern enters the game with a 2-1 record after falling at Oklahoma Christian 70-65 Monday night.

✓ **LADY BLUES ON RADIO:** The game will be broadcast in northeast Kansas on KWIC 99.3 Topeka, Kansas, with Ron Simon calling the action. Simon is in his 14th season as the play-by-play man for the Ichabods and Lady Blues. The Washburn coaches show is at McB's Sports Bar on Thursday's from 6-7 p.m and can be heard on KMAJ 1440 AM.

✓ **THE COACHES:** Ron McHenry begins his second season on the bench for the Lady Blues.

McHenry was named the head coach on May 8, 2000, taking over for Patty Dick, who retired in April.

He became only the fifth coach in the history of the women's basketball program at Washburn and the first new head coach since Dick joined the Lady Blues as the head coach in the 1977-78 season.

McHenry led Washburn to a 13-14 record in his first season, which was also his first season as a head coach at the collegiate level.

Prior to his new appointment, McHenry spent the previous 11 seasons as a member of the men's basketball coaching staff under current coach Bob Chipman. While on the Washburn bench, he was a part of 243 wins. In addition to his basketball duties, McHenry was the men's golf coach for eight seasons.

McHenry has had a diverse coaching career. He began his career as a graduate assistant to Chipman during the 1984-85 season. He then went on to Perry High School in 1986 where he served as assistant boys coach.

McHenry quickly moved up the coaching ranks in 1988 when he assumed an assistant's position with the Topeka Sizzlers of the Continental Basketball Association. McHenry eventually became the Sizzlers' interim head coach before joining the Washburn staff for the 1989-90 campaign. During his first year on the Washburn staff, McHenry was the department's academic advisor.

McHenry played for Washburn after stints at Coffeyville Community College and the University of Kansas. He started for the Ichabods during the 1983-84 season.

He graduated from Washburn with a bachelor's degree in communications and went on to earn a master's degree in sports administration from Wichita State University in 1987.

McHenry and his wife, Mischa, have three children, Danielle, Samantha and Ronnie. Danielle is a freshman on the University of Kansas volleyball team.

✓ LADY BLUES NOTES:
Washburn is 22-9 in all-time season opening games and 1-0 under coach Ron McHenry. The Lady Blues have won 18 of their last 19 openers.

✓ LADY BLUES LAST TIME OUT:
The Lady Blues topped Spartak Moscow 72-68 in an exhibition game in Lee Arena Saturday night.

Washburn was led by Kristy Chapman's 22 points effort on 6-of-10 shooting from the field, while Carissa Goglein added 13 points.

✓ LADY BUILDERS NOTES:
The Lady Builders fell to 2-1 after a loss at Oklahoma Christian Monday night.

Niki Nicholas leads the team with 18.0 points and 7.7 rebounds a game but may not play in tonight's game

because of a knee injury.

✓ SERIES NOTES: Tonight's meeting is the seventh between the two squads with the series noddod at three wins apiece. The last meeting between the two squads was during the 1972-73 season, when Washburn topped Southwestern 52-42 under coach Belinda McPherson.

✓ LADY BLUES IN LEE ARENA:
In 17 seasons in Lee Arena, the Lady Blues are 199-50 (.799). The Lady Blues were 8-5 at home last season. The longest winning streak was 44 games from Dec. 1, 1990 to March 20, 1993.

✓ LADY BLUES HISTORY:
Washburn is 482-276 (.638) in its 32nd season of intercollegiate action.
