NO. 1 WASHBURN LOOKING FOR 40TH CONSECUTIVE WIN; HOSTING GRIFFONS ON WEDNESDAY NIGHT . . .

The No. 1 ranked Washburn Lady Blues will take on Missouri Western for the second time in a weeks period Feb. 1 in Lee Arena at 5:30 p.m. Washburn enters the game looking for its 40th consecutive win dating back to last season and their 21st straight to open the current campaign. Missouri Western enters the game with a 14-6 overall record and a 4-5 MIAA record after dropping a 69-61 decision at Missouri Southern on Jan. 28. The Lady Blues improved to 20-0 and 9-0 in the MIAA after topping Truman 77-61 last time out on Saturday.

LADY BLUES ON RADIO . . .

Lady Blues games will be broadcast on AM 580-WIBW radio with former Washburn quarterback Mark Elliott calling all the action. Bruce Steinbrock will provide color analysis for the games.

LADY BLUES ON TELEVISION . . .

Tonight's game will be broadcast live on KTWU - Channel 11 in Topeka. AM 580-WIBW Greg Sharpe, Director of Operations will provide the play by play and Brenda VanLengen will provide the color commentary. Sharpe was the former voice of K-State athletics and VanLengen has done games for Fox Sports Midwest, Metro Sports, ESPN radio for KU women's broadcasts and ESPN2. She was a two-time Academic All-American at Nebraska-Kearney, and played against Washburn in the CSIC conference. Wednesday's game will be broadcast live on KTWU in Topeka. The broadcasts also are available in Pittsburg (Ch. 11 on Cox Cable), Emporia (Ch. 11 on CableOne) and St. Joseph (Ch. 11 on St. Joseph Cablevision). KTWU also retransmits its signal over the air on K30AL-TV (Channel 30), based in Iola, Kan. Most of eastern Kansas will have access to these games through various cable systems. The games will be available in the Kansas City area (Kansas side only) on Time Warner Cable channel 19, as well as channel 5 on Comcast Cable in Olathe and channel 9 on Everest Cable in Johnson County.

LADY BLUES LAST TIME OUT . . .

No. 1 Washburn 77, Truman 61 (Jan. 28, 2006) TOPEKA - The No. 1 ranked Washburn Lady Blues improved to 20-0 and 9-0 in the MIAA with their 77-61 win over Truman State. The win was the 39th straight for the Lady Blues dating back to last season and they will look for No. 40 against Missouri Western on Wednesday at 5:30 p.m. in Lee Arena.

Washburn shot 42 percent in the opening half on 15 of 36 shooting while holding the Bulldogs to 9 of 24 shooting. The Lady Blues opened up a lead as many as 12 in the first half before taking a 36-26 lead into the break. Washburn forced 14 turnovers for Truman while coughing up six of their own.

In the second half, both teams heated up from the field with the Lady Blues shooting 49 percent from the field and Truman improved to 44 percent, but it was not enough as the Lady Blues pushed its lead to as many as 24 at 71-47 before cruising to the 16-point win.

Washburn was led by Jennifer Harris who scored 14 of her game-high 27 in the second half. She was 11 of 19 from the field with four assists and three steals in 27 minutes of action. Brooke Ubelaker scored 18 points and Megan Sullivan scored 14. April Roadhouse tied a career-high with eight assists and no turnovers to go along with five steals.

Katie Fowler led three Bulldogs in double figures with 16 points.

Washburn turned 21 Bulldog turnovers into 32 points and scored more on the break topping Truman 14-0. Washburn collected a total of 38 rebounds with 18 coming on the offensive end.

THE COACHES . . .

Since his appointment as head coach prior to the 2000-01 season, Ron McHenry has quickly returned the Washburn women's basketball program to national prominence.

In 2004-05, McHenry was named MIAA Coach of the Year and Molten/Division II Bulletin National Coach of the Year after guiding Washburn to its first-ever NCAA Division II crown in any sport. He also led the Lady Blues to a third straight MIAA regular season title, an MIAA Tournament title and a South Central Regional title with a 35-2 record.

In his five seasons McHenry has posted a 147-32 (.821) record overall and 76-23 (.767) record in the MIAA. He is 134-18 (.882) the last five seasons. He is fourth among active women's NCAA Division II Coaches in winning percentage and has the 10th most wins in MIAA history.

The Lady Blues posted a 26-5 record and won a second straight MIAA regular season crown in 2003-04. The Lady Blues also earned a berth to the NCAA Division II National Tournament for the third straight year.

In only his third season in 2002-03, McHenry guided the Lady Blues to a regular season MIAA title, a Sonic/MIAA Tournament championship and a berth to the Division II Elite Eight.

The Lady Blues tied for second most wins in team history at 30-4 and went to the Elite Eight for the third time in team history.

In his second season McHenry engineered one of the best turnarounds in Division II, guiding Washburn to the South Central Regional and finishing with a 23-7 record.

He guided the Lady Blues to back-to-back 20 win seasons after finishing with a 13-14 record in 2000-01, which was also his first season as a head coach at the collegiate level.

McHenry was named the head coach on May 8, 2000.

He became only the fifth coach in the history of the women's basketball program at Washburn and the first new head coach since Patty Dick joined the Lady Blues as the head coach in the 1977-78 season.

Prior to his new appointment, McHenry spent the previous 11 seasons as a member of the men's basketball coaching staff under current coach Bob Chipman. While on the Washburn bench, he was a part of 243 wins. In addition to his basketball duties, McHenry was the men's golf coach for eight seasons.

He graduated from Washburn with a bachelor's degree in communications and went on to earn a master's degree in sports administration from Wichita State University in 1987.

McHenry and his wife, Mischa, have three children, Danielle, Samantha and Ronnie.

Missouri Western head coach Josh Keister is in his second season as the Griffons head coach after spending the previous five seasons as the Griffons' top assistant coach. He is 34-15 in his second year at Western and 0-4 against Washburn.

Keister received his bachelor's degree in business administration from Mount Mercy (Iowa) College in 1996.

MISSOURI WESTERN SERIES NOTES . . .

Washburn is 32-35 against the Griffons all-time after beating Western in all three meetings last season. Washburn has won eight straight in the series after dropping the previous 11 meetings with the Griffons. In Topeka, Washburn has won the last two meetings.

LAST TIME OUT AGAINST THE GRIFFONS . . .

(Jan. 25, 2006) ST. JOSEPH, Mo. - The No. 1 ranked Washburn Lady Blues completed the first half of the MIAA season with a perfect 8-0 record lifting its overall record to 19-0 in a 74-66 win over Missouri Western.

The Lady Blues trailed at 2-0 before building a 19-8 lead with 11:23 remaining in the opening stanza. Washburn shot 52 percent in the first half hitting 15 of 29 shots in the half including 4 of 7 from 3-point range. Washburn held the Griffons to 35 percent shooting limiting Western to 11 of 31 from the field. Washburn led the rest of the half in the first half taking a 37-24 lead into the break.

In the second half, Washburn pushed its lead to 14 at 38-24, before the Griffons rallied to cut the score down to six at 57-51 with seven minutes remaining. After a layup by Megan Sullivan off a Jennifer Harris assist. Washburn was up by 11 after Harris converted a three-point play. Washburn was up by 10 with :56 seconds remaining, but hit 2 of 6 free throws over a :19 second period as Western would get with six at 70-64 with :26 remaining. Washburn was fouled again and April Roadhouse and Sullivan each hit a pair of free throws increasing the lead to 10 before Western would hit a lay up as time expired.

Harris led Washburn with 33 points in 39 minutes. She was 13 of 26 from the field for the game. Brooke Ubelaker scored 17 points and recorded 10 rebounds for her first Washburn double double. She also had a career-high six assists. Sullivan finished with 13 points and eight rebounds. Jill Johnson led Western with 17 points and 10 rebounds.

ABOUT THE GRIFFONS . . .

The Griffons are 14-6 overall and 4-5 in the MIAA this season. Western has gone 3-5 over their last eight games, including two straight losses, after winning 10-straight at one point this season. In the last six games, Jill Johnson has led the Griffons in scoring averaging 19.3 points per game with outputs of 24, 19, 22, 18, 17 and 16. Inga Buzoka leads the Griffons in scoring this season with a 13.5 ppg average and 7.7 rpg. She is averaging 12.8 ppg and 8.5 rpg in MIAA play. Also averaging in double figures is Johnson with 13.4 ppg, Tiffany Davis with 11.6 ppg and Brandi Rodgers with 11.0 ppg. Western is fourth in the MIAA in scoring defense allowing 60.2 ppg behind Washburn who is allowing 54.2 ppg. The Griffons are last in the league in 3-point shooting percentage hitting 96 of 364 attempts (.261).

Last time out for the Griffons - Jan. 28, 2006 — JOPLIN, Mo. -- Missouri Southern out-scored Missouri Western, 18-9, over the final 3:12 of the game to secure a 69-61 victory Saturday night (Jan. 28) at the Leggett & Platt Athletic Center.

Robin Kantin made a pair of free throws to give Southern (13-7, 5-4 MIAA) a 53-52 lead with 3:12 to go. The Lions scored nine of the next 11 points -- on a pair of three-pointers from Marina Caran and another by Dana-Mae Robbs -- for a 62-54 lead with 1:06 to go.

Southern scored the first five points of the game, before Western (14-6, 4-5 MIAA) went on a 17-6 run for a six-point lead with 11:17 to go in the first half. Inga Buzoka's consecutive buckets sparked the run.

The Lions scored seven straight points -- the last five contributed by Caran -- for a brief two-point lead, 27-25, with 2:52 to go. Western would get baskets by Tiffany Davis and Jill Johnson to regain the lead, and Griffons held a 32-31 lead at the break.

Western led by five, 39-34, when the Lions used a 14-4 run for a five-point lead of their own with 6:04 to go, 48-43. The Griffons would score six straight points, four from Jill Johnson, for a 49-48 lead with 4:48 left.

Kantin converted a traditional three-point play with 4:35 left to put MSSU ahead, 51-49, with 4:35 left. Johnson answered for Western by making a three-pointer with 3:22 left to give the Griffons their last lead, 52-51.

Kantin logged her second double-double in as many games with 19 points and 12 rebounds to go with four assists. Caran scored 16 points and Robbs added 13 in reserve roles, while Dacie Ruetlinger had 10 points.

Johnson had 16 points and 11 rebounds for the Griffons, while Buzoka had 15 points and three blocked shots. Brandi Rodgers scored 10 points, while Davis had eight points and 12 assists.

Southern was 25-of-29 (86.2 percent) from the foul line in the game, and forced Western into 21 turnovers.

HARRIS CONTINUING ROLL FROM LAST SEASON . . .

Senior Jennifer Harris led the Lady Blues with 14.4 points a game last season earning just honorable mention All-MIAA. Harris had a career-high 31 points in the regional final against Emporia State March 14. She was named South Central Regional MVP. She also scored 21 points (all in second half) at Kansas Dec. 2, and a then-career best 26 points at Drury Dec. 11 last season.

Harris, named to the Division II Bulletin's Super 16 Preseason All-American team, has a 121-3 record in her collegiate career after going 30-1 (2002-03) and 36-0 (2003-04) to win a national title at Trinity Valley Community College and 35-2 with the Lady Blues last season.

Harris leads the team in scoring this season with a 21.4 points per game average and second in the MIAA behind Michelle Stueve's 21.7 ppg. She has gone over the 20-point mark 10 times this season including a then-career-high 33 points against No. 2 ranked Drury on Dec. 17. She topped that tally scoring a school record 39 points against Northwest Missouri on Jan. 4, recording 22 points in the second half against the Bearcats. Against No. 3 Emporia State on Jan. 4, she scored 20 points in the final 9:23 of the game finishing with 28 in the 72-70 win in Emporia.

Harris' 944 points rank No. 20 on the all-time Washburn scoring chart.

ROADHOUSE DISHING IT OUT & REJECTING SHOTS . . .

This season, April Roadhouse is dishing out the rock with 87 assists, while committing 35 turnovers. She is second in the MIAA in assist to turnover ratio with a 2.49 to 1.00 ratio. Roadhouse has 361 assists in her career which is fourth in Washburn history. Her 164 steals is sixth in school history. She had a career-high five blocks against Pitt State on Jan. 18. She has 48 career blocks, which is 11th on the Washburn all-time chart.

The senior guard is averaging 27.6 minutes per game this season and her 2,686 minutes played is the seventh most played since the 1988 season in Lady Blues history.

UBELAKER MOVING ON UP CAREER CHARTS . . .

Junior Brooke Ubelaker became the 18th Lady Blue to pass the 1,000 point mark December 21 with 27 points against Cameron in Las Vegas. With 1,148 career points she is ninth on the list. Ubelaker has made 435 of

807 (.539 percent) field goal attempts in her career and she has made 160 of 204 free throws (.784 percent).

Ubelaker currently has 491 rebounds in her career. She is tied for 15th in rebounding in Washburn career history. With nine rebounds, she would become only the 13th person in school history to have 1,000 points and 500 rebounds. Her 118 3-pointers is fourth on the all-time chart. She trails only Lora Westling (144), Kristy Chapman (122), Alison Garrett (120) on the all-time chart.

LADY BLUES IN LEE ARENA . . .

In their 22nd season in Lee Arena, the Lady Blues are 270-53 (.836) overall at home. The longest winning streak was 44 games from Dec. 1, 1990 to March 20, 1993.

The Lady Blues were 15-0 in Lee Arena last season, outscoring opponents by a 78.2-49.9 average. The Lady Blues were 13-1 in Lee Arena in 2003-04, 16-1 in 2002-03 and 15-1 in 2001-02.

Washburn is 78-8 (.901) in home games under Ron McHenry. The Lady Blues currently have a 33-game winning streak in Lee Arena. The current winning streak of 33 games is the 12th longest in NCAA Division II history.

LADY BLUES HISTORY . . .

Washburn is 628-315 (.666 in 943 games) in its 37th season of inter-collegiate action. Entering this season, the Lady Blues were 24th in Division II winning percentage and 18th in Division II wins.

LADY BLUES IN THE NATIONAL POLL . . .

(Jan. 24, 2006): The Washburn Lady Blues basketball team retained its position as the No. 1 team in the USA Today/ESPN Top 25 Coaches Poll that was released Jan. 14, taking 23 of 25 first-place votes. The Lady Blues, who received 18 first place votes in the preseason poll from Nov. 8, also received 22 first place votes in the first six polls of the season.

It was also the 54th straight WBCA National Poll that the Lady Blues have been ranked in the top 25.

The Lady Blues were ranked in all 21 polls each of the last two seasons and were ranked in the last 15 polls in the 2002-03 season after entering the poll Dec. 11, 2002.

(Jan. 25, 2005): The Washburn Lady Blues basketball team was the top team in the second NCAA South Central Regional Poll of the season. The Lady Blues have wins over the No. 2 and No. 3 ranked teams in Emporia State and West Texas A&M along with wins over No. 5 Cameron, No. 7 Northwest Missouri, No. 8 ranked Missouri Western, and No. 10 Missouri Southern. For those scoring at home, former south central regional foe Drury is No. 1 in the Great Lakes Region, who the Lady Blues topped 89-66 on Dec. 2 in Topeka.

overall winning streak of 39 games. The Lady Blues have also won their last 50 non-conference games. Their last non-conference loss came to Drury in the 2004 NCAA South Central Regional in Springfield, Mo., on March 13, 2004 by a 67-55 score.
