#### NO. 1 WASHBURN HEADS TO SBU FOR 2ND STRAIGHT ROAD GAME . . .

The No. 1 ranked Washburn Lady Blues will take on Southwest Baptist on Saturday night in Bolivar, Mo., looking for a season-sweep of the Lady Bearcats. Washburn enters the game with a 23-0 record and a 12-0 mark in MIAA play sitting on top of the conference, one game ahead of Emporia State. The Bearcat are 10-12 and 2-9 in the MIAA, currently in eighth place one game behind Pittsburg State and one game ahead of Truman State in the standings. Washburn blasted Pittsburg State last time out 95-65 and the Lady Bearcats had Wednesday night off with their MIAA bye game and have not played since a 64-50 setback at Missouri Western on Feb. 4.

After Saturday's game, Washburn will play three of their final four regular season games on the road with only a home date with No. 3 Emporia State next Wednesday in Lee Arena. The Lady Blues will then travel to Northwest Missouri on Feb. 22 and to Central Missouri on Feb. 25 to wrap up the regular season. The Lady Blues have already clinched a spot in the MIAA Postseason Tournament March 2-5 in Kansas City.

#### LADY BLUES ON RADIO . . .

Lady Blues games will be broadcast on AM 580-WIBW radio with former Washburn quarterback Mark Elliott calling all the action. Bruce Steinbrock will provide color analysis for the games.

NCAA II history and improved to 23-0 (12-0 MIAA).

Washburn trailed early at 2-0 as the Gorillas took the opening tap and scored, but from that point on, it was all Washburn as they rolled to a 15-point lead via a 19-2 run over the next 3:45. The Gorillas rallied and cut the lead back to five at 22-17 and eventually to two at 32-30 with 3:29 left, but would not get any closer the rest of the half as the Lady Blues ripped off a 12-2 run to end the half taking a 44-32 lead into the break.

In the second half, Washburn continued their hot shooting from the first half (55.6 percent) and shot 55.9 percent in the second half hitting 19 of 34 shots rolling to the 30-point win. The Gorillas sliced the lead to nine on two separate occasions, but Washburn led by double digits the remainder of the game pushing the lead to 30 as time expired.

Harris was 8 for 12 in the first half, making 4 of 5 3-pointers. She finished the night 12 for 19 and 5 for 7 from 3-point range. Brooke Ubelaker had 16 points with 14 of them coming in the second half with 4 of 6 shooting. April Roadhouse had a career-high 10 assists and finished with 11 points. It was her first double double of her Washburn career.

Lady Blues coach Ron McHenry won his 150th game on the Washburn bench lifting his career coaching record to 150-32.

## THE COACHES . . .

Since his appointment as head coach prior to the 2000-01 season, Ron McHenry has quickly returned the Washburn women's basketball program to national prominence.

In 2004-05, McHenry was named MIAA Coach of the Year and Molten/Division II Bulletin National Coach of the Year after guiding Washburn to its first-ever NCAA Division II crown in any sport. He also led the Lady Blues to a third straight MIAA regular season title, an MIAA Tournament title and a South Central Regional title with a 35-2 record.

In his five seasons McHenry has posted a 150-32 (.823) record overall and 79-23 (.772) record in the MIAA. He is 137-18 (.883) the last five seasons. He is fourth among active women's NCAA Division II Coaches in winning percentage and has the 10th most wins in MIAA history.

The Lady Blues posted a 26-5 record and won a second straight MIAA regular season crown in 2003-04. The Lady Blues also earned a berth to the NCAA Division II National Tournament for the third straight year.

In only his third season in 2002-03, McHenry guided the Lady Blues to a regular season MIAA title, a Sonic/MIAA Tournament championship and a berth to the Division II Elite Eight.

The Lady Blues tied for second most wins in team history at 30-4 and went to the Elite Eight for the third time in team history.

In his second season McHenry engineered one of the best turnarounds in Division II, guiding Washburn to the South Central Regional and finishing with a 23-7 record.

He guided the Lady Blues to back-to-back 20 win seasons after finishing with a 13-14 record in 2000-01, which was also his first season as a head coach at the collegiate level.

McHenry was named the head coach on May 8, 2000.

He became only the fifth coach in the history of the women's basketball program at Washburn and the first new head coach since Patty Dick joined the Lady Blues as the head coach in the 1977-78 season.

Prior to his new appointment, McHenry spent the previous 11 seasons as a member of the men's basketball coaching staff under current coach Bob Chipman. While on the Washburn bench, he was a part of 243 wins. In addition to his basketball duties, McHenry was the men's golf coach for eight seasons.

He graduated from Washburn with a bachelor's degree in communications and went on to earn a master's degree in sports administration from Wichita State University in 1987.

McHenry and his wife, Mischa, have three children, Danielle, Samantha and Ronnie.

**Southwest Baptist head coach Jim Middleton** is in his 11th season as the head coach at Southwest Baptist. Middleton (203-130) a Southwest Missouri State graduate has spent his entire head coaching career at Southwest Baptist. Middleton led the Lady Bearcats to a 11-17 mark last season and finished (5-13) 8th in the MIAA.

## SOUTHWEST BAPTIST SERIES NOTES . . .

Washburn is 20-10 all-time against the Lady Bearcats and Washburn has won the last 11 meetings in the series. Washburn ended Southwest Baptist's season last year knocking them out of the MIAA Tournament in the quarterfinals with a 64-51 win. Washburn has won their

seventh straight meeting over Southwest Baptist in Topeka and they have won the last four in Bolivar. SBU's last win in the series was on Feb. 3, 2001 in a 73-65 win.

### **LAST TIME OUT AGAINST THE LADY BEARCATS . . .**

(Jan. 14, 2006) TOPEKA - The No. 1 ranked Washburn Lady Blues won its 35th straight game and its 31st in a row in Lee Arena with a 95-49 win over Southwest Baptist. The 46-point win is the most lopsided win over the Lady Bearcats in the 30-game series history and the 11th straight win over SBU overall.

Washburn (16-0, 5-0) led from start to finish building an 18-5 lead 4:14 into the game and never looked back as SBU cut the lead to 11 and not get closer the rest of the way as the Lady Blues took a 47-22 score into the break. Washburn shot a blistering 61 percent from the field in the first half hitting 19 of 31 attempts while limiting the Lady Bearcats (8-8, 1-5 MIAA) to 8 of 32 shooting from the field.

In the second half it was much the same as Washburn continued to roll building the lead to the final margin of 46.

Washburn had six players in double figures led by Cindy Keeley who scored a career-high 19 points on 7 of 10 shooting including a 4 of 5 performance from 3-point land. Bojana Samardziska recorded her first double double at Washburn with 13 points and 12 rebounds. Also in double figures were Jennifer Harris with 12, Amanda Holmes and Brooke Ubelaker with 11 and Jessica Mainz with 10.

SBU was paced by Casey Beavers and Livia Brito, each with 11.

Washburn finished the game shooting 58 percent from the field while SBU was held to 28 percent. Washburn also led on the boards as well outrebounding the Lady Bearcats 44 to 34 and forced 19 turnovers as well.

### **ABOUT THE LADY BEARCATS . . .**

The Lady Bearcats are 10-12 and 2-9 in the MIAA after dropping a 64-50 road game to Missouri Western on Feb. 4. SBU has lost three straight with a 40-point loss to Emporia State, a 10-point loss at Missouri Southern and the 14-point setback at Missouri Western. Livia Brito leads SBU with 12.0 ppg and Casey Beavers is averaging 10.2 points and 8.0 rebounds a game to pace the Lady Bearcats. The Lady Bearcats have played most of the season without Amber Wheeler, the 2004 MIAA MVP. She averaged 15.0 ppg, but only played in five games of the first nine scheduled games this season for SBU.

Last time out for the Lady Bearcats - Feb. 4, 2006 — ST. JOSEPH, Mo. -- The Missouri Western Griffons rallied from a first half where they shot just 28.1 percent from the field and handed Southwest Baptist a 64-50 setback Saturday night (Feb. 4) at the MWSU Fieldhouse.

The Griffons (15-7, 5-6 MIAA) struggled early in the first half, as SBU held an early 7-2 lead. Western answered with a 16-4 run from that point to take control. The

Grieffons led by eight late in the half before back-to-back layups from Livia Brito sliced it half by the break, 23-19.

Western out-scored SBU (10-12, 2-9 MIAA), 20-11, in the first 10 minutes of the second half -- their lead never slipped from double figures after that point.

The Griffons were led by junior C Inga Buzoka with a game-high 22 points and nine rebounds. Two other Griffons were in double figures. Senior G Brandi Rodgers added 15 points and junior G Tiffany Davis added 11.

Cortney Shewmaker was the only Lady Bearcat to score in double figures, leading the way with 17 points.

For the game, Western shot just 37 percent from the floor and 1-of-15 from the three-point line, but forced 26 SBU turnovers in the win.

### **HARRIS CONTINUING ROLL FROM LAST SEASON . . .**

Senior Jennifer Harris led the Lady Blues with 14.4 points a game last season earning just honorable mention All-MIAA. Harris had a career-high 31 points in the regional final against Emporia State March 14. She was named South Central Regional MVP. She also scored 21 points (all in second half) at Kansas Dec. 2, and a then-career best 26 points at Drury Dec. 11 last season.

Harris, named to the Division II Bulletin's Super 16 Preseason All-American team, has a 124-3 record in her collegiate career after going 30-1 (2002-03) and 36-0 (2003-04) to win a national title at Trinity Valley Community College and 35-2 with the Lady Blues last season.

Harris leads the team and the MIAA in scoring this season with a 22.7 points per game average. ESU's Michelle Stueve close behind at 21.4 ppg. She has gone over the 20-point mark 13 times this season including a then-career-high 33 points against No. 2 ranked Drury on Dec. 17. She topped that tally scoring a school record 39 points against Northwest Missouri on Jan. 4, recording 22 points in the second half against the Bearcats. Against No. 3 Emporia State on Jan. 4, she scored 20 points in the final 9:23 of the game finishing with 28 in the 72-70 win in Emporia.

Harris became the 19th Lady Blue to go over the 1,000 point mark with her 28 points against Missouri Southern. Her point total now sits at 1,039 points. She has scored 522 points this season (five more than all of the 2004-05 season), which ranks ninth on the single season scoring chart.

### **ROADHOUSE DISHING IT OUT & REJECTING SHOTS . . .**

This season, April Roadhouse is dishing out the rock with 104 assists, while committing 41 turnovers. She is second in the MIAA in assist to turnover ratio with a 2.54 to 1.00 ratio. Roadhouse has 378 assists in her career which is fourth in Washburn history. Her 170 steals is sixth in school history. She had a career-high five blocks against Pitt State on Jan. 18. She has 51 career blocks, which is 11th on the Washburn all-time chart.

The senior guard is averaging 28.6 minutes per game this season and her 2,793 minutes played is the seventh most played since the 1988 season in Lady Blues history.

### **LADY BLUES IN LEE ARENA . . .**

In their 22nd season in Lee Arena, the Lady Blues are 272-53 (.836) overall at home. The longest winning streak was 44 games from Dec. 1, 1990 to March 20, 1993.

The Lady Blues were 15-0 in Lee Arena last season, outscoring opponents by a 78.2-49.9 average. The Lady Blues were 13-1 in Lee Arena in 2003-04, 16-1 in 2002-03 and 15-1 in 2001-02.

Washburn is 80-8 (.909) in home games under Ron McHenry. The

### **LADY BLUES HISTORY . . .**

Washburn is 631-315 (.667 in 946 games) in its 37th season of inter-collegiate action. Entering this season, the Lady Blues were 24th in Division II winning percentage and 18th in Division II wins.

### **LADY BLUES IN THE NATIONAL POLL . . .**

**(Feb. 7, 2006):** The Washburn Lady Blues basketball team retained its position as the No. 1 team in the USA Today/ESPN Top 25 Coaches Poll that was released Feb. 7, taking 22 of 25 first-place votes. The Lady Blues, who received 18 first place votes in the preseason poll from Nov. 8, also received 22 first place votes in the first seven polls of the season.

It was also the 56th straight WBCA National Poll that the Lady Blues have been ranked in the top 25 after being ranked in each poll the last two seasons, plus the last 15 of the 2002-03 season entering the poll on Dec. 11, 2002.

#### WASHBURN TIP-INS . . .

• On top of the Lady Blues' 34-game winning streak in Lee Arena is an overall winning streak of 43 games. The Lady Blues have also won their last 50 non-conference games. Their last non-conference loss came to Drury in the 2004 NCAA South Central Regional in Springfield, Mo., on March 13, 2004 by a 67-55 score.

• The Lady Blues have won 33 consecutive regular season games setting a new Washburn record for consecutive regular season wins. The 1991-92 Lady Blues won their final four regular season games and the 1992-93 team won all 26 regular season games and the 1993-94 team won their first two regular season games before falling in its third game of the season.

• Washburn has not allowed an opponent to shoot better than 50 percent against them all season.

• Ron McHenry recorded his 150th on the Lady Blues bench against

Pitt State. It was in his 182nd game on the bench for the Lady Blues. Former head coach Patty Dick recorded her 150th win in her 270th game on the Washburn bench. The two would be the only Washburn Lady Blues coaches to reach at least a 150 wins.

• The 23 straight wins to open the season is the longest streak in the MIAA since Emporia State won their first 33 games before falling in the national championship game.

• The 42 straight wins for Washburn dating back to last season is tied for the second longest streak in NCAA D-II history. Should the Lady Blues record No. 43 against Southwest Baptist, they would pass North Dakota State for the second longest streak. The longest streak is held by North Dakota State who won 49 straight from Feb. 25, 1994 to Dec. 15, 1995.

• The Lady Blues have won 23 straight games away from Lee Arena counting all neutral site and road games.

• Megan Sullivan is averaging 10.8 rebounds per game and 7.8 points per game in the last five contests. She is shooting 58 percent from the field hitting 22 of 38 attempts.

• Jennifer Harris is averaging 31.0 points, 5.1 assists, 4.0 rebounds and 2.1 steals in the last five games.

• The four-year members of this year's senior class in April Roadhouse and Dani McHenry are 114-11 (.912). They have tied last season's four-year class of Lora Westling and Alison Garrett's four-year win total of 114 wins with only 18 losses for a .864 winning percentage. The 114 wins is the most in school history in a four-year period for any Lady Blue.

• In the Feb. 5 NCAA rankings, the Lady Blues were leading the nation in field goal percentage (.482) and were second in scoring margin (+28.0) trailing Emporia State, who has a +28.3 margin. They were fifth in rebound margin (+10.0) and sixth in scoring offense (84.3). They were also 13th in field goal percentage defense (34.5) and 28th in free throw percentage (.741).

• Individually in the NCAA rankings, Jennifer Harris was 6th in scoring (22.3) and Brooke Ubelaker was 39th (17.5). Harris was also ranked 21st in assists per game (5.5) and 39th in steals per game (2.8).
