Ron McHenry, 7th season

Since his appointment as head coach prior to the 2000-01 season, Ron McHenry has quickly returned the Washburn women's basketball program to national prominence.

In seven seasons on the Lady Blues bench, McHenry has won 82 percent of his games going 161-33 overall with four straight MIAA Championships and two straight MIAA Tournaments. During the 2005-06 season,

Washburn continued its NCAA record 51-game winning streak into the regional finals, where Washburn fell in overtime. For his efforts, he named the MIAA Coach of the Year after leading the team to a perfect 16-0 season.

In 2004-05, McHenry was named MIAA Coach of the Year and Molten/Division II Bulletin National Coach of the Year after guiding Washburn to its first-ever NCAA Division II crown in any sport. He also led the Lady Blues to a third straight MIAA regular season title, an MIAA Tournament title and a South Central Regional title with a 35-2 record.

In his seven seasons McHenry has posted a 161-33 (.828) record overall and 83-23 (.783) record in the MIAA. He is 146-11 the last five seasons. He is third among active women's NCAA Division II Coaches in winning percentage.

The Lady Blues posted a 26-5 record and a second straight MIAA regular season crown in 2003-04. The Lady Blues also earned a berth to the NCAA Division II National Tournament for the third straight year.

In only his third season in 2002-03, McHenry guided the Lady Blues to a regular season MIAA title, a Sonic/MIAA Tournament championship and a berth to the Division II Elite Eight.

The Lady Blues tied for second most wins in team history at 30-4 and went to the Elite Eight for the third time in team history. For his efforts he was named District VI Coach of the Year.

In his second season McHenry engineered one of the best turnarounds in Division II, guiding Washburn to the South Central Regional and finishing with a 23-7 record.

He guided the Lady Blues to back-to-back 20 win seasons after finishing with a 13-14 record in 2000-01, which was also his first season as a head coach at the collegiate level.

McHenry was named the head coach on May 8, 2000.

He became only the fifth coach in the history of the women's basketball program at Washburn and the first new head coach since Patty Dick joined the Lady Blues as the head coach in the 1977-78 season.

Prior to his new appointment, McHenry spent the previous 11 seasons as a member of the men's basketball coaching staff under current coach Bob Chipman. While on the Washburn bench, he was a part of 243 wins. In addition to his basketball duties, McHenry was the men's golf coach for eight seasons.

McHenry has had a diverse coaching career. He began his career as a graduate assistant to Chipman during the 1984-85 season. He then went on to Perry High School in 1986 where he served as assistant boys coach.

McHenry quickly moved up the coaching ranks in 1988 when he assumed an assistant's position with the Topeka Sizzlers of the Continental Basketball Association.

McHenry eventually became the Sizzlers' interim head coach before joining the Washburn staff for the 1989-90 campaign. During his first year on the Washburn staff, McHenry was the department's academic advisor.

McHenry played for Washburn after stints at Coffeyville Community College and the University of Kansas. He started for the Ichabods during the 1983-84 season.

He graduated from Washburn with a bachelor's degree in communications and went on to earn a master's degree in sports administration from Wichita State University in 1987.

McHenry and his wife, Mischa, have three children, Danielle, Samantha and Ronnie.

THE COACHES...

Washburn head coach Ron McHenry has posted a 161-33 (.834) record overall and 83-23 (.783) record in the MIAA with four consecutive MIAA regular season championships and the 2005 NCAA National Championship. He was named the Lady Blues head coach prior to the 2000-01 season. He is fourth among active women's NCAA Division II Coaches in winning percentage and has the 10th most wins in MIAA history. McHenry was named the MIAA's Coach of the Year in 2005 and in 2006 and the Division II Bulletin National Coach of the Year in 2005. (complete bio on page 2 of notes.)

Cameron's head coach Kevin Hackerott was introduced as the school's new women's basketball head coach on April 5, 2006, in a brief news conference on the CU campus. He is 0-3 in his first season at Cameron.

The former athletic director and head women's basketball coach at Pratt (Kan.) Community College, Hackerott was selected from a pool of more than 50 candidates and assumed official control of the Lady Aggie program on April 17.

In three seasons with the Pratt women's team, Hackerott guided the Lady Beavers to new heights. His teams have averaged 17 victories a year while establishing 20 new school records in the process, including season-high marks for points scored, assists and three-pointers made. Hackerott joined the Pratt program in 2003, and promptly guided the team to one of the best records in school history, finishing 20-12 and advancing to the quarterfinals of the ultra-competitive Kansas Jayhawk Community College Conference (KJCCC) postseason tournament.

Lynn head coach Pam DeCosta is in her fourth season at Lynn. She is 30-55 overall. Prior to arriving at Lynn University, DeCosta served as an assistant to head coach Mrian Washington at the University of Kansas for eight seasons. While at KU, DeCosta oversaw recruiting services of the women's basketball program. In addition to attracting some of the nation's top talent to Lawrence, DeCosta assisted in scouting, working with post players in practice sessions and handling various administrative duties. DeCosta also coached at Kansas from 1993-96 and in that time helped lead the Jayhawks to a Big Eight Championship and three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances, including a 1996 Sweet 16 Berth. In between her stints at KU, DeCosta worked at the University of Oklahoma from 1996-1998.

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE LADY BLUES...

(Nov. 17) EMPORIA, Kan. - The No. 6 Washburn Lady Blues used a 20-0 run over 5:40 stretch in the second half turning a 53-52 lead into a 73-52 advantage leading to a 93-65 win over Cameron in the ESU/Candlewood Suites Classic. The win lifts the Lady Blues to 2-0 on the season and drops Cameron to 0-3.

The Lady Blues jumped out to an early 10-3 lead before the Lady Aggies would come back and knot the score at 10. Washburn would rally to take the lead pushing the margin to as many as 12 in the first half at 39-27 on a 3-pointer by Brooke Ubelaker before Cameron would again come back and the cut the lead to five at 43-38 on a 3-pointer at the buzzer by the Lady Aggies Megan Atkins.

Washburn lead at 53-46 before Cameron cut the lead to one at 53-52 before the Lady Blues would go on their run to put the game away.

Corkey Stiger led the Lady Blues with 17 points off the bench. Jessica Aebi and Amanda Holmes each scored 14. Holmes added 10 rebounds for her second double-double at Washburn. Ubelaker added 11 and Renata Germano scored 10.

Washburn shot 63 percent in the second half connecting on 20 of 32 attempts and finished the game with a 49 percent average.

WASHBURN/CAMERON SERIES NOTES...

The Lady Blues lead the all-time series 4-0 with Washburn winning the last meeting six days ago in Emporia. The Lady Blues won the two meetings before that in games that were played in Las Vegas. The other meeting in Las Vegas was on Dec. 17, 2003 with the Lady Blues winning by a 72-61 score. The first meeting in the series on Dec. 7, 2002 in Springfield, Mo., with Washburn winning by a 64-54 count.

ABOUT CAMERON...

Cameron is still looking for their first win of the season after falling to Washburn on Nov. 17 by a score 96-65 and to Emporia State 81-56 the day before. Tiffany Williams leads the Lady Aggies with 14.3 points per game.

WASHBURN/LYNN SERIES NOTES...

The Lady Blues lead the all-time series with Lynn 1-0 winning their only meeting 58-47 on Dec. 18, 2002 in Boca Raton, Fla. The Lady Blues won the game lifting their record to 8-0 on the season. Washburn would go on to the Elite Eight in St. Joseph, Mo., that season. Current Lady Blues student assistant coach Lora Westling was a freshman on the team scoring three points in 17 minutes. All-American and MIAA MVP Crystal Walker led the Lady Blues that night with 15 points and 11 rebounds while Kristy Chapman scored 13 and Carissa Goeglein had 10.

ABOUT LYNN...

Lynn enters the holiday classic with a 2-0 record after topping Puerto Rico Mayaguez 68-57 and Puerto Rico Rio Piedras 95-39. Sarah Mahan leads four Fighting Knights in double figures averaging 14.0 ppg. Vanessa Black is averaging 13.5 ppg followed by Jade Williams with 12.0 ppg and Rae Rae Fripp with 10.0 ppg. Allegra Armstrong is nearly averaging a double-double with 9.5 points and 9.5 rebounds per game.

LAST TIME OUT FOR LYNN...

(Nov. 19) Fort Myers, Fla. - The Lynn University women's basketball team cruised to their second win to begin the season, easily dispatching Puerto Rico-Rio Piedras 95-39 in non-conference action.

Senior Allegra Armstrong had a career day, setting at least three personal records in the Fighting Knights (2-0) lopsided victory. The Palm Beach Gardens, Fla., native tied a career best with 17 points while grabbing 15 rebounds and four steals, both career highs.

Freshman Vanessa Black scored 17 points off the bench in just 18 minutes while senior Sara Mahan and sophomore Jade Williams each tallied double-figure points with 14 and 10 respectively.

It was also the 61st straight WBCA National Poll that the Lady Blues have been ranked in the top 25 after being ranked in each poll the last three seasons, plus the last 15 of the 2002-03 season entering the poll on Dec. 11, 2002.

The Lady Blues will take on Southwestern College from Winfield, Kan. on Dec. 4 at 7 p.m. in Lee Arena. It will be the first meeting between the two schools since Nov. 17, 2001 when the Lady Blues won 97-61 in Lee Arena.
